THE GAME

East Carolina continues its four-game homestand to start the 2022 season playing host to Old Dominion Saturday, Sept. 10 followed by Campbell (Sept. 17) and Navy (Sept. 24) ... ECU will look to get into the win column after a tough loss to No. 13 NC State in the season opener ... The Monarchs are rolling into town after a 20-17 come from behind win over Virginia Tech ... This will be the fourth meeting between the two schools with the Pirates holding a 3-0 series lead.

EAST CAROLINA RECORDS, STREAKS & TRENDS

- ▶ Has allowed only three 4th-quarter offensive TDs in the last seven games dating back to '21 ...
- ▶ Has forced at least one turnover in 19 of the last 21 games (and in 30 of the last 31) ...
- ▶ Has held the edge in time of possession for six-straight contests (32:18 vs. NC State) ...
- ▶ Had +6.4 ppg, +86.7 typpg and +107.0 typpg cumulative margins in all eight AAC games ...
- ▶ Had a collective time of possession edge in all eight AAC games (+8:42 avg.) ...
- ▶ Snapped more offensive plays in all eight AAC games (+112 the last five contests) ...
- ▶ Is averaging 38,295 fans per game since the start of 2021 season ...

FAST FACTS

Record – 0-1 (.000); **AAC Record/Standing** – 0-0 (.000)/NA; **Last 5 Games** – 3-2; **Last 10 Games** – 6-4; **Last 15 Games** – 8-7; **Streaks** – East Carolina will play the 35th game of the Mike Houston Era when the Pirates face off against Old Dominion. ECU's contest against the Monarchs will be the Pirates' 906th since the start of football in 1932 (454-440-11/508).

SCHEMES

ODU utilizes a multiple offensive attack while also employing a multiple defensive alignment. ECU will feature a multiple pro-style look on offense and are a multiple unit on defense.

THE COACHES

MIKE HOUSTON (Mars Hill '94) is in his 12th year as a collegiate head coach with a 94-45 (.676) mark, while he is 14-20 (.411) during four seasons at East Carolina. When he officially became the Pirates' 22nd all-time head football coach on Dec. 4, 2018, Houston finished a three-year stint directing the James Madison program. Houston signed a contract extension with the Pirates securing his position through the 2026 season.

Houston guided the Dukes to a 37-6 mark, which included three NCAA FCS postseason appearances (2016 national champions, 2017 national runner-up, 2018 second round) and a pair of Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles. He was named the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) FCS National Coach-of-the-Year in 2016 after JMU turned in a 14-1 campaign.

The appointment to the top Dukes' football position followed brief head coaching assignments at Lenoir-Rhyne (2011-13) and The Citadel (2014-15). He led the Bears to a 29-8 ledger and a pair of NCAA Division II playoff showings before guiding the Bulldogs to a 14-11 record, a Southern Conference co-championship and a venture into the FCS playoffs in 2015.

Houston, a Franklin, N.C. native, began his collegiate coaching career as defensive coordinator at Brevard College in 2006 before serving in a similar capacity at L-R from 2007 to 2010.

RICKY RAHNE (Cornell '02) is 7-97 (.500) in his second season heading the football program at Old Dominion. In his first season on the field in 2021, Rahne took a team that went 1-11 in 2019, and did not play in 2020, to a bowl game. ODU started the season 1-6 and won five-straight behind Rahne's 1-0 mentality, to earn a bid to the Myrtle Beach Bowl to play Tulsa. ODU became just the third team since 1936 (AP Poll era) to start the season 1-6 or worse and win six games. Before arriving in Norfolk, Va, he spent six years on the Penn State staff two as the offensive coordinator and four as the quarterbacks coach. He has also served as an offensive assistant at Vanderbilt (2011-13), Kansas State (2006-10), Cornell (2005) and Holy Cross (2004) where he helped lead those schools to a combined 11 bowl games.

THE SERIES

East Carolina leads 3-0 ... During Mike Houston's initial season with the Pirates, his defense booked 11 tackles for loss which included four sacks spearheading a 24-21 win in Norfolk ... In the first meeting between the two schools, the Pirates used a then-school-record passing performance (447 yards, 46 completions) from Shane Carden to open the series with a victory in Greenville (2013) before benefitting from Jake Verity's game-winning field goal in 2018:

HOUSTON AGAINST THE MONARCHS

Mike Houston is 1-0 all-time against Old Dominion as a head coach ... Houston and the Pirates earned a 24-21 win back in 2019 that snapped a 10-game road losing streak.

RAHNE AGAINST THE PIRATES

This will be the first meeting for Ricky Rahne's against East Carolina.

LAST MEETING

East Carolina 24, Old Dominion 21

<Sept. 28, 2019 @S.B. Ballard Stadium, Norfolk, Va.>

A swarming East Carolina defense booked 11 tackles for lost yardage, including four sacks, to spearhead the Pirates' 24-21 non-conference win over Old Dominion at S.B. Ballard Stadium ... The victory snapped ECU's 10-game road losing streak dating back to 2017 while also serving as the first non-league road triumph since 2014 ... Through its effort on the defensive side of the ball, the Pirates built a 17-3 halftime lead by limiting the Monarchs to just 106 total yards (38 passing) in the opening 30 minutes ... East Carolina also used a four-yard blocked punt return for a touchdown by Warren Saba - its first special teams score in nearly four years - late in the first quarter to break a 3-3 deadlock before quarterback Holton Ahlers connected with Blake Proehl on a 72-yard TD strike early in the second stanza ... ODU bounced back to trim the margin to four, 17-13, midway through the third quarter on a Nick Rice field goal and a five-yard scoring run by Stone Smartt ... ECU answered the charge on Anthony Watley's five-yard touchdown catch that capped an eight-play, 75-yard march to open the fourth quarter ... The Monarchs rallied back again on Kesean Strong's one-yard plunge and a subsequent two-point pass conversion with 2:13 remaining but the Pirates recovered the onside kick to seal the win ... Kendall Futrell created most of the pressure with a team-best seven tackles, three sacks and a pair of quarterback hurries ... ECU kept the Monarch's ground game mostly in check by allowing a meager 90 yards on 42 carries - an average of just 2.1 per attempt ... Ahlers completed 8-of-21 passes for 202 yards.

EAST CAROLINA AGAINST THE SUN BELT CONFERENCE

East Carolina has compiled an all-time record of 36-34 (.514) against current members of the Sun Belt Conference ... The Pirates are 3-0 against Old Dominion, 11-5 vs. Marshall, 3-0 vs. Georgia Southern, 2-0 vs. Arkansas State, 1-0 vs. Texas State, 0-1 vs. Georgia State, 0-1 vs. James Madison 4-7 vs. Louisiana, 12-20 vs. Appalachian State ... Since taking over the helm of the program, Mike Houston is 2-2 (.500) all-time against Sun Belt teams which included a split last year with a season-opening loss against Appalachian State (33-19) and a road win at Marshall (42-38).

ANALYZING THE 2022 OVERALL SCHEDULE

ECU's 2022 opponents tallied a combined 79-71 (.527) record in 2021 ... The Pirates' four non-conference foes were a collective 28-21 (.571), while the eight AAC teams posted a 51-50 (.505) mark ... Five programs had seven (7) or more wins – Cincinnati (13-1), Houston (12-2), BYU (10-3), UCF (9-4) and NC State (9-3).

WHO WENT BOWLING ... The Pirates' current slate features contests against seven teams who were invited to bowl games in 2021, including Cincinnati, who earned the AAC's first College Football Playoff berth ... NC State (San Diego County Credit Union Holiday), Old Dominion (Myrtle Beach), Memphis (Hawaii), UCF (Union Home Mortgage Gasparilla), BYU (Radiance Technologies Independence), Houston (TicketSmarter Birmingham) and Cincinnati (Goodyear Cotton) ... Five of the Pirates' seven home games are against 2021 bowl qualifiers.

IN THE FINAL POLLS ... Four of ECU's 2022 opponents finished the 2021 season in college football's two major polls (*Associated Press* and *USA Today Amway Coaches*) – league champion Cincinnati (4/4), Houston (17/17), NC State (20/19) and BYU (19/22).

A SINGLE-GAME RECORD-BREAKER

With an attendance total of 51,711 against NC State last weekend, ECU established a single-game home record - surpassing the 51,082 clip who watched the Pirates beat North Carolina on Sept. 20, 2014 ... In all, East Carolina has enjoyed sell out crowds for 13 contests since Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium was expanded in 2010:

LOOKING FOR MORE LOOT

Despite its impressive 45-3 win, East Carolina's 16-game streak of forcing at least one turnover came to a halt against Temple on Nov. 6 (2021) ... The run, which began on Oct. 3, 2020 at Georgia State and produced 36 takeaways (22 interceptions, 14 fumble recoveries), was the program's longest since a 33-game streak (from 2007 to 2010) ... In all, ECU still has at least one takeaway in 19 of the last 21 (and 30 of 33) contests.

East Carolina is 21-29 in non-Saturday games since 2000 ... Oddly, the Pirates have fared better on the road (14-14; 7-15 at home) ... In terms of days (including bowls), ECU is 5-1 on Sundays, 1-1 on Mondays, 2-1 on Tuesdays, 0-3 on Wednesdays, 8-12 on Thursdays and 5-11 on Fridays ... Most recently, ECU is 10-14 when deviating from the normal Saturday routine since 2010 ... The Pirates' last Monday outing was a successful one as East Carolina downed Ohio 37-20 on Dec. 23, 2013 in the Beef 'O' Brady's Bowl at Tropicana Field in St. Petersburg, Fla.

WHAT WE SAW (2021)

- ▶ The Pirates closed the year by capturing four of their last five games (and seven of 10) to produce East Carolina's first winning season (7-5) and earn postseason eligibility for the first time since 2014 ...
- ▶ There were only a combined six players (5 who return in 2022) who made their first ECU start during the 2021 campaign - two on offense, four on defense. In comparison, there were 21 first-time starters in 2020 ...
- ▶ ECU ranked among the Top 25 nationally in seven statistical categories in 2021, including four in the Top 15 - 4th down offense (9th/72.2%), 3rd down defense (12th/32.7%), time of possession (12th/32:33) and most passes intercepted (14th/15) ...
- ▶ **RB Keaton Mitchell** became the first Pirate since 2013 to turn in a 1K rushing season with 1,132 yards ...
- ▶ **CB Ja'Quan McMillian**, a five-time Second-Team All America selection, captured a NCAA statistical title by leading the nation in passes defended (1.75), while also standing 4th in most passes intercepted (5).

WHAT WE HAVE (2022)

- ▶ ECU returns a perfect 100 percent of its ground yards in 2022, which was responsible for the Pirates' 1,949-yard net total - the program's fifth-highest clip since 2000 (and best since 2014) ...
- ▶ ECU returns 98 percent of its total yards (5,101 of 5,198) in 2022 ...
- ▶ ECU returns 97 percent (3,147 of 3,249) of its passing yards in 2022 ...
- ▶ Of ECU's 43 touchdowns last year, 35 (81 percent) were scored by players who return in 2022 ...
- ▶ Of ECU's 21 takeaways last year, eight were tallied by defenders who return in 2022 ...
- ▶ Both Pirates who earned First-Team American Athletic Conference honors last year return in 2022 - **PK Owen Daffer** and **RB Keaton Mitchell** ...
- ▶ Among 2021 individual Top 25 national (FBS) statistical leaders for 2022 returners - **RB Keaton Mitchell** stood 9th in rush yards per carry (6.51), **PK Owen Daffer** ranked 18th in field goals made per game (1.58) and **QB Holton Ahlers** was 19th in pass yards per game (260.5) and 21st in completions per game (21.3) ...
- ▶ ECU's defensive unit, which returns seven of 11 starters in 2022, held two single-game opponents under 100 yards rushing and two more under the 100-yard passing mark in 2021 ...

The Pirates dropped to 40-46 (.465) on opening day since ECU started its football program back in 1932 ... With its 21-20 loss against No. 13 NC State, the Pirates have dropped its last six.

AT DOWDY-FICKLEN STADIUM

East Carolina's all-time record at Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium is 196-112 (.636) ... The Pirates opened the facility on Sept. 21, 1963 with a 20-10 win over Wake Forest in front of 17,000 fans, celebrated the stadium's 50th anniversary in 2013 and recently hosted its 300th game vs. Tulane in 2020 ... Before a 4-2 clip in 2021, a 1-3 record two years ago and a collective 13-19 mark from 2015-2019, ECU was 5-1 in 2014, 2013 and 2012 (15-3) and won a combined 10 of 12 home matchups in 2009 (6-1) and 2008 (4-1) ... Overall, ECU has posted 40 winning campaigns at DFS since 1963.

THE PIRATE NATION - OVER 9 MILLION STRONG

East Carolina has usually been able to claim plenty of hometown support when playing at Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium - establishing itself among conference attendance leaders on a near annual basis ... In all, a total of **9,173,535** fans have seen the Pirates in action since 1963, and since the completion of a 7,000-seat expansion project in 2010 (to push capacity to 50,000), the Pirates have drawn 2,902,246 fans.

East Carolina will enter the Old Dominion game with an active streak of 300 games of not suffering a shutout - a school record (previous mark was 110 set from '71-'81) ... The last time the Pirates were blanked was on Oct. 4, 1997 (56-0 at Syracuse) ... ECU's 300-game run currently ranks among the Top 10 nationally (Florida is first with 424).

Keaton Mitchell (124/CIN, 103/TEM in 2020 and 135/MAR, 125/CSU, 222/TLN, 146/TEM in 2021) became the first Pirates' RB in eight years to post six career 100-yard rushing contests when he eclipsed triple digits vs. Temple on Nov. 6 ... **Rahjai Harris** tallied his fourth (22-100) vs. USF a week earlier, marking the first time since 2003 that ECU featured teammates with at least four each (**Marvin Townes/5, Art Brown/4**) ... Individually, **Dominique Lindsay** posted five in 2009 for the most recent single-season best.

AMONG TOP PASSING UNITS IN AMERICAN HISTORY

Since joining the AAC in 2014, the Pirates stand second in passing yards over a combined seven-plus year period despite utilizing nine starting quarterbacks, four offensive coordinators and three head coaches: **1. Memphis (30,104), 2. East Carolina (28,501), 3. UCF (26,374), 4. SMU (26,168), 5. Houston (25,872), 6. Cincinnati (25,770), 7. Tulsa (24,512), 8. Temple (22,345), 9. South Florida (20,432), 10. Tulane (18,123) and 11. Navy (8,054)** ... However, the Pirates top the league in completions (2,406) and attempts (3,983) ... **ECU has also accounted for a conference-high 19 400-yard passing games** and surpassed the 300-yard mark on 49 occasions during the 91-game span ... The top two receivers in NCAA FBS history by career receptions - **Zay Jones** (399 from 2013-16) and **Justin Hardy** (387 from 2011-2014) - are former ECU players.

GREENVILLE, N.C. — Following his first game as East Carolina’s football coach, a decisive loss at NC State on the last day of August in 2019, Mike Houston vowed to bring a vastly different team into battle the next time the teams met.

That day came on a steamy Saturday afternoon before a record crowd of 51,711 Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium to open the 2022 season. And Houston’s words proved prophetic down to the final seconds when Owen Daffer’s 41-yard field goal attempt sailed right, leaving the Pirates heartbroken and on the end of a 21-20 loss.

ECU, bolstered by two goal-line stands and an interception, clawed back from a 21-7 halftime deficit and had a chance to tie with 2:58 left, but Daffer hooked his extra-point kick. A chance at redemption came with nine seconds showing, but the miss ended an upset bid of the nation’s 13th-ranked team.

The Wolfpack, playing their first true road game season-opener since 2008 (at South Carolina), escaped with their third straight and just their second win in six trips to Greenville. N.C. State had won the previous two meetings by a combined 92-9 score, including Houston’s debut.

Saturday’s heart-wrenching finish hit hard for Houston, who is 0-4 in season-openers at ECU and has dropped five straight.

“The kids fought their tails off,” he said. “They inspire me with the way they play. I know nobody outside of Greenville gave us much of a chance, but those kids never doubted. We should have won the ballgame. We outplayed them. We dominated them physically in the second half. I’m just really hurt for those kids in that locker

room right now

“They’ve brought this program from the depths back to where it was today.”

Senior quarterback Holton Ahlers and linebacker Myles Berry remember those days and take pride in resurrecting the program. Both served as game captains and soaked in the moment as they walked out before an electric crowd for the coin toss.

“We were both here in 2018 when Coach Mo (Scottie Montgomery) got fired, actually in this room before the State game, and then we went on to lose, I think it was 58 to 3 at State,” Ahlers said. “The program that it is now, it just makes me proud – I’m about to tear up even thinking about it. I looked at Myles when we were walking out there, and I was like, ‘Dude, we did it. We brought ECU football back.’ Whatever happens in game, look around, the energy’s back in Greenville and around this team.”

Berry and his defensive mates made a statement by ending the Wolfpack’s streak of 10 consecutive games with at least 27 points, including a second-half shutout. The Pirates limited quarterback Devin Leary to 211 yards passing, his lowest total since Oct. 17, 2020, when he suffered a season-ending injury against Duke.

“The standard that we play with has risen tremendously,” Berry said. “We knew it was going to be a big task, but a game is a game. We fear no one. It was just great to see, and I’m proud of the guys and how we competed today.”

Ahlers, on track to eclipse nearly every school record for a quarterback, became the American Athletic Conference leader in career completions (833) after connecting on 25 of 41 passes for 267 yards. He overcame an interception on the opening drive to toss a 39-yarder to former high school teammate C.J. Johnson for a 7-0 lead. The offense stalled against an aggressive Wolfpack defense the rest of the half, and State stormed back on a 12-yard pass from Leary to Thayer Thomas and a 24-yard run by Demi Sumo-Karngbaya sandwiched around a blocked punt that Sean Brown recovered for a touchdown.

That special-teams hiccup looked to be a backbreaker, but ECU found life in the second half.

A 13-play, 79-yard drive highlighted by a one-handed catch by at the 1 by Isaiah Winstead (10 catches, 58) yards and capped by Shane Calhoun’s 1-yard catch drew ECU within 21-14.

A quick answer by the Wolfpack vanished on a third-down play from the 2 when Jordan Houston’s fumble wound up in the hands of Gerard Stringer. Moments later, the ECU defense responded yet again, denying Sumo-Karngbaya on four tries from the one.

“That’s what we play for as a defense,” Berry said. “We play to get those stops. We play to get put in those bad situations and then winning those situations.”

Winning the game would have made those stands legendary, Houston said.

“If we hit that kick at the end, we’re sitting here saying those are historic plays in the history of the program,” he said. “Everybody in the stadium has to respect what those kids did down there. You don’t do that. You don’t do that to a 13th-ranked team, you don’t do that to one of the better teams in the ACC. Nobody does that to them. I think that says a lot about those kids, says a lot about the heart they’ve got, says a lot about the toughness they’ve got.”

The stalwart stands did set the stage for a dramatic finish. After Jireh Wilson picked off a Leary pass and returned it 34 yards, Rahjai Harris scored four plays later from the 3 to make it 21-20. Daffer’s attempt to tie hooked low and left.

ECU then forced a three-and-out and started one final drive from its 29 with 2:27 to play. A 37-yard catch and run by Keaton Mitchell got the Pirates in field-goal range at the 31. An Ahlers keeper to the 24 on third down set up the potential game-winner.

After an NC State timeout, Daffer pushed his kick right of the upright.

“He’s hurting worse than anybody right now,” Houston said. “We’ve got to support him, and he’s got to rebound from this.”

Ahlers, always under the microscope as a quarterback, offered his support.

“We’re going to need him to win a conference championship; we feel like we have a team to do that,” Ahlers said. “I believe in him. I’ve been through a lot here too. I’ve been through all sorts of scrutiny and all that too, so I told him I was there for him.”
