Quick Hits:

- 900 WINS! With their win against Hofstra, Old Dominion became just the third program in NCAA history to reach 900 wins in program history (Louisiana Tech and Tennessee)
- ODU has won seven straight and eight of the last nine games; over .500 for the first time this season, 10-9
- According to rpiratings.com, the Lady Monarch schedule through 17 games was ranked the 18th toughest in the nation, #13 out of 345 total programs; ODU's RPI is now 63, third in the CAA
- Senior Jessica Canady is averaging 11.7 ppg and 8.4 rpg in CAA games this year
- Sophomore Tia Lewis ranks fourth in the CAA in rebounding with 7.8 per game. She is averaging 11.8 points per game and 7.8 rpg after averaging a double-double during her first season at UCF
- Despite just 92 points her freshman year as a reserve player, senior Jessica Canady now has 913 career points; she needs to average 9.7 ppg to reach 1,000 before the end of the regular season
- UNC Wilmington has two wins in CAA play this year, both against the College of William & Mary

Recap:

The Old Dominion women's basketball team opened up defense of its conference crown with a 61-56 victory over UNC-Wilmington in the CAA Tournament quarterfinals.

ODU (17-12) looked to have the game in hand as the Lady Monarchs had established a 13-point lead with 3:12 remaining in the game. However a 15-4 run by the Seahawks (16-15) made it a two-point ball game with less than a minute remaining. UNC Wilmington's Brittany Blackwell ran the length of the court laying the ball up and it and was fouled as Old Dominion clung to a 58-56 advantage with the clock reading 54 seconds.

Blackwell missed her chance for the Seahawks to close the gap to within one as junior Jessica Canady made one of her game-high 13 rebounds. Canady quickly turned the ball over giving UNC Wilmington a shot at tying the game. The Seahawks, however, were not able to find its way to the basket as senior Jen Nuzzo tipped away the inbounds for the Lady Monarchs to gain possession.

Nuzzo went to the line, missing her first shot, but connecting on the second to give Old Dominion a three-point cushion with 25 seconds left. The Seahawks' came down the court needing a three to potentially send the game into overtime, but Whitney Simmon's jumper was off its mark. Sophomore Shadasia Green grabbed the board and was fouled. The second year Lady Monarch, who entered the game shooting just 55 percent from the charity stripe and was 1-of-3 from the line on the day, iced both free throws to send the Lady Monarch to the semifinal match-up with top-seeded Drexel.

Canady, a Second Team All-CAA pick, led all scorers with 21 points. She also added a game-high 13 rebounds for her ninth double-double of the 2008-09 season.

All-Time Series

Against UNC Wilmington:

The Lady Monarchs have never lost the Seahawks of UNC Wilmington, owning a perfect 40-0 record against the CAA opponent. The streak is the second longest active winning streak for the Lady Monarchs, after the 49-game winning streak against William & Mary. Old Dominion won all three matchups last season, including a 61-56 win in the CAA quarterfinals.

About the Seahawks:

UNC Wilmington opened the season 3-1 at home, but has lost three of the last four to CAA opponents, including losses to VCU, Northeastern and an overtime loss to Hofstra. The Seahawks have fallen into a slump, dropping nine of the last twelve games.

UNCW has been led this season by Brittany Blackwell, scoring 13.3 points per game and is also leading the Seahawks on the glass, hauling in 7.8 rebounds per game. Blackwell is also leading the team in assists and steals this season.

Greta Luksyte is also averaging double figures as the deep-ball threat in the starting lineup, pouring in 10.5 points per game. Martha White is third on the team in scoring, with 8.9 ppg and is also averaging 4.6 rebounds per game while blocking a shot per game.

51's Enough

Old Dominion defeated Hofstra this season by a final of 51-46. The 51 points scored tied the lowest scored in a win for Old Dominion since 1973-74. Twice prior, ODU has won with just 51 points scored, against UVA in 1980-81 and an overtime win against UNC Wilmington in 2002-03.

Whew! That Was Close

ODU is excelling in tight ball games this season, winning six of the eight games decided by single digits, including four straight at JMU, against Georgia State, on the road against Towson and at home vs. Hofstra. Old Dominion's closest game this season was a 1-point win at Delaware, powered to victory by Jasmine Parker taking a charge and knocking down a go-ahead 3-pointer late in the game.

Three-Point Defense

JMU, one of the nation's top long-ball teams, was able to knock down just a pair of 3-pointers on 23 attempts against the Lady Monarchs. For the season, ODU ranks third in the CAA in 3-pt FG percentage defense, allowing just 29.3% from beyond the arc. In conference only games, ODU leads the league, allowing an abysmal 20.0% from long range (25-for-125).

Big Win in Harrisonburg

The Lady Monarchs earned their first win against JMU in Harrisonburg since 2005, snapping a four-game losing streak over that span. The win also snapped JMU's nine-game home winning streak and was just the ninth loss suffered on the home floor in the last 75 home games for the Dukes. Old Dominion won 67-58, holding off a second half surge from the Dukes after taking a 15-point halftime lead. Junior Jasmine Parker nearly had a triple-double, hauling in a career-high nine rebounds and dishing a career-high tying six assists to go with her ten points. Senior Jessica Canady led the way with 14 points.

Hot Conference Shooting

ODU can be found among the league leaders in several statistical categories. In conference games this season, sophomore Tia Lewis is second in the league in field goal percentage, knocking down 58.9% of her shots. In fact, ODU holds two of the top three spots. Senior Jessica Canady is third in the league, with 56.3% of her shots falling.

As a team, Old Dominion is leading the league in shooting percentage. ODU is shooting at a 44.1% clip while Delaware is second at 42.2% as a team. The Lady Monarchs are also scorching from long-range, shooting 33.6% from beyond the arc in CAA games, third in the league. ODU also ranks third in free-throw shooting, knocking down 75.1% from the charity stripe.

12-for-12

Junior Jasmine Parker helped lead ODU past Drexel with a perfect 12-for-12 night at the free-throw line. It was a career-best, a new Constant Center record and the second best performance by a Lady Monarch in the history of the program. Only Nancy Lieberman had a better night from the line, going 15-for-15 in 1978.

1200 And Counting...

With the non-conference finale against Tennessee, the Lady Monarchs reached 1200 games played in the history of the program. ODU joins a select group of just eight programs to play 1200 games in their histories. They are Tennessee Tech, Tennessee, Stephen F. Austin, Long Beach State, Kansas State, James Madison, and Hofstra. ODU ranks second in winning percentage among these eight teams, going 900-309 over the past 41 years for a .744 success rate.

Senior Moments

ODU has just one senior this season, First Team Pre-season All-CAA forward Jessica Canady. Canady has been working her way back from offseason surgery and has now started ten straight games after being forced to sit through half of the non-conference schedule. She broke out in a big way against Northeastern, scoring 18 points and hauling in a team-high 12 rebounds while playing a career-high 36 minutes. She led ODU in rebounding again against Drexel, with 11. The Lady Monarch senior has breached the 900-point plateau and is now also over 600 career rebounds. Canady was a reserve player her freshman year, scoring only 92 points, making her 913 career all the more impressive, averaging 11.1 points per game since her sophomore season.

A Rare Occurrence

ODU lost to Tennessee by a final score of 102-62 in the non-conference finale this season, marking just the sixth time in program history the Lady Monarchs allowed a team to reach 100 points. Northeastern then posted its first ever 100-point game against ODU, marking just the seventh occurrence against the Lady Monarchs.

Stop! Thief!

Jasmine Parker is among the CAA leaders in steals this season, averaging 2.5 per game with 48 thefts. The ODU junior now has 144 career steals, averaging 1.7 per game in her career.

Still Toughest Schedule in the CAA

Old Dominion's schedule is the toughest in the CAA, and among the strongest in the country. After closing out the non-conference schedule, Old Dominion had the fifth toughest schedule in the nation. Heading into today's game, ODU's schedule was listed as the 18th strongest and the Lady Monarchs RPI is also listed as #63 after the first 17 games. Both numbers come from rpiratings.com's weekly report.

Magic Number 24

Three players have tallied new career highs early this season, all with 24 points scored. Jasmine Parker scored 24 against Maryland to set a new career-high, while Tia Lewis and Shadasia Green both scored 24 against Louisville to set their new mark.

Toughest Schedule in the Nation

Though it's early, the Lady Monarchs schedule has been ranked the toughest in the nation through six games by rpiratings.com. According to the same source, ODU had the 74th best RPI, even with just the 1-5 record. Through six games ODU faced four teams receiving votes in the national rankings and the six teams combined had gone 39-8.

17 Again...

Sophomore forward Tia Lewis tied her career-high with 17 rebounds against Ole Miss, taking over the top spot in the CAA with 9.2 rebounds per game at the time. Lewis had 17 in a game against North Florida during her freshman year while playing for Central Florida and the 17 hauled in against Mississippi tied that mark for the first time as a Lady Monarch. She also posted her first double-double in the game, scoring 15 points for Old Dominion.

Potent Parker

In the second game of the season, Jasmine Parker scored a career-high 24 points and is now third on the team, averaging 11.7 points per game this season. She came out of the locker room on a torrid pace, scoring 12 of Old Dominion's first 20 points and giving the Lady Monarchs the lead against the 20th ranked team in the nation. She finished with 24 points, four assists, four rebounds and three steals in her second consecutive solid game against a nationally ranked opponent.

Parker is knocking down scoring marks this season, breaching the 600- and 700-point plateaus as a junior. She is just 39 points shy of 800 in her third year for Old Dominion. She is one of two active Lady Monarchs to reach 700 points, as senior Jessica Canady has over 900.

Welcome to the Ted

Since the doors opened at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2002, the Lady Monarchs have enjoyed a 98-18 record. Last season, ODU suffered just its second CAA loss ever at the Ted, when JMU defeated the Lady Monarchs 72-67 on January 25, 2009. Of the 18 losses in the Constant Center, TEN have been to nationally ranked opponents.

Startin' Out Right

Jasmine Parker played extremely well against the second ranked Cardinal in the season opener, scoring a team-high 16 points and adding five rebounds, four assists, a career-high five steals and a perfect 5-for-5 night from the free-throw line. Despite a poor first half, Tia Lewis also came away with a stellar first game, finishing just one rebound shy of a double-double. Lewis finished with 15 points and nine rebounds in her first game as a Lady Monarch. Junior Shadasia Green continued her hot play of late with 11 points and seven rebounds. She averaged 16 ppg and 7 rpg in the two exhibitions.

Season Openers

The Lady Monarchs are 27-14 in season openers, falling to 2nd ranked Stanford at home in this season's opener. ODU has dropped six of their last eight season-opening games.

Home Openers

In home openers, Old Dominion is 29-12, including a 4-4 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Last season, ODU opened the regular season home schedule with an upset of 11th ranked UVA by a final score of 78-70. It was the second straight win over the nationally ranked opponent at the Ted, including the overtime thriller in the NCAA Tournament the year before, and the seventh win over a nationally ranked opponent at the Constant Center. ODU lost to #2 Stanford in this season's home opener.

Exhibition Recap - Shaw

In the final tune-up of the 2009-10 preseason, ODU took care of the Shaw Lady Bears by a final score of 82-48. Senior Jessica Canady returned to the floor for her 2009-10 debut and dazzled, scoring 13 of her 15 points in the first half. She also grabbed five rebounds in 21 minutes of play. Junior Shadasia Green again had a stellar outing, posting 16 points in her second straight exhibition and added five boards. Tia Lewis joined Green and Canady in double figures with 10, despite only scoring two points in limited action in the first half due to foul trouble. Lewis finished 4-for-6 from the field. Rookie point guard Carolann Cloutier distributed eight assists in the game while newcomers Jackie Cook and Kquanise Byrd each dished four. Cook added eight points in the game and Byrd had two thefts. Sophomore center Mairi Buchan got on the boards for a second straight game, rebounding a team-high six missed shots against Shaw.

Exhibition Recap - Chowan

In the first look at the Lady Monarchs, ODU won in front of nearly 3,000 fans with ease, 85-52. Junior Shadasia Green led the way, with 16 points and 9 rebounds, just shy of a double-double. Newcomers Tia Lewis and Kquanise Byrd also showed off what Lady Monarch fans can expect to see this season with 11 and 12 points respectively. Byrd added four steals off the bench and went a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line, while Lewis hauled in six boards. Leading the way on the glass after Green was sophomore center Mairi Buchan, grabbing eight boards. ODU had a commanding rebounding edge with 59 in the game compared to just 30 for Chowan.
