SEAHAWKS BEGIN BUSY STRETCH SUNDAY VERSUS LADY MONARCHS

The UNCW women's basketball team begins a busy stretch that will see the team take to the floor four times over the next eight days Sunday when it faces Old Dominion in a 3 p.m. matinee at the Ted Constant Center.

The Seahawks begin the hectic stretch looking to snap a losing skid that reached five games with a 63-61 setback to visiting William & Mary Thursday.

Senior Karneshia Garrett posted her second straight double-double with 17 points and 12 rebounds, but the Seahawks were unable to overcome a Tribe lineup that owned a commanding 54-37 advantage on the glass and converted 23 offensive rebounds into 26 second-chance points.

UNCW returns home Tuesday to host Hofstra in a 7 p.m. tip at Trask Coliseum.

**SEAHAWK STORYLINES**

► Sunday's contest marks the 46th meeting between UNCW and Old Dominion. The Lady Monarchs have dominated the series since its inception, winning all but one of the previous 45 meetings between the two schools since joining the CAA in 1991-92, including a 74-50 triumph in their first meeting at Trask Coliseum on Jan. 17. UNCW's lone win in the series game in their last visit to Norfolk, a 76-54 triumph last January.

► The UNCW women's basketball program is in its 40th season of competition and has compiled an all-time record of 459-577 (.443) entering today's contest. The Seahawks have recorded four 20-wins seasons (1983-84, 2002-03, 2010-11, 2011-12) and made two post-season appearances (2011 & 2012 WNIT) in that span.

► UNCW has struggled to rebound the basketball this season as it ranks 11th in the CAA and 312th in the NCAA in rebounding margin (-6.7). The Seahawks have been out-rebounded by their opponent in all but four of its 18 games this season and have been out-rebounded by an average of 11.0 boards per game during its current five-game losing skid.

► The Seahawks have made it hard for the opposition to make shots from the field this season as opponents are making just 38.6 percent (433-of-1123) of their tries from the field this season, representing the fifth-best field goal percentage defense in program history. Of UNCW's 18 opponents this season, only six (Liberty, NKU, North Carolina A&T, William & Mary, Drexel and ODU) have shot better than 40 percent from the field against UNCW.

► UNCW has struggled to shoot the basketball this season, ranking 10th in the CAA and 266th nationally in field goal percentage, making just 36.3 percent (350-of-995) of its attempts from the floor this season. The Seahawks have shot better than 40 percent from the floor in just five of 18 games this season, including three of their last six contests (William & Mary, Drexel and Towson).

► Senior forward Karneshia Garrett has been a force to be reckoned with on the glass this season as she enters Sunday's contest ranked 27th in the nation in rebounds per game (10.6). She has grabbed double-digit rebounds in nine of 17 games played this season, highlighted by a pair of 18-rebound performances at Wake Forest (Nov. 14) and against North Carolina Central (Nov. 28). She has pulled down double-digit boards in each of the past two games, grabbing 12 boards against both Towson and William & Mary.

► Garrett has also picked up her point production in recent games, averaging 13.4 points in the Seahawks' last five contests. Garrett is shooting 53.8 percent (28-of-52) from the field during that stretch as she has reached double figures in all five of those contests, highlighted by a 17-point effort against William & Mary on Thursday.

► Junior guard Jessica Freeman leads the team in scoring (10.4) and steals (2.3) and ranks third in assists (2.3). Freeman has served as an iron-woman of sorts for the Seahawks, having played all 40 minutes in eight games this season, including seven of the last nine contests. She ranks second in the league in minutes played per game (36.4).

WILLIAM & MARY RECAP

UNCW saw its losing streak reach five games with a 63-61 setback versus William & Mary Thursday at Trask Coliseum.

► William & Mary led by 12 with six minutes remaining in the second half, only to see UNCW battle back and make it a one-point game with 37 seconds remaining. The Tribe missed their shot on the next possession, but were able to get the rebound and make one of two free throws to record the two-point victory.

► The Tribe avenged a nine-point loss to the Seahawks on Jan. 8 in Williamsburg and ended an eight-game losing skid to the Seahawks to expand their lead in the all-time series to 31-29.

► Senior guard Taylor Hilton led three W&M players in double figures with 15 points. Senior forward Emily Correal added 12 points and senior guard Janine Aldridge netted 11.

► Junior Kaitlyn Mathieu pulled down 11 rebounds and senior Emily Correal added 10 as the Tribe enjoyed a commanding 54-37 advantage on the glass. William & Mary finished with 23 offensive rebounds and notched 26 second-chance points, both season-highs for a UNCW opponent.

► Senior forward Karneshia Garrett scored a game-high 17 points and grabbed a game-high 12 rebounds for her second straight double-double and her sixth of the season.

► Senior guard Tawanna Lee added 13 points, junior guard Jessica Freeman scored 12 and freshman guard Dana Brown finished with 11 as UNCW featured four in double digits for the first time this season.

► The two teams combined for just 24 turnovers (UNCW 11, William & Mary 13). The two sides teamed up for 47 miscues in their first meeting on Jan. 8.

► UNCW finished with double-digit steals for the fourth time this season as they recorded 10 thefts against the Tribe.

► The Seahawks dished out double-digit assists for the fourth straight contest and the 11th time this season as they handed out 11 helpers.

► UNCW moved to 2-1 this season and 69-6 since the start of the 2007-08 season when holding a lead of 10 points or more in a contest. It is the first such loss for the Seahawks, who led by as many as 11 in the first half, since suffering a 63-54 setback to Eastern Michigan on March 21, 2011.

► The Seahawks held a lead at halftime for just the fourth time this season and moved to 1-3 when doing so. UNCW also moved to 68-20 since the start of the 2007-08 season when holding a lead at the break.

► The Seahawks held their opponent to below 40 percent shooting for the 12th time this season as the Tigers were 24-of-70 (.343) from the floor for the game.

► UNCW shot better than 33 percent from 3-point range for the fifth time this season as it made 8 of 21 tries from 3-point range. William & Mary was also solid from beyond the arc, making 8-of-22 (.364) from downtown.

► UNCW was out-rebounded for the 14th time this season and moved to 0-14 on the season when that occurs.

HALF-DOLLAR DEFENSE

The Seahawks are 53-0 since the start of the 2002-03 campaign when limiting the opposition to 50 points or less.

► UNCW held its first opponent to 50 points or less during the Adell Harris era with a 59-45 victory over North Carolina Central on Nov. 28. The win also marked the first time the Seahawks had limited its opposition to fewer than 50 points since a 76-47 victory at Towson on Feb. 24, 2011.

► The last time the Seahawks lost a game in which they held their opponent to less than 50 points was a 49-44 setback at rival Campbell on Nov. 17, 2001.

INTERSTATE 70

UNCW is 69-8 (.896) since the start of the 2000-01 campaign when it scores 70 or more points in a contest.

► The Seahawks were 10-1 in 2011-12 and are 23-2 since the start of the 2010-11 season when reaching the 70-point plateau.

► UNCW's last loss when scoring 70 or more points came in a 79-73 setback to Appalachian State in the first round of the Postseason WNIT last March.

GETTING OFF TO A GOOD START IMPORTANT FOR UNCW

The Seahawks are 68-20 (.772) since the start of the 2007-08 season when leading at halftime.

► UNCW is 1-3 this season when holding a halftime advantage. All three of the Seahawks losses under such circumstances have come in games where their halftime advantage was three points or less (25-24 vs. Charlotte; 30-27 at Towson; 33-32 vs. William & Mary).

► On the flip side, the Seahawks are just 21-64 (.247) since 2007-08 when trailing at intermission. UNCW picked up its first win under such circumstances this season with its victory at William & Mary, overcoming a 23-22 halftime deficit to pick up the win.

DOUBLE-DIGIT DOMINANCE

UNCW has benefitted from building big leads in recent years as it is a combined 69-6 (.920) since the start of the 2007-08 season when it holds a lead of 10 points or more during a contest.

► The Seahawks are 2-1 this season under such circumstances. UNCW suffered its first loss in a game when holding a double-digit lead when it suffered a 63-61 setback against William & Mary, a game that saw the Seahawks lead by as many as 11 in the 1st half.

► The Seahawks have struggled to overcome big deficits in that same timeframe, posting an 12-71 (.145) mark during games in which they have trailed by 10 points or more. Nine of those 12 victories, however, have come since the start of the 2010-11 season, including their 61-52 victory at William & Mary on Jan. 8 that saw the Seahawks erase a 14-point deficit in the second half on their way to victory.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

According to research conducted by the athletic communications department at St. John's University, UNCW Head Coach Adell Harris is one of the youngest Division I head coaches in the country.

► Harris is the 10th youngest head coach in the nation based on birth date, having celebrated her 32nd birthday on May 1, just two days before accepting the head coaching position at UNCW.

► Harris is the youngest coach in the CAA, but not the youngest in the state of North Carolina. That honor goes to High Point Head Coach De-Anna Hendrix. The 28-year-old is in her first season as head coach of the Panthers.

HARRIS, MCGOWEN REUNITED

When UNCW Head Coach Adell Harris took over the Seahawks program last May, she was already familiar with one player on her new roster from her time at Tusculum College.

► Harris coached current UNCW senior Chelsea McGowen at Tusculum during the 2009-10 season.

► Together the duo combined to lead the Pioneers to a 23-10 overall record, the South Atlantic Conference Tournament championship and an appearance in the NCAA Elite Eight.

► McGowen averaged 2.1 points and 1.7 rebounds during her freshman season before transferring to Brunswick Community College for the 2011-12 campaign.

FREEMAN, LEE MAKING THEIR WAY UP SCHOOL'S THREE-POINT CHART

Senior Tawanna Lee and redshirt junior Jessica Freeman are both making their way up the school's career three-point field goals made chart.

► Freeman currently sits tied for 7th place on the all-time list with 88 three-pointers made while Lee is in 12th place with 78 treys made.

► Freeman surpassed Katy Walters for 10th place on the school's career three-point field goals made list (79) with her three made trifectas in UNCW's game at Northern Kentucky on Dec. 20. Freeman enters today's game just one 3-pointer away from surpassing Jeri Lynn Coker for sole possession of seventh place on the all-time list.

► Lee, meanwhile, is just one 3-pointer away from equalling Katy Walters (79) for 11th place and four triples shy of matching Treasure Johnson for 10th place (83).

► Both players have been consistent from beyond the arc during their careers, with Lee sixth (.351) and Freeman 10th (.331) on the squad's chart for career three-point field goal percentage. Freeman led the league in three-point field goal percentage in 2011-12 (.414), while Lee ranks seventh on the circuit this season in that category (.384).

HAIL TO THE THEIF

Junior guard Jessica Freeman recently moved into the top 10 of the program's career steals chart.

► Freeman entered the program's career top 10 on Jan. 31, recording five steals against William & Mary to surpass Johnnie Smith for sole possession of 10th place on the school's all-time chart.

► Freeman enters today's contest with 165 career steals and needs just two thefts to catch Sahsha Taylor for ninth place on the all-time list (167).

► Thievery is nothing new for the Charlotte, N.C. native as Freeman ranked sixth in the league in steals in 2011-12 (2.2). She currently ranks fourth among all league players in that category (2.3).

SEAHAWKS TABBED SEVENTH, GARRETT PRESEASON HONORABLE MENTION

UNCW was picked to finish seventh overall during the upcoming 2012-13 season and senior forward Karneshia Garrett was a Honorable Mention Preseason All-CAA selection.

► The Seahawks and George Mason were selected to finish seventh in a vote of the league's 11 head coaches, ahead of Towson, William & Mary and Georgia State.

► Delaware was picked to repeat as regular-season champion while James Madison was tabbed to finish second. Hofstra was picked third, followed by Drexel, Old Dominion, Northeastern, UNCW and George Mason (tie), Towson and William & Mary (tie) and Georgia State.

► Garrett earned Honorable Mention Preseason All-CAA accolades after appearing in 32 games and making 21 starts during her first season with the program in 2011-12. She averaged 9.8 points and 7.5 rebounds while pacing the team with six double-doubles.

SEAHAWKS ANNOUNCE SIGNING CLASS

UNCW head women's basketball coach Adell Harris announced the signing of D'Asia Cain (Smyrna, Ga./Campbell), Ryan Flowers (Raleigh, N.C./Millbrook) and Johanna McMillan (Mullica Hill, N.J./Sanford) to National Letters-of-Intent during the early signing period.

► D'Asia Cain averaged 7.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, and 4.0 assists per game during her junior season in helping lead Campbell to a regional championship and State Final Four appearance. She was Named MVP of the Campbell Holiday Classic last season.

► Ryan Flowers Led Millbrook to the 2011-12 Class 4A state championship, earning Most Outstanding Player accolades during the championship game. She averaged 14.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game during junior season and is a Two-time All-Capital 8 selection. Flowers led the Wildcats to Class 4A state runner-up finish as a sophomore and was a 2011 Regional All-Tournament Team selection.

► Johanna McMillan is ranked as a top 100 prospect for her position by ESPN.com. She was an Honorable Mention All-State selection following a junior season that saw her average 11.3 points, 3.6 rebounds, 1.8 assists and 1.5 steals per game. a Two-time All-Conference selection (First-team 2011-12 and Second-Team 2010-11) she has led Sanford to back-to-back DIIAA State Championships (2010 & 11) and a runner-up finish in the 2012 championship. She has also helped the Warriors capture three straight D.I.S.C. titles.

2011-12 RECAP

The UNCW women's basketball program enjoyed another highly successful campaign in 2011-12.

► The Seahawks reached the 20-win plateau for the second consecutive season and the fourth time in program history as it finished the 2011-12 campaign with a 20-13 overall mark. It marked the first time in school history that the program had recorded back-to-back 20-win campaigns.

► UNCW made its second straight appearance in the Postseason WNIT as it fell to Appalachian State, 79-73, in first-round action at Trask Coliseum. The loss dropped the Seahawks to 1-2 in two appearances in the 64-team event (2011 & 2012).

► UNCW once again made life difficult for opposing offenses as the Seahawks averaged 10.3 steals per game to rank second in the CAA and 52nd in the nation in that category. UNCW recorded double-figure steals in 19 of their 33 games in 2011-12, including a season-high 17 thefts in their win against East Carolina on Nov. 20.

► UNCW thrived in close contests last season as the Seahawks were 8-1 in games decided by five points or less during the 2011-12 season. Their only loss under such circumstances came in a 59-57 setback to Old Dominion at Trask Coliseum on Feb. 12.

► The Seahawks enjoyed considerable success at home last season, compiling a 9-4 record in the Port City in 2011-12. UNCW finished the season by winning eight of its last 11 home contests.

► The Seahawks thrived from three-point range last season as they established a new program mark for three-point field goals made in a season with 188. UNCW twice matched the program record for three-point field goals made in a contest last season, converting 11 three-point attempts in wins at Northeastern (Jan. 26) and at William and Mary (Feb. 19).

Series Notes

Series History

Sunday's contest marks the 46th meeting between UNCW and Old Dominion. The Lady Monarchs have dominated the series since its inception, winning all but one of the previous 45 meetings between the two schools since joining the CAA in 1991-92, including a 74-50 triumph in their first meeting at Trask Coliseum on Jan. 17.

UNCW Versus Old Dominion On The Road

UNCW is 1-21 versus Old Dominion in 22 previous visits to the Tidewater region. The Seahawks picked up their only victory in the series during their most recent appearance in the Ted Constant Center, a 76-54 win over the Lady Monarchs last January.

The Last Meeting

Old Dominion used its deep bench and two big runs in the final period to pull away from UNCW, 74-50, in Colonial Athletic Association women's basketball action at Trask Coliseum.

Freshman guard LaQuanda Younger scored all 12 of her points in the first half to lead three ODU players in double figures. Senior guard Jackie Cook added 11 points and senior forward Mairi Buchan chipped in 10 for the Lady Monarchs, who shot 45.9 percent and benefitted from 38 points by reserves.

Senior forward Karneshia Garrett and junior guard Jessica Freeman scored 11 points apiece to pace UNCW. Senior guard Tawanna Lee added 10 points for the Seahawks.

UNCW cut into ODU's 42-28 halftime lead by scoring the first six points of the second period until sophomore forward Shae Kelley banged in a jumper in the paint at 16:30 to key an 11-2 run that pushed the lead back to 53-36. Cook banged in a running jumper near the free throw line to give the Monarchs a 17-point cushion at 11:02.

The Seahawks were still hanging around and only trailed, 53-41, when ODU went on its decisive spurt. The Monarchs reeled off a 12-2 rally, with junior guard Rebecca Allison making four consecutive free throws as the margin ballooned to 65-43 at 4:46.

ODU recorded its largest lead of the contest with just over a minute to play. Junior forward Shakeva Richards picked up a loose ball in front of the Monarch basket and dropped it in the net for a 74-48 bulge.

UNCW HEAD COACH ADELL HARRIS 1ST SEASON, WAKE FOREST '02



Former Wake Forest standout and Tusculum College head coach coach Adell Harris became the 10th head coach in UNCW's women's basketball history on May 3, 2012.

Harris, who grew up in High Point, played at Wake and later coached at UNC Asheville, has heavy North Carolina ties as she returns to her home state for her first NCAA Division I head coaching position.

Harris, 32, takes over the Seahawk women's fortunes following a successful three-year stint as head coach of the Pioneers, guiding the NCAA Division II school to a 61-30 overall record, back-to-back Food Lion South Atlantic Conference Tournament championships (2010 & 2011) and three straight appearances to the NCAA

Tournament.

In 2011-12, Harris guided the Pioneers to a 17-11 overall mark as the team posted victories over defending DII national champion and top-ranked Clayton State and 2012 NCAA Champion Shaw en route to the school's fifth straight NCAA Southeast Regional berth.

Tusculum opened the 2010-11 season ranked third in the USA Today/ESPN Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll and finished the campaign with a 21-9 record as it captured the SAC regular season crown and repeated as league tournament champions.

In her inaugural season with the Pioneers in 2009-10, Harris guided Tusculum to its first-ever appearance in the NCAA Division II Elite Eight after capturing the program's first Southeast Region Championship. She also led the team to its inaugural post-season ranking, capping the campaign as the ninth-ranked team in the final USA Today/ESPN Top 25 Coaches Poll.

Harris was instrumental in the development of many of the top players in Tusculum history. Guard Jasmine Gunn was named the program's first consensus Division II All-American, Daktronics Southeast Region Player-of-the-Year and SAC Player-of-the-Year after ranking among the top-10 players in the nation in scoring (21.6) during her junior season. Gunn repeated as SAC Player-of-the-Year the following season to finish her career second in school history and third in league history with 2,180 points.

In addition, guard Kendal Baxter set a school and league record with 105 three-pointers during her freshman season on her way to earning SAC All-Rookie Team accolades. Center Catherine Hintz earned MVP honors at the 2011 Food Lion SAC Tournament and was selected to the All-Tournament Team at the 2010 NCAA Southeast Regional.

Prior to taking the reins at Tusculum, Harris spent six seasons at UNCA (2003-09), serving as an assistant and associate head coach. She helped the Bulldogs capture their first Big South Tournament title and NCAA Tournament appearance in 2006-07 and mentored nine All-Big South Conference honorees, including a pair of BSC Rookie-of-the-Year honorees in Brittany Hendley (2004) and Kyla Jones (2007).

Harris was a four-year letter winner at Wake, playing in 106 games during her career with the Demon Deacons from 1998-2002. She paced Coach Charlene Curtis' squad with 108 assists and averaged 4.6 points per game during her senior season as co-captain. Harris, who finished her career in 10th place on the WFU career assists chart, graduated in 2002 with a Bachelor's Degree in Sociology.
