

Quick Hits:

- ODU is still seeking it's first win this season, going 0-3 for just the fifth time in school history
- Junior guard Jasmine Parker leads the Lady Monarchs in scoring through two games with 16.3 points per game and has also added 4.3 rebounds per game and a team high 3.7 assists and 4.0 steals per game.
- Sophomore forward Tia Lewis is averaging 8.3 ppg and 6.7 rpg; she averaged a double-double during her first season at the University of Central Florida
- Junior Shadasia Green is averaging double figures with 10.3 points per game and is second on the team in rebounding with 6.3 per contest
- Old Dominion is just 10 wins shy of 900 in program history
- Syracuse has jumped to a 4-0 start this season while Louisville is 2-1
- Both ODU opponents are receiving votes in the Associated Press and ESPN/ USA Today Coach's Poll in this week's rankings; it will be the third and fourth games this season against a team at least receiving votes
- Nicole Michael is leading the way for Syracuse, averaging a double-double with 19.8 ppg and 10.3 rpg -- she has already knocked down 16 3-pointers, hitting 55.2% from deep
- Louisville's Monique Reid (13.0) and Becky Burke (12.7) are in double figures for the Cardinals

Last Time Vs. Syracuse:

ODU hasn't faced the Orange since the 2000-01 ODU faced Louisville in the Dial Classic during overtime decision. Paula Moore hit a jumper with five seconds remaining to win in double overtime over the then 18th ranked Lady Monarchs in the 2000-01 home opener. Hamchetou Maiga. a CAA 25th Anniversary Team honoree, poured in 24 points while Okeisha Howard and Tiffany Thompson had 16 and 13 each.

All-Time Series Against Orange:

Old Dominion holds a 7-3 advantage in the alltime series against Syracuse, but have not played the Orange in nine years. The Lady Monarchs won two of the last three games against Syracuse with two of the games being decided by just one point. Who's Back?

The top returner for the Lady Monarchs in 2009-10 is senior forward Jessica Canady. Canady was a 2nd Team All-CAA Forward last year and was tabbed to the Pre-Season First Team headed into her final campaign. The Williamsburg native ranked second in the CAA in rebounding, hauling in 9.6 boards per game, despite missing six games due to injury. She also returns the highest scoring for ODU this year, after averaging 12.6 points per game last season. Also back for ODU is third-leading scorer Jasmine Parker (10.2 ppg) in the backcourt. Parker started nearly half the games at the shooting guard slot last season. Shadasia Green also returns after a breakout sophomore season that saw her finish with 9.3 ppg and 6.0 rpg a year ago. Juniors Vicki Collier and Russia Voronina are also back in the fold, with sophomore Pryncess Tate-Dublin and redshirt freshman Jo Guilford returning as well.

Who's New?

Though not new to the Lady Monarchs, as she was with the team all last season, Tia Lewis is the most exciting newcomer to the hardwood this year. The 2007-08 Conference USA Freshman of the Year and league-leading rebounder is finally set to debut for the Lady Monarchs. A transfer from Central Florida, Lewis has had a year to learn Coach Larry's system and will be asked to shoulder a heavy load right away. Also expect junior transfer Kquanise Byrd to step in right away as a scoring threat. She ranked third in the nation in scoring (24.4 ppg) at the junior college level playing for Miami-Dade College. True freshmen Carolann Cloutier, Jackie Cook and Becca Allison will also provide significant depth right away for the Lady Monarchs.

Season Openers

Mary's on November 15, 2008. ODU won that game 93-63 in Austin, Texas as a part of the World Vision her 2009-10 debut and dazzled, scoring 13 of her 15 Classic. It was the second straight season opening victory after ODU had been on a streak of five straight losses in the opening game from 2002-2006.

Home Openers

In home openers, Old Dominion is 29-12, including a 4-4 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Last season, ODU opened the regular season home schedule with an upset of 11th ranked UVA by a final score of 78-70. It was the second straight win over a ranked opponent at the Ted, including the overtime thriller in the NCAA Tournament the year before, and the seventh win over a nationally ranked opponent at the Constant Center.

Tia Lewis joined Green and Canady in double figures with 10, despite only scoring two points in limited action in the first half due to foul trouble. Lewis finished 4-for-6 from the field. Rookie point guard Carolann Cloutier distributed eight assists in the game while newcomers Jackie Cook and Kquanise Byrd each dished four. Cook added eight points in the game and Byrd had two thefts. Sophomore center Mairi Buchan got on the boards for a second straight game, rebounding a team-high six missed shots against Shaw.

Exhibition Recap - Chowan

In the first look at the Lady Monarchs, ODU won in front of nearly 3,000 fans with ease, 85-52. Junior Shadasia Green led the way, with 16 points and 9 rebounds, just shy of a double-double. Newcomers Tia Lewis and Kquanise Byrd also showed off what Lady Monarch fans can expect to see this season with 11 and 12 points respectively. Byrd added four steals off the bench and went a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line, while Lewis hauled in six boards. Leading the way on the glass after Green was sophomore center Mairi Buchan, grabbing eight boards. ODU had a commanding rebounding edge with 59 in the game compared to just 30 for Chowan.

Startin' Out Right

Jasmine Parker played extremely well against the second ranked Cardinal in the season opener, scoring a teamhigh 16 points and adding five rebounds, four assists, a career-high five steals and a perfect 5-for-5 night from the free-throw line. Despite a poor first half, Tia Lewis also came away with a stellar first game, finishing just one rebound shy of a double-double. Lewis finished with 15 points and nine rebounds in her first game as a Lady Monarch. Junior Shadasia Green continued her hot play of late with 11 points and seven rebounds. She averaged 16 ppg and 7 rpg in the two exhibitions.

Potent Parker Attack

In the second game of the season, Jasmine Parker scored a career-high 24 points and is now averaging 20.0 points per game this season. She came out of the locker room on a torrid pace, scoring 12 of Old Dominion's first 20 points and giving the Lady Monarchs the lead against the 20th ranked team in the nation. She finished with 24 points, four assists, four rebounds and three steals in her second consecutive solid game against a nationally ranked opponent.
