

# ODU WOMEN'S BASKETBALL POSTGAME NOTES

#### **TEAM RECORDS**

## **TEAM NOTES**

- CHA: Outscored ODU, 21-3, in the 2nd quarter (ended 2Q on 17-1 run; led 36-22 at the half)
- ODU: Outscored CHA, 56-48, in the 1st, 3rd and 4th quarters
- ODU: Led 19-15 at the end of 1st quarter (ODU is now 13-3 when leading after 1st quarter)
- ODU: Trimmed lead to one possesion (44-41) with 2:38 remaining in 3rd quarter
- ODU: Was outrebounded, 40-29 (ODU was a combined +42 on the boards in the last two games)
- ODU: Shot 27% (8-of-30) and attempted the second-most threes in a game this season (most was 33 at NC State)

## **PLAYER NOTES**

- AMARI YOUNG (17pts, 6rebs) tied her career high in scoring (also scored 17 twice at LA Tech & vs. UTEP)
- AMARI YOUNG scored 15 of her 17 points in the 2nd half
- MAGGIE ROBINSON (12pts, 4-13 3PT) recorded her 9th double-figure scoring game of season
- TAYLOR EDWARDS (9pts, 6asts): ODU is now 10-2 when Edwards has 5+ assists
- VICTORIA MORRIS (DNP) did not play due to right foot injury; third consecutive game missed (listed as day-to-day)
