EXTRA, EXTRA... THE LATEST NEWS

- **Climbing the Ladder:** Senior **Tarik Hislop** moved into 4th on the JMU all-time scoring list (1,632) 2/10 vs. Delaware, passing Lesley Dickinson (1,616; '07). She also set the record for most starts (126) in a JMU uniform, passing Tamera Young (125, '08). She is tied with Young for the JMU record of 127 consecutive games played.
- **Steppin' on the Gas:** Over the last 4 games, sophomore **Toia Giggetts** is shooting 53.3% & averaging 9.3 ppg, 1.0 blocks & 7.3 rpg. Overall, she is shooting 48.9% & averaging 5.7 ppg, 0.6 blocks & 5.4 rpg.
- **Block Party:** Since league play began, senior **Kanita Shepherd** and sophomores **Toia Giggetts** and **Crystal Ross** have posted six blocks apiece, accounting for 18 of JMU's 25 blocks against CAA opponents.
- **Paper Match-Up:** JMU leads the CAA in scoring offense (68.6) and ODU ranks 3rd in defense (55.9). JMU is 2nd with a +4.7 rebounding margin while ODU (10th) is being outrebounded by 4.3 boards per game. ODU leads the CAA with a +4.91 turnover margin, edging JMU (+3.35) in second place.
- **Bump in the Road:** JMU had won **8 straight** before falling 71-64 to Delaware on 2/10. The Dukes have 12 victories in their last 14 games. The 8-game win-streak is the longest streak of the season. The 7-pt. loss is the closest margin of victory for the Blue Hens in a CAA game this season, who entered the game winning by 24.3 pts.
- **On the Sidelines:** Senior **Nikki Newman** is likely out for the remainder of season with a foot injury. The 2012 CAA Defensive Player of the Year had played in 112 of 113 games before the injury, suffered Dec. 16 at Duquesne, kept her out of uniform.

DID YOU KNOW?

- **Top of the Class:** The 2012-13 freshman class was ranked the No. 1 mid-major conference recruiting class by ESPN.
- **Sticking Together:** JMU boasts two pairs of athletes who were teammates before becoming Dukes. Senior **Nikki Newman** and junior **Kirby Burkholder** were high school teammates at Turner Ashby as well as AAU teammates. Freshmen **Precious Hall** and **Destiny Jones** were also AAU teammates, both playing for Florida Essence.
- **Recruiters, Unite!:** Assistant Lindsay Smith, JMU's recruiting coordinator and a member of the coaching staff since 2009, became **Lindsay Smith Edmonds** in the off-season when she married Ulrick Edmonds, the JMU football team's recruiting coordinator/running backs coach in August.

- Members keep everyone informed when the Dukes are close to the **79-point mark** (see *last note in right column*), e.g. "Nine more points, nine more points."
- After a Kirby Burkholder 3-pointer, a chant of "**You got Kirby'd**" can be heard.
- They chant "**Kenny Brooks... Kenny Brooks**" when the Dukes' head coach makes his first appearance at the Convocation Center before a game.
- In unison, they ask JMU PA announcer Jack Cavanaugh "**Jack, how much time is left?**" just before the one-minute mark of each half.
- When Nikki Newman's in the lineup, they chant "**Nikki says 'No'**" when she blocks a shot or makes a defensive play.
- In the late stages of games, they helpfully guide losing teams home, chanting "81 South, 64 East" or other directions appropriate to the visiting team.
- Just before tipoff the band plays "**Start Wearing Purple**" and sings the lyrics below. (NOTE: The song was first performed by the band Gogol Bordello, circa 2006.)

You Might Know.... You Might Not...

Lineup Settled Now The Dukes used **nine different starting line-ups** in their first 14 games, in part due to injury or illness. Then Kenny Brooks **started the same five** (Giggetts, Burkholder, Ross, Hislop, Hall) **in games 15-21** before inserting Gwathmey for Ross in the last two games. Tarik Hislop and Kirby Burkholder are the only two to start every game this season. Ten of JMU's 11 players have been in the starting lineup at least once, with freshman Destiny Jones the only player not to start this season.

Cutting it Close The Dukes' 68-63 win at William & Mary on 2/3 marked the eighth time this season a JMU game has been decided by five or fewer points. JMU is 4-4 in those tightly-contested games.

Steals Record **Precious Hall** had a career-high and JMU freshman record 7 steals 1/24 at George Mason... former mark was 6, shared by Sandy Broughton (1984-85), Donna Budd (1985-86), Mistiza Colebank (1985-86), Kia Cole (1997-98).

Accurate at the Line JMU converted 20 of 21 free throw attempts and scored on its first 18 free throw tries at Georgia State (1/20/13). That gave the Dukes a string of **23 consecutive made three throws** (including the last five in a 1/17 win over William and Mary), **one short of the school record**. The record of 24 was set at East Carolina on Feb. 11, 2000.

JMU subsequently had a stretch of **21 straight free throw makes**, including the last nine 2/7 vs. UNCW and the first 12 2/10 vs. Delaware. The Dukes were 13-for-15 from the foul line vs. Delaware. Ironically, the two misses came from the CAA's top free-throw shooter, **Kirby Burkholder**. She had a good excuse to be off target, though, as minutes earlier her shooting hand had been inadvertently stepped on by an opposing player.

3-Point Record Tied JMU hit **eight 3's** in the second half 1/13/13 vs. Northeastern, tying the **school record for 3's in a half**. That's happened four times, all during Kenny Brooks' tenure... others were 3/13/11 vs. Delaware in the CAA final; 11/26/10 vs. Montana in a tournament in Mexico; 11/20/08 at Maryland.

Hislop's Clutch 3's **Tarik Hislop** leads JMU in field goals but only 18 of her 143 (12.6%) have come from 3-point range. Two of those 3's came late in regulation and **helped clinch wins**: 1/13/13 vs. Northeastern, when she hit a 3 with 2.9 seconds left for 68-65 home win; 11/22/12 vs. Green Bay, when she hit a 3 with 2.3 seconds left to tie game at 79 and force OT.

That Masked Woman Sophomore **Toia Giggetts** spent her freshman season wearing a mask to protect her nose after breaking it on the first day of practice. After an injury in a December practice that required some stitches above her nose, Giggetts resumed wearing the protective mask in a game Dec. 21 vs. American. The mask is not required by medical personnel; Giggetts has made a personal choice to wear it.

Bye, Bye Crutches, Hello Real Shoes! After being forced to use crutches for more than five weeks following her Dec. 16 foot injury, senior **Nikki Newman** upgraded to a walking boot on Jan. 23. On Feb. 8 she shed the boot ... just in time to slip on a fashionable magenta-hued pair of flats for the Feb. 10 Play 4Kay "pink out" game vs. Delaware.

Balanced Playing Time Only Tarik Hislop (35.0) and Kirby Burkholder (33.5) are playing an average of more than 23.8 minutes a game. Six of the remaining seven active players average between 11.3 and 23.8 minutes per game.

The Name Game

Muff The name freshman guard **Angela Mickens** answers to. Her mother called her "my little muffin" as an infant. "Anyone call you Angela?" we asked. "You mean, besides my professors?" Muff replied.

Bert The name her coaches and teammates call **Jazmon Gwathmey** on the court. Teammate Kanita Shepherd bestowed the nickname, as Shepherd felt that Gwathmey bears a resemblance to the Sesame Street character of Bert & Ernie fame.

Just Call Her 'P' In everyday life **Precious Hall** enjoys the name her father chose for her at birth. ("When I first saw her, that was the first thing that came to my mind. So we named her Precious," her dad told Matt Stoss of the *Harrisonburg News-Record*.) But the Dukes freshman says "Precious" doesn't fit her style of play on the court, so she prefers her first initial to be her call sign.

"Shooter, shooter!" When JMU 3-point ace **Kirby Burkholder** gets the ball, what you'll hear opposing coaches shouting this to alert their players.

Virginia's Marquee Program

Paul Woody, Richmond (Va.) Times-Dispatch (11/7/12):

If you are looking for the marquee program in the state now, your gaze should turn to Harrisonburg. Kenny Brooks has things going in the right direction.

The Dukes reached the championship game of the WNIT last season, beating Virginia along the way. The Dukes have beaten just about everyone else in the state and would be the odds-on favorite to win the CAA title this year, except for one team with one player (Delaware with national Player of the Year candidate Elena Delle Donne).

Brooks on JMU's Defense

Pre-game radio interview, 1/6/13

One of the things I've been most impressed with is that we're starting to play good defense. We've switched our defensive scheme. [In the past] we were getting out and pressuring the wings because we had Lauren Whitehurst and Nikki Newman, two of the best shot blockers in JMU history, in the back.

We've sloughed it in a little bit, protected the paint, and given a lot of help on the strong side. Kids are buying into it, they really understand it, and we've gone exclusively with it.

Dukes vs. Delaware

Coach Kenny Brooks (Richmond Times-Dispatch, 11/7/12):

Delaware is an obstacle, but we look forward to the challenge. We like the fact Elena (Delle Donne) is there. It brings national attention to our league.

And we've played them four times since she arrived, and beaten them in three of those games. If we beat Delaware now, we get national attention.

Brooks on Recruiting

Richmond Times-Dispatch, 11/7/12

Our margin of error is smaller than the BCS programs. The top recruits are not going to grow up dreaming of playing in the CAA.

We have to educate them about our school, which is a gem. We feel that seeing is believing. If we can get them on campus, we have a chance to get them in our program.

The first thing we do is identify the caliber of kids we want in our program, from the athletic and character standpoint. Character always is essential for us.

A lot of times we don't get the highest-rated players. But we have hard-working assistants, a lot of continuity on our staff, which is not always the case for a mid-major, and we keep working and working with our players to get better so we can compete with teams in power conferences.

Brooks on Precious Hall

Harrisonburg News-Record, 11/9/12

She's not overly quick but just understands how to play the game. She can get separation, shoots the ball extremely well — probably the second-best shooter behind Kirby [Burkholder] when she gets her feet set.

* * *

Post-game radio interview, 12/31/12

Precious has the quickest hands. She's just a nuisance. You put the ball in front of her, and she's going to get it, and she's very strong with it.

[I've told her] I'm going to continue to push you. I don't want you to be just the best freshman in the league, I want you to be one of the best **guards** in the league, and I think you can do that this year.

* * *

Pre-game radio interview, 1/6/13

Precious has done a fantastic job the last few games, taking some pressure off Tarik Hislop and Kirby Burkholder. It's hard to focus on Kirby and not leave her when Precious is running around and doing her thing. It's hard to deny Tarik the basketball because Precious is very adequate at bringing the ball up the floor and running the offense.

Defensively, we've put her on the best player. Where we thought defense was something she needed to work on in the beginning, she's turning out to be our best defender on the ball.

She's so strong, she's so smart. She's playing like a veteran now. We feel really comfortable with her in the game.

Brooks on Nikki Newman

Nikki is the best defender I've ever had. She impacts the game as well as anybody. If I had to pick an all-time starting five she'd be in it just because of the little things she does. (The others: Point guard Andrea Benvenuto '07 and three CAA POYs: Dawn Evans '11, Tamera Young '08, Meredith Alexis '07.)

Brooks on Tarik Hislop

Post-game radio interview, 12/31/12

I've been blessed to be able to coach some of the more dynamic players who've played here -- Andrea Benvenuto, Meredith Alexis, Dawn Evans, Tamera Young --and I'm blessed to be able to coach Tarik Hislop. Tarik does exactly what I ask her to do. She doesn't do very many things out on the floor that I don't agree with.

I absolutely adore coaching that kid. She's constantly texting me, calling me, 'Hey coach can we get an extra workout in?'

We've been taking her game to another level, to get her ready for life after JMU, and she just eats it up, loves the opportunity.

She's really taken Precious under her wing. She's the ultimate competitor. Sometimes I have to calm her down because she wants to win everything, EVERYTHING. If we're playing purple team against the gold team and they don't win, she's visibly upset.

You LOVE coaching kids like that. It's been a treat to watch her go from being in the shadows of Dawn Evans to gladly accepting the challenge of taking over the program. She's done a wonderful job of doing it, and I love her to death.

Preseason Injuries

Matt Stoss (Harrisonburg News-Record, 11/9/12):

Nikki Newman has a torn meniscus in her knee. Newman sustained the injury at practice in early October but hasn't missed any time and said she plans to play through it, putting off surgery as long as possible.

Newman: I'm going to try to [avoid surgery] as long as I can and not get it done. I'm sure it'll eventually happen, and if so, it will be before conference play.

Kanita Shepherd tore an ACL two years ago and took a medical redshirt last season. The senior has suffered several setbacks and endured multiple surgeries, and Brooks said Shepherd still isn't full strength.

Angela Mickens has practiced sparingly during the preseason because of an injured thumb and a concussion. Brooks said she's over the concussion but doesn't expect her to be cleared for the thumb until today [Nov. 9].

Game 21, Feb. 1, 2012: JMU 57, Old Dominion 55

Game Flow: Tarik Hislop's driving shot off the glass dropped in the basket with 3.7 seconds left to lift JMU to the win... the Dukes rallied from 14 points down in the second half.

First Half: ODU did not trail in the half and used a 15-5 run to pull ahead to a 19-9 lead at 12:52... five ODU players scored during the run... JMU closed to within five, 26-21, on a Kirby Burkholder 3-pointer at 4:53... ODU outscored JMU 10-5 in the final 4:32 to take a 36-26 lead at halftime... Burkholder led all players with 14 points; she hit four 3-pointers... JMU shot only 25 percent (9-36) from the floor, while ODU shot 39 percent (14-36), and ODU out-rebounded JMU 29-21.

Second Half: ODU led 36-26 at halftime and opened the second half with a 6-2 run to open up its biggest lead, 14 points, 42-28 at 17:54... JMU then outscored ODU 18-3, including 13 unanswered points, to lead 46-45 on a layup by Crystal Ross with 10:00 to play... the Dukes held the lead until Tia Lewis scored on a layup with 45.6 seconds left to tie the game at 55-55.

Game Flow, con't: On JMU's next possession Hislop drove the length of the court, but ODU freshman Ashley Betz-White stole the ball with 37 seconds remaining... however, ODU's Jackie Cooke turned the ball over on a bad pass, giving the Dukes the ball and setting up Hislop's game-winning basket.

JMU Stats Standouts: Kirby Burkholder game-high 20 points and career-high-tying six 3-pointers; also four assists and three steals... Jasmine Gill 14 points... Lauren Whitehurst team-high nine rebounds... Crystal Ross six blocked shots, tying a JMU freshman single-game record.

ODU Leaders: Tia Lewis 17 points and game-high 10 rebounds... Mairi Buchan 10 points, nine rebounds... Jackie Cooke nine points, 10 rebounds.

Of Note: Hislop, the Dukes' leading scorer, was only 2-of-19 from the field but had a game-high six assists... the 36 first-half points scored by ODU was a JMU opponent first-half high this season... ODU out-rebounded JMU by 21 (59-38), and that tied (with two other games) for the biggest rebounding margin for a Dukes' opponent in Kenny Brooks' 10 JMU seasons.
