#### STARTING FIVE

- Sunday's game is the first meeting between Old Dominion and Dartmouth since the 1994-95 season. The Big Green are making their second trip to Norfolk as they also traveled to Norfolk for the first meeting in the series.
- Old Dominion is the second opponent from the Colonial Athletic Association the Big Green will face this season. Dartmouth has also taken on Northeastern, falling to the Huskies, 80-45, in Boston. .
- The Big Green are looking to snap its current four-game slide after falling to Syracuse in their last outing on Thursday (Nov. 29). Dartmouth is also looking for its second road win after defeating Bryant, 64-53, in its season-opener on Nov. 10.
- Today's game is the first of back-to-back road games for the Big Green and is the beginning of a stretch of games in which Dartmouth will play four of its next five on the road. The lone home game is a matchup with Hartford on Sunday Dec. 9, which will be the last home game before the team breaks for the winter holidays.
- Dartmouth is looking to keep its hot shooting from long range going against the Lady Monarchs. The Big Green drilled a season-high eight triples against the Orange and shot 61.5 percent from long range. Entering the game, Dartmouth was averaging just 2.8 three-pointers per game.

**Dartmouth vs. Old Dominion Notables**

- Dartmouth and Old Dominion are meeting for the first time since the 1994-95 season. The Lady Monarchs won that meeting, 69-47. Sunday's meeting is the second time the Big Green have traveled to Norfolk, Va., Old Dominion hasn't made the trip to Hanover.

-Dartmouth is the lone Ivy League team on Old Dominion's schedule, but the teams' have a common opponent in Northeastern as well as Delaware, who could be a Dartmouth opponent in the Blue Sky Classic in Hanover, Dec. 29-30.

-The Big Green are searching for their first win over a CAA team since defeating Northeastern during the 2010-11 season. Dartmouth has a 14-8 record against teams from the Colonial Athletic Association.

**A Win Would ...**

1. Give Dartmouth head coach Chris Wielgus her 389th win at Dartmouth. She entered the 2012-13 season needing 13 wins to claim her 400th victory as head coach of the Big Green.

2. Snap the Big Green's four-game skid and give Dartmouth its second road win this season. Last season, Dartmouth won four road games including non-conference wins over Vermont and Colgate.

3. Give Old Dominion its second consecutive loss after falling to No. 10/11 Cal on Friday. The Lady Monarchs were 4-0 entering Friday's game with the Golden Bears.

**Scouting Old Dominion**

Old Dominion enters Sunday's game with a 4-1 record after dropping a, 63-47, home contest to No. 10/11 California on Friday (Nov. 30). Jackie Cook leads the Lady Monarch offense and is averaging 16.6 points per game and 7.2 rebounds per game. She is joined in double figures by teammate Shae Kelly who is tallying 12.6 points per game and is leading the rebounding efforts with 7.8 rebounds per game. Head coach Karen Barefoot is in her second season at the helm of the Lady Monarch program. The California game was the beginning of a three-game homestand for Old Dominion.

**On the Road Again ...**

Sunday's game against Old Dominion marks the first game of a stretch where the Big Green will play of four of their next five games on the road. The Big Green follow up Sunday's game with a road contest at rival, New Hampshire, on Wednesday (Dec. 5) and will travel for games at Florida International (Dec. 15) and Marquette (Dec. 20). Dartmouth will be at home for a showdown with Hartford on Dec. 9.

**Big Green Made the Orange Work in the First Half**

Despite dropping the contest to Syracuse, Dartmouth made the Orange work for everything in the first half. Dartmouth battled with the Big East squad and held an early advantage. The biggest help was three-point shooting. Dartmouth shot 66.7 (4-of-6) in the first frame and was a perfect 3-of-3 from the free throw line and only trailed the 'Cuse by four at halftime.

**Heatin' Up From Long Range**

Entering the Syracuse game, Dartmouth was shooting just .200 (11-of-55) from behind the arc, but got things going from long range against the Orange. Dartmouth shot a season-best 61.5 percent (8-of-13) and Nicola Zimmer (Chevy Chase, Md.) nailed a game-best three treys. Prior to the Syracuse game, Dartmouth was only averaging 2.8 three-pointers, down from its average of 4.6 in 2011-12. In fact, the Syracuse game was the opposite of the Northeastern game, in which the Huskies shot 61.5 percent against the Big Green.

**Schmitt Goes Off Against Syracuse**

Sophomore Abbey Schmitt (Winnetka, Ill.) had a career-night against the Orange, pouring in a team-best 18 points and setting a new career-high in the process. It was Schmitt's third game in double figures this season. Schmitt, who is also leading the Big Green in rebounding, has been in either double-figure rebounds or points in each game this season. She opened the season with a double-double (11 points and 14 rebounds) against Bryant.

**Dartmouth Finds Shooting Touch**

After opening the season with 64 points against Bryant, Dartmouth hadn't been able to score 60 points until Thursday's game against Syracuse. The Big Green shot 41.8 percent (23-of-55) and tied their season-high with the 64 points. The loss was the first this season in which the Big Green scored at least 60 points and lost. In fact, Dartmouth's 64 points was the most points a "mid major" school had scored on Syracuse to that point and was just shy of the 72 and 73 points, Orange opponents Georgia Tech and Virginia each posted on Syracuse.

**Steen Back in Double Figures**

Faziah Steen (Detroit, Mich.) was back in double -figures with 13 points against Syracuse. Steen, who had her six-game streak of double figure games stopped at Northeastern, has been in double figures in 23 of her last 25 appearances dating back to the 2011-12 season. Last season, Steen only failed to reach double figures on three occasions.

**Three-Point Plays are Steen's Specialty**

Not only was Steen back in double-figures against Syracuse, she completed her fourth consecutive three-point play. She has completed at least one three-point play in every

game she has played in. Coincidentally, she is also Dartmouth's top free-point shooter at 90.9 percent (20-of-22).

#### May We Assist You?

For the second time this season, the Big Green posted double figure assists with 15 helpers against the Orange. Dartmouth also posted double figure assists against Bryant with a season-high 16. Nicola Zimmer (Chevy Chase, Md.) had five assists for her third game of five or more assists this season.

#### Taking Advantage of the Charity Stripe

The Big Green are shooting 71.8 percent (74-103) from the charity stripe this season and have really stepped up their free throw shooting and after shooting just 56.0 (14-of-25) against Bryant, Dartmouth has shot at least 65 percent from the free throw line. Against Syracuse, the Big Green went 10-of-11 from the line for a season best 90.5 percent. Several of the Dartmouth players are streaking from the charity stripe, including Milica Toskovic (Santa Monica, Calif.) who has made six straight while Faziaah Steen (Detroit, Mich.) and Abbey Schmitt (Winnetka, Ill.) have both made eight straight. Last season, Steen made 13 consecutive free throws. Although, the Big Green are shooting well from the line, Syracuse became the first team to go to the line more than Dartmouth this season, making 18 trips and hitting 15 shots.

#### Still Looking For a Weekday Win

The Big Green haven't had much luck in games played during the week. This season, Dartmouth is 0-3 in games played during the week. On Tuesdays Dartmouth is 0-2 with losses to BYU and Northeastern and the Big Green's loss to Syracuse on Thursday is the other weekday loss. Last season, Dartmouth was 3-13 in games played during the week.

#### Need to Protect the Rock

Turnovers have been the Big Green's Achilles heel this season. Dartmouth enters the Old Dominion game averaging 18.2 turnovers per game, which are nearly four more than their opponents. Dartmouth had a season-high 26 turnovers against Albany and has had at least 15 turnovers in four of its five games. Last season, the Big Green averaged 21.6 turnovers per game.

#### Syracuse's Alexander Goes For 27

Syracuse leading scorer Kayla Alexander became the second opponent to score at least 20 points on the Big Green this season dropping in 27 points. She joins Albany's Megan Craig as the only opponents to record 20 points this season.

#### Orange Shoot and Rebound Well against the Big Green

Syracuse became the second consecutive team to shoot 50 percent or better against the Big Green. The Orange shot 54.7 percent (35-of-64), joining Northeastern, who shot 54.9 percent (28-of-51) from the field, as the only teams to shoot 50 percent or better against Dartmouth. Syracuse's 91 points was the most points an opponent scored since Princeton tallied 94 last season. Additionally, Syracuse became the second consecutive team to outrebound the Big Green.

#### Roman Gets In the Scorebook

Freshman Sofia Roman (White Plains, N.J.) tallied her first collegiate points in Dartmouth's last outing against Syracuse. She nailed a three-pointer and becomes the first of the Big Green rookies to hit a triple this season.

#### Dawson Attacks the Glass

Dartmouth's leading rebounder from 2011-12, Tia Dawson (Cedar Rapids, Iowa) picked up a team-best seven rebounds against the Syracuse. It was just the second time Dawson led the team in rebounding this season, she also led the squad against BYU on Nov. 13. Dawson, who averaged 7.0 rebounds in the rookie season, entered the Syracuse game averaging just 5.5 rebounds and was coming off a season-low of two boards against Northeastern.

#### In the Rankings

Abbey Schmitt (Winnetka, Ill.) ranks 53rd in the NCAA statistics in rebounding (10.0 rebounds/game), while Tia Dawson (Cedar Rapids, Iowa) is 98th in blocks per game (1.67). As a team, Dartmouth is 91st in rebounding margin sitting at +4.0. These statistics are through Nov. 25 games.

#### Schmitt Not Only Scores ... She Bakes!

Abbey Schmitt (Winnetka, Ill.) has had a memorable return to the hardwood after a nearly two-year absence. She missed her entire senior year at New Trier HS and her freshman year at Dartmouth with a knee injury, but she looks more than ready to

be back. She posted a double-double (14 points, 11 rebounds) in her debut against Bryant and became the first Big Green rookie to post a double-double in her collegiate debut since the 2003-04 season when Elise Morrison had 10 points and 11 rebounds against Charlotte. She also became the first Dartmouth player to record a double-double in a season-opener since 2010-11 when Brittany Smith has 13 rebounds and 12 points. Off the court, Schmitt is a baker and she recently won Dartmouth's version of "Cupcake Wars" ... Dessert anyone?

### Put A Ring On It

Every Dartmouth class but one since 1980 has graduated with at least one Ivy League Championship ring. If Dartmouth doesn't win the Ivy League title, senior Faziaah Steen will become the first senior to not win at least one Ivy League title since 1980. Graduated senior Sasha Dosenko was the last member of the 2008-09 Ivy League Championship.

### Need Some Home Cookin'

This season Dartmouth will look to turn things around at Leede Arena. Last season the Big Green went 2-10 on its home court, posting its second losing home record in the last three seasons. Dartmouth has only posted eight losing home records in 39 years of varsity competition. Dartmouth will have plenty of opportunity to right the ship at home playing 13 home games, the most since the 2009-10 season when they also played a baker's dozen.

### Youth Be Served

The Dartmouth women's basketball team is young ... very young this season. Dartmouth features just one senior in Faziaah Steen (Detroit, Mich.) and only two juniors in Eve Zelinger (Palo Alto, Calif.) and Nicola Zimmer (Chevy Chase, Md.). Conversely, there are 11 underclassmen, highlighted by a seven-member

freshman class. Dartmouth will open the 2012-13 season with a collective 10 years of basketball experience among its 14 players giving them the second youngest squad in the nation. There will be quite a bit of youth in Leede Arena this season as the Dartmouth men's squad also has the distinction of being the second youngest team in the nation.

### Steen Climbing Up the Career Charts

Faziaah Steen (Detroit, Mich.) opens the season poised to make some moves into the Dartmouth history books. Opening the 2012-13 season, she ranks No. 15 on the all-time scoring list with 1,025 career points. She is averaging 341 points per season and should hold true she has a chance to move as high as No. 8 on the all-time lists. Steen is also making a run at the steals record. She enters her senior season with 181 and needs 28 more to move into the top-five all-time. The record is 370 held by former great Betsy Gilmore. Steen also has a chance to move up the three-point field goals made list. She currently has 137 and is averaging 56 three-pointers over the last two seasons. If she can keep that up, she can move as high as third, ousting current Director of Operations, Koren Schram who concluded her career with 198 triples.

### Is That a New Number I See?

There will be several returners donning new numbers for the 2012-13 season. Sophomore Nicola Zimmer has done away with No. 10 and will be wearing No. 3 while Kamala Thompson will sport No. 52.

### Wielgus Approaching 400 Dartmouth Career Wins

Dartmouth head coach Chris Wielgus is just 12 wins shy of reaching her 400th win at Dartmouth. She is already the winningest coach in program history and has won 12 Ivy League titles in her two stints. Her last title came in 2008-09.

## TWENTY-EIGHTH SEASON

HEAD COACH **CHRIS WIELGUS**

**DARTMOUTH: 387-320 (27) • OVERALL: 424-341 (29) • IVY: 223-112 (27)**

With 12 Ivy League championships, one Patriot League title and seven NCAA Tournament appearances, Dartmouth College head women's basketball coach Christina "Chris" Wielgus has established herself as one of the nation's elite coaches. Entering her 28th year at the helm, Wielgus has not fallen out of step, recently leading the Big Green to four of the last eight Ivy League Championships (2005, 2006, 2008 and 2009) and five straight postseason appearances from 2005-09.

Wielgus is entering her 28th season and in her second stint (1976-84,

1993-present) as the head coach of the program she built from the ground up, also coaching the first Dartmouth team that competed in the Ivy League in 1976. She is the winningest coach in the illustrious history of Dartmouth College, amassing a record of 387-320 in 27 seasons. Including her two years as a head coach with Fordham, Wielgus sports a 424-341 overall record in 29 years as a head coach.

Dartmouth was faced with arguably its youngest team ever in 2011-12 with just two upperclassmen to go along with five freshmen. The Big Green battled valiantly throughout the course of the season and by the end the team had found the chemistry that they had lacked in the early part of the season. The young squad posted wins over Vermont and Colgate in non-conference action and earned a sweep of Columbia and added wins over Brown and Cornell in Ivy League action. Wielgus enters the 2012-13 season 13 wins shy of her 400th Ivy League victory.

In its most recent Ivy Championship season, 2008-09, Dartmouth was just five points - an overtime loss - away from the first undefeated Ivy campaign in program history. But with a 13-1 mark the Big Green still brought home its 17th Ivy title, six more than Harvard, which ranks second. The season was sweet for Wielgus, who started two seniors and two sophomores and coached one of her best defensive teams ever. The Big Green took power conference members Michigan State and Arkansas to the wire while finding the gritty identity that would allow it to run through the Ivy slate, including an 11-game winning streak.

On March 10, 2009, Wielgus won her 400th career game in fitting fashion as Dartmouth topped Harvard, then one game back, to clinch its first outright Ivy Championship since 2000 in front of 1700 fans at Leede Arena. She also witnessed one of her finest guards ever, two-time first team All-Ivy honoree Koren Schram '09, score her 1,000th point that magical championship night.

The previous championship season, 2008, was one in which most had written off the Big Green after a slow start. Wielgus and her squad rallied to post an 11-3 Ivy record and force a three-way playoff for the NCAA Tournament bid. After topping Harvard in the first round, Dartmouth fell to Cornell, who had received a first-round bye after a coin pull, in the final game, but still advanced to the Postseason WNIT.

Wielgus has been particularly successful against the Ivy League. During her 25-year tenure the Big Green boasts a staggering 219-102 record against Ivy opponents, as well as 12 conference titles and all seven of Dartmouth's forays into the NCAA tournament (1983, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2005, 2006 and 2009). In 1980-81, Wielgus led the Big Green to a 20-9 record, earning Dartmouth a spot in the EIAIW tournament.

During her tenure, Wielgus has created one of the most consistent programs in the Ivies. The Big Green has finished third or better in the conference standings in 19 of her last 23 years at the helm. She is responsible for 12 of Dartmouth's 17 Ivy League championships. She has mentored five Ivy League players of the year honored seven times and eight Ivy League rookies of the year, including Brittney Smith '11, who won both awards back-to-back in her first two seasons. Wielgus' players have put up staggering numbers for All-Ivy recognition as well, with 16 first-team players honored 28 times and 35 total All-Ivy players recognized 80 times.

Wielgus continues to be a big-game coach, winning playoffs in 2005 and 2006 for the League's NCAA Tournament bid. The Big Green had a streak of five consecutive postseason appearances dating back to 2005, going to the NCAA Tournament in 2005, 2006 and 2009 and earning a Postseason WNIT bid in 2007 and 2008. At the 2006 NCAA

Tournament, the Big Green put forth a tremendous effort against third-seeded Rutgers. Dartmouth valiantly came back from an 11-point deficit late in the game, but eventually fell 63-58 to the Big East Champions. The 2009 Big Green fell to eventual Elite Eight team and No. 1-seed Maryland.

During her tenure, she has led Dartmouth to two of the biggest comeback victories in NCAA history including a 21-point comeback win against Siena on Jan. 2, 2006, which ranks second.

Wielgus first took over the program in just its fifth year of existence (1976-77) and led the Big Green to unprecedented heights, winning four consecutive Ivy League titles from 1980-83 before leaving Hanover in 1984 after eight seasons. She returned to the College on the Hill prior to the 1993-94 season and has revitalized the most decorated women's basketball program in the Ivy League, leading Dartmouth to seven more Ivy League championships and five additional NCAA tournament appearances.

Wielgus' second stint at Dartmouth came after a successful two-year reign at Fordham University. Under her tutelage, the Rams had back-to-back winning seasons for the first time in 13 years.

In between her first Dartmouth stint and her two-year stay at Fordham, Wielgus remained actively involved in women's basketball around the country. She served as training camp coordinator for the United States women's basketball teams that won gold medals at the 1986 Goodwill Games and the 1986 World Championship. Wielgus also directed the Developmental Basketball Program in Hilton Head, S.C. and the All-Star Basketball Camps in Baton Rouge, La. and Jacksonville, Fla. Today, she is director of the All-Star Basketball Camp that runs during the summer in Hanover.

A 1974 graduate of Springfield, Wielgus was a physical education instructor before coming to Dartmouth. Wielgus was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame in 2004 and the Springfield College Athletics Hall of Fame in 2007.
