GAMEDAY NOTES

- This is the Monarchs first game in 19 days. The Panthers last played on Dec. 21, 11 days ago.
- ODU's Tuesday 1 p.m. non-conference game at Delaware State was canceled due to contact tracing protocols and out of an abundance of caution. There were no positive COVID-19 cases within either program.
- The C-USA game features a head coaching match up of two first-year head coaches in DeLisha Milton-Jones and Jesyka Burks-Wiley.
- ODU has not dropped a game against FIU since joining the C-USA.
- The Monarchs last loss to FIU came in 2005-06 on the road, falling 80-76.
- Amari Young and Ajah Wayne both recorded double-doubles last contest. Young has back-to-back double double games.
- After the Monarchs win over USC Upstate, Victoria Morris, who compiled 19 points, jumped up to the 28th spot on the all-time scoring list, where she currently sits right behind Sharron Francis. Morris has 1,074 career points.

DeLisha Milton-Jones, the two-time Olympic gold medalist and former head coach at Pepperdine University, has been selected as the new head coach of the Old Dominion women's basketball program, as announced by Director of Athletics Dr. Camden Wood Selig on April 17, 2020.

Milton-Jones, who also had a decorated professional career in the WNBA and overseas, spent the past season as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for Syracuse University.

Milton-Jones has excelled at every stop of her basketball career. She started her college coaching career as an assistant at Pepperdine in 2016-17. After one season, she moved into the head coaching role and led the program to unprecedented success. In the 2017-18 season, she guided Pepperdine to 10 wins, the most at the Malibu school since 2012. In her second year, the Waves won 12 more games than the previous year by finishing 22-10, one of the best turnarounds in the country. The Waves 22 victories in 2018-19 also marked the program's most wins since 2002. Pepperdine earned a WNIT bid, the program's first postseason tournament, and then advanced to the Sweet 16 with wins over St. Mary's and Cal Baptist.

She left Pepperdine for the assistant coaching role at Syracuse following the 2019 WNIT run. Milton-Jones joined the staff of veteran head coach Quentin Hillsman. This past season, the Orange put together a 16-15 mark, highlighted by wins over No. 5 Louisville and No. 8 Florida State.

Milton-Jones is the eighth head coach in ODU's storied women's basketball history, replacing Nikki McCray-Penson, who left the role last week to become the head coach at Mississippi State. Milton and McCray were both members of the USA team that won the gold medal in the 2000 Olympics.

Milton-Jones's coaching career followed a long and successful professional and international basketball career. Drafted fourth in the 1999 WNBA draft, she played 17 years in the league, retiring from the WNBA in 2016 after setting the record for most games played in league history with 499, which was later broken by WNBA great Sue Bird. She helped lead the Los Angeles Sparks to back-to-back WNBA Championships in 2001 and 2002. She was selected to the WNBA All-Star team in 2000, 2004 and 2007. In all, Milton-Jones played for Atlanta, New York, Washington and San Antonio, in addition to Los Angeles. Her 5,571 career points still ranks ninth in WNBA history. She also made stops in Spain, Italy, Turkey, South Korea, the Czech Republic and Russia to play professionally.

On the international stage, Milton-Jones helped the United States win Olympic gold medals in 2000 and 2008. In the latter, she was coached by former ODU legend, Anne Donovan. She missed the 2004 Olympics with an injury. While playing for the national team, Milton-Jones also helped Team USA win FIBA Championships in 1998 and 2002.

Milton-Jones's first venture into coaching came when she was named interim coach of the Los Angeles Stars midway through the 2005 American Basketball Association. She became just the second woman to coach a men's professional basketball team.

Milton-Jones, who played for four years for Carol Ross at Florida, had one of the most remarkable college careers at Florida, capped off her senior year when she was named the 1997 Wade Trophy Winner, the 1997 Honda Award Winner, the 1997 SEC Player of the Year, a First Team All-American selection amongst other highly-touted accolades. She scored 1,858 points during her career, helping the Gators to four straight NCAA tournament appearances. Ironically, her final collegiate game was a 53-51 loss to Old Dominion in the 1997 NCAA Elite Eight. She was named to the Florida Gator Hall of Fame in 2007.

Milton-Jones takes over a program with a storied history that has returned to the national spotlight in recent years. The Monarchs' 1,084 wins ranks top-10 in the NCAA all-time wins category. ODU also owns three national championships, 25 NCAA Tournament appearances, 17 conference championships and 55 All-Americans.

SCOUTING THE PANTHERS

FIU is currently on a two-game losing streak, dropping back-to-back contests to FGCU.

The Panthers are led by Kyla Nelson, who averages 13.3 ppg. Defensively, Emerald Ekpiteta averages 10.0 rpg, while Raquel Ferrer-Bernad has grabbed 15 steals this season.

ODU'S LAST TIME OUT

The Monarchs won its third-straight contest with a 73-39 win over USC Upstate at Chartway Arena on Dec. 13. Senior Victoris Morris once again led the way offensively for the Monarchs, recording 19 points. It also marked her third-straight game compiling a double-digit performance.

Adding to that, ODU outrebounded Upstate, 40-28, as well as every other category other than turnovers, where the Spartans turned the ball over 17 times and ODU just eight.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES

In all four of the Monarchs games so far this season, at least one player has put together a double-double.

- Leading the way for ODU is **Amari Young** who currently owns three double-doubles this season (GW, VCU, Upstate). She currently has 11 career double-doubles. Young currently leads the league in double-doubles this season. - Right behind Young is junior **Ajah Wayne** who put together a double-double against William & Mary. She currently has 10 career double-doubles.

C-USA UTILIZES DIVISIONAL STANDINGS FOR 20-21 SEASON

Conference USA men's and women's basketball will move to a divisional standings format for the 2020-21 season, as approved by the league's Board of Directors.

C-USA will feature East and West divisions and will crown divisional champions at the conclusion of conference play in March. Standings will be based on overall conference winning percentage. In addition, divisional seeding will be utilized for the C-USA Men's and Women's Championships. A cross-divisional bracket will be used to determine first-round matchups.

The East Division will be comprised of Charlotte, FIU, Florida Atlantic, Marshall, Middle Tennessee, **Old Dominion** and WKU. Louisiana Tech, North Texas, Rice, Southern Miss, UAB, UTEP and UTSA will make up the West Division.

Men's and women's conference competition begins Friday, leading up to the 2021 Air Force Reserve C-USA Basketball Championships presented by Baylor,

Scott & White Sports Performance Center at The Star, scheduled for March 10-13 in Frisco, Texas. This will be the fourth year that the event will be held in Frisco.

A NEW COACH IN TOWN

Milton-Jones was introduced at the Monarchs eighth women's basketball head coach in program history on April 17, 2020. Milton-Jones joined ODU after serving one season at Syracuse as Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator where she helped bring in the No. 4 recruiting class in the nation. She earned her first win as head coach of ODU on Dec. 3, 2020 with a 70-47 win over William & Mary.

TIP-TIME CHANGES VERSUS FIU

Old Dominion women's basketball has announced time changes for its Jan. 1 and Jan. 2 home games against FIU. The back-to-back C-USA games will now both tip at 2 p.m. at Chartway Arena.

The games were originally slated for 6:30 p.m. and 4 p.m., respectively.

The Jan. 1 contest will be aired on ESPN Radio 94.1, while the Jan. 2 matchup will be aired on Money Talk 1310. Both games will be streamed on CUSA.TV.

A BRAND NEW STAFF

2019-20 POSTSEASON ACCOLADES

Amari Young captured spots on the Second Team All-C-USA and the All-Defensive Team and Ajah Wayne tabbed a spot on the Second Team All-C-USA as announced by the league.

Young was been a force for the Monarchs in 2019-20 packing the stat sheets. The South Carolina native led the Monarchs in rebounding with 8.2 per game, which was good for seventh in the league. Young averaged 10.6 ppg and picked up 63 steals this season, which was second-most in the league. She compiled four double-doubles and was the only sophomore to be named on the Defensive Team.

A three-time C-USA Player of the Week, Wayne opened her season with a career-high 35 points to take down Auburn, the Monarchs first win over a Power 5 opponent since March 2015. Missing three games due to an ankle injury, Wayne averaged 10.7 points per game and 6.9 rebounds per game. The sophomore put together five double-doubles this season.

Hudson was the Monarchs leading scorer off the bench in 2019-20, averaging 6.5 ppg. The New York native drained 48 triples, which was good for 14th-most in the league. Hudson put together five double digit performances, leading the Monarchs in three of those contests.
