Quick Hits:

- ODU won the 2010 CAA Regular Season Title with their win at VCU on Sun. Feb. 28. They will be the top seed at this weekend's CAA Tournament in Harrisonburg
- This will be the Lady Monarchs 19th year in the CAA Tournament, but just the first time since year one in the league (1992) that ODU will enter the tournament not defending its crown
- The Lady Monarchs are 52-1 all-time in CAA Tournament action, including a run of 17 straight titles, an NCAA record
- Old Dominion is the top seed for the 15th time in 19 appearances at the CAA Tourny
- The Lady Monarch schedule through 25 games still ranks the toughest in the CAA; ranked as high as #1 this season, it is now slated as the 34th toughest in the nation
- Speaking of Canady, she became the 27th Lady Monarch in history to score 1,000 points when she dropped seven at VCU last Sunday. She now has 1,027 career points, passing Aubrey Eblin for 26th all-time
- Junior Jasmine Parker has been on fire since the CAA season started, leading the team in CAA-only scoring with 11.8 ppg; she has 858 career points in her third year, ranking fourth among active CAA juniors
- Old Dominion defeated Delaware twice this season, by a combined score of just three points. ODU won the CAA Opener in Newark by one point and then finished with a two-point lead in Norfolk

Game Day Notes

Big Win in Harrisonburg

The Lady Monarchs earned their first win against JMU in Harrisonburg since 2005, snapping a four-game losing streak over that span. The win also snapped JMU's nine-game home winning streak and was just the ninth loss suffered on the home floor in the previous 75 home games for the Dukes. Old Dominion won 67-58, holding off a second half surge from the Dukes after taking a 15-point halftime lead. Junior Jasmine Parker nearly had a triple-double, hauling in a career-high nine rebounds and dishing a career-high tying six assists to go with her ten points. Senior Jessica Canady led the way with 14 points on 7-of-10 shooting while leading scorer Shadasia Green added 13 on 4-of-6.

Home Struggles with the Dukes

With a 65-59 win over the Lady Monarchs at the Constant Center this season, the James Madison University Dukes became the only CAA team to defeat ODU in Norfolk more than once. They also became the only team to beat ODU in Norfolk in back-to-back seasons.

Storied Postseason Rivalry

The Lady Monarchs and Dukes have a long history of matching up in the postseason, as Old Dominion has ended eight James Madison quests for the crown. In 18 previous tournaments, Old Dominion has gone through the Dukes eight times, including five times matched up in the Championship Game. ODU has faced no other opponent more often in the CAA Tournament than the Dukes, as they will be facing each other for the ninth time in postseason play.

Chalk Talk

Today's game will be the 15th time in 25 years of league tournaments that the CAA Championship game features the top two seeds. The number one seed has been victorious in 11 of the 14 previous #1 vs. #2 Finals, including seven wins for Old Dominion. The last two times ODU faced James Madison in the CAA Tournament were in these such matchups, as top-seeded ODU defeated second-seeded JMU in both, as a part of the 2006 and 2007 CAA Championship Tournament.

3-Point Defense

Led by Dawn Evans, the Dukes are one of the league's top 3-point shooting teams. Evans led the CAA with 106 3-pointers made, averaging 3.7 per game. Against ODU, though, the Dukes shot an abysmal 17.1% from long range in two games this season. Evans, over 34% from deep, is hitting just 20% against the Lady Monarchs this season.

Return of the King... (uh, Queen?)

With a 50-49 win over Delaware in the emifinals, the Lady Monarchs return to the CAA Championship game after a one-year hiatus in 2009. Last season, eventual CAA Champion Drexel finally unseated the Lady Monarchs from their NCAA record reign atop the league. ODU had won 17 straight CAA Tournaments before falling in the semifinals to the Dragons last season, 62-41.

The Championship game is familiar territory for ODU, as they have never lost a CAA Final since joining the league in 1992.

3/1/10 - Co-Rookie of the Week

The CAA announced that ODU freshman Jackie Cook earned Co-Rookie of the Week honors, the first of the year for Old Dominion. Cook helped Old Dominion clinch the 2010 regular season title with a pair of wins over William & Mary and VCU.

The Lady Monarch guard came off the bench to shoot 72.7% from the field, including 75% from long-range. Cook triggered a momentum-shifting run in the second half at VCU, knocking down a pair of trey's to put Old Dominion up six on the road.

She would also bury the most important basket of the game under a minute to play, cutting to the basket after her defender lost sight of her and knocking down the eventual game-winning basket off an assist from Jessica Canady. The layup gave ODU a 4-point lead with 53 seconds left that ODU held to seal the 2010 regular season title.
