- ODU senior James Nicholson leads the Monarchs in his final season wearing the singlet. The Des Moines, lowa native is currently fifth on ODU's all-time wins list with 127. He needs one more win to tie Jesse Strawn for fourth on ODU's career wins list.
- The senior went 3-0 at the Virginia Duals to up his season record to 17-0. In his only match against a ranked foe, Nicholson defeated No. 19 Tyler Cox of Wyoming 16-8.
- For his performance at the Southern Scuffle, Nicholson was named the CAA Wrestler of the Month for December. His second time this season receiving the monthly honor.
- Nicholson continued his impressive start to his senior season with a dominant performance at the Southern Scuffle, winning the 125 pound weight class. The senior went 5-0 and did not allow more than two points in any of his matches. He defeated two ranked opponents; No. 20 Jason Lara of Oregon State 8-1 in the semi's and No. 7 Zach Sanders (two-time All-American) of Minnesota 4-2 in the finals. The win over Sanders is especially nice for Nicholson as it avenges a loss to Sanders at the 2009 NCAA Championships
- Nicholson opened the season with a first place finish at the Hokie Open, going 5-0, defeating No. 10 Jarrod Garnett in the finals.
- The senior capped off his terrific start to the season by being named the CAA Wrestler of the Month for November. Nicholson went 9-0 on the month with four major decisions and one technical fall.
- A three-time CAA Champion at 125-pounds, Nicholson earned All-American honors as a freshman in 2008. Also solid in the classroom, he was named the CAA Wrestling Scholar Athlete of the Year last season.

- The Monarchs will be back on the road for the 12th and final time this season as they travel to NC State.
- ODU will finish the season with three-straight home events, starting Feb. 10 versus Virginia Tech.

Back For More

- Kyle Hutter lost for just the second time in January, falling 4-0 to No. 9 Scotti Sentes of Central Michigan last week. Both of his losses in January were to wrestlers ranked in the top-10, Sentes and No. 6 Lou Ruggirello of Hofstra.
- Hutter became the 12 Monarch in school history to reach the 100-win plateau, going 3-0 at the Virginia Duals to give him 101 career wins. He is now 106-49 in his career.
- Hutter finished in fourth place at the Southern Scuffle.
- He defeated No. 19 Zac Stevens of Michigan 5-4 to move into the semi's before dropping a tight 6-4 decision to No. 9 Rollie Peterkin of Penn. Peterkin went on to win the 133 pound championship.
- The Mokena, Ill. native opened the season with back-to-second place finishes at the Hokie Open and Binghamton Open. Hutter has won his last five matches.
- Hutter is a two-time NCAA Qualifier.

First Time Starter

- After suffering a six-match losing streak, Dan Rivera has come back strong, having won his last two. He defeated George Mason's Aaron Keeten 4-3 and Central Michigan's Eric Cubberly 3-1 in overtime.
- Rivera has been in a ton of close matches this season, including 14 matches decided by two points or less. He is 8-6 in those matches.
- Dan Rivera was one of three Monarchs to go 2-1 at the Virginia Duals, he won a 2-1 overtime match against Edinboro and a 7-2 decision over VMI. His only loss came agianst No. 6 Shane Onufer of Wyoming.
- A senior from Winter Springs, Fla., Rivera is 36-58 for his career.
- Rivera took second place at the Binghamton Open, beating 2010 NCAA qualifier Eren Civan in the process.

Year Number Three

- Joe Budi continued his push for an NCAA berth with two more wins last week, winning matches against Bucknell and George Mason.
- Joe Budi went 3-1 at the CAA Duals, improving his record to 11-10 on the year.
- Budi earned his 55th career win on Friday night with a 2-0 decision at Bucknell.
