WHAT WILL IT TAKE FOR 500?

Head Coach Wendy Larry is rapidly approaching the 500 victory mark in her career. To date she needs one victory to reach the mark. She currently holds a 499-185 overall record in her 23rd season as a head coach. Additionally, Coach Larry just recently captured her 450th victory as the head coach at her alma mater with a 57-46 win over Delaware State on November 25. She holds a 450-154 record in her 20th season at the helm of the Old Dominion program.

ABOUT OLD DOMINION:

The Lady Monarchs are looking to return to the win column and put their 40-89 loss to #Duke behind them. Senior Tish Lyons was the lone Lady Monarch to reach double digits against the Blue Devils, notching a season-high 11 points. It marked the first time this season that junior guard T.J. Jordan did not lead the team in the scoring department. Lyons also grabbed a team-high four rebounds along with junior Shahida Williams. Duke rushed out to a 9-0 lead and never looked back. At the half, the Blue Devils held a commanding 43-11 lead. In their last win, a 57-46 home win against Delaware State, head coach Wendy Larry earned her earned her 450th win as the head coach of the Lady Monarch program and moved to within one game of collecting her 500th career win. Junior T.J. Jordan and senior Sherida Triggs led Old Dominion with 12 points each.

ABOUT PENN STATE:

The Lady Lions enter Sunday's contest with a 4-5 record fresh off its 60-51 loss at Pitt Friday night. The loss was Penn State's fifth straight which have also included losses to common ODU opponents Duke and Rutgers. The Lady Lions fell to the Scarlet Knights, 44-57, at the Paradise Jam Tournament in the Virgin Islands, and 42-70 to the Blue Devils at Cameron Indoor Stadium. Penn State is returning the friendly confines of the Bryce Jordan Arena, site of their last win, a 75-49 victory over Notre Dame back on November 16. Penn State is led in scoring and rebounding by Amanda Brown (13.2 ppg, 9.1 rpg). Also scoring in double figures for the Lady Lions is Adrienne Squire (12.0 ppg), Kamela Gissendanner (10.1 ppg), and Tyra Grant (10.0). The Bryce Jordan Center, Penn State's home court will honor its 1,000,000th fan at the Old Dominion game.

SERIES WITH PENN STATE:

Old Dominion leads the all-time series 6-4 with both teams trading wins and losses over the last six meetings. While Old Dominion holds a 4-0 record when playing the Lady Lions in Norfolk, the Lady Monarchs are looking for their first win in State College since 1983. Penn State holds a 3-1 series advantage on their home court.

LAST TIME VS. PENN STATE:

It was a well balanced scoring attack which led the Old Dominion women's basketball team to its first win of the 2005-06 season with a 93-61 victory over Penn State back on November 29, 2005. Four Lady Monarchs reached double digits highlighted by a 20-point second-half scoring barrage by leading scorer T.J. Jordan. The Lady Monarchs' 32-point win over the Lady Lions was not only ODU's largest margin of victory over Penn State in the 10 games played between the two teams, but also the largest margin over a team from the BIG 10. After being held scoreless in the first half, sophomore T.J. Jordan once again came off the bench to lead her squad in scoring, becoming the first Lady Monarch to reach the 20-point mark last season. All six of Jordan's field goals came from three-point land and she added in four more points as she went a perfect 2-of-2 from the charity stripe. Jordan was joined by three others in double figures, Tish Lyons and Sherida Triggs with 16, and Lawona Davis with 17. Old Dominion had its best shooting percentages from the floor, three-point range, and the free throw line of the season. Old Dominion connected on 33-of-63 from the floor to finished shooting 48.6 percent for the night, 17-of-20 for 85 percent from the stripe, and 10-of-15 from downtown for 66.7 percent. Four Lady Monarchs went perfect from the line which included 4-for-4 performances by Triggs and Shantel Wilson. Old Dominion opened the game on a 22-9 run and never looked back. Penn State was outscored 49-26 in the second half.

The Blue Devils were the second ranked team the Lady Monarchs have faced this season. SO WE MEET FOR THE FIRST TIME:

When you look at the Old Dominion Lady Monarch schedule, you can always count on familiar teams such as Tennessee, Rutgers, and Penn State along with various other teams they play on again and off again. Three teams grace this years schedule who the Lady Monarchs have never met. First up is Delaware State, who the Lady Monarchs handed a 57-46 loss at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Old Dominion will also have its first meeting in school history at home against Chicago State and at Middle Tennessee State.

LESSON LEARNED - ON TO THE FUTURE:

Old Dominion will look to put its 40-89 loss to #5 Duke behind them when they travel to Penn State this weekend. The Lady Monarchs' 11 first half points tied the school record for fewest points scored in a half with the original record set back in December of 1972 with 11 second half points in a 23-12 victory over James Madison. The Lady Monarchs score only 12 points in the first half of that game. Additionally, Old Dominion shot a low of 25.0 percent (13-of-52) from the floor, its lowest since shooting 26.0 percent (17-of-65) against Virginia in 1975.

GET THE BALL IN THE HOLE:

Let's look the Lady Monarch shooting percentages in wins and losses:

In victories, the Lady Monarchs shoot an average of .474 from the floor, while the opponent has been held to just .321. Meanwhile in losses, Old Dominion has been shooting just .300 from the field, while opponents are connecting on .517.

D-D-D-DEFENSE:

In their 57-46 win over Delaware State, the Lady Monarchs held the Hornets to 29.0 percent (18-of-62) from the floor, the lowest percentage by an ODU opponent this season.

NOT SEEN VERY OFTEN:

In a rare occurrence, the opposition outrebounded Old Dominion in a victory. The East Carolina Pirates held a 45-33 advantage on the boards, which included holding the Lady Monarchs to just seven offensive rebounds. The Lady Monarchs were outrebounded in only nine of its 31 games last year and none by double digits. Five of the nine times Old Dominion was outrebounded resulted in a loss for the Lady Monarchs. In six of those nine occasions, the opponent outboarded Old Dominion by four rebounds or less. Florida International and James Madison, in the first meeting of the year, both held an eight board advantage over Old Dominion, the most of the season.

SHE SHOOTS...SHE SCORES...A LOT:

Junior guard T.J. Jordan has led the Lady Monarchs in scoring in all four games this season. Jordan has led Old Dominion in scoring on 19 occasions during her career, including 12 times serving as the team's point guard last year.

0-2...SO WHAT?:

The Lady Monarchs may have started the 2006-07 season 0-2, but that's no reason to think the sky is falling. Last season, Old Dominion opened the season 0-2 and finished the year with a 22-9 overall mark and their 15th straight CAA title. The 2003-04 Lady Monarchs opened 0-2 and picked up ranked wins over #7 Penn State and #12/13 North Carolina. They finished 25-7 along with the CAA title. The 2002-03 Lady Monarchs opened 0-3 but managed a 20 win season going 21-9 with a CAA title. The 2000-01 season saw Old Dominion go 0-2 and also finished with a 21-9 mark and a CAA title. The 1992-93 women's team started the year off 0-4, but ended the year 22-8 overall, with yes...another CAA title and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

KEEP SHOOTING PARTNER:

Junior guard T.J. Jordan came off the bench in the 72-92 season opening loss at Virginia to net a team-high 21 points. Shooting 6-of-19 from the field, including 6-of-17 from three-point range, the third year Lady Monarch set new career-highs in field goals and three-pointers attempted. The Lady Monarchs' three-point specialist, she holds the single season three-point attempt mark (2005-06 - 248).

BREAKING DOWN THE OPENERS:

The Lady Monarchs are 25-13 in season openers, suffering a 72-92 set back in this year's opener at Virginia. Of the previous 38 season

openers, Old Dominion has opened the season three times with Virginia with a win in 1977, a loss in 2002 with the opening of ODU's Ted Constant Convocation Center, and a loss in 2006 at the opening of UVA's John Paul Jones Arena. In home openers, the Lady Monarchs are 27-11 including a 2-3 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Old Dominion fell to #21/24 Kentucky in its 2006-07 home debut, 55-69.

OPEN THE DOOR:

The Lady Monarch women's basketball team helped the Virginia Cavaliers open their new building - The John Paul Jones Arena - in ODU's first regular season contest on Saturday, November 12th. It was Virginia back on November 22nd, 2002 that helped Old Dominion open the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

BACK TO THE POLLS:

The Lady Monarchs received votes in both the Preseason Associated Press and WBCA/USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll. The Lady Monarchs have received votes over the last few seasons and are looking to return to the Top 25 in both polls. Old Dominion's last Top 25 ranking in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll was November 18th, 2003. Old Dominion's last appearance in the Associated Press Top 25 was the final poll of the 2002 season as the Lady Monarchs danced their way to the "Elite Eight".

STREET & SMITH:

Street and Smith Magazine has listed the Old Dominion women's basketball team at No. 18 in its in their annual College Basketball Yearbook which went on sale on Oct. 1. Included on this year's schedule are five teams also appearing in Street and Smith's list including No. 5 Tennessee, No. 7 Duke, No. 14 Rutgers, No. 15 Kentucky and No. 20 Virginia.

WHAT THE LADY MONARCHS WELCOME BACK:

The Old Dominion women's basketball team welcomes back four starters and nine letter-winners from last year's team that went 22-9 overall and captured its 15th consecutive Colonial Athletic Association title. Seventy two percent of the offense returns including the four of the five leading scorers and three of the four leading rebounders from a season ago. This year's group of seniors - Tish Lyons, Sherida Triggs, Shantel Wilson - enter the 2006-07 season having collected three CAA titles, three NCAA appearances, a 69-25 overall record and 49-5 mark in CAA matchups. Triggs joins junior guard T.J. Jordan on the Preseason Second Team All-CAA list. Triggs led the CAA in field goal percentage, was second on the ODU squad in scoring, and led the Lady Monarch rebounding corps. Jordan led the team in scoring and reset the single season three-point attempt record.

UP NEXT:

The Lady Monarchs host Chicago State on Saturday at 7:00 p.m. in the first ever meeting between the two schools. The Cougars are coached by former Lady Monarch standout Angela Jackson. Jackson was a member of the Lady Monarchs in 1989 and 1990, helping the Old Dominion women's basketball team to two second round appearances in the NCAA. As a senior in 1990, she was named First Team All-Sun Belt averaging a team second best 16.6 points per game.

COLONIAL DOMINANCE: Old Dominion has captured 14-straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 269-15 overall record, which includes eight seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 143-2 record at home and a 128-13 road record. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992 and the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005. Five schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Georgia State (2-0), George Mason (39-0), Northeastern (2-0), UNC-Wilmington (33-0), and Towson (9-0).

CHARLOTTESVILLE, Va. -- The Old Dominion women's basketball team opened the 2006-07 season with a 92-72 loss at in-state rival Virginia on Sunday afternoon at the brand new John Paul Jones Arena.

The game marked the opening of the Cavaliers brand new facility. Virginia had helped open ODU's new home, the Ted Constant Convocation Center, back when the door opened in 2002.

The loss dropped Old Dominion to 0-1 in their first showing of the regular season. Virginia improved to 2-0.

Virginia jumped out to a 14-point lead, 24-10. The Cavaliers built its lead to 21 points, 36-15 with 6:38 to go in the half and entered the locker room with a 14-point edge, 44-30, paced by senior Siedah Williams' 15 points.

In the second half, Virginia maintained its double-digit lead, going ahead by as many as 21 points.

Junior guard T.J. Jordan (Portsmouth, Va.) led the Lady Monarch squad with 21 points, all coming from three-point range. The third-year Lady Monarch shot 6-of-19 from the field, including 6-of-17 from three-point range setting new career-highs in field goals and three-pointers attempted.

Senior Sherida Triggs (Norcross, Ga.) sat out most of the first half in foul trouble and scored all 15 of her points in the second half.

Redshirt sophomore Tiffany Green (Chesapeake, Va.) collected a game-high 10 boards as Virginia only held a slight one rebound margin over Old Dominion, 43-42.

Sophomore Lyndra Littles led Virginia with a career-high 23 points and 12 rebounds for her second double-double of the season and seventh of her career. She went 13-of-14 from the line. Williams followed with 21 points. Junior Denesha Kenyon came off the bench for a career-high 13 points, while freshman Monica Wright rounded out the double-figure scoring with 11 points. The frosh also added six boards, four assists, and three steals in her second start.

NORFOLK, Va. -- The Old Dominion women's basketball team fell to 0-2 on the season falling, 55-69, to No. 21 (AP) 24 (ESPN/USA Today) Kentucky on Homecoming at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

The Wildcats improved to 2-1 on the season and picked up their first victory in Norfolk in five trips to Hampton Roads.

In the first half, neither team enjoyed more than a five-point lead. Old Dominion led for much of the first half holding on to a 15-12 edge with 8:19 left in the half. From there Kentucky took a 7-0 run to take over a lead they would never relinquish. Old Dominion did manage to tie the game up late in the half. A T.J. Jordan (Portsmouth, Va.) lay-up with 1:36 remaining tied the game at 23-23 and the Lady Monarchs ended the half down only 27-23.

Kentucky had a hot hand in the second half. After the Lady Monarch defense held the Wildcats to just 27.3 percent shooting in half number one, Kentucky ignited for 15-of-23 to hit 65.2 percent from the floor in the second half.

Old Dominion cut the Kentucky edge down to one twice in the opening minutes of the second half, but the Wildcats bumped up their margin to eight, 27-39, with 13:16 remaining. The Lady Monarchs only managed to nudge the Wildcat lead down to five. On the next two plays, a Jordan free-throw and a Sherida Triggs lay-up, Old Dominion got as close to the Kentucky lead, 47-42, as it would get the rest of the game.

Guards Carly Ormerod and Samantha Mahoney helped Kentucky take a 6-0 run to give the Wildcats a double digit lead it would hold on for almost the rest of the game. Senior forward Jennifer Humphrey hit two free throws giving the Wildcats its largest lead of the game, a 16-point 65-49 advantage.

Jordan was the team's leading scorer for the second straight game and the lone Lady Monarch in double figures. Jordan netted 11 with six points coming from the line. Sophomore Jazzmin Walters (Norfolk, Va.) added in nine.

Kentucky's Jenny Pfeiffer came off the Wildcat bench to lead all scorers with 22 points. Two other Wildcats joined Pfeiffer with double digit scoring. Ormerod added in 18 points, while Mahoney poured in 12.

Old Dominion won the battle of the boards by one, 42-41. Junior Megan Pym (Newfield, N.Y.) hauled in seven rebounds in just six minutes, but missed the rest of the game while an injury.

NORFOLK, Va. -- The Old Dominion women's basketball team got its first win of the 2006-07 season by handing former CAA rival East Carolina a 77-66 loss at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

The win snapped a two-game losing streak for the Lady Monarchs as they head into Saturday's game with Delaware State sporting a 1-2 record. East Carolina, in their first appearance against Old Dominion since switching from the CAA to Conference USA, fell to 1-3 overall.

Junior T.J. Jordan (Portsmouth, Va.) led the team in scoring for the third straight game with 16 points, connecting on 4-of-7 from the field, 3-of-6 from three-point range, and a perfect 5-of-5 from the free throw line. Junior Tay Ransburg (Kansas City, Mo.) netted 14, while senior Sherida Triggs (Norcross, Ga.) added 11 with 10 of those points coming in the first half.

East Carolina also saw three in double figures with Cherie Mills leading the way with 17 points. Jasmine Young collected 16 points, while LaCoya Terry dropped in 13.

In a rare occurrence, the opposition outrebounded Old Dominion. The Pirates held a 45-33 advantage on the boards, which included holding the Lady Monarchs to just seven offensive rebounds. Ransburg led the squad on the glass with six rebounds. East Carolina saw Mills and Jessica Slack record nine.

Old Dominion had a 39-27 lead at the half and led by as many as 18 in the opening stanza. Sophomore Jen Nuzzo (Newport News, Va.) came off the bench to hit one of her two treys of the evening to give the Lady Monarchs a 12-9 edge and the lead for good at the 14:31 mark.

The Lady Monarchs managed to hold off a second half comeback by the Pirates. With Old Dominion leading 46-33 and enjoying a 13-point edge, East Carolina used a 12-2 run to pull within three with 9:56 left in the game. Ahead 48-45, Old Dominion turned the table and took a run of its own. Outsourcing the Pirates 13-2 sparked by nine straight points by Jordan, the Lady Monarchs pushed their lead to 14, 61-47, with 5:50 left. During the run, Jordan hit two three's and was fouled on an attempt where she went to the line to hit all three free throw attempts. Additionally, senior Shantel Wilson (Washington, D.C.) went perfect from the line as well.

The Pirates did not go away and still had another run left in them. Ransburg helped the Lady Monarchs to their largest lead of the half on a jumper to give ODU a 15-point advantage, 68-53, with just 2:43 remaining in the game. Over the next minute and a half, East Carolina outscored Old Dominion 10-2, making it a seven-point ball game. The Pirates would only score three more points in the game and would foul the Lady Monarchs to close out the game. While Mills only connected on one of a three-shot award from the line and Slack put in a lay-up, the Lady Monarchs went 7-of-10 from the stripe to hold on to the win.

DURHAM, N.C. -- Old Dominion women's basketball coach Wendy Larry will have to wait one more game to see if she reaches her 500th career victory as the fifth-ranked Blue Devils downed the Lady Monarchs, 89-40, at Cameron Indoor Stadium on Wednesday night.

The loss, ODU's second to a ranked opponent this season, brings the Lady Monarchs to 2-3 overall. The Blue Devils remain perfect at 6-0.

Duke rushed out to a 9-0 lead and never looked back. At the half, the Blue Devils held a commanding 43-11 lead. The 11 points scored by the Lady Monarchs tied the school record for fewest points in a half. Old Dominion only hit four field goals and had three points from the line. Junior Tamara Ransburg (Kansas City, Mo.) led ODU at the half with four points. The Lady Monarchs' top two scorers, junior T.J. Jordan (Portsmouth, Va.) and senior Sherida Triggs (Norcross, Ga.), were both held scoreless.

Old Dominion had a stronger second half but was outscored by Duke, 46-29.

Senior Tish Lyons (Newport News, Va.) was the lone Lady Monarch in double figures. Lyons finished the night with 11 points, nine of them coming in the second half.

Five Blue Devils reached double digits led by Abby Waner with 16 points. Carrem Gay poured in 13, including 11 first half points, followed by Joy Cheek with 12, Keturah Jackson with 11, and Alison Bales with 10.

The Duke defense held Old Dominion to 25.0 percent (13-of-52) shooting for the game, while going on to record a season-high 59.0 percent (36-of-61) from the floor.

The Blue Devils also won the battle of the board, 36-33. Lyons and junior Shahida Williams (Newark, N.J.) both grabbed four in the loss. Bales hauled in a game-high seven for the Blue Devils.
