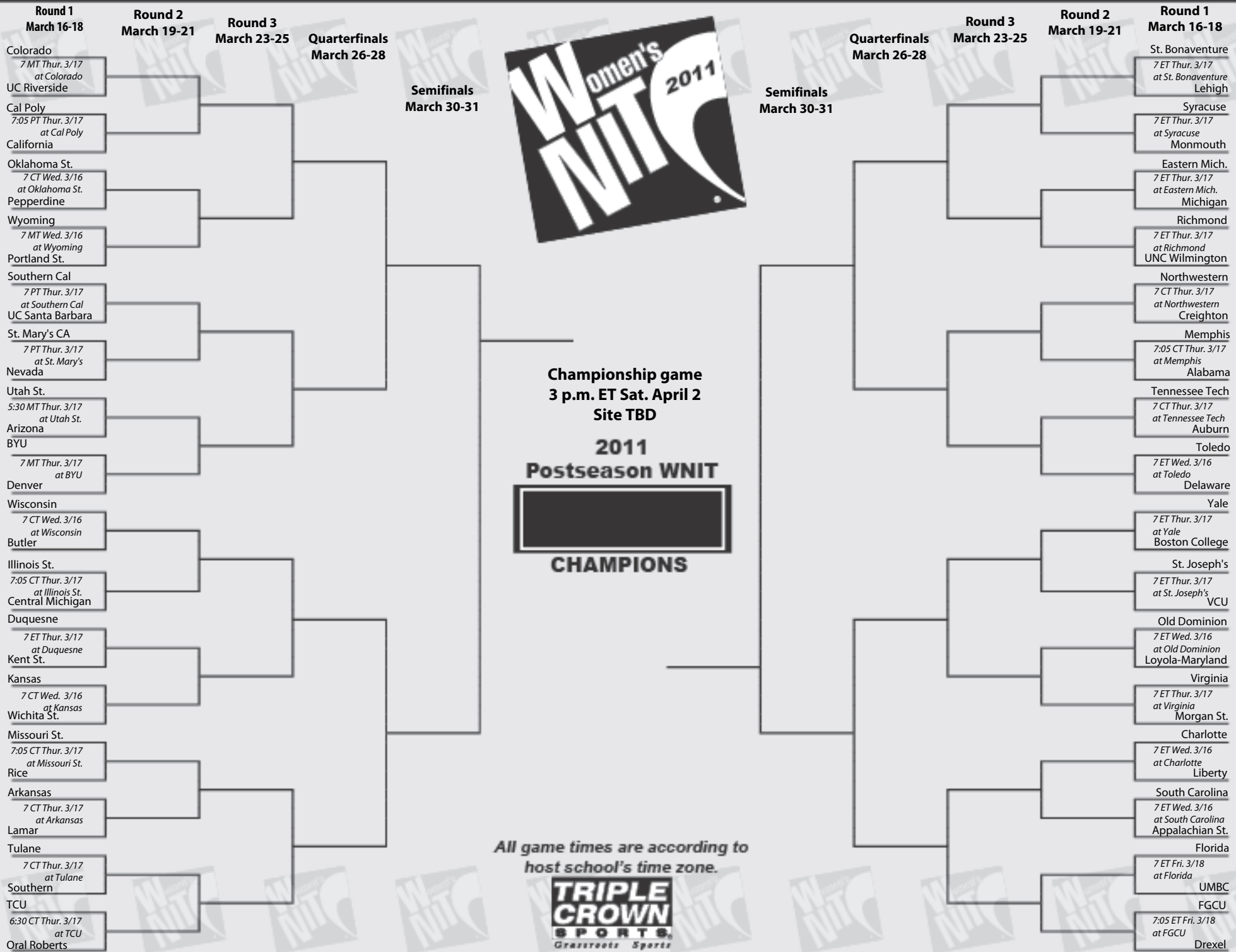

About Loyola-Maryland

- The Greyhounds are a WNIT automatic qualifier from the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference and will be making the programs first appearance in the tournament. The Greyhounds finished second in the MAAC regular season standings and fell to No. 18 Marist, 63-45, in the leagues championship game.
- Loyola needs just one more win to tie the program's single-season win record, set during the 1998-99 season when the Greyhounds won 21 games.
- Tonight's game will feature a pair of conference defensive players of the year. Sophomore guard Katie Sheahin was named the MAAC's top defender, while ODU senior Jasminer Parker was selected as the best defensive stopper in the CAA. Sheahin is second in the nation in steals per game, while Parker is sixth.
- Miriam McKenzie leads Loyola in scoring at 14.3 points per game. McKenzie drilled a three-point field goal in the first half of the MAAC Championship game to score her 1,000th career point.

About Old Dominion

- The Lady Monarchs led by All-CAA selections Jasmine Parker and Tia Lewis. Parker, who was named Second Team All-CAA and the league's Defensive Player of the Year, averages a team-high 12 points and has swiped 3.2 steals per game, which ranks sixth nationally. Lewis, an All-CAA Third Team pick, averages 11.9 points a game and pulls down a team-high 7.8 rebounds a contest.
- Old Dominion finished second in the Colonial Athletic Association and won 20 games for the 29th time in program history.
- ODU is a perfect 19-0 this season when scoring 61 points or more and the Lady Monarchs have yet to drop a game when leading at the 10-minute mark of the second half.
- Old Dominion's loss in the CAA Tournament quarterfinals is its earliest conference tournament loss in the 20 years the Lady Monarchs have been in the CAA.

CAA Year-End Awards

Senior guard Jasmine Parker was named the Colonial Athletic Association Defensive Player of the year to highlight Old Dominion's honorees at the 2011 CAA Women's Basketball Awards Banquet held at the Gaylord National Hotel. Parker was also named to the All-CAA second team and All-CAA Defensive team. Junior forward Tia Lewis was an All-CAA third team selection, while junior center Mairi Buchan garnered All-Academic Honorable Mention honors.

Delaware Recap

The second-seeded Old Dominion women's basketball team had four players score in double-figures, but couldn't overcome sophomore All-American Elena Delle Donne's 31 points and 10 rebounds, which led seventh-seeded Delaware to a 72-55 CAA Tournament quarterfinal upset over the Lady Monarchs last Friday evening. Old Dominion failed to advance to the CAA Tournament semifinals for the first time in its 20 years in the league. The Lady Monarchs are now 53-3 in CAA Tournament games, but just 2-3 in the last three years. Jasmine Parker led ODU with 16 points, while classmate Kquanise Byrd chipped in 14 points to go along with a team-high tying five rebounds. Alena Voronina netted 11 points and Tia Lewis reached double-figures with 10.

Sixth In The Nation

Old Dominion ranks No. 6 nationally in defending the three-point line. The Lady Monarchs have shut down their opponents on the perimeter, holding them to a 26.0 percent shooting clip. Teams are 109-of-420 from beyond the arc against ODU this year.

600-Win Club

Old Dominion's Wendy Larry reached yet another coaching milestone this season, netting her 600th career victory on January 23 against Towson. She has compiled a 608-233 record in 27 seasons as a head coach, including 559 career wins at ODU. Larry reached the 600-win plateau in just 829 games which makes her the 10th fastest coach to accomplish the feat.

Parker & Lewis Reach 1,000

Senior guard Jasmine Parker became just the 28th all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points with her game-high 16 points against Tennessee on December 5. Just over two months later junior Tia Lewis reached the 1,000-point plateau by scoring nine against Northeastern.

Mid-Major Poll

Old Dominion fell to No. 17 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, which was released March 15. Green Bay sits atop the rankings, while James Madison (No. 6) and UNC Wilmington (No. 18) also represent the CAA.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs played one of the toughest schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule featured games against five teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane and JMU) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida, Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel). At the end of its non-conference slate, ODU's schedule ranked No. 16 according to CollegeRPI.com.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship was held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. from March 11-14, 2011. The tournament was played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998. Top-seeded James Madison topped seventh-seeded Delaware for the leagues automatic bid into the 2011 NCAA Women's Basketball Championships.

RECORD CROWDS AT THE TED:

Old Dominion set the all-time women's basketball attendance record at the Ted Constant Center earlier this season when the Lady Monarchs hosted Tennessee. The game between the two historic programs was a **BLUE OUT** and a remarkable 7,774 fans packed the Ted. ODU boasts a dominant 114-23 overall record in the Constant Center, including seven victories over nationally ranked opponents.

ACC Win

Old Dominion topped Atlantic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008. The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

Dixon's Jersey Retired

Former Lady Monarch basketball All-American and Olympian Medina Dixon had her jersey retired on Sunday, Jan. 30, prior to Old Dominion's game against Georgia State at the Ted Constant Center. During her three years as a Lady Monarch, Dixon helped lead Old Dominion to an 84-14 record and two trips to the NCAA Final Four. In 1983 the Lady Monarchs rolled to a 29-6 record and hosted the Final Four in Norfolk. ODU lost the semi-final game to Louisiana Tech. As a senior in 1985, Dixon guided Old Dominion to a 31-3 record and the NCAA National Championship. The Lady Monarchs topped Georgia for the title and Dixon was named to the NCAA All-Tournament team. Dixon, a Boston, Mass. native, was a standout forward for ODU from 1982-85. She completed her career with 1,968 points, 979 rebounds, 417 assists and 277 steals. She ranks seventh all-time at Old Dominion in scoring and rebounding, fourth in steals and fifth in assists.

Since Old Dominion joined the CAA in 1992, the Lady Monarchs have only lost seven games in Norfolk. The most recent was this January against VCU. The Rams are just the second team (JMU) to win twice in Norfolk. Old Dominion is now 160-7 in regular season conference games at home since joining the CAA. Including the eight CAA Tournaments held in Norfolk, Old Dominion has a 183-7 overall record against CAA opponents.

Lady Monarchs Ink Five To National Letters of Intent

Old Dominion head women's basketball coach Wendy Larry announced the signing of five players to National Letters of Intent. Myeisha Hall, Tiffany Minor, Queen Tiye Jackson, Ashley Betz-White and Kaneisha Atwater will continue their academic and athletic careers with the Lady Monarchs beginning in 2011-12.

Hall is ranked the 53rd-best guard in the Class of 2011 by ESPN. She's 5-8 and can play the point or shooting guard spots. Hall averaged 22 points, nine rebounds and four assists last season for Palm Beach (Fla.) Lakes High School. The combo guard, who scored 40 points in a game as a junior, was named the South Florida Sun-Sentinel Big School Player of the Year in Palm Beach County.

Larry on Hall: "Myeisha is an athletic scorer with tremendous transitional skills."

Minor is ranked No. 72 among wing players in her class by ESPN.com. The 5-11 wing player averaged 16.7 points last year at The Maret School in Washington, D.C. She's an excellent set shooter who can rebound and pass well for a wing player. She's expected to either play shooting guard or small forward at ODU.

Larry on Minor: "She's extremely versatile with good court awareness. She also adds a great deal of length on the defensive side of the ball."

Jackson led Trenton (N.J.) Catholic Academy to a state title last year. She's an excellent rebounder at 5-11 and she's expected to contribute at one of the two forward spots at ODU. Jackson has a strong build and can score both inside and out. Her range extends to the three-point line.

Larry on Jackson: "She has the size of a post player with a perimeter players skills."

Betz-White is a 5-5 point guard out of Trinity High School in Camp Hill, Pa. She averaged 11.4 points and 4.2 steals last year en route to being named to the Class AAA All-State Third Team as a junior. A true point guard, Betz-White excels in transition and on the secondary break, but is also comfortable in a set offense. The guard is a solid outside shooter and features a good pull-up jumper.

Larry on Betz-White: "She's a true point guard with personality and flare. Ashley makes everyone around her better."

Atwater is a 5-7 combo guard from Fort Pierce Westwood High School in Florida. She led her high school team in scoring as a junior, averaging 28.2 points. Atwater tallied five triple-doubles last season. She's a three-sport high school athlete who is quick off the dribble and strong on the defensive side of the ball.

Larry on Atwater: "She's an athlete that's extremely quick and fast. Additionally, she's an exceptional defender that can help us a great deal."
