- The Lady Monarchs have won eight of their last nine games and are currently in a three-way tie atop the CAA standings with UNC Wilmington & VCU.
- Old Dominion is 4-0 in league road games this season and it has won 12 of its last 13 CAA road games dating back to last year.
- The Lady Monarchs topped George Mason at home on January 6, 70-66. Junior Tia Lewis posted a season-high 24 points in the win.
- Old Dominion ranks third in the nation in three-point field goal defense (23.3%) and third in the CAA in both assists per game (13.9) and steals per game (10.5).
- ODU is 13-0 this season when scoring 61 points or more.

George Mason recorded its only win over Old Dominion, 63-57, on February 22, 2009 in Fairfax. Since then, the Lady Monarchs have won three straight over the Patriots, including a 70-66 victory on January 6 at the Ted Constant Center. Junior Tia Lewis exploded for a career-high tying 24 points in the win.

About George Mason

- The Patriots have won three of their last four games, including wins over Drexel and Delaware. George Mason is 7-3 at home this year and 2-2 in CAA home games.

- Brittany Poindexter (11.8 ppg) and Taleia Moton (11.5 ppg) lead the Patriots in the scoring department, while Angelee LaTouche's 6.4 rebounds a game pace Mason on the boards.

- George Mason ranks first in the CAA in scoring defense. The Patriots have held their opponents to just 56.5 points per game. The Patriots are also second in the league in both turnover margin (+1.9) and rebounding defense (34.7)

- Old Dominion and George Mason shared two non-conference common opponents. Both squads won by over 20 against Stony Brook, but the Patriots fell (67-58) at George Washington, while the Lady Monarchs cruised to a 60-35 win at home over the Colonials.

About Old Dominion

- Old Dominion has won eight of its last nine games and is riding a four-game road winning streak

- Senior Jasmine Parker leads the team with 12.8 points and 3.6 steals per game. The guard has scored in double-figures in 17 of 20 games and she has led the team in scoring in seven contests. Her 3.6 steals per game ranks third nationally. The Norfolk native has swiped six or more steals in a game on four occasions this season.

- Junior Tia Lewis paces the squad in rebounding (7.8 rpg) and is second in scoring (11.7 ppg). The forward has a team-high seven double-doubles.

- At the completion of her junior season, Alena Voronina averaged 1.3 points & 1.0 rebounds for her career. This season, the forward is third on the team in scoring (11.5 ppg) and second in rebounding (5.9 rpg).

- The Lady Monarchs played the 16th most difficult non-conference schedule in the country according to CollegeRPI.com.

Georgia State Recap

Old Dominion forced a season-high 27 turnovers and held Georgia State to just 32 percent shooting from the field in a dominating 64-41 win Sunday at the Ted Constant Center. Senior Jasmine Parker led a balanced ODU attack with 13 points and a career-high tying seven steals, while sophomore JoNiquia Guilford posted 10 points and pulled down a career-high eight rebounds. Tia Lewis fell just short of her eighth double-double of the season as the junior chipped in eight points and led the team with nine boards.

Third In The Nation

Old Dominion ranks No. 3 nationally in defending the three-point line. The Lady Monarchs have shut down their opponents on the perimeter, holding them to a 23.3 percent shooting clip. Teams are 60-of-257 from beyond the arc against ODU this year.

Mid-Major Poll

Old Dominion moved up to No. 8 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, which was released February 1. Green Bay sits atop the rankings, while James Madison (No. 10), UNC Wilmington (No. 17) & Drexel (24) also represent the CAA.

600-Win Club

Old Dominion's Wendy Larry reached yet another coaching milestone this season, netting her 600th career victory on January 23 against Towson. She has compiled a 602-229 record in 27 seasons as a head coach, including 552 career wins at ODU. Larry reached the 600-win plateau in just 829 games which makes her the 10th fastest coach to accomplish the feat.

CAA Honors

Three different Lady Monarchs have garnered the CAA Player of the Week award this season. Senior Jasmine Parker was named the CAA Co-Player of the week Nov. 29 after scoring a combined 47 points and swiping nine steals in games at NC State and home vs. Louisville. Junior Tia Lewis earned the same honor January 10 after recording back-to-back double-doubles against George Mason and James Madison and Kquanise Byrd was honored after scoring a career-high 22 points in ODU's win at Delaware on January 16.

Parker Reaches 1,000

Senior guard Jasmine Parker became just the 28th all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points. With her game-high 16 points against No. 9/8 Tennessee, the guard from Norfolk reached the major plateau.

ACC Win

Old Dominion topped Atlantic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008. The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs play one of the toughest schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule features games against five teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane and JMU) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida, Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel). At the end of its non-conference slate, ODU's schedule ranked No. 16 according to CollegeRPI.com.

RECORD CROWDS AT THE TED:

Old Dominion set the all-time women's basketball attendance record at the Ted Constant Center earlier this season when the Lady Monarchs hosted Tennessee. The game between the two historic programs was a **BLUE OUT** and a remarkable 7,774 fans packed the Ted. ODU boasts a dominant 110-23 overall record in the Constant Center, including seven victories over nationally ranked opponents.

Dixon's Jersey Retired

Former Lady Monarch basketball All-American and Olympian Medina Dixon had her jersey retired on Sunday, Jan. 30, prior to Old Dominion's game against Georgia State at the Ted Constant Center. During her three years as a Lady Monarch, Dixon helped lead Old Dominion to an 84-14 record and two trips to the NCAA Final Four. In 1983 the Lady Monarchs rolled to a 29-6 record and hosted the Final Four in Norfolk. ODU lost the semi-final game to Louisiana Tech. As a senior in 1985, Dixon guided Old Dominion to a 31-3 record and the NCAA National Championship. The Lady Monarchs topped Georgia for the title and Dixon was named to the NCAA All-Tournament team. Dixon, a Boston, Mass. native, was a standout forward for ODU from 1982-85. She completed her career with 1,968 points, 979 rebounds, 417 assists and 277 steals. She ranks seventh all-time at Old Dominion in scoring and rebounding, fourth in steals and fifth in assists.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

Openers

After topping Georgia Tech on Nov. 14, Old Dominion improves to 30-12 all-time in home openers. In season openers, the Lady Monarchs are 28-14 all-time. After topping Towson on January 6, ODU improved to 20-0 all-time in CAA openers.

CAA Preseason Poll

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish second in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the league head coaches. Defending champion James Madison was pegged as the top team heading into 2010-11.

Lady Monarchs Ink Five To National Letters of Intent

Old Dominion head women's basketball coach Wendy Larry announced the signing of five players to National Letters of Intent. Myeisha Hall, Tiffany Minor, Queen Tiye Jackson, Ashley Betz-White and Kaneisha Atwater will continue their academic and athletic careers with the Lady Monarchs beginning in 2011-12.

Hall is ranked the 53rd-best guard in the Class of 2011 by ESPN. She's 5-8 and can play the point or shooting guard spots. Hall averaged 22 points, nine rebounds and four assists last season for Palm Beach (Fla.) Lakes High School. The combo guard, who scored 40 points in a game as a junior, was named the South Florida Sun-Sentinel Big School Player of the Year in Palm Beach County.

Larry on Hall: "Myeisha is an athletic scorer with tremendous transitional skills."

Minor is ranked No. 72 among wing players in her class by ESPN.com. The 5-11 wing player averaged 16.7 points last year at The Maret School in Washington, D.C. She's an excellent set shooter who can rebound and pass well for a wing player. She's expected to either play shooting guard or small forward at ODU.

Larry on Minor: "She's extremely versatile with good court awareness. She also adds a great deal of length on the defensive side of the ball."

Jackson led Trenton (N.J.) Catholic Academy to a state title last year. She's an excellent rebounder at 5-11 and she's expected to contribute at one of the two forward spots at ODU. Jackson has a strong build and can score both inside and out. Her range extends to the three-point line.

Larry on Jackson: "She has the size of a post player with a perimeter players skills."

Betz-White is a 5-5 point guard out of Trinity High School in Camp Hill, Pa. She averaged 11.4 points and 4.2 steals last year en route to being named to the Class AAA All-State Third Team as a junior. A true point guard, Betz-White excels in transition and on the secondary break, but is also comfortable in a set offense. The guard is a solid outside shooter and features a good pull-up jumper.

Larry on Betz-White: "She's a true point guard with personality and flare. Ashley makes everyone around her better."

Atwater is a 5-7 combo guard from Fort Pierce Westwood High School in Florida. She led her high school team in scoring as a junior, averaging 28.2 points. Atwater tallied five triple-doubles last season. She's a three-sport high school athlete who is quick off the dribble and strong on the defensive side of the ball.

Larry on Atwater: "She's an athlete that's extremely quick and fast. Additionally, she's an exceptional defender that can help us a great deal."

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 923-320 (.743) and is in its 42nd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.
