- Old Dominion will be looking for its second consecutive win over an ACC foe as the Lady Monarchs topped Georgia Tech, 65-63, in their season opener.
- The Lady Monarchs are off to a 2-0 start for the third time in the last four seasons. The last time the Lady Monarchs went 3-0 to begin a year was 2007-08 when ODU ended the season 31-5 overall and reached the Sweet 16.
- Senior Alena Voronina and sophomore Jackie Cook both set career-high's in ODU's win over North Carolina A&T. Voronina set a new career-high in points for the second consecutive game with 14, while Cook pulled down a career-best 11 boards, easily surpassing her previous career-high of seven rebounds.
- After tonight's contest, ODU will return home to take on BIG EAST foe Louisville. The game will tip from the Constant Center at 7 p.m. on Friday, Nov. 26.

Old Dominion and NC State will be playing for the 34th time in the history of the two programs tonight. The Wolfpack upended ODU in Norfolk last year, 62-52. Shadasia Green led the Lady Monarchs with 13 points and seven rebounds, while Marissa Kastanek posted a team-high 12 points for NC State.

About NC State

- NC State has dropped consecutive games after starting the year 2-0. The Wolfpack dominated the College of Charleston (73-36) and Creighton (84-71) at home in the Wolfpack Invitational, but fell on the road at Alabama (95-84) and Richmond (81-75).

- Marissa Kastanek leads three NC State players averaging double figures in scoring with 19.5 points per game. Amber White is averaging 18.0 ppg and is shooting 56-percent from the field, while Bonae Holston is averaging 12.3 ppg and a team-high 9.5 rebounds per game.

- NC State was picked to finish sixth in the ACC preseason poll, just behind Georgia Tech. The Wolfpack received one first place vote in the poll, the program's first since earning six in 2001.

About Old Dominion

- Old Dominion cruised to a 79-65 win over North Carolina A&T last Thursday to improve to 2-0. The Lady Monarchs led for all but 14 seconds and built their lead up to as many as 29 points late in the second half.

- Tia Lewis led four ODU players in double-figures with 15 points against NC A&T. Sophomore Jackie Cook posted her first career double-double with 10 points and a career-best 11 rebounds.

- Tonight is Old Dominion's first road contest of the 2010-11 season. The Lady Monarchs went 8-6 away from the Ted Constant Center last year, but were 0-5 in non-conference road games.

- In ODU's first two games, its opponents have shot exactly 50 percent and have attempted more free throws, however the Lady Monarchs came out on top on each occasion.

Game Day Notes

North Carolina A&T Recap

The Old Dominion women's basketball team stayed hot last Thursday evening, cruising past North Carolina A&T, 79-65, at the Ted Constant Center. Junior Tia Lewis posted a game-high 15 points and sophomore Jackie Cook recorded her first career double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds. Old Dominion (2-0) led for all but 14 seconds and built its lead up to as many as 29 points late in the second half. Senior Alena Voronina posted a career-high 14 points and classmate Jasmine Parker chipped in 11 in the win.

After North Carolina A&T scored the first bucket of the game, Old Dominion rattled off 11 straight points to go up nine at the 17:02 mark. The Aggies cut the first half deficit to just four (16-12) midway through the first stanza, but the Lady Monarchs would break the game open from that point. A Voronina lay-in with just over five minutes remaining in the opening period capped a 15-5 ODU run and put the Lady Monarchs up 31-17. After North Carolina A&T got to within nine (33-24), Old Dominion closed the half on a 8-0 run to go into the intermission up 41-24. The Aggies tallied nine of the first 15 points out of the break to close to within 14 points (47-33), but the Lady Monarchs would take control during the remainder of the contest. Leading 62-43 at the 10:48 mark, ODU went on a 11-1 spurt in which five different players scored. The run was capped with a Cook triple that gave the Lady Monarchs a 73-44 advantage. North Carolina A&T would close the gap late, but get no closer than 12 the remainder of the game.

Everyone Involved

Everyone contributed to ODU's win over NC A&T as 10 of 11 Monarchs that played, scored, including Kquanise Byrd, who scored six points after missing the opener with a broken finger on her shooting hand.

Tracking Parker

Senior guard Jasmine Parker is inching closer to becoming the 28 all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points. With her 11 points in ODU's win over North Carolina A&T on Thursday, she now sits with 928 points.

Milestone March

Head Coach Wendy Larry is approaching yet another milestone, just 10 wins shy of her 600th career victory. She has piled up a 590-223 record in 27 seasons as a head coach, including 541 career wins at ODU.

ACC Win

Old Dominion topped Atlantic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008. The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs will play one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule features games against four teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida, Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel).

CAA Preseason Poll

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish second in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the league head coaches. Defending champion James Madison was pegged as the top team heading into 2010-11.

After topping Georgia Tech on Nov. 14, Old Dominion improves to 30-12 all-time in home openers. In season openers, the Lady Monarchs are 28-14 all-time.

Exhibition Success

The Lady Monarchs went 2-0 in a pair of home exhibition games against Davis & Elkins and Bowie State. Junior Tia Lewis posted 20 points and 23 rebounds against D&E, while sophomore JoNiquia Guilford shined versus Bowie State with a game-high 19 points.

NCAA Host Site

Old Dominion has been selected as one of 16 host sites for first- and second-round games in the 2012 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Games will be played at the Ted Constant Convocation Center on either March 17 and 19 or March 18 and 20, with exact dates and ticket availability for those contests to be released at a later date.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

900 WINS!

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 911-314 (.744) and is in its 42nd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.
