ABOUT OLD DOMINION:

Old Dominion returns home to host #5 Tennessee, the third Top 25 and second Top Five team it will face this season. The Lady Monarchs return home after a two-game road trip that saw ODU fall 64-68 to Charlotte and pick up a 71-86 loss to Middle Tennessee, a team that is receiving votes in both major polls and knocked off No. 8 Georgia in Athens. The game against Middle Tennessee was a lot closer than the score indicated as the game endured 10 ties and 20 lead changes. The Lady Monarchs were led by starting point guard Jazzmin Walters with a career-high 13 points along with a career-high four steals and three assists. Both juniors Shahida Williams and T.J. Jordan added in 12. The Lady Monarchs had one of its best performance from the field and the line against the Blue Raiders. Old Dominion ended the evening hitting 48.1 percent from the floor and 72.2 from the charity stripe.

ABOUT TENNESSEE:

The Lady Vols enter Friday's contest with a 10-1 overall record and winners of four straight. Their lone set back of the season with a 57-70 loss at North Carolina back on December 3rd. Like the Lady Monarchs, Tennessee will be playing in its third game this week and are coming off a 66-51 victory at home over West Virginia on Wednesday. Tennessee is led by sophomore Candace Parker at 18.8 points per game and a team-leading 8.8 rebounds per game. Two other Lady Vols are averaging double figures including Sidney Spencer (12.5 ppg) and Alexis Hornbuckle (10.1 ppg).

SERIES WITH TENNESSEE:

Old Dominion has only faced CAA rival James Madison more times than it has the Tennessee Lady Vols. Friday's meeting will mark the 40th meeting between the two teams with the Lady Vols holding a 30-9 advantage in the all-time series sharing an annual game each season since the 1976-77 season. Old Dominion is looking for its first win over Tennessee in its last ten attempts. The last Lady Monarch win over the Lady Vols came in 1997 with an 83-72 regular season victory at the ODU Fieldhouse. Later that season in the NCAA Championship game, the roles were reversed as Tennessee walked away with the title. Old Dominion has not won in Knoxville since 1982 when the Lady Monarchs used overtime for a 78-72 win and has not won at home since the 1997 regular season win.

LAST TIME VS. TENNESSEE:

Shanna Zolman scored 23 points and Nicky Anosike added 17 to lead top-ranked Tennessee to an 83-67 win over Old Dominion on January 2nd, 2006. The Lady Vols led nearly the entire game, but Old Dominion made them work for their 10th straight victory in the series. The Lady Monarchs, coming off

an 88-80 overtime loss to fifth-ranked North Carolina last week, were scrappy and aggressive, but couldn't do enough defensively despite shooting 46 percent (28-of-61). Tennessee shot 52 percent (26-of-50) from the floor and went 24-of-28 from the foul line. Old Dominion had only seven chances at the line and made six. Zolman rallied from scoring five points and making one of seven shots from the floor in Tennessee's 62-51 win at then-No. 12 Notre Dame on New Year's Eve. The senior from Syracuse, Ind., was playing in front of hundreds of hometown fans. Against Old Dominion, she was 6-of-10 from the floor and 3-of-5 from beyond the arc. Alexis Hornbuckle added 14 points and Candace Parker had 10. The Lady Monarchs were led by T.J. Jordan with 17 points. She was 0-of-13 shooting in last year's game as a freshman. Sherida Triggs added 16 points and Shahida Williams had 10 for Old Dominion, which has the toughest schedule in the country according to the latest RPI. The Lady Vols were ahead by 18 early in the second half when Old Dominion rallied with a 16-6 run. Jordan had consecutive 3s during the spurt, and Lawona Davis scored four points to cut it to 61-53. Tennessee stretched it to 12, but Old Dominion trimmed it in half after two baskets by Paula Muxiri and a pair of free throws by Triggs. That was as close as the Lady Monarchs would get as Zolman hit a 3 and then sank two foul shots to restore the double-digit lead with 6:18 left.

Old Dominion grabbed the lead early but could not extend it beyond three points. After Triggs' putback with 8:32 left that put the Lady Monarchs ahead 23-21, the Lady Vols regained the lead with an 18-4 run started by Hornbuckle's 3. Hornbuckle scored eight points during the spurt. Jordan ended the rally with a 3, but the Lady Vols responded with Lindsey Moss' 3-pointer and Parker's steal and breakaway layup to stretch the lead to 44-30. Parker was far ahead of the trailing defender and had a wide open look at the basket but let the ball roll off her fingers into the cylinder. Fans had been waiting for Parker to get her first collegiate dunk.

THE VOLUNTEER STATE:

Old Dominion will face back-to-back opponents from the Volunteer State this week. The Lady Monarchs will be in Murfreesboro, Tennessee to take on the Blue Raiders of Middle Tennessee State and then return home to Norfolk for its annual meeting with the Lady Vols of the University of Tennessee.

THE 500 CLUB:

With the 77-38 win over Chicago State on December 9th, Old Dominion head coach Wendy Larry became the 30th all-time Division I coach and 23rd active Division I coach to reach the 500-victory milestone. In 23 years as a head coach, she has compiled a 500-186 mark. Now in her 20th season at the helm of the Old Dominion program, Larry holds a 451-155 mark at her alma mater. Coach Larry just recently captured her 450th victory as the head coach at her alma mater with a 57-46 win over Delaware State on November 25.

NOTE: Larry picked up career win No. 250 vs. Tennessee on Jan. 7, 1997 in their last win over the Lady Vols. ODU won 83-72 at the ODU Fieldhouse.

THE DUNKS:

Tennessee played its first and second round games of the NCAA Tournament at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2006 enroute to the Elite Eight. It was during their first round game vs. Army that Candace Parker collected her first dunk (and would dunk again). It was the first dunk in a women's game during NCAA Tournament action and the first time a woman dunked twice in a game.

STARTING FIVE:

With the Lady Monarch roster as deep as it is in recent memory, its hard to pick just which Lady Monarch will get the starting nod. Through eight games, seven different starting combos have been used with Sherida Triggs being the only Lady Monarch to have started every single game.

KEEPING THE BALL:

Old Dominion's 32 turnovers at Charlotte and 29 turnovers at Middle Tennessee certainly aren't numbers it would like to see on the stat sheet again this season. The good news is those were not school records. The most turnovers in a game in Lady Monarch history was 37. That happen twice - against Kansas on January 20, 1978 and against Tennessee on January 13, 1994.

STREAKING:

The Charlotte 49ers won their 15th straight home contests dating back to last season with its 68-64 win over Old Dominion on December 17th. The streak began right after Old Dominion beat the 49ers 79-69 back on December 18th, 2005. The Lady Monarchs certainly know about streaks. Old Dominion held a 115 game CAA win streak from 1992 to 2001 and currently have a 44 game CAA Tournament win streak with 15 straight CAA titles. Additionally, Old Dominion had a 64 home game win streak at the old ODU Fieldhouse from 1976 to 1981. Also the Lady Monarchs had a 122 game CAA home win streak from 1992 until 2005.

HOME SWEET HOME:

Since the doors opened at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2002, the Lady Monarchs have enjoyed a 56-11 record.

RANK 'EM UP:

Tennessee will mark the third ranked team Lady Monarchs will face this season. Before the season is through, Old Dominion will match-up against four teams represented in the Preseason Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today Polls. The Lady Monarchs have already faced Kentucky, falling to a #21 (AP)/24 (ESPN/USA Today) Wildcat squad 55-69 in their home opener back on November 18th and fell 40-89 to #5 Duke on their home court on November 30th. Other teams still left on the schedule include Tennessee (Dec. 22) and Rutgers (Dec. 30) - who as of late has fallen into the receiving votes category. Virginia, Penn State, and Middle Tennessee along CAA rivals Hofstra and Delaware have also been seen in the "receiving votes" categories in both polls. Old Dominion fell 72-92 at Virginia in the season opener, lost at Penn State, 77-80, despite overcoming a 20-point second half deficit, and was edged out 71-86 by Middle Tennessee.

BOARDING:

The Lady Monarchs have collected a season-high 27 board rebounding margin recently. Old Dominion collected 56 rebounds against both Charlotte and Chicago State while holding both teams to just 29 boards.

HOW LOW CAN YOU GO?:

The 38 points scored by Chicago State were the fewest points collected by an ODU opponent since the Lady Monarchs' 85-33 win over William & Mary on February 26, 2006.

JUST LIKE MIKE:

Junior guard T.J. Jordan has led the team in scoring in all but two games this season - at #5 Duke and at Middle Tennessee. At Charlotte, Jordan collected her first career double-double with 16-points and a career-high 10 rebounds. Additionally she set a new career mark with 22 field goals attempted.

WELCOME BACK:

In their last home game, Old Dominion welcomed back former Lady Monarch Angela Jackson, the head coach of the Chicago State Cougars. Jackson was a member of the Lady Monarchs in 1989 and 1990, helping the Old Dominion women's basketball team to two second round appearances in the NCAA. As a senior in 1990, she was named First Team All-Sun Belt averaging a team second best 16.6 points per game. Additionally in 1990, Jackson led the Lady Monarchs with 4.1 assists per game (126 total) and is tied with Sharese Grant on the senior all-time assist leaders list. As a junior, she poured in 513 points to rank sixth on the junior all-time scoring leaders list.

FORMER LADY MONARCHS IN THE COACHING RANKS:

Former Lady Monarchs Wendy Larry ('77) Angela Jackson ('90) aren't the only Lady Monarch to have gone from player to coach. Chris Critelli ('80) - head coach Brock University in Canada, Maura McHugh ('75) - head coach Stony Brook, Anne Donovan ('83) - head coach WNBA's Seattle Storm & US Senior National Team, Rhonda Rompola ('81) - head coach Southern Methodist, Kim McQuarter ('88) - head coach Malcolm X Junior College, Regina Miller ('84) - head coach UNLV, Inge Nissen ('80) - Co-Head Coach Florida International, Cindy Russo ('75) - Co-Head Coach Florida International, Aubrey Eblin ('99) - assistant coach University of San Diego.

SO WE MEET FOR THE FIRST TIME:

When you look at the Old Dominion Lady Monarch schedule, you can always count on familiar teams such as Tennessee, Rutgers, and Penn State along with various other teams they play on again and off again. Three teams grace this years schedule who the Lady Monarchs have never met. First up is Delaware State, who the Lady Monarchs handed a 57-46 loss at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. ODU also had a 77-38. win over Chicago State in its first meeting with the Cougars. Old Dominion also took on Middle Tennessee for the first time in school history, falling 71-86 to the Blue Raiders in Murfreesboro.

LESSON LEARNED - ON TO THE FUTURE:

Old Dominion has already put it 40-89 loss to #5 Duke behind them. The Lady Monarchs' 11 first half points tied the school record for fewest points scored in a half with the original record set back in December of 1972 with 11 second half points in a 23-12 victory over James Madison. The Lady Monarchs scored only 12 points in the first half of that game. Additionally, Old Dominion shot a low of 25.0 percent (13-of-52) from the floor, its lowest since shooting 26.0 percent (17-of-65) against Virginia in 1975. Old Dominion did-

n't repeat its poor performance when it came out in its next game against Penn State and shot 46.9 percent (30-of-64) against the Lady Lions.

NOT SEEN VERY OFTEN:

In a rare occurrence, the opposition outrebounded Old Dominion in a victory. The East Carolina Pirates held a 45-33 advantage on the boards, which included holding the Lady Monarchs to just seven offensive rebounds. The Lady Monarchs were outrebounded in only nine of its 31 games last year and none by double digits. Five of the nine times Old Dominion was outrebounded resulted in a loss for the Lady Monarchs. In six of those nine occasions, the opponent outboarded Old Dominion by four rebounds or less. Florida International and James Madison, in the first meeting of the year, both held an eight board advantage over Old Dominion, the most of the season.

SHE SHOOTS...SHE SCORES...A LOT:

Junior guard T.J. Jordan has led the Lady Monarchs in scoring in seven of eight games this season. Jordan has led Old Dominion in scoring on 22 occasions during her career, including 12 times serving as the team's point guard last year.

D-D-D-DEFENSE:

In their 57-46 win over Delaware State, the Lady Monarchs held the Hornets to 29.0 percent (18-of-62) from the floor, the lowest percentage by an ODU opponent this season.

OPEN THE DOOR:

The Lady Monarch women's basketball team helped the Virginia Cavaliers open their new building - The John Paul Jones Arena - in ODU's first regular season contest on Saturday, November 12th. It was Virginia back on November 22nd, 2002 that helped Old Dominion open the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

BREAKING DOWN THE OPENERS:

The Lady Monarchs are 25-13 in season openers, suffering a 72-92 set back in this year's opener at Virginia. Of the previous 38 season openers, Old Dominion has opened the season three times with Virginia with a win in 1977, a loss in 2002 with the opening of ODU's Ted Constant Convocation Center, and a loss in 2006 at the opening of UVA's John Paul Jones Arena. In home openers, the Lady Monarchs are 27-11 including a 2-3 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Old Dominion fell to #21/24 Kentucky in its 2006-07 home debut, 55-69.

0-2...SO WHAT?:

The Lady Monarchs may have started the 2006-07 season 0-2, but that's no reason to think the sky is falling. Last season, Old Dominion opened the season 0-2 and finished the year with a 22-9 overall mark and their 15th straight CAA title. The 2003-04 Lady Monarchs opened 0-2 and picked up ranked wins over #7 Penn State and #12/13 North Carolina. They finished 25-7 along with the CAA title. The 2002-03 Lady Monarchs opened 0-3 but managed a 20 win season going 21-9 with a CAA title. The 2000-01 season saw Old Dominion go 0-2 and also finished with a 21-9 mark and a CAA title. The 1992-93 women's team started the year off 0-4, but ended the year 22-8 overall, with yes...another CAA title and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

KEEP SHOOTING PARTNER:

Junior guard T.J. Jordan came off the bench in the 72-92 season opening loss at Virginia to net a team-high 21 points. Shooting 6-of-19 from the field, including 6-of-17 from three-point range, the third year Lady Monarch set new career-highs in field goals and three-pointers attempted. Against Penn State, the third year Lady Monarch reset her field goal attempt high by launching 20 shots from the floor and finishing with a season-high 24 points, her second 20+ point effort of the season. Jordan recently set a new season mark hitting eight field goals against Chicago State, just one shy of her career high. Against Charlotte, Jordan reset her field goal attempts mark for the third time this season taking 22 shots. The Lady Monarchs' three-point specialist, she holds the single season three-point attempt mark (2005-06 - 248).

WHAT THE LADY MONARCHS WELCOME BACK:

The Old Dominion women's basketball team welcomes back four starters and nine letter-winners from last year's team that went 22-9 overall and captured its 15th consecutive Colonial Athletic Association title. Seventy two percent of the offense returns including four of the five leading scorers and three of the four leading rebounders from a season ago. This year's group of seniors - Tish Lyons, Sherida Triggs, Shantel Wilson - enter the 2006-07 season having collected three CAA titles, three NCAA appearances, a 69-25 overall record and 49-5 mark in CAA matchups. Triggs joins junior guard T.J. Jordan on the Preseason Second Team All-CAA list. Triggs led the CAA in field goal percentage, was second on the ODU squad in scoring, and led the Lady Monarch rebounding corps. Jordan led the team in scoring and reset the single season three-point attempt record.

BACK TO THE POLLS:

The Lady Monarchs received votes in both the Preseason Associated Press and WBCA/USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll. The Lady Monarchs have received votes over the last few seasons and are looking to return to the Top 25 in both polls. Old Dominion's last Top 25 ranking in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll was November 18th, 2003. Old Dominion's last appearance in the Associated Press Top 25 was the final poll of the 2002 season as the Lady Monarchs danced their way to the "Elite Eight".

STREET & SMITH:

Street and Smith Magazine has listed the Old Dominion women's basketball team at No. 18 in its in their annual College Basketball Yearbook which went on sale on Oct. 1. Included on this year's schedule are five teams also appearing in Street and Smith's list including No. 5 Tennessee, No. 7 Duke, No. 14 Rutgers, No. 15 Kentucky and No. 20 Virginia.

UP NEXT:

Old Dominion breaks for the holidays and returns to action on Saturday, December 30th, against Rutgers. That game will be aired on Comcast SportsNet.

COLONIAL DOMINANCE: Old Dominion has captured 15-straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 269-15 overall record, which includes eight seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 143-2 record at home and a 128-13 road record. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992 and the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005. Five schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Georgia State (2-0), George Mason (39-0), Northeastern (2-0), UNC-Wilmington (33-0), and Towson (9-0).

MURFREESBORO, Tenn. -- Middle Tennessee State used a late second half run to earn a 87-71 victory over the Lady Monarchs Tuesday night at the Murphy Center.

Old Dominion drops its second straight contest falling to 3-6 overall, while Middle Tennessee improves to 9-3 overall.

The Lady Monarchs were led by starting point guard Jazzmin Walters (Norfolk, Va.) with a career-high 13 points along with four steals and three assists. Both juniors Shahida Williams (Newark, N.J.) and T.J. Jordan (Portsmouth, Va.) added in 12.

The Blue Raiders had a trio in double figures led by Amber Holt with a game-high 27. Krystle Horton had 23 points and Chrissy Given poured in 17 along with a game-high six assists.

The Blue Raiders were able to capitalize on 29 Old Dominion turnovers resulting in 39 points for the opposing team.

In the first half, neither team managed more than a four point lead and endured seven ties. Middle Tennessee only held a one-point lead, 39-28, at intermission.

The ODU defense was able to keep the Blue Raiders to just 32.4 percent shooting in the first half, but the second half saw Middle Tennessee shot a blistering 60.9 percent. Middle Tennessee quickly established a seven point lead the first minute into the second half, but the Lady Monarchs fought back. By the 14:18 mark of half number two, Old Dominion managed to tie the game at 51-51.

Following a Horton bucket, the Lady Monarchs responded with a three by Jordan and took back the lead, 54-53.

During the next three minutes the game would endure four lead changes and Old Dominion would see its last lead at the 8:09 mark. Williams converted the traditional three-point play for a 62-60 Old Dominion advantage.

MTSU's Jackie Pickel sparked a Blue Raider 15-3 run with back-to-back three-pointers to return the lead back to Middle Tennessee. The Blue Raiders had a 10-point, 75-65, edge with 2:58 remaining.

The Lady Monarchs fought back to within six with a minute and a half to go, but were charged with an intentional foul giving the Blue Raiders two free throws and possession of the ball. Middle Tennessee scored its final nine points from the line.

Old Dominion held a 37-31 advantage on the boards led by junior Tay Ransburg (Kansas City, Mo.) with seven.

The Lady Monarchs had one of its best performance from the field and the line against the Blue Raiders. Old Dominion ended the evening hitting 48.1 percent from the floor and 72.2 from the charity stripe.
