TIME FOR A NEW STREAK TO START:

The Lady Monarchs had their 122 CAA home win streak snapped in a 70-73 setback to Delaware on January 9th. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992. The streak began on February 29, 1992 with a 64-56 victory over William & Mary and lasted nearly 13 years. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 242-13 overall record, which includes eight seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 132-2 record at home and a 110-11 road record. Old Dominion also holds an NCAA record 13 straight conference titles. Since the Loss the Lady Monarchs have rattled off seven straight home wins.

HOME STREAK STOPPED:

On January 2nd, with 58-68 setback to the eighth ranked Lady Vols of Tennessee, Old Dominion had its 21-game home win streak snapped. During that span, the Lady Monarch knocked off three ranked opponents which included this year's 69-61 victory over #16/19 Rutgers. Last season the Lady Monarchs went a perfect 17-0 at home with their previous loss before Tennessee at the Ted Constant Convocation Center being back on March 22, 2003 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament with a 73-74 setback to "Sweet 16" participant Boston College. The Lady Monarchs have suffered just six home losses since moving to the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2001. The win streak began on November 25th against the Lady Lions of #7 Penn State with a 75-68 win back on November 25, 2003.

SPEAKING OF STREAKS:

Old Dominion did not managed to stop Delaware's 16 game win streak that has dated back to December 5th with a loss to the Blue Hens last Friday night. Back on January 11, 2002, #25 ODU snapped the University of Delaware' three-year home winning streak with an 82-55 victory in their first ever meeting. In that game, the Blue Hens lost consecutive games for the first time since the 1999-2000 season, had their school record 22-game

home winning streak snapped. The loss was Delaware's first at home since a 73-58 setback to Maine back on January 4, 2000. The Lady Monarchs are definately no strangers to stopping streaks though. The Lady Monarchs snapped Louisiana Tech's record 54 game win streak that spanned from December. 1, 1980 through January 27, 1982 with a 61-58 victory at the ODU Fieldhouse. The Lady Techsters record remained in the NCAA record books until the UConn Huskies rewrote the record with 70 straight wins from 2001 to 2003.

ATTENDANCE MATTERS:

The University of Delaware set a women's basketball attendance record on February 11th against the Lady Monarchs when 4,772 people witnessed the battle. Old Dominion helped set the previous record when 2,642 were in attendance in the first meeting back when the Lady Monarchs were ranked 25th and en-route to capturing its 11th straight CAA title and dancing on to the "Elite Eight" of the NCAA Tournament. The Lady Monarchs are currently 29th in the nation in attendance according to the unofficial survey kept by the University of Wisconsin Sports Information Office. The largest crowd to witness the Lady Monarchs play this season was when 7,063 people turned the turnstiles at the Ted Constant Convocation Center to see the then-ninth ranked Lady Vols of Tennessee battle ODU.

CHAMPIONSHIP REUNION:

The Old Dominion University athletic department will celebrate two significant anniversaries on Sunday, Feb. 27 at the Lady Monarchs' home season finale with James Madison at 3 p.m. at the Constant Center. Twenty-five years ago, the Lady Monarchs, led by All Americans Nancy Lieberman, Inge Nissen and Anne Donovan, captured their second consecutive AIAW national crown en route to posting a 37-1 record (the 1978/79 team won the title with a 35-1 mark). Then, five years later a new group of Lady Monarchs, led by All American Medina Dixon, Tracy Claxton and freshmen All Americans Donna Harrington and Adrienne Goodson, captured the NCAA title with a victory over the University of Georgia. The teams will be honored during the halftime ceremonies of the game, which is being broadcast on Comcast sportsnet in the Mid-Atlantic region. Early indications are that many of the former players will be in attendance, including Lieberman, Donovan, Rhonda Rompolo, Chris Critelli, Dawn Cullen, Goodson, and more. The general public is invited to renew old friendships with the members of the teams prior to the game at an open house hosted by the ODU alumni association from 1-2 p.m. at the new Barry Kornblau Alumni Center on the corner of Hampton Boulevard and 49th street.

CAA PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

11/29 - Shareese Grant :

Shareese Grant averaged 20 points per game against ACC opponents Georgia Tech and Virginia Tech and scored her 1,000th career point in an Old Dominion uniform last week. Grant scored a team-high 18 points on 7-of-16 shooting against Georgia Tech. The senior from Virginia Beach, Va. led all scorers with a 22 point outing on 10-of-19 shooting in the Lady Monarchs' win over Virginia Tech. Additionally, she dished out a game-high six assists against the Hokies.

12/6 - Shareese Grant:

Grant led Old Dominion to two victories, a 30 + point victory over East Tennessee State and a 69-61 win over #16/19 Rutgers. Grant led all scorers in the 86-52 win over the Lady Bucs as Old Dominion posted back-to-back 30-point wins for the first time since the 2001-02 season. Grant once again led all scorers with 21 points against a ranked Scarlet Knight squad to give Old Dominion its third victory over a ranked opponent at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Of her 21 points, Grant scored 17 of them from the free throw line setting a new school record for free throws made in a game. She resets the record held by Nancy Lieberman that was set back on January 10, 1978 against Pittsburgh.

1/3 - Tiffany Green

Tiffany Green earn Rookie of the Week honors after averaging 14.3 points and 11.0 rebounds in games against Harvard, #5/7 North Carolina, and #8 Tennessee. Green collected three double-doubles over the holidays as the Lady Monarchs defeated Harvard 83-55 and took on two Top 25 teams. Against Harvard, Green, in her second career start, picked up her first career double-double with 12 points and a game-high 11 rebounds. She followed with a team-leading 19 points and 11 rebounds at #5/7 North Carolina. Green continued to shine as she picked up double-double number three with a team-high 12 points and game-high 11 rebounds against #8 Tennessee. Over the course of the three games, Green shot .536 percent from the floor and moved into second on the Lady Monarch squad in scoring.

CHAIRWOMEN OF THE BOARDS

Old Dominion has certainly done its job on the boards, outrebounding all but two of its opponents thus far in the 2004-05 season. The Lady Monarchs are outboarding their opponent by an average of 11.0 rebounds per game, ranking third nationally and double the rebounding average of the next CAA team on the list (James Madison - 5.5). Sophomore Sherida Triggs has certainly done her job of crashing the boards. Against Virginia Tech in the home opener the 6-1 forward collected a career-high 17 rebounds (eight offensive, nine defensive), the most rebounds by a Lady Monarch since Monique Coker grabbed 17 on three occasions last season (2/29 - at George Mason, 2/5 - at Towson, 12-15 vs. Florida International). Rookie Tiffany Green also been a monster in the glass. The freshman forward has registered double figures in rebounding seven times so far this season.

FREE THROW RECORDS FALL:

Old Dominion hit a school record 35 free throws in a January 16th victory over Hofstra. The game which saw 57 fouls, including 34 on the Pride, had the Lady Monarchs go to line 56 times. The 35 made by Old Dominion surpasses the previous school record of 34 recorded against former conference rival American back on February 13, 2000. Sophomore Jen Nuzzo netted the record free throw. ODU's other free throw record set came at the hands of senior guard Shareese Grant. Shareese Grant managed to take a record away from Nancy Lieberman in December 10th's victory over #16/19 Rutgers. Although Grant shot just 2-of-12 from the field, the Virginia Beach, Virginia native sunk an incredible 17-of-18 from the floor and ended the afternoon with a game-high 21

points. The 17 free throws made surpassed the previous record of 15 held by Lady Monarch legend Nancy Lieberman against Pittsburgh back on Jan. 10, 1978. Lieberman's record stood for over 26 years.

A TALE OF TWO ACL'S:

Both junior Paula Muxiri and sophomore Corrina Turner will miss the 2004-05 season after suffering an ACL tears in their knees. Muxiri tore her ACL in her left knee in mid-November. Last season, Muxiri averaged 3.7 points and 2.6 rebounds as one of the top Lady Monarchs off the bench. She averaged 14.2 minutes per game and shot .480 from the field. Center Corrina Turner has elected surgery on her left knee after suffering a tear in her anterior cruciate ligament during the Lady Monarchs' season opener at Georgia Tech on November 23rd. In the meantime, she will complete her degree in communications this December with in the intention of continuing with a post-graduate degree in the spring. The 6-6 center from Miami, Florida has been a member of the Lady Monarchs since the Fall of 2000. During her career she has averaged 6.8 points and 7.0 rebounds. During Old Dominion's run to the "Elite Eight" in 2002, Turner's first full season, she made 25 starts averaging 6.2 points and 7.0 rebounds per game. Turner has suffered two torn ACL's in her right knee, the first occurring after six games in her first season with Old Dominion in 2000 and the second right before the start of the preseason in 2001. She originally tore her left ACL right after the start of preseason practice for the 2003-04 season.

FAMILIAR FACE RETURNS:

Adrienne Goodson, a WNBA All-Star, Kodak District All-American, and a member of the 1985 NCAA National Championship women's basketball team, has joined the Lady Monarch coaching staff. Goodson served as a replacement for assistant coach Juliet Schweiter who was on maternity leave earlier in the year and will continue in that capacity as assistant coach Susan Montgomery takes her maternity leave. Schweiter welcomed their first child, Gavin Richard, on October 15th, while Montgomery welcomed daughter Reese Baily on February 4th. During her career at Old Dominion, Goodson was a two-time second team All-Sun Belt performer and was also on the Sun-Belt All-Tournament squad in 1987. As a junior in 1987, she was named the Sun Belt Conference Tournament Most Valuable Player and as a senior in 1988, she was named the Sun Belt Player of the Year. During her freshman season, Goodson was a member of the 1985 NCAA National Championship squad. She averaged 9.5 points per game as she scored 323 points, which is the seventh most points scored in Lady Monarch history for a freshman. In the NCAA title game, Goodson scored nine points and hauled in six rebounds to help the Lady Monarchs defeat Georgia, 70-65 in Austin, Texas as Old Dominion rolled to a 31-3 record. With

Goodson on the floor, the Lady Monarchs won the Sun Belt Conference title in 1985 and in 1987 and helped lead Old Dominion to three NCAA tournaments. Goodson closed out her career with 1,574 career points and 863 career rebounds. She ranks 11th all-time in scoring. Following her graduation in 1988 with a degree in secondary education, Goodson captained the 1993 USA National Basketball team and was a two-time All-Star in the American Basketball League for the Richmond/Philadelphia Rage. She has spent the last six years in the WNBA. Selected by the Starz in the third round in the 1999 WNBA Draft, she spent four years in Utah before playing the last two seasons with the San Antonio Silver Stars. In 2002, she was selected to the WNBA All-Star Team.

WE'LL BE BACK:

The Lady Monarchs visited the city of Atlanta, Georgia in their 2004-05 season opener and the city will be one the Lady Monarchs will become familiar with in the near future. Georgia State, located in Atlanta with approximately 28,000 students along with Northeastern in Boston, Massachusetts, will join the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) as the conference expands to 12 members for the first time in its 20-year history in the 2005-06 season. The new members will give the CAA a presence in five of the nation's nine largest media markets (#1 New York, #4 Philadelphia, #6 Boston, #8 Washington, D.C. and #9 Atlanta). CAA schools have produced 16 national team champions in five different sports, 33 individual national champions, 11 national coaches of the year, 11 national players of the year, 12 Honda Award winners, 16 NCAA post-graduate scholars, five Rhodes Scholars and four Nobel Prize winning faculty.

ALL THAT JAZZ:

Jazzmin Walters, a 5-2 guard from Lake Taylor High School in Norfolk, Virginia, has signed a national letter of intent to play women's basketball at Old Dominion beginning next fall. Walters averaged 19.9 points, seven assists, and six steals as a junior, leading her school to a 20-4 record and an appearance in the East Region quarterfinals. Entering her senior season, she has accumulated 1,286 career points and scored in double figures in each of her 24 appearances last season. Additionally, she also earned Eastern District Defensive Player of the Year, a First Team All-Eastern District, Street & Smith Honorable Mention All-America, and AP Second Team All-State honors. Walters was ranked 87th in the Blue Star Report of the country's Top 100 senior high school women's basketball athletes. She also attended the Nike All-America Camp and was a Co-MVP at the End of the Trail Tournament, an all-star event in Oregon. Walters becomes the fifth student-athlete to sign with Old Dominion from the Hampton Roads area in the last three seasons.

- Old Dominion University athletic teams have captured 28 team national championships and four individual titles, including a men's basketball crown in Division II in 1975, three titles women's basketball, nine in field hockey, 15 in sailing, and individual championships in wrestling and women's tennis.
- Old Dominion has been the site of five NCAA women's national championships including the 1982 and 1983 basketball "Final Four" and the 1985, 1986 & 2000 field hockey tournaments.
- Old Dominion was selected as one of 45 institutions nationally for the NCAA Pilot Certification Program, a pioneer program that looked at the athletic department's overall operations, including philosophy, academic requirements, competition, etc.
- Old Dominion was among one of the first institutions to implement a successful drug testing and education program, now entering its thirteenth year.
- The SACS Committee commended the University and the Athletic Department on its program on high integrity, honesty, fiscal soundness and effective management, noting that excellent people, facilities and services are in place
- Old Dominion University was the first institution in Virginia to offer grants-in-aid for women athletes, beginning in 1974.
- Old Dominion's nine national titles in field hockey are unprecedented in NCAA record books for most titles in that sport by the same school.
- Old Dominion has had 100 first team All-Americans and 82 Academic All-Americans since 1976.
- Old Dominion has been the host site of three ICSA Sailing national championships, including 1985 Team Race, Dinghy, Women 1993 Team Race and 2001 men's and women's singlehanded.

Reaching the pinnacle of achievement and honor within sport...

- Seven former Old Dominion coaches or athletes have been inducted into national sports halls of fame. Former Old Dominion basketball standout and three-time Olympian Anne Donovan was inducted into the GTE/CoSIDA Academic All-American Hall of Fame in May of 1994, and was inducted into the Hall of Fame on May 15, 1995. Nancy Lieberman-Cline was inducted into the Basketball Naismith Hall of Fame in 1996 and both Nancy and Anne were in the first class of inductees in the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame in 1998. In 2002, former women's basketball coach Marianne Stanley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame. Retired wrestling coach Gray Simons is an inductee of the U.S. Wrestling Hall of Fame, Beth Anders is enshrined in the U.S. Field Hockey Association Hall of Fame, and the late Bud Metheny is remembered in the Collegiate Baseball Coaches Hall of Fame. Sue Stahl, named Lacrosse Magazine's Coach of the Century, was inducted into Virginia Lacrosse Hall of Fame and the United States Lacrosse Hall of Fame.
- Ten Monarch coaches and athletes have been enshrined in the Virginia Sports Hall of Fame in Portsmouth, Va. - Bud Metheny, Paul Webb, Gray Simons, Dave Twardzik, Nancy Lieberman, Tom Scott, Anne Donovan, Yogi Hightower-Boothe, Joseph "Scrap" Chandler and Lou Plummer.
- Three former Old Dominion University women's basketball players have been recognized as national players of the year; Nancy Lieberman - 1979 and 1980 Wade Trophy winner and Honda-Broderick Cup winner in 1980 (nation's top female athlete); Anne Donovan - 1983 Naismith Award winner; and Ticha Penicherio - 1998 Wade Trophy winner.
- Seven women athletes have earned the Honda award as the nation's top athlete in their sport. Nancy Lieberman won the award in 1979 and 1980 in women's basketball, Anne Donovan in 1983, while Yogi Hightower, Kelli James, Chrisy Morgan, Mimi Smith, Marina DiGiacomo and Tiffany Snow were named the Honda Award winners for field hockey in 1983, 1984, 1993, 1998, 2000 and 2002.
