- Senior guard Shadasia Green leads the team in rebounding with 6.3 per game. She posted a seasonhigh 10 boards at Richmond on December 12. The mark was only one rebound shy of her careerhigh.
- ODU has been dealing with a pair of significant injuries this season. Key reserve Mairi Buchan has missed every game with a foot injury, while senior Alena Voronina has missed the past three games with an elbow injury.

points, but that was one of the lone bright spots other milestone, just eight wins shy of her 600th in a 65-43 Old Dominion loss at Richmond on career victory. She has compiled a 592-227 re-December 12. The Lady Monarchs never led in the contest and failed to score in the final three career wins at ODU. minutes after cutting the deficit to just 10. Old Dominion (4-4) shot just 27.3 percent from the floor and went 1-of-12 from beyond the arc. ODU scored just 18 first half points, its lowest effort in any half this season. Richmond (6-4) was led by senior Brittani Shells, who registered a gamehigh 23 points. The win was the Spiders first against the Lady Monarchs in their last 22 tries.

Dixon To Have Jersey Retired

Former Lady Monarch basketball All-American and Olympian Medina Dixon will have her jersey retired on Sunday, Jan. 30, prior to Old Dominion's 2 p.m. game against Georgia State at the Ted Constant Center. During her three years as a Lady Monarch, Dixon helped lead Old Dominion to an 84-14 record and two trips to the NCAA Final Four. In 1983 the Lady Monarchs rolled to a 29-6 record and hosted the Final Four in Norfolk. ODU lost the semi-final game to Louisiana Tech. As a senior in 1985, Dixon guided Old Dominion to a 31-3 record and the NCAA National Championship. The Lady Monarchs topped Georgia for the title and Dixon was named to the NCAA All-Tournament team. Dixon, a Boston, Mass. native, was a standout forward for ODU from 1982-85. She completed her career with 1,968 points, 979 rebounds, 417 assists and 277 steals. She ranks seventh all-time at Old Dominion in scoring and rebounding, fourth in steals and fifth in assists.

Defending The Three

Old Dominion has shut down its opponents on the perimeter early this season, ranking third nationally in three-point field goal defense (20.2%). Teams are 22-of-109 from beyond the arc against the Lady Monarchs this year.

RECORD CROWDS AT THE TED:

Old Dominion set the all-time women's basketball attendance record at the Ted Constant Center earlier this season when the Lady Monarchs hosted Tennessee. The game between the two historic 2. Old Dominion programs was a **BLUE OUT** and a remarkable 3. Delaware 7,774 fans packed the Ted. Old Dominion boasts 4. Parker Reaches 1.000

Senior guard Jasmine Parker became just the 28th all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points. With her game-high 16 points against No 9/8 Tennessee, the guard from Norfolk reached the major plateau.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs will play one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule features games against four teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel)

ACC Win

Old Dominion topped Atlatic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008 The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish second in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the league head coaches. Defending champion James Madision was pegged as the top team heading into 2010-11.

Old Dominion has been selected as one of 16 host sites for first- and second-round games in the 2012 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Games will be played at the Ted Constant Convocation Center on either March 17 and 19 or March 18 and 20, with exact dates and ticket availability for those contests to be released at a later date.

Exhibition Success

The Lady Monarchs went 2-0 in a pair of home exhibition games against Davis & Elkins and Bowie State. Junior Tia Lewis posted 20 points and 23 rebounds against D&E, while sophomore JoNiquia Guilford shined versus Bowie State with a game-high 19 points.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

900 WINS!

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 913-318 (.742) and is in its 42nd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.
