- Northeastern is 6-20 overall and 4-11 in CAA play.
- The Huskies have won two-straight, defeating Georgia State, 76-51, and second place James Madison, 61-50. Both wins came in Boston.
- Deanna Kerkhof was named CAA Player of the Week last week and leads the squad with 14.5 points per game.
- Sophomore Jewel Tunstull leads the CAA in field goal percentage at 57.9 percent and is second on the team with 12.4 points per game.
- ODU won the first contest 73-70 in Boston. Jackie Cook led three Lady Monarchs in double-figures with 19 while Tia Lewis added 16 and Myeisha Hall had 15, all three-pointers. ODU made a season-high 11 treys in the game.

Kerkhof led NU with 19 points while Tunstull had 17 and A'lece Mark added 15.

Shakeva Richards came off the bench to score a team-high 13 points in the win at UNCW. It was the first time since Nov. 25 vs. La. Tech she reached double-figures.

Hall Provides Spark

Myeisha Hall provided a second half spark on Thursday, scoring 14 points after thre break, including three treys. Hall had 11-straight points for ODU over a five-minute stretch. It was the third time this season she has hit double-figures.

Hanging Tough

ODU got down by 23 with 13 minutes remaining, but went on a 16-2 run, to get back in the game.

Buchan Lights it Up

Mairi Buchan scored 14 points in the first seven minutes and finished with a career-high 20 points in the win Sunday at Hofstra.

Leading Lewis

Tia Lewis notched her third-straight double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds.

Down the Wire

Jackie Cook got the game-winner for ODU on a layup with 2.7 seconds to go off a pass from Ashley Betz-White. Cook finished with 15 points on 6-of-8 from the floor.

Helping Hand

ODU dished out 21 assists in the

win over Hofstra on Sunday. Jo Guilford led the way with six while Ashley Betz-White had five. It was the third highest total on the season. ODU had 24 against Northeastern and 22 versus Alabama. All three games ODU has won.

Honor for Buchan

Mairi Buchan was named to the Capital One Academic All-District First Team that was released Thursday. The teams are selected by College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSida). Buchan holds a 3.92 grade point average majoring in biology (pre-med).

Pulling Down the Rock

Old Dominion pulled down a season-high 59 rebounds Wednesday night against JMU. The plus 21 margin was also a season-best, as was their 25 offensive rebounds. Tia Lewis and Jackie Cook each had 10 while Mairi Buchan and Ashley Betz-White had nine apiece, including a career-high mark for Betz-White.

Guilford big in the Clutch

JoNiquia Guilford led the way early and got the key stop late to lift ODU over George Mason Sunday. Guilford scored nine of her career-high 20 points in the first seven minutes, and stopped Taleia Moton from hitting a game-tying three-pointer.

Two in a Row

For the first time since Richmond and Alabama, Ashley Betz-White had back-to-back double-figure games. With 22 at W&M and 16 in the win over Mason. Combined, 30 of those 38 points came in the second half.

Lewis In Elite Company

After joining the 1,000 rebound club, Tia Lewis wasted no time tying Kelly Lyons for sixth on the all-time rebound list with 1,008.

Career-Best Again

Junior Jackie Cook has been impressive the last week for ODU, recording her career-high in two-straight games, as she had 20 points at VCU Jan. 11.

Beyond the Arc

Freshman Myeisha Hall has struggled shooting the ball this season, but not last Sunday, as she

was 5-of-6 from three-point range for a season-high 15 points. Hall was just 2-of-21 from beyond the arc this year before Sunday with both makes coming against Seton Hall November 26.

Stepping up (Part Two)

With 15:12 to play in the second half and trailing by one, Tia Lewis picked up her fourth foul. For the next 10 minutes with Lewis on the bench, instead of struggling with their leader off the floor, ODU grabbed a 67-63 lead, one they would keep the rest of the way.

Career-High, Again

Senior Tia Lewis pumped in a career-best 30 points in ODU's win over Georgia State on Jan. 4. She also had 10 rebounds for her sixth double-double of the season. It was the third different team she has set her career-high this season.

CAA Openers

The loss to George Mason on Dec. 4 was the first ever to open CAA play. ODU drops to 20-1 all-time in openers. ODU is now 48-2 all-time against George Mason.

Double-Double for Two

Tia Lewis and JoNiquia Guilford became the first ODU teammates

to record a double-double in the same game in the loss at GW Nov. 30 since Lewis (14 pts., 11 reb. and Jessica Canady (15 pts., 14 reb.) did it on Jan. 21, 2010 against Georgia State.

Guilford Gets First

JoNiquia Guilford recorded her first career double-double in the 58-52 OT loss at George Washington, with 12 points and 14 rebounds. She came off the bench and shot 5-of-11 from the floor including knocking down a three-pointer. The 14 boards are a career best.

With four double-doubles this season and 38 for her career, Tia Lewis is eighth on the NCAA Division I active list for career double-doubles.
