LADY MONARCH MOMENTS:

● The No. 25/24 Old Dominion Lady Monarchs kick off the home portion of its 2008-09 schedule against Virginia. The game features a rematch of the two squads from the thrilling Second Round NCAA Tournament overtime game.

● Jazzmin Walters hit a three-points with 4.8 seconds remaining and Tiffany Green came down the other end to block a potential game-winning shot by Lyndra Littles to send Old Dominion to the "Sweet 16" for the first time since 2002.

● Virginia will be the second ranked team the Lady Monarchs will face this season following a 78-44 setback to #14/13 Texas on Monday night. Other upcoming ranked opponents include #5/13 Tennessee and #11/16 Maryland, as well as Michigan State, who is receiving votes.

● Old Dominion is currently riding a 26-game home win streak, tied for the second longest in the nation.

● Prior to the game with the Cavaliers, the Lady Monarchs will receive their 2008 Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) championship rings. Old Dominion has won a NCAA A record 17 straight CAA titles.

● Following tonight's game, the Lady Monarchs will travel to Michigan State and then return home for the month of December for a four-game homestand.

ABOUT VIRGINIA:

The Virginia Cavaliers return to the Ted Constant Convocation Center for a rematch of the thrilling 2008 Second Round NCAA Tournament Game. The Cavaliers are off to a 2-0 start with a 78-48 season opening victory over High Point and an 83-82 upset over Tennessee in Knoxville. Against the Lady Vols, Virginia's Britnee Millner converted a free throw with 6.4 seconds left to give the Cavaliers the win. Although Virginia returns nine letterwinners and

four starters from last year's team that finished 24-10 overall, the Cavaliers will be without the services of junior guard Paulisha Kellum and senior forward Lyndra Littles. Kellum suffered an ACL tear during a practice, while Little will sit out the fall semester for academic reasons. The Cavaliers do return junior guard Monica Wright and senior center Aisha Mohammed. Wright leads Virginia with 25.5 points per game, while Mohammed is pouring in 15.0 points and a team-leading 10.5 rebounds per game.

SERIES WITH VIRGINIA:

Old Dominion and Virginia will meet for the 32nd time on Friday night. The Lady Monarchs leads the all-time series with the Cavaliers, 17-14. In their most recent meeting, fifth-seeded Old Dominion upset fourth-seeded Virginia in overtime, 88-85, in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The NCAA Tournament victory snapped a five-game Cavalier win streak against the Lady Monarchs. However, the Cavaliers have won the last four meetings. Each team served as the squad's opener for their respective buildings - ODU's Ted Constant Convocation in 2002 and Virginia's John Paul Jones arena in 2006.

LAST TIME VS. VIRGINIA:

The littles player made the biggest shot for Old Dominion. Then one of the tallest made sure it would be enough to win a thrilling game. Jazzmin Walters made a 3-pointer with 4.8 seconds left in overtime Tuesday night, and Tiffany Green blocked an attempt at a tying 3-pointer just before the buzzer, giving the Lady Monarchs an 88-85 victory over Virginia and a trip to the Greensboro Regional back on March 25th. Fifth-seeded Old Dominion (31-4) fell behind 85-81 in overtime, but closed the game on a 7-0 run. Walters started it with a free throw, Jessica Canady added a three-point play with 1:25 to go, and the 5-foot-2 Walters made a shot from her hip just before the shot-clock buzzer to send the Lady Monarchs' crowd into a frenzy. It got even louder when the 6-2 Green met Lyndra Littles at the top of the key and blocked her shot. Littles, who scored 29 points, collected the rejection and tried again, but her second effort came up well short and the wild contest was finished. Fourth-seeded Virginia (24-10), which trailed almost all night, forced overtime when Aisha Mohammed was fouled with 1.8 seconds to go--on the Cavaliers' sixth shot from in close on the possession--and she swished the free throw to extend the game 5 more minutes. Walters led Old Dominion with 17 points and 10 assists and committed just one turnover. T.J. Jordan added 14 points, Shahida Williams and Green had 13 each. Green also had 12 rebounds and six blocks. Canady added 12 points and 10 rebounds. Littles grabbed 14 rebounds, and Mohammed finished with 17 points and 15 rebounds. Sharnee Zoll scored 13 with nine assists in her final collegiate game, and Virginia's best scorer, Monica Wright, had 11 on 5-for-17 shooting before she fouled out with 5:23 left. Littles shot 10-for-29 for Virginia and scored five points in overtime, but Virginia didn't score after her layup put them ahead by four with 2:14 to play.

COLONIAL DOMINANCE: Old Dominion has captured 17-straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 311-17 overall record, which includes eight seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 161-2 record at home and a 150-15 road record. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992 and the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005. Five schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Georgia State (6-0), George Mason (43-0), Northeastern (5-0), UNC-Wilmington (36-0), and Towson (12-0).

- Old Dominion kicked off the 2008-09 season with a 93-63 victory over St. Mary's in the opening day of the World Vision Classic. The victory brought the Lady Monarchs to 27-13 in season openers. Old Dominion's 30-point victory was the most in a season opener since their 82-26 victory over Towson to start the 2001-02 season.
- Old Dominion has now won back-to-back season openers (including last season's 76-68 victory over Middle Tennessee). It is the first time the Lady Monarchs have had back-to-back season opening victories since winning seven straight from 93-94 to 99-00.
- Junior Jessica Canady with her 13 points and 10 rebounds performed her first double-double of the season. It was the sixth double-double of her career.
- With her game-high 19 points, senior Tiffany Green has brought her career scoring total to 1,019. Green needs four more points to move into 25th on the all-time Lady Monarch scoring leaders list surpassing Aubrey Eblin (1995-1999).
- In her first career game as a Lady Monarch, freshman Mairi Buchan nearly registered a double-double. Buchan went 6-of-10 from the floor and 2-of-2 from the line to finish with 15 points as ODU's second leading scorer. She also hauled in nine boards.
- In addition to making her first career start, sophomore Shadasia Green set a new career-high mark in rebounds. Leading the Lady Monarchs, who outboarded the Gaels 57-35, 11 boards, Green reset her former mark of eight set against Delaware State back on Dec. 20, 2007.
- Three of the Lady Monarch freshman played in their first career games. Mairi Buchan played 22 minutes narrowly missing a double-double with 15 points and nine rebounds. Margaret Harvey saw 16 minutes of action registering three points and three assists. Rachel DeMita logged three minutes of time on the hardwood.
- Alena "Russia" Voronina set a new career mark in minutes played. Voronina logged 10 minutes in the ODU win over St. Mary's.

- Texas represented the first of five teams in both the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today Polls the Lady Monarchs will face this season.
- Senior Tiffany Green, who was named CAA Co-Player of the Week earlier in the day, was the lone Lady Monarch in double figures. The Chesapeake, Virginia native collected 17 points.
- Junior Jessica Canady was held to six points. Entering the game against the Longhorns, Canady had scored in double figures in eight of her last nine contests and last five straight dating back to last season.
- Foul trouble plagued the guards in the loss against Texas. Seniors Jen Nuzzo and Jazzmin Walters each at three fouls at the end of the first half.
- Old Dominion was outrebounded for the first time this season, 50-31. Junior Jessica Canady led the Lady Monarchs on the boards with nine.
- Seniors Tiffany Green and Jazzmin Walters accounted for 15 of ODU's 23 first half points. Green and Walters scored the Lady Monarchs first 13 points giving the Lady Monarchs a 13-9 lead with 15:54 left in the opening half. Walters, who up to that point had collected seven points, would not score again the rest of the game. Green finish the first half with eight points.
- Only three Lady Monarchs reached the line in the loss to the Longhorns. Senior Tiffany Green went 3-of-7, senior Jazzmin Walters went 1-of-2, and freshman Mairi Buchan went 0-for-2.
- Old Dominion opened the season with three road games for the first time since the 2003-04.

- Senior Tiffany Green posted her first double-double of the 2008-09 season and 18th of her career with her 15-point and 16-rebound performance against Dayton.
- Senior Tiffany Green reset her career-high rebounding mark with 16 against the Flyers. Her previous high was 15, which she had collected twice, most recently against William & Mary back on January 28, 2007. It was also the 24th time in her career she reached the double figure rebounding mark.
- Junior Jessica Canady became the first Lady Monarch to score 20 or more points this season with a team-high 23 points in the victory over Dayton. It was the third time Canady scored 20 or more points in a game.
- With her 15 points against the Flyers, senior Tiffany Green moved up on the ODU All-Time Scoring Leaders List. Green moved into 25th on the list with 1,034 career points surpassing Aubrey Eblin (1995-99). Green needs 17 more points to move past Rhonda Rompola (1978-81) in 24th on the list.
- While the Lady Monarchs did not go to the free throw line often, they were certainly accurate. Old Dominion went 5-of-6 from the charity stripe to shoot 83.3 percent. The Lady Monarchs reached the 80 percent mark from the line only four times last season.
- Old Dominion certainly cut down the number of turnovers in game number two. After suffering 27 turnovers in the season opener against St. Mary's, the Lady Monarchs committed just 12 in its 70-58 victory over Dayton. No Lady Monarch turned the ball over more than twice against the Flyers.
