Quick Hits:

- Old Dominion head coach Wendy Larry will be going for her 600th career coaching victory today. With her next win she'll be the 12th active coach and 20th all-time to reach the 600-win plateau.
- The Lady Monarchs will be facing Towson for the second time this season today. Led by the return of Alena Voronina, ODU topped the Tigers, 69-63, in Towson, Md. on January 2. Voronina returned from a six game absence because of an elbow injury and tallied a career-high 25 points in the win.
- The Lady Monarchs saw their five-game win streak snapped Thursday against VCU. There is currently a four-way tie atop the CAA standings with ODU, VCU, UNC Wilmington & JMU all having 5-1 records in league play.
- Old Dominion jumped to #35 in the latest RPI rankings. The Lady Monarchs are just ahead of Louisville, Missouri & North Carolina.

About Towson

- The Tigers have dropped five of their last six games, but their lone win in that time frame came against VCU at home.
- Five Towson players scored in double figures in the meeting between ODU and Towson on January 2. Senior forward Dovile Miliauskaitė paced the team with 13 points and 10 rebounds.
- The Tigers are 3-5 on the road this season and winless in two road CAA games thus far.
- Sheree Ledbetter is the lone Tiger averaging double-figures in scoring. Ledbetter paces the team with 10.0 points and 6.2 rebounds per game.
- Old Dominion and Towson shared only one non-conference common opponent. The Tigers lost at home to Richmond on December 22, 66-50, while the Lady Monarch lost at Richmond on December 12, 65-43.

About Old Dominion

- The Lady Monarchs are 7-2 at home this season, but did fall to Towson at home last season.
- As of Jan. 17 Old Dominion boasts an RPI of #35. That is the best among all CAA schools.
- Senior Jasmine Parker leads the team with 13.3 points and 3.4 steals per game. The guard has hit for double figures in 15 of 17 games this year and she has led the team in scoring in six contests.
- Junior Tia Lewis paces the squad in rebounding (7.4 rpg) and is third in scoring (12.0 ppg). The forward has a team-high six double-doubles on the year.
- ODU has been dealing with a pair of significant injuries this season. Key reserve Mairi Buchan has missed every game with a foot injury, while senior Alena Voronina missed six games with an elbow injury before returning at Towson.

VCU Recap

Despite cutting a 14-point second half deficit to just two with less than three minutes to play, Old Dominion came up just short in a 63-60 loss to Virginia Commonwealth Thursday evening at the Ted Constant Center. The loss snapped ODU's five-game winning streak and was the first home loss for the Lady Monarchs since being defeated by Tennessee on December 5. Senior Kquanise Byrd and junior Tia Lewis led the way for Old Dominion with 11 points each, while VCU's Courtney Hurt posted game-highs in points (19) and rebounds (16).

Third In The Nation

Old Dominion ranks No. 3 nationally in defending the three-point line. The Lady Monarchs have shut down their opponents on the perimeter, holding them to a 22.9 percent shooting clip. Teams are 52-of-227 from beyond the arc against ODU this year.

Mid-Major Poll

Old Dominion remained No. 8 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, which was released January 11. Green Bay sits atop the rankings, while Drexel (No. 13), James Madison (18), Delaware (19) & UNC Wilmington (23) also represent the CAA.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs play one of the toughest schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule features games against five teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane and JMU) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida, Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel). At the end of its non-conference slate, ODU's schedule ranked No. 16 according to CollegeRPI.com.

RECORD CROWDS AT THE

TED:

Old Dominion set the all-time women's basketball attendance record at the Ted Constant Center earlier this season when the Lady Monarchs hosted Tennessee. The game between the two historic programs was a **BLUE OUT** and a remarkable 7,774 fans packed the Ted. Old Dominion boasts a dominant 108-23 overall record in the Constant Center, including seven victories over nationally ranked opponents.

Parker Reaches 1,000

Senior guard Jasmine Parker became just the 28th all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points. With her game-high 16 points against No. 9/8 Tennessee, the guard from Norfolk reached the major plateau.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

ACC Win

Old Dominion topped Atlantic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008. The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

CAA Honors

Senior Jasmine Parker was named the CAA Co-Player of the week Nov. 29 after scoring a combined 47 points and swiping nine steals in games at NC State and home vs. Louisville. Junior Tia Lewis earned the same honor January 10 after recording back-to-back double-doubles against George Mason and James Madison. This week a third Lady Monarch garnered CAA Player of the Week accolades as senior Kquanise Byrd was honored after scoring a career-high 22 points in ODU's win at Delaware.

Openers

After topping Georgia Tech on Nov. 14, Old Dominion improves to 30-12 all-time in home openers. In season openers, the Lady Monarchs are 28-14 all-time. After topping Towson on January 6, ODU improved to 20-0 all-time in CAA openers.

Exhibition Success

The Lady Monarchs went 2-0 in a pair of home exhibition games against Davis & Elkins and Bowie State. Junior Tia Lewis posted 20 points and 23 rebounds against D&E, while sophomore JoNiquia Guilford shined versus Bowie State with a game-high 19 points.

Dixon To Have Jersey Retired

Former Lady Monarch basketball All-American and Olympian Medina Dixon will have her jersey retired on Sunday, Jan. 30, prior to Old Dominion's 2 p.m. game against Georgia State at the Ted Constant Center. During her three years as a Lady Monarch, Dixon helped lead Old Dominion to an 84-14 record and two trips to the NCAA Final Four. In 1983 the Lady Monarchs rolled to a 29-6 record and hosted the Final Four in Norfolk. ODU lost the semi-final game to Louisiana Tech. As a senior in 1985, Dixon guided Old Dominion to a 31-3 record and the NCAA National Championship. The Lady Monarchs topped Georgia for the title and Dixon was named to the NCAA All-Tournament team. Dixon, a Boston, Mass. native, was a standout forward for ODU from 1982-85. She completed her career with 1,968 points, 979 rebounds, 417 assists and 277 steals. She ranks seventh all-time at Old Dominion in scoring and rebounding, fourth in steals and fifth in assists.

CAA Preseason Poll

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish second in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the league head coaches. Defending champion James Madison was pegged as the top team heading into 2010-11.

NCAA Host Site

Old Dominion has been selected as one of 16 host sites for first- and second-round games in the 2012 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Lady Monarchs Ink Five To National Letters of Intent

Old Dominion head women's basketball coach Wendy Larry announced the signing of five players to National Letters of Intent. Myeisha Hall, Tiffany Minor, Queen Tiye Jackson, Ashley Betz-White and Kaneisha Atwater will continue their academic and athletic careers with the Lady Monarchs beginning in 2011-12.

Hall is ranked the 53rd-best guard in the Class of 2011 by ESPN. She's 5-8 and can play the point or shooting guard spots. Hall averaged 22 points, nine rebounds and four assists last season for Palm Beach (Fla.) Lakes High School. The combo guard, who scored 40 points in a game as a junior, was named the South Florida Sun-Sentinel Big School Player of the Year in Palm Beach County.

Larry on Hall: "Myeisha is an athletic scorer with tremendous transitional skills."

Minor is ranked No. 72 among wing players in her class by ESPN.com. The 5-11 wing player averaged 16.7 points last year at The Maret School in Washington, D.C. She's an excellent set shooter who can rebound and pass well for a wing player. She's expected to either play shooting guard or small forward at ODU.

Larry on Minor: "She's extremely versatile with good court awareness. She also adds a great deal of length on the defensive side of the ball."

Jackson led Trenton (N.J.) Catholic Academy to a state title last year. She's an excellent rebounder at 5-11 and she's expected to contribute at one of the two forward spots at ODU. Jackson has a strong build and can score both inside and out. Her range extends to the three-point line.

Larry on Jackson: "She has the size of a post player with a perimeter players skills."

Betz-White is a 5-5 point guard out of Trinity High School in Camp Hill, Pa. She averaged 11.4 points and 4.2 steals last year en route to being named to the Class AAA All-State Third Team as a junior. A true point guard, Betz-White excels in transition and on the secondary break, but is also comfortable in a set offense. The guard is a solid outside shooter and features a good pull-up jumper.

Larry on Betz-White: "She's a true point guard with personality and flare. Ashley makes everyone around her better."

Atwater is a 5-7 combo guard from Fort Pierce Westwood High School in Florida. She led her high school team in scoring as a junior, averaging 28.2 points. Atwater tallied five triple-doubles last season. She's a three-sport high school athlete who is quick off the dribble and strong on the defensive side of the ball.

Larry on Atwater: "She's an athlete that's extremely quick and fast. Additionally, she's an exceptional defender that can help us a great deal."

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 920-320 (.742) and is in its 42nd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.
