

Delaware State Head Coach David Caputo (Montclair State, '05): 19-41 at DSU; 155-101 career

(10th yr.); 0-0 vs. ODU; 13-19 MEAC regular season record; 0-2 MEAC Tournament

The Game

Delaware State welcomes Old Dominion, one of the top all-time women's college programs, to Memorial Hall for a non-conference game. The Lady Hornets have dropped their last two games after winning their season opener. DSU is coming off a 69-46 road loss to George Mason on Dec. 21. The Lady Hornets were plaqued by poor shooting in the contest, hitting just 18 of their 64 shots from the floor (28.1%), including four-of-21 on three-point attempts (19.0%), Naomi Shorts, playing in her first game of the season, was the only double-figure scorer for Delaware State with 12 points off the bench in the George Mason contest. Ashley Primas, also making her season debut, came off the bench to score six points and tie for the team lead with seven rebounds in the last outing. Sha Collins (sr.), a Preseason All-MEAC Second Team selection, is the team scoring leader at 12.0 points per game. She also tops the team with five three-point field goals. Janasia Law (sr.) averages 8.7 points per game and leads the Lady Hornets with seven assists. **Zoe Holmes** (sr.) is DSU's leading rebounder at 8.0 per game. She had a team season-high 10 boards vs. Rider in the season opener (Dec. 5). As a team, Delaware State is averaging 53.0 points per game on 33.5% shooting this season. The Lady Hornets do enjoy a rebound advantage over their opponents this season, averaging 38.7 boards per game compared to 37.7 for the opposition through three games this year.

Old Dominion has been idle since a 73-39 thumping of USC Upstate on Dec. 13, its third straight win after dropping the season opener. Victoria Morris led three double-figure scorers for the Monarch with 19 points in the contest. Her performance was highlighted by four three-point field goals (4-9) in the contest. For the season, Morris is ODU's top scorer at 18.0 points per game. Amari Young is averaging a double-double for the season. She is second on the Monarchs in scoring at 13.0 points per game and is the team's top rebounder at 10.0 per outing. Ajah Wayne is ODU's third leading scorer (12.3 ppg) and second best rebounder (9.3 pg).

DSU vs Old Dominion Series History

The Hornets and Monarchs are meeting for the first time since 2013 and fourth time overall. The Lady Hornets are seeking their first win in the series. The teams also met in 2006 and '07. ODU won the last meeting 97-67 on Nov. 9, 2013 in Norfolk, Va. This is also the first time the teams are meeting at Delaware State.

Caputo is in his third year as head coach of the Lady Hornets. Delaware State Director of Athletics Dr. Scott Gines announced his appointment on Aug. 10, 2018.

In his second season with the program, Caputo led DSU to a 12-18 overall record and 8-8 mark in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference in 2019-20, the most total and league wins by the team since the 2008-09 campaign.

The 2019-20 Lady Hornets also posted the program's most home wins (8) in 11 years, ranked 13th among all NCAA Division I teams in three-point defense and 38th in forced turnovers.

In addition, the team improved its national RPI (rating percentage index) by 77 spots in Caputo's second season at the helm.

Delaware State's 2020-21 newcomer class is rated No. 1 in the MEAC, according to ESPNW.

Prior to joining the Lady Hornets, Caputo's career was highlighted by six conference championships in seven seasons as a head coach, a 136-59 overall record, including 95-16 against conference opponents, two NCAA Tournament appearances and four nationally-ranked teams.

He had most recently served as a women's basketball assistant at the University of North Carolina-Wilmington of the NCAA Div. I Colonial Athletic Association during the 2017-18 season.

His career also includes Div. I assistant coach positions at Louisiana Tech and Florida Atlantic.

Prior to his stint at UNCW, Caputo enjoyed a highly successful four-year run as head coach at NCAA Division II Bloomfield College in New Jersey. In his first season, he led the Bears to the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference championship and the NCAA Tournament for the first time in team history.

Caputo compiled an overall record of 82-36 (.729 win pct.) at Bloomfield, including a 65-11 mark in conference games (.855). His teams claimed three CACC regular season titles and two NCAA Tournament berths.

Under Caputo's guidance, the Bears won 20-or-more games three times. He was selected as the CACC Coach-of-the-Year in 2015-16 after leading Bloomfield to school records for total victo-

ries (24), conference wins (18) and the program's first at-large berth in the NCAA Tournament. The following season (2016-17), Bloomfield posted a 21-8 overall record and 17-2 conference mark. His two-year conference record of 35-3 was third best among all Div. 2 coaches during the span.

Also during his tenure, Bloomfield produced one CACC Player-of-the-Year, two conference defensive players-of-the-year, an All-America honoree and 10 all-conference players.

From 2011-to-2013, Caputo was an assistant coach at Louisiana Tech of the Western Athletic Conference. As the team's recruiting coordinator, his 2012 class of newcomers was ranked No. 1 in the WAC and 55th among all NCAA Div. 1 teams (350 schools). The list included the second-ranked junior college player at her position.

During his first season at Louisiana Tech, the Lady Techsters reached the WAC Tournament championship game.

As an assistant at Florida Atlantic, Caputo helped produce the nation's 54th best recruiting class during the 2007-08 season, while the 2017-18 UNC-Wilmington newcomers ranked 75th in the country during his year with the Seahawks.

Caputo's career also includes a three-year stint as head coach at Florida's Indian River Community College, leading the team to three regular season conference championships and three National Junior College Div. I regional Elite 8 appearances from 2008-to-2011.

His 30-5 conference record at Indian River was tops among all Florida junior college coaches during his three years at the school.

The 2008-09 Southern Conference Coach-of-the-Year, Caputo was twice nominated for national top-coach honors while at Indian River. A total of 12 players signed with NCAA Div. I programs while nine more on to other four-year colleges during his tenure at the school.

He previously served as an assistant coach at Bloomfield College and Santa Fe Community College.

Caputo earned a bachelor's degree in Psychology from Montclair State (N.J.) in 2005.

He and wife Denise have two sons. His oldest son Dana Raysor was a member of the Delaware State men's basketball team from 2015-to-2017.

COLLINS, TURNER NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-MEAC TEAMS

Delaware State's **Sha Collins** has been selected to the 2020-21 All-MEAC Second Team, while fellow senior **Lyric Turner** was name to the third team in voting by league head coaches and sports information representatives. Collins was a two-time MEAC

Co-Player of the Week during her first season with the Lady Hornets during the 2019-20 campaign.

She was tops on the Lady Hornets and 12th in scoring at 11.7 points per game during the 2019-20 season.

Collins reached double-figures in scoring in 18 games, including a season-high 25 vs. St. Peter's on Dec. 7. She was 11-for-15 from the field (1-1 3pt FG) in that contest.

She topped the 20-point mark in three other contests, including 24 points to lead the Lady Hornets to their first-ever victory against the University of Delaware.

Collins also ranked 12th in the MEAC in field goal percentage (.417), 15th in assists (2.1 pg), fourth in free throw percentage (.723) and tied for 11th in steals (1.6 pg) last season.

Turner averaged 10.1 points per game (second on team), 2.2 rebounds and 1.4 assist per game. She scored 10-or-more points in 14 games, including four games with 20 or more. Turner nailed a team-high 54 three-pointers to rank fifth in the MEAC at 1.8 per game. Turner was also 15th in the league with a .289 three-point FG percentage.

MEAC RELEASES REVISED 2020-21 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL SCHEDULE

Hometown

Winter Haven, Fla.

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference has announced a revised conference schedule for women's basketball, a slate to be played January through the beginning of March, leading up to the 2021 MEAC Basketball Tournament. With Bethune-Cookman, Maryland Eastern Shore and the Florida A&M women opting out of the 2020-21 season due to COVID-19 concerns, the schedules have shifted from what was announced in October. Divisional play will be enacted in an effort to minimize both travel time and time spent outside of class, reduce travel expenses and eliminate air travel. In addition, teams will play back-to-back dates on Saturdays and Sundays. For the women, the Northern Division will be comprised of Coppin State, Delaware State, Howard and Morgan State, with Norfolk State, North Carolina A&T State, North Carolina Central and South Carolina State making up the Southern Division. Teams can opt out during the season, based on state and local restrictions related to COVID-19. The 2021 MEAC Basketball Tournament will be held March 10-13 at the Norfolk Scope Arena in Norfolk, Va.

DSU in MEAC (2000s)

The 2019-20 Lady Hornets are hoping to return the program to its early 2000s success in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference. From 2000 to 2009, DSU posted a 108-50 win/loss record vs. MEAC opponents, highlighted by a share of the 2003-04 regular season title, the tournament championship and NCAA Tournament berth in 2006-07 and eight top three regular season finishes. Delaware State's sixth place MEAC finish during the 2019-20 season was its best since showing since ranking third during the 2008-09 campaign.

DIVISION I TRANSFERS TOPS LIST OF 2020-21 NEW BLOOD

The DSU debut of one of the Lady Hornets' top 2020-21 newcomers is currently on hold. **Shannon** Dozier, former Washington, D.C., area high school star who played one season at the University of Mississippi, has been sideline for an undisclosed period of time due to a wrist injury. Dozier enrolled at Delaware State in 2019 and sat out the 2019-20 season due to NCAA transfer rules. She was one of three Ole Miss players to appear in all 31 games during the 2018-19 season, starting nine games. She averaged 3.2 points, 1.7 rebounds, 0.5 assists, and 0.4 steals over 18.5 minutes. Dozier tied for the team lead with 11 points vs. #2 UCONN and scored her career-high of 13 points at #6 Mississippi State on 6-for-8 shooting. Dozier was a four-year letterwinner at National Christian Academy in Fort Washington, Maryland. She helped lead her team to a combined 104-26 record in her four seasons, including a perfect 31-0 record her senior season in 2015-16. Member of teams that won DCAA, DCSAA and USA Prep School titles and rated a three-star recruit by ESPN.

Dozier is already somewhat of a "folk hero" at Delaware State. She was the winner of the DSU "Virtual Pep Rally" women's three-point contest, hitting her first 11 shots en route to a 12 for 15 performance to claim the title.

Kiana Coomber joined the Lady Hornets this season by way of the University of Memphis. She sat out last season for the Tigers, but averaged 4.5 points and 5.0 rebounds per game in 20 contests during the 2018-19 season. Coomber played her freshman year at the University of Loyola-Chicago. She averaged nearly 20 points and eight rebounds per game as a high school senior, and scored 1,733 points in her scholastic career.

Daije Harris began her collegiate career at Cal State Bakersfield, while **Ashley Primas** previously attended Tennessee State before enrolling at DSU.

FUTURE LOOKING BRIGHT

With nine seniors on the 2020-21 squad, the Lady Hornets have already begun the process of reloading for next year's campaign. Head coach Dave Caputo recently announced that nine newcomers have signed to attend the university and join the Lady Hornets beginning in the 2021-22 campaign.
