### Quick Hits:

- ODU won the 2010 CAA Regular Season Title with their win at VCU on Sun. Feb. 28. They will be the top seed at this weekend's CAA Tournament in Harrisonburg
- This will be the Lady Monarchs 19th year in the CAA Tournament, but just the first time since year one in the league (1992) that ODU will enter the tournament not defending its crown
- The Lady Monarchs are 51-1 all-time in CAA Tournament action, including a run of 17 straight titles, an NCAA record
- Old Dominion is the top seed for the 15th time in 19 appearances at the CAA Tourney
- The Lady Monarch schedule through 25 games still ranks the toughest in the CAA; ranked as high as #1 this season, it is now slated as the 34th toughest in the nation
- Speaking of Canady, she became the 27th Lady Monarch in history to score 1,000 points when she dropped seven at VCU last Sunday. She now has 1,012 career pts
- Junior Jasmine Parker has been on fire since the CAA season started, leading the team in CAA-only scoring with 11.8 ppg; she has 848 career points in her third year, ranking fourth among active CAA juniors
- **Injury Update:** Parker should be considered probable heading into the CAA Tournament, after taking an elbow to the left side of her face against Towson.

## Game Day Notes



Old Dominion University participated in their seventh annual Hoops for a Cure game as a part of the WBCA Pink Zone when they hosted James Madison University Dukes on February 21st. This year, the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) announced that over 1,550 schools and organizations were committed to participating in the 2010 Pink Zone initiative.

The WBCA Pink Zone initiative is a global, unified effort for the WBCA's nation of coaches to assist in raising breast cancer awareness on the court, across campuses, in communities and beyond. As with many other school's during the February 12-21 Pink Zone timeframe, the Lady Monarchs asked fans to PINK OUT THE TED to help raise breast cancer awareness and funding. In all, 5,179 fans joined the Lady Monarchs in the Pink Out effort, the seventh highest attended CAA game ever at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

Prior to the opening tip, Old Dominion had a survivors reception and march to honor the strong women who have battled this terrible disease. During the game, the game officials used pink whistles and players will be in pink uniforms from head to toe, including pink shoelaces.

The effort has seen increased success across the nation every year. In 2008, over 1,200 teams and organizations raised over \$930,000 and in 2009 more than 1600 participants raised an incredible \$1.3 million.

### Struggling with the Dukes

With a 65-59 win over the Lady Monarchs at the Constant Center this season, the James Madison University Dukes became the only CAA team to defeat ODU in Norfolk more than once. They also became the only team to beat ODU in Norfolk in back-to-back seasons.

### Home Sweet Home! 100 Wins at the Ted

With the 70-52 win over William & Mary on February 25, the Lady Monarchs reached 100 victories in their beautiful arena, opened in 2002. The ODU women have averaged over 12 home wins per year at the Ted Constant Convocation Center and had eight such victories this season.

### Georgia On Her Mind

Sophomore Tia Lewis must have been thinking "Home Sweet Home" when she knocked down the game-winning layup with 0.6 seconds remaining at Georgia State. The ODU forward is from Poulan, Georgia and in her first trip to her home state as a Lady Monarch, she was the hero. As the defense collapsed onto junior Jasmine Parker, she found Lewis on the left side of the paint for a wide-open bucket and was fouled. She converted the old-fashioned three-point play to put ODU up by two with less than a second to play. She finished with 10 points and nine rebounds in the game.

### ODU Clinches

#### Regular Season Title

Old Dominion has won another CAA regular season title and has guaranteed the top seed in the upcoming 2010 CAA Tournament. ODU has been in first place for much of the season, and they have locked up the #1 seed for the 15th time since joining the league in 1992. The CAA Tournament this year is being held at the JMU Convocation Center in Harrisonburg, Va. and will begin on March 11 through March 14.

Earlier, VCU had a 19-point win over the Lady Monarchs, the largest margin of defeat ODU has suffered in a home conference game, and JMU became the only team to beat ODU twice in Norfolk. ### 51's Enough

Old Dominion defeated Hofstra this season by a final of 51-46. The 51 points scored tied the lowest scored in a win for Old Dominion since 1973-74. Twice prior, ODU has won with just 51 points scored, against UVA in 1980-81 and an overtime win against UNC Wilmington in 2002-03.

### Whew! That Was Close

ODU is excelling in tight ball games this season, going 10-4 in the 14 games decided by single digits this season. ODU had won seven straight close games until their 6-point loss to JMU, and have now won another against VCU. Four of those seven straight came on the road (JMU, Towson, UNCW and GSU) and ODU also defeated Georgia State, Hofstra and Delaware at home by single digits. Old Dominion's closest game this season was a 1-point win at Delaware, powered to victory by Jasmine Parker taking a charge and knocking down a go-ahead 3-pointer late in the game. They were also forced to win on a last second shot at Georgia State, when Tia Lewis converted an old-fashioned three-point play with 0.6 seconds remaining for the two-point win.

### Big Win in Harrisonburg

The Lady Monarchs earned their first win against JMU in Harrisonburg since 2005, snapping a four-game losing streak over that span. The win also snapped JMU's nine-game home winning streak and was just the ninth loss suffered on the home floor in the last 75 home games for the Dukes. Old Dominion won 67-58, holding off a second half surge from the Dukes after taking a 15-point halftime lead. Junior Jasmine Parker nearly had a triple-double, hauling in a career-high nine rebounds and dishing a career-high tying six assists to go with her ten points. ## Three-Point Defense

JMU, one of the nation's top long-ball teams, was able to knock down just a pair of 3-pointers on 23 attempts against the Lady Monarchs. For the season, ODU ranks third in the CAA in 3-pt FG percentage defense, allowing just 29.6% from beyond the arc. In conference only games, ODU leads the league, allowing an abysmal 24.9% from long range (60-for-240).

## Hot Conference Shooting

ODU can be found among the league leaders in several statistical categories. In conference games this season, sophomore Tia Lewis is third in the league in field goal percentage, knocking down 54% of her shots. ODU holds two of the top six spots as senior Jessica Canady is sixth in the league, with 50% of her shots falling.

As a team, ODU leads in the league in shooting percentage. ODU is shooting at a 42.6% clip while Delaware is second at 41.7% as a team. ODU also ranks third in free-throw shooting, knocking down 73.2% from the charity stripe.

## 12-for-12

Junior Jasmine Parker helped lead ODU past Drexel with a perfect 12-for-12 night at the free-throw line. It was a career-best, a new Constant Center record and the second best performance by a Lady Monarch in the history of the program. Only Nancy Lieberman had a better night from the line, going 15-for-15 in 1978. Parker nearly matched her perfect night again against William & Mary, going 10-for-11 from the line vs the Tribe. She leads ODU, knocking down over 79% from the line.

## 1200 And Counting...

With the non-conference finale against Tennessee, the Lady Monarchs reached 1200 games played in the history of the program. ODU joins a select group of just eight programs to play 1200 games in their histories. They are Tennessee Tech, Tennessee, Stephen F. Austin, Long Beach State, Kansas State, James Madison, and Hofstra. ODU ranks second in winning percentage among these eight teams, going 906-312 over the past 41 years for a .744 success rate.

## Senior Moments

ODU has just one senior this season, First Team Pre-season All-CAA forward Jessica Canady. Canady has worked her way back from offseason surgery and has now started 19 straight games after being forced to sit through half of the non-conference schedule. She broke out in a big way against Northeastern, scoring 18 points and hauling in a team-high 12 rebounds while playing a career-high 36 minutes. At VCU, the Lady Monarch senior became the 27th Lady Monarch in history to score 1,000-points and is now also over 650 career rebounds. Canady was a reserve player her freshman year, scoring only 92 points, making her 1,012 career all the more impressive, averaging 11.1 points per game since her sophomore season.

## A Rare Occurrence

ODU lost to Tennessee by a final score of 102-62 in the non-conference finale this season, marking just the sixth time in program history the Lady Monarchs allowed a team to reach 100 points. Northeastern then posted its first ever 100-point game against ODU, marking just the seventh occurrence against the Lady Monarchs.

## Stop! Thief!

Jasmine Parker leads the CAA in total steals and is among the CAA leaders in steals/game this season, averaging 2.5 per game with 71 thefts. The ODU junior now has 167 career steals, averaging 1.8 per game in her career.

## Still Toughest Schedule in the CAA

Old Dominion's schedule is the toughest in the CAA, and among the strongest in the country. After closing out the non-conference schedule, Old Dominion had the fifth toughest schedule in the nation. Heading into the CAA Tournament, ODU's schedule was listed as the 34th strongest and the Lady Monarchs RPI is also listed as #54 after 25 games. Both numbers come from rpirat-ings.com's weekly report.

## Magic Number 24

Three players have tallied new career highs early this season, all with 24 points scored. Jasmine Parker scored 24 against Maryland to set a new career-high, while Tia Lewis and Shadasia Green both scored 24 against Louisville to set their new mark.

## 17 Again...

Sophomore forward Tia Lewis tied her career-high with 17 rebounds against Ole Miss, taking over the top spot in the CAA with 9.2 rebounds per game at the time. Lewis had 17 in a game against North Florida during her freshman year while playing for Central Florida and the 17 hauled in against Mississippi tied that mark for the first time as a Lady Monarch. She also posted her first double-double in the game, scoring 15 points for Old Dominion. She notched a new CAA-high with 13 rebounds against VCU.

# Game Day Notes

## Potent Parker

In the second game of the season, Jasmine Parker scored a career-high 24 points and is now second on the team, averaging 11.3 points per game this season. She came out of the locker room on a torrid pace, scoring 12 of Old Dominion's first 20 points and giving the Lady Monarchs the lead against the 20th ranked team in the nation. She finished with 24 points, four assists, four rebounds and three steals in her second consecutive solid game against a nationally ranked opponent.

Parker is knocking down scoring marks this season, breaching the 600-, 700- and 800-point plateaus as a junior. She is one of two active Lady Monarchs to reach 800 points, as senior Jessica Canady has 1,001.

## Welcome to the Ted

Since the doors opened at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2002, the Lady Monarchs have enjoyed a 100-21 record. ODU suffered its third, fourth and fifth-CAA losses ever at the Ted earlier this season, when VCU defeated the Lady Monarchs 75-56 on February 7, 2010, followed by a 65-59 loss to JMU two weeks later.; Towson rounded out the CAA opponent victories with a 64-56 win in the regular season finale. Of the 21 losses in the Constant Center, TEN have been to nationally ranked opponents.

## Milestone March

Head Coach Wendy Larry is approaching yet another milestone, just 15 wins shy of her 600th. Individually, Jessica Canady became the 27th Lady Monarch to reach the 1,000 point mark with her seven points at VCU in the road finale. She now has 1,001 joining the elite Lady Monarch list.

## 900 WINS!

With the 51-46 win over Hofstra on January 31, the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 906-311 (.744) in 41 years of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.

## Toughest Schedule in the Nation

Though it's early, the Lady Monarchs schedule has been ranked the toughest in the nation through six games by rpiratings.com. According to the same source, ODU had the 74th best RPI, even with just the 1-5 record. Through six games ODU faced four teams receiving votes in the national rankings and the six teams combined had gone 39-8.

## CAA Preseason Poll

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish third in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the head coaches. Defending champions Drexel were pegged as the top team heading into 2009-10 with James Madison also selected ahead of ODU.

## Startin' Out Right

Jasmine Parker played extremely well against the second ranked Cardinal in the season opener, scoring a team-high 16 points and adding five rebounds, four assists, a career-high five steals and a perfect 5-for-5 night from the free-throw line. Despite a poor first half, Tia Lewis also came away with a stellar first game, finishing just one rebound shy of a double-double. Lewis finished with 15 points and nine rebounds in her first game as a Lady Monarch. Junior Shadasia Green continued her hot play of late with 11 points and seven rebounds. She averaged 16 ppg and 7 rpg in the two exhibitions.

## Season Openers

The Lady Monarchs are 27-14 in season openers, falling to 2nd ranked Stanford at home in this season's opener. ODU has dropped six of their last eight season-opening games.

## Home Openers

In home openers, Old Dominion is 29-12, including a 4-4 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Last season, ODU opened the regular season home schedule with an upset of 11th ranked UVA by a final score of 78-70. It was the second straight win over the nationally ranked opponent at the Ted, including the overtime thriller in the NCAA Tournament the year before, and the seventh win over a nationally ranked opponent at the Constant Center. ODU lost to #2 Stanford in this season's home opener.

## Exhibition Recap - Shaw

In the final tune-up of the 2009-10 preseason, ODU took care of the Shaw Lady Bears by a final score of 82-48. Senior Jessica Canady returned to the floor for her 2009-10 debut and dazzled, scoring 13 of her 15 points in the first half. She also grabbed five rebounds in 21 minutes of play. Junior Shadasia Green again had a stellar outing, posting 16 points in her second straight exhibition and added five boards. Tia Lewis joined Green and Canady in double figures with 10, despite only scoring two points in limited action in the first half due to foul trouble. Lewis finished 4-for-6 from the field. Rookie point guard Carolann Cloutier distributed eight assists in the game while newcomers Jackie Cook and Kquanise Byrd each dished four. Cook added eight points in the game and Byrd had two thefts. Sophomore center Mairi Buchan got on the boards for a second straight game, rebounding a team-high six missed shots against Shaw.

## Exhibition Recap - Chowan

In the first look at the Lady Monarchs, ODU won in front of nearly 3,000 fans with ease, 85-52. Junior Shadasia Green led the way, with 16 points and 9 rebounds, just shy of a double-double. Newcomers Tia Lewis and Kquanise Byrd also showed off what Lady Monarch fans can expect to see this season with 11 and 12 points respectively. Byrd added four steals off the bench and went a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line, while Lewis hauled in six boards. Leading the way on the glass after Green was sophomore center Mairi Buchan, grabbing eight boards. ODU had a commanding rebounding edge with 59 in the game compared to just 30 for Chowan.
