About George Washington

- The Colonials are coached by Mike Bozeman, who is in his fourth season at the helm. He is the younger brother of Todd Bozeman, current head coach of the men's basketball team at Morgan State and former head coach at Cal.
- GW comes in with a 2-3 record after hammering Radford on Saturday 83-59. The win snapped a three-game losing streak for the Colonials after opening the season with a 63-41 win over UT Arlington.
- Sara Mostafa leads the Colonials in scoring with 13.6 points while Danni Jackson is second on the team with 10.6 points per game. Brooke Wilson leads the team with 8.6 rebounds a game and 7.8 points a game.

About Old Dominion

- ODU is plays its fourth straight game away from the Ted Constant Center as they take on George Washington tonight.
- Senior Tia Lewis had an impressive Paradise Jam Tournament, earning all-tournament team honors, averaging 20.7 points and 10.7 rebounds per game. She scored a career-high 27 points in the opening win against Alabama, recorded her first double-double of the season with 24 points and 10 boards against Louisiana Tech, and had another double-double with 11 points and 16 rebounds against Seton Hall.
- Sophomore Shakeva Richards poured in a career-best 18 points, going 7-for-11 from the field. She also had a season-best five rebounds.
- Shakeva Richards has twice reached double-figures this season, scoring a career-best 18 against Louisiana Tech last Friday. She has scored 60 points so far this season, already matching her total from last year.

Game Day Notes

CAA Leaders

Tia Leaders ranks among the top-10 in the CAA in five categories; scoring (7th at 16.6), rebounding (8th at 8.6, offensive rebounds (10th at 3.1), defensive rebounds (6th at 5.4) and minutes played (8th at 34.1). Ashley Betz-White is eighth in free-throw pct. at 83.3.

Double-Double

Senior forward Tia Lewis recorded her second double of the season against Seton Hall with 11 points and 16 rebounds. Lewis averaged 20.7 points and 10.7 rebounds a game at the Paradise Jam Tournament, earning all-tournament team honors.

Back to 20

Senior Tia Lewis had her second-straight 20 point effort with 24 points against Louisiana Tech. She also registered her first double-double of the season.

Career-High (Part One)

Sophomore Shakeva Richards poured in a career-best 18 points against La. Tech. The sophomore went 4-for-5 from the foul line and pulled down five rebounds.

Career-High (Part Two)

She's only played in six games, but Myeisha Hall had her most impressive game of the season in just 12 minutes against Louisiana Tech. Hall went 5-of-8 from the floor, scoring 14 points and making her first two career three-pointers.

Leading the Way

Senior Tia Lewis scored a career-high 27 points in the 77-76 win over Alabama. Lewis made a career-best 12 field goals as well and went 3-of-6 from the line.

At the Buzzer

Sophomore Becca Allison knocked in the game-winner with just 1.2 seconds left. Allison wasn't the most likely last second

shooter, going just 2-of-6 on the day with five points, but she was the right shooter as she drained the jumper.

Back at It

Freshman Ashley Betz-White finished with 20 points and went 10-of-12 from the foul line. It is the third time this season she has had at least 18 points in a game.

Swatting the Shots

ODU ranks third in the CAA in shots blocked, swatting 5.8 shots a game. Tia Lewis leads ODU with seven and ranks fifth in the league averaging 1.8 a game.

Lewis the Leader

Tia Lewis has led ODU in scoring just twice this season, but has hit double-figures in all but one game. She had 18 in the opener against Virginia Tech, 11 at No. 5 Stanford and 16 against Richmond. Her only none double-digit game was nine at Georgia Tech.

Crash the Glass

ODU is shooting just 34 percent from the field, but making up for some of that by averaging 15 offensive rebounds a game, ranking fourth in the CAA. Lewis leads the team with 11 offensive boards.

CAA Rookie of the Week, Again

Freshman Ashley Betz-White earned her second-straight CAA Rookie of the Week honor. The Mechanicsburg, Pa. native had a team-best 18 points against Richmond. It is the second time this season she's led the team in scoring, having 22 in the opener against VT.

Coming on Strong

Freshman Tiffany Minor had eight points and two three-pointers at No. 5 Stanford. The points and

Lewis Preseason All-CAA

Senior Tia Lewis was the lone Lady Monarch selected to the preseason All-Conference team. Lewis is ODU's only returning starter, and led last year's squad with 12.1 points per game and 7.8 boards a game.

Buchan is Back

Junior Mairi Buchan is back after redshirting last season due to an injury. The Scotland native will add another post presence to go along with Tia Lewis.

As a sophomore, Buchan averaged 4.8 points per game averaging 15 minutes a game coming off the bench.

Barefoot Brings in Five

Head coach Karen Barefoot brought in five student-athletes in her first recruiting class. They are Michelle Brandao, Ashley Betz-White, Myeisha Hall, Tiffany Minor and Queen Tiye Jackson.

Battle Against the ACC

ODU looks to make it back-to-back years with a win over an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent.

Game Day Notes

ODU defeated Georgia Tech in last year's opener 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC team since a 78-70 win over Virginia in 2008.

The Lady Monarchs will have two chances this season, starting with the Hokies tonight, and again against the Yellow Jackets on Sunday in the first road game of the season.

Openers

ODU lost to Virginia Tech in the Season-Opener on Friday night, as the Lady Monarchs are now 28-15 all-time in season openers. It was the first time ODU played an ACC opponent in its opener since the 2006-07 season, when the Lady Monarchs began the season with a 99-72 loss at Virginia.

It was the second time in school history opening up against Virginia Tech. ODU began the 1985-86 season against Virginia Tech at the scope. VT won 73-72. It is the eighth time opening against an

ACC foe.

Exhibition Success

ODU defeated Davis and Elkins 93-32 last week in their only exhibition contest. Freshman Tiffany Minor led four Lady Monarchs in double figures with 17 points. Mairi Buchan and JoNiquia Guilford each had a double-double, with Buchan notching 15 points and 12 boards while Guilford had 13 points and pulled in 10 rebounds. Jackie Cook rounded out the double-digit scorers with 15 points.

NCAA Host Site

Old Dominion has been selected as one of 16 host sites for first- and second-round games in the 2012 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Games will be played at the Ted Constant Convocation Center on March 17 and 19.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

900 WINS!

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 929-325 (.741) and is in its 43rd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins,
