### About UMES

- The Hawks lost at George Mason to open the season, 64-38 and then defeated Elizabeth City State in their home opener on Saturday, 66-62.
- UMES was picked to finish sixth in the MEAC in the preseason polls.
- UMES comes into the season with one of the youngest rosters in the country. The Lady Hawks have nine freshmen on the roster, tying with Maine for the most freshmen on a D-I women's basketball team this season. The UMES freshmen, who hail from six different states, make up over half the roster with nine of the 16 players.
- The top four scorers from last season, Chelsea Sanders, Kwinnyata Mercer, Adobi Agbasi and Amber Cook, all finished their careers last year. The team lost over 78% of its scoring from last season into this year. The leading scorer among returners is senior Karona Roach, who averaged four points a game last year, followed by senior Sha-Kiyla Finney's 2.3 points a contest.

### About Old Dominion

- Old Dominion is 3-0 for the first time since the 2007-08 season after defeating VCU on Saturday, 74-51.
- The Lady Monarchs snapped a four-game losing streak to the Rams on Saturday and have now won 56 of the 70 all-time match-ups.
- On Nov. 13 in their home opener, senior Jackie Cook scored a career-high 24 points and ODU forced 34 turnovers in a 77-46 win over USC Upstate. The 31-point is the largest for ODU in non-conference since Dec. 2008.
- The Lady Monarchs return seven letterwinners and three starters from last season when they went 11-21.
- Head Coach Karen Barefoot added five newcomers in the offseason as six new faces will see action in the 2012-13 season.
- Incoming freshmen include guards Galaisha Goodhope and LaQuanda Younger and center Brittany Martin. Transfers in to ODU include forward Shae Kelley and guard Stephanie Gardner.
- ODU was picked to finish fifth in the preseason CAA poll.

### **Karen Barefoot**

ODU head coach Karen Barefoot enters her 14th year as a head coach in 2012-13 and 200 plus wins in her career as she leads the Lady Monarch program in year two. As head coach at the Apprentice School in 2001, she led the Builders to a National Championship in the school's first ever women's sport while taking Lenoir-Rhyne the NCAA Tournament in the 2002-03 season. In 2010-11 while at Elon, she led the Phoenix to the WBI, the schools first ever women's basketball tournament appearance. The last time that ODU made the NCAA Tournament was in 2008 when Barefoot was an assistant coach for the Lady Monarchs and helped them make the Sweet 16.

### **Cook Named CAA Player of the Week**

Senior Jackie Cook was named the CAA Player of the Week on Monday, Nov. 19 after leading the Lady Monarchs to a 2-0 record on the week with wins over USC Upstate and former CAA opponent VCU. The senior averaged team highs of 18.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game.

She opened the week scoring a career-high 24 points against USC Upstate in 27 minutes of play on 83.3 percent shooting (10-of-12) from the floor to go along with a career-high five steals. On Saturday, Cook missed tying her career-best by one in rebounds with 10 boards against VCU in recording her second career double-double as she added 12 points.

Cook finished the week shooting 66.7 percent (14-for-21) from the field, 66.7 percent (4-for-6) from long range and 80 percent (4-for-5) from the free-throw line. The senior also added six assists, seven steals and one block on the week for the Lady Monarchs.

### **ODU Batters VCU**

Jackie Cook registered her second career double-double and was one of three Lady Monarchs to register double figures as Old Dominion snapped its four-game losing streak to VCU on Saturday with a 74-51 win in Norfolk.

ODU has now won 56 of the 70 all-time meetings. The 3-0 start for the Lady Monarchs is their first since the 2007-08 season while the 23-point victory over VCU is their largest since a 94-66 victory in Norfolk on Feb. 24, 2006.

Cook scored 12 points and scooped a game-high 10 rebounds while sophomore Ashley Betz-White scored a season-high 17 points to go along with four steals and three rebounds. Sophomore Myeisha Hall was the game's leading scorer at halftime with 10 points and five rebounds and finished with 11 points and eight rebounds in the contest.

Old Dominion's pressure defense continues to give opponents trouble as the Rams were forced into 25 turnovers with ODU scoring 22 points off those turnovers. VCU shot just 15.4% from three-point range as they were 2-for-13 in the game and shot just 31.3% from the field overall. ODU had a 16-0 advantage in fast break points.

### **ODU Too Much for Spartans**

Jackie Cook had 18 points by halftime and ODU jumped out to a 16-3 lead and never looked back on Nov. 13 in a 77-46 win over USC Upstate in their home-opener.

Cook racked up a career-high 24 points and five steals as ODU scored 34 points over 34 Spartan turnovers. Sophomore Shae Kelley added 10 points and seven rebounds while freshman Galaisha Goodhope scored 12 points and had two steals off the bench.

### **Lady Monarchs Sign Two**

Coach Barefoot announced the addition of Odegua Oigbokie and Destinee Young who signed letters of intent to play for the Lady Monarchs next fall on Nov. 14.

Oigbokie is a highly touted forward from Ridgeway High School in Memphis, Tenn., while Young is a power forward out of Hoffman Estates High School in Hoffmann Estates, Ill.

Oigbokie, who is 6-foot-1, averaged 18 points and eight rebounds as a junior and has been named all-district and all-region for Ridgeway the past two seasons. Young, who is also 6-foot-1, averaged 15.4 points and 11 rebounds as a junior at Hoffman Estates High School, where she already is the record holder for career rebounds and single-season blocks.

Out of the five recruits that second-year head coach Karen Barefoot has landed at ODU, four have been rated as three stars or better by ESPN. The other three were local freshmen guards Galaisha Goodhope out of Norfolk and LaQuanda Younger of Newport News and forward Chelisa Painter from Chesapeake who is sitting out this season after transferring from George Washington.

### **ODU Smother Hokies Defensively**

Jackie Cook (17 pts, 9 asst) and sophomore Shae Kelley (14 pts, 9 asst) each missed a double-double by just a single assist as the Lady Monarchs locked down defensively in their season-opening 55-35 win at Virginia Tech on Nov. 9.

It was the lowest output for the Hokies against ODU since their initial meeting back in 1972 when VT scored 29 points, a span of 30 games. The last time ODU held an opponent to 35 total points and 13 points at the half was on Dec. 8, 2010 vs. George Washington.



# Game # 4 at UMES - Nov. 20, 2012

Virginia Tech shot just 19.6% in the first half from the field and finished the game 0-for-12 from behind the arc. ODU improved to 29-15 all-time in season openers with the win at Virginia Tech on Friday.

### Stepping Up Defensively

In three games this season, ODU has forced 75 turnovers, collected 33 steals and held their opponents to just 3-for-31 (9.7%) from behind the three-point line.

### Captains

Senior guard Jackie Cook, senior forward Mairi Buchan and sophomore forward Shae Kelley have been selected as team captains for the 2012-13 season.

### Young Monarchs

Old Dominion is ranked 22nd in the country in terms of most inexperienced teams in the country. The Lady Monarchs have just 16 years of combined experience with three freshmen and five newcomers. ODU is the highest ranked team in the CAA and in the state of Virginia on the list.

### Lady Monarchs Picked Fifth

Old Dominion was picked to finish fifth this season in the CAA pre-season poll. The voting was done by the league's head coaches. Delaware was picked to win the CAA, followed by James Madison, Hofstra and Drexel. Old Dominion and Northeastern followed, while George Mason and UNCW tied for seventh. Towson and William & Mary tied for ninth, followed by Georgia State.

### Betz-White Preseason All-CAA

Sophomore Ashley Betz-White was listed as honorable mention on the preseason All-CAA teams. Last season, she was named the CAA Rookie of the Year and to the All-CAA Rookie Team after leading all CAA freshmen in points per game (8.1), assists per game (3.4) and minutes per game (31.3). Betz-White became just the sixth player in program history to record over 100 assists in her first year.

### Kelley A Key

Sophomore forward Shae Kelley has already made a big impact on her teammates as she was selected as one of the team captains for 2012-13 despite not having played a single minute yet for Old Dominion. The Colorado native has scored in double-digit in two of the three regular season games so far and in the exhibition victory as well.

### Betz-White Shines in First Year

Sophomore Ashley Betz-White was named the CAA Rookie of the Year in 2011-12 and finished the season with 110 assists which made her only the sixth Lady Monarch in school history to have 100 assists her rookie season.

Mairi Buchan was named to the Capital One Academic All-District First Team in 2011-12. The teams are selected by College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Buchan holds a 3.92 grade point average majoring in biology (pre-med).

### Brandao and Gardner

Sophomore guard transfer Stephanie Gardner will be eligible to play on Dec. 19 at UNLV while junior guard transfer Michalle Brandao will be eligible to play on Jan. 2 vs. Pittsburgh. Both players are sitting out due to NCAA transfer rules.

### Newcomers

Head Coach Karen Barefoot added three freshmen this season in local talented guards Galaisha Goodhope and LaQuanda Younger along with center Brittany Martin out of the New York. Transferring in are forward Shae Kelley and Miami (FL) transfer guard Stephanie Gardner. The incoming class is ranked the best in the CAA and No. 42 in the country overall.

### NCAA Host Site

Old Dominion has been selected as one of four host sites for regional semifinals and finals for the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Games will be played at the Ted Constant Convocation Center on March 31 and April 2 with the winner advancing to the NCAA Final Four in New Orleans.
