About Stony Brook

- The Seawolves are out of the America East Conference and were picked to finish fourth in the league's preseason poll. Stony Brook brings back 10 letter-winners, including four starters, from that squad that reached the America East Tournament semifinals a year ago. That group accounted for over 72 percent of the Seawolves points and nearly 70 percent of their rebounding last season.

- Senior Kirsten Jeter, a 2009 second team all-conference selection and preseason candidate for America East Player of the Year, leads Stony Brook in scoring (11.2 ppg) and steals (22).

- Stony Brook has dropped contests to a pair of CAA teams already this season. Hofstra topped the Seawolves, 84-72, in November and George Mason dominated Stony Brook, 74-48, on December 9.

About Old Dominion

- Old Dominion is 4-1 at home this season, including wins over Louisville, Georgia Tech & George Washington.

- Senior Jasmine Parker leads the team with 14.5 points and 2.9 steals per game. The guard has hit for double figures in seven of eight games this year and she has led the team in scoring in five contests.

- Senior guard Shadasia Green leads the team in rebounding with 6.3 per game. She posted a season-high 10 boards at Richmond on December 12. The mark was only one rebound shy of her career-high.

- ODU has been dealing with a pair of significant injuries this season. Key reserve Mairi Buchan has missed every game with a foot injury, while senior Alena Voronina has missed the past three games with an elbow injury.

Game Day Notes

Richmond Recap

Senior Jasmine Parker tallied a team-high 13 points, but that was one of the lone bright spots in a 65-43 Old Dominion loss at Richmond on December 12. The Lady Monarchs never led in the contest and failed to score in the final three minutes after cutting the deficit to just 10. Old Dominion (4-4) shot just 27.3 percent from the floor and went 1-of-12 from beyond the arc. ODU scored just 18 first half points, its lowest effort in any half this season. Richmond (6-4) was led by senior Brittani Shells, who registered a game-high 23 points. The win was the Spiders first against the Lady Monarchs in their last 22 tries.

Dixon To Have Jersey Retired

Former Lady Monarch basketball All-American and Olympian Medina Dixon will have her jersey retired on Sunday, Jan. 30, prior to Old Dominion's 2 p.m. game against Georgia State at the Ted Constant Center. During her three years as a Lady Monarch, Dixon helped lead Old Dominion to an 84-14 record and two trips to the NCAA Final Four. In 1983 the Lady Monarchs rolled to a 29-6 record and hosted the Final Four in Norfolk. ODU lost the semi-final game to Louisiana Tech. As a senior in 1985, Dixon guided Old Dominion to a 31-3 record and the NCAA National Championship. The Lady Monarchs topped Georgia for the title and Dixon was named to the NCAA All-Tournament team. Dixon, a Boston, Mass. native, was a standout forward for ODU from 1982-85. She completed her career with 1,968 points, 979 rebounds, 417 assists and 277 steals. She ranks seventh all-time at Old Dominion in scoring and rebounding, fourth in steals and fifth in assists.

Defending The Three

Old Dominion has shut down its opponents on the perimeter early this season, ranking third nationally in three-point field goal defense (20.2%). Teams are 22-of-109 from beyond the arc against the Lady Monarchs this year.

RECORD CROWDS AT THE TED:

Old Dominion set the all-time women's basketball attendance record at the Ted Constant Center earlier this season when the Lady Monarchs hosted Tennessee. The game between the two historic programs was a **BLUE OUT** and a remarkable 7,774 fans packed the Ted. Old Dominion boasts a dominant 105-22 overall record in the Constant Center, including seven victories over nationally ranked opponents.

Milestone March

Head Coach Wendy Larry is approaching yet another milestone, just eight wins shy of her 600th career victory. She has compiled a 592-227 record in 27 seasons as a head coach, including 543 career wins at ODU.

Mid-Major Poll

Old Dominion dropped to No. 9 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, which was released December 14. Green Bay sits atop the rankings, while Delaware (No. 7), James Madison (No. 13), Drexel (No. 17) & Hofstra (25) also represent the CAA.

Parker Reaches 1,000

Senior guard Jasmine Parker became just the 28th all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points. With her game-high 16 points against No. 9/8 Tennessee, the guard from Norfolk reached the major plateau.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs will play one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule features games against four teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida, Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel).

ACC Win

Old Dominion topped Atlantic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008. The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

CAA Preseason Poll

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish second in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the league head coaches. Defending champion James Madison was pegged as the top team heading into 2010-11.

Openers

After topping Georgia Tech on Nov. 14, Old Dominion improves to 30-12 all-time in home openers. In season openers, the Lady Monarchs are 28-14 all-time.

NCAA Host Site

Old Dominion has been selected as one of 16 host sites for first- and second-round games in the 2012 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Games will be played at the Ted Constant Convocation Center on either March 17 and 19 or March 18 and 20, with exact dates and ticket availability for those contests to be released at a later date.

Exhibition Success

The Lady Monarchs went 2-0 in a pair of home exhibition games against Davis & Elkins and Bowie State. Junior Tia Lewis posted 20 points and 23 rebounds against D&E, while sophomore JoNiquia Guilford shined versus Bowie State with a game-high 19 points.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

900 WINS!

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 913-318 (.742) and is in its 42nd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.

2009-10 Recap/2010-11 Preview

•Old Dominion won the 2010 CAA regular season title, advanced to the CAA Tournament championship game and reached the WNIT second round before falling to BIG EAST foe Providence last year.

•The Lady Monarchs have reached the postseason in 18 of the past 19 years.
