Head Coach Wendy Larry is rapidly approaching the 500 victory mark in her career. To date she needs three victories to reach the mark. She currently holds a 497-183 overall record in her 23rd season as a head coach. Additionally, Coach Larry is approaching her 450th victory as the head coach at her alma mater. She holds a 448-152 record in her 20th season at the helm of the Old Dominion program.

BACK TO THE POLLS:

The Lady Monarchs received votes in both the Preseason Associated Press and WBCA/USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll. The Lady Monarchs have received votes over the last few seasons and are looking to return to the Top 25 in both polls. Old Dominion's last Top 25 ranking in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll was November 18th, 2003. Old Dominion's last appearance in the Associated Press Top 25 was the final poll of the 2002 season as the Lady Monarchs danced their way to the "Elite Eight".

STREET & SMITH:

Street and Smith Magazine has listed the Old Dominion women's basketball team at No. 18 in its in their annual College Basketball Yearbook which went on sale on Oct. 1. Included on this year's schedule are five teams also appearing in Street and Smith's list including No. 5 Tennessee, No. 7 Duke, No. 14 Rutgers, No. 15 Kentucky and No. 20 Virginia.

WHAT THE LADY MONARCHS WELCOME BACK:

The Old Dominion women's basketball team welcomes back four starters and nine letter-winners from last year's team that went 22-9 overall and captured its 15th consecutive Colonial Athletic Association title. Seventy two percent of the offense returns including the four of the five leading scorers and three of the four leading rebounders from a season ago. This year's group of seniors - Tish Lyons, Sherida Triggs, Shantel Wilson - enter the 2006-07 season having collected three CAA titles, three NCAA appearances, a 69-25 overall record and 49-5 mark in CAA matchups. Triggs joins junior guard T.J. Jordan on the Preseason Second Team All-CAA list. Triggs led the CAA in field goal percentage, was second on the ODU squad in scoring, and led the Lady Monarch rebounding corps. Jordan led the team in scoring and reset the single season three-point attempt record.

OPEN THE DOOR:

The Lady Monarch women's basketball team helped the Virginia Cavaliers open their new building - The John Paul Jones Arena - in ODU's first regular season contest on Saturday, November 12th. It was Virginia back on November 22nd, 2002 that helped Old Dominion open the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

HOME SWEET HOME:

Since the doors opened at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2002, the Lady Monarchs have enjoyed a 53-10 record.

CAA PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

SERIES WITH KENTUCKY:

Old Dominion leads the all-time series with Kentucky 7-2. The Lady Monarchs last faced the Wildcats back on January 23, 1987 as Kentucky snapped a four-game losing streak to Old Dominion with an 85-70 win in Lexington. It will be the fifth time the Wildcats come to Norfolk, but the first time playing in the Ted Constant Convocation Center having played all previous meetings at Old Dominion at the Fieldhouse, which is currently being torn down to make way for a new state-of-the-art recreation facility. Old Dominion is 4-0 at home against Kentucky, 2-1 in Lexington, and 1-0 in neutral site games. The Lady Monarchs faced the Wildcats at the C.Q. Data Systems Holiday Tournament in December of 1984 in the neutral site game, the same season Old Dominion won the NCAA Championship.

ABOUT KENTUCKY:

The Kentucky Wildcats enter Saturday's game sporting a 1-1 record after opening the season at the Women's Sports Foundation Tournament in Lexington. The Wildcats produced a season opening 80-51 victory over Washington State, but dropped a 51-54 decision the following game to Indiana. Head coach Mickie DeMoss begins her fourth year at the helm of the Kentucky women's basketball program after guiding the Wildcats to the most wins (22) in seven years, the most Southeastern Conference wins in school history (9), the highest conference finish (4) in 23 years, and UK's first appearance in the NCAA Tournament in seven years last season. The 2006 SEC Coach of the Year should be familiar to long-time Lady Monarch fans. DeMoss was the top assistant for 18 years at Tennessee helping the Lady Vols to 13 Final Fours and six national championships. The Wildcats are led by in scoring by senior forward Jennifer Humphrey (11.5 ppg) and sophomore point guard Carly Ormerod (10.5 ppg). Junior center Sarah Elliott lead the rebounding department (10.0 rpg).

BREAKING DOWN THE OPENERS:

The Lady Monarchs are 25-13 in season openers, suffering a 72-92 set back in this year's opener at Virginia. Of the previous 38 season openers, Old Dominion has opened the season three times with Virginia with a win in 1977, a loss in 2002 with the opening of ODU's Ted Constant Convocation Center, and a loss in 2006 at the opening of UVA's John Paul Jones Arena. In home openers, the Lady Monarchs are 27-10. Last season, Old Dominion opened the slate against the top-ranked team in the nation in Duke. The Lady Monarchs last home opening win was against Virginia Tech as Old Dominion opened the 2004-05 season with a 87-56 victory over the Hokies.

KEEP SHOOTING PARTNER:

Junior guard T.J. Jordan came off the bench in last Sunday's 72-92 loss at Virginia to net a team-high 21 points. Shooting 6-of-19 from the field, including 6-of-17 from three-point range, the third year Lady Monarch set new career-highs in field goals and three-pointers attempted. The Lady Monarchs' three-point specialist, she holds the single season three-point attempt mark (2005-06 - 248).

TAKING AWAY SOME GOOD:

Nobody likes a loss, but let's look at one thing the Lady Monarchs improved on from the exhibition season at last Sunday's loss at Virginia...Free Throw Shooting. In their last exhibition showing, a 105-50 win over M.I. Express, Old Dominion shot just 54.5 percent from the charity stripe hitting 24-of-44. Of the nine Lady Monarchs that got to the line, only three shot 50 percent or better (Sherida Triggs - 7-of-7, T.J. Jordan - 4-of-4, Jessica Canady - 3-of-4). Against Virginia, Old Dominion improved that mark to 63 percent as four of the six Lady Monarchs who got to the line hit 75 percent or better.

UP NEXT:

The Lady Monarchs continue their three-game home stand by hosting East Carolina on Tuesday, November 21 and Delaware State on Saturday, November 25th in a double header with the men's team. Old Dominion will be taking on the Pirates for the first time since they left the Colonial Athletic Association for Conference USA. The Delaware State game will be the first meeting between the two teams. Kentucky will get another taste of the CAA. They will take on Delaware at the Odwalla Classic in San Francisco, California.

COLONIAL DOMINANCE: Old Dominion has captured 14-straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 269-15 overall record, which includes eight seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 143-2 record at home and a 128-13 road record. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992 and the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005. Five schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Georgia State (2-0), George Mason (39-0), Northeastern (2-0), UNC-Wilmington (33-0), and Towson (9-0).

CHARLOTTESVILLE, Va. -- The Old Dominion women's basketball team opened the 2006-07 season with a 92-72 loss at in-state rival Virginia on Sunday afternoon at the brand new John Paul Jones Arena.

The game marked the opening of the Cavaliers brand new facility. Virginia had helped open ODU's new home, the Ted Constant Convocation Center, back when the door opened in 2002.

The loss dropped Old Dominion to 0-1 in their first showing of the regular season. Virginia improved to 2-0.

Virginia jumped out to a 14-point lead, 24-10. The Cavaliers built its lead to 21 points, 36-15 with 6:38 to go in the half and entered the locker room with a 14-point edge, 44-30, paced by senior Siedah Williams' 15 points.

In the second half, Virginia maintained its double-digit lead, going ahead by as many as 21 points.

Junior guard T.J. Jordan (Portsmouth, Va.) led the Lady Monarch squad with 21 points, all coming from three-point range. The third-year Lady Monarch shot 6-of-19 from the field, including 6-of-17 from three-point range setting new career-highs in field goals and three-pointers attempted.

Senior Sherida Triggs (Norcross, Ga.) sat out most of the first half in foul trouble and scored all 15 of her points in the second half.

Redshirt sophomore Tiffany Green (Chesapeake, Va.) collected a game-high 10 boards as Virginia only held a slight one rebound margin over Old Dominion, 43-42.

Sophomore Lyndra Littles led Virginia with a career-high 23 points and 12 rebounds for her second double-double of the season and seventh of her career. She went 13-of-14 from the line. Williams followed with 21 points. Junior Denesha Kenion came off the bench for a career-high 13 points, while freshman Monica Wright rounded out the double-figure scoring with 11 points. The frosh also added six boards, four assists, and three steals in her second start.
