The Monarchs Hit .500 from three(7-14), which is the second time this season they have done that. The other was 9-18 in the season opener at Charlotte.

Old Dominion University's athletic program is among the most successful in the United States, boasting 32 team and individual national championships, including three in women's basketball, nine in field hockey, 15 in sailing, a men's basketball Division II title, three individual wrestling Division II national championships, and one women's tennis clay court national crown.

The Department of Intercollegiate Athletics is home for Old Dominion University's 18 varsity programs for men and women. ODU offers competitive programs for student-athletes in the following sports: men's and women's soccer, field hockey, men's and women's sailing, men's and women's basketball, wrestling, men's and women's golf, men's and women's tennis, baseball, and women's rowing. Football will begin in the fall of 2009, and will compete in the CAA in 20111. ODU also plans to begin softball and women's volleyball in the near future.


