TIME CHANGE:

The December 30th women's basketball game between North Carolina and Old Dominion has been moved to the Dean E. Smith Center and will tip off at 4 p.m. The game was originally to be played at Carmichael Auditorium at 2 p.m. There will be no charge for admission to the game. The Smith Center doors will open at 3 p.m. for general admission seating and the building will be cleared after the game, prior to the 8 p.m. men's basketball game against Cleveland State. Parking is free in the lots around the Smith Center, but cars must be moved within 30 minutes after the game to accommodate reserved parking for the men's basketball game that evening.

NOT IN OUR HOUSE:

In their last game, a 83-55 victory over the Ivy League's Harvard, Old Dominion improved its home win streak to 21 straight games. Additionally, on December 5th, a 69-61 victory over #16/19 Rutgers gave the Lady Monarchs its third victory over a ranked opponent at the Ted Constant Convocation Center since the building opened for the 2002-03 season. Last season the Lady Monarchs went a perfect 17-0 at home with their lass loss at the Ted Constant Convocation Center being back on March 22, 2003 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament with a 73-74 setback to "Sweet 16" participant Boston College. The Lady Monarchs have suffered just four home losses since moving to the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2001. The win streak began on November 25th against the Lady Lions of #7 Penn State with a 75-68 win back on November 25, 2003.

The Lady Monarchs are trying to get rid of the turnover demon that has plagued them on road games this season. While at home, Old Dominion is averaging just 17.0 turnovers per game, while conversely on the road, the Lady Monarchs are giving away the ball 27.3 times, a number that head coach Wendy Larry certainly wants to see go down. NEW TO US:

WINS:

The last game against the Harvard marked a new rivalry between the Crimson and ODU. Harvard is not the only school on this year's schedule that the Lady Monarchs have never tipped-off against. East Tennessee State fell, 86-52, in their first meeting with Old Dominion. In fact, most of the non-conference teams on the schedule have long established rivalries with the Lady Monarchs including, Penn State (9 meetings), North Carolina (17 meetings), Rutgers (21 meetings), Tennessee (27 meetings), Virginia Tech (28 meetings) and Virginia (29 meetings).

SEEING GREEN:

Rookie Tiffany Green notched her first career double-double with 12 points and 11 boards as the Lady Monarch women's basketball returned home to the Ted Constant Convocation Center to an 83-55 non-conference victory over Harvard last Wednesday, overcoming a two-game slide. Green's double-double was the Lady Monarchs second double figure, double digit performance. The first was performed by Sherida Triggs with 12 points and a career-high 17 boards in the home opener against Virginia Tech back on November 27th. The game also marked Green's second career start.

CHAIRWOMAN OF THE BOARDS

Old Dominion has certainly done its job on the boards, outrebounding all seven opponents thus far in the 2004-05 season. The Lady Monarchs are outboarding their opponent by an average of 13.3 rebounds per game, 5.8 rebounds more than the next CAA team in rebounding margin (James Madison - 6.9). Sophomore Sherida Triggs has certainly done her job of crashing the boards. Against Virginia Tech in the home opener the 6-1 forward collected a career-high 17 rebounds (eight offensive, nine defensive), the most rebounds by a Lady Monarch since Monique Coker grabbed 17 on three occasions last season (2/29 - at George Mason, 2/5 - at Towson, 12-15 vs. Florida International). Triggs' previous high was nine against a ranked Colorado squad in the first game of the season last year.

LIGHTS OUT:

TO:

The Lady Monarchs have outshot its opponent in six of its seven games thus far in the 2004-05 campaign. Only Rutgers has managed to outshot ODU and it wasn't by much. The Lady Monarchs shot 33 percent (17-of-51), while the Scarlet Knights hit 39 percent (22-of-56) from the floor. The Lady Monarchs have hit 50 percent or above in four of their last five games.

DYNAMO DAVIS:

Lawona Davis, who had just two points against Virginia and was held scoreless against Penn State in ODU's last two games, rebounded with a season and team-high 16 points in ODU's last game, a 83-55 victory over Harvard. She shot 6-of-9 from the floor, 4-of-4 from the free throw line and added eight rebounds, three assists, and three steals as one of three Lady Monarchs in double figures.

HEAR ME ROAR:

Sophomore Tish Lyons had her first double digit output of the 2004-05 season in last Wednesday's victory over Harvard. Lyons tied her career her career-high with 12 points. Last time the Newport News, Virginia product poured in 12 was against Hofstra back on February 12, 2004 at the Constant Center as ODU avenged its only conference loss of the season..

JUST LIKE MIKE:

Rookie T.J. Jordan has certainly been a lights out shooter from three-point land. Since an 0-for-6 night at Georgia Tech in the season opener, Jordan has connected on at least one three pointer since. Jordan currently ranks 11th in the CAA in three-point field goal percentage, shooting 32.6 percent from beyond the arc having connected on 14-of-43.

LAST TIME VERSUS UNC:

The Old Dominion women's basketball team defeated the previously undefeated #12/13 North Carolina Lady Tar Heels 73-68 back on December 7th, 2003 at the Ted Constant Convocation Center, North Carolina led 13-12, with 14:26 left in the half but that would be the last time UNC would hold the lead for the rest of the half. The Lady Monarchs extended their lead to as much as 13 points, 26-13 at the 10:14 mark. North Carolina came back with a 13-2 run to cut the deficit to just two points, 28-26, with 5:40 left in the half. Down 37-35 in the final minute of the half, UNC's Camille Little made a game-tying layup with 36 seconds remaining in the half at 37 all. Former Lady Monarchs and WNBA Los Angeles Spark Monique Coker had 10 points at the half to lead the Lady Monarchs. Holding onto a slim 68-66 edge with just under a minute left, ODU rolled off five straight points to go up 73-66. A Leah Metcalf layup for North Carolina would be the final score of the game, with ODU taking a 73-68 victory. For the game, ODU shot 30 of 66 (45.5%) from the field, while North Carolina shot 27 of 54 (50%). The Lady Monarchs held a 38-31 rebounding margin for the game. Former Lady Monarchs Myriah Spence and Monique Coker each scored 17 points for ODU during the game, with Shareese Grant and Max Nhassengo adding 13 and 12 points respectively. UNC's Camille Little led all game-scorers with 23 points.

1,000 AND COUNTING:

With 17 points against the Penn State Lady Lions, senior guard Shareese Grant continued to move up the all-time scoring leaders list. Back on December 19th in State College, Grant surpassed Shonda DeBerry (1992-96) for the 20th spot on the all-time leading scorers list. With 1,125 career points under her belt, Grant might be awhile in moving up the list. She has her eyes set moving past Kim McQuarter (1985-89) who currently sits in 19th place with 1.275. Grant eclipsed the 1,000 career point mark becoming the 24th Lady Monarch in history to reach the milestone. Grant reached the mark with her fifth point in season opening 64-71 setback at Georgia Tech in the first of a two free throw award with 8:53 remaining in the first half.

LAST TIME SINCE #1 UCONN:

In their first victory of the season, Old Dominion handed in-state rival Virginia Tech a 87-56 loss. The 31-point defeat was the biggest loss for the Hokies since a 42-77 setback to then top ranked Connecticut back on February 10th, 2002.

A TALE OF TWO ACL'S:

Both junior Paula Muxiri and sophomore Corrina Turner will miss the 2004-05 season after suffering an ACL tears in their knees and underwent surgery earlier this week.. Muxiri tore her ACL in her left knee in mid-November. Last season, Muxiri averaged 3.7 points and 2.6 rebounds as one of the top Lady Monarchs off the bench. She averaged 14.2 minutes per game and shot .480 from the field. Center Corrina Turner has elected surgery on her left knee after suffering a tear in her anterior cruciate ligament during the Lady Monarchs' season opener at Georgia Tech on November 23rd. In the meantime, she will complete her degree in communications this December with in the intention of continuing with a post-graduate degree in the spring. The 6-6 center from Miami, Florida has been a member of the Lady Monarchs since the Fall of 2000. During her career she has averaged 6.8 points and 7.0 rebounds. During Old Dominion's run to the "Elite Eight" in 2002, Turner's first full season, she made 25 starts averaging 6.2 points and 7.0 rebounds per game. Turner has suffered two torn ACL's in her right knee, the first occurring after six games in her first season with Old Dominion in 2000 and the second right before the start of the preseason in 2001. She originally tore her left ACL right after the start of preseason practice for the 2003-04 season. Turner will undergo surgery on December 15th.

SORRY NANCY:

Shareese Grant managed to take a record away from Nancy Lieberman in December 10th's victory over #16/19 Rutgers. Although Grant shot just 2-of-12 from the field, the Virginia Beach, Virginia native sunk an incredible 17-of-18 from the floor and ended the afternoon with a game-high 21 points. The 17 free throws made surpassed the previous record of 15 held by Lady Monarch legend Nancy Lieberman against Pittsburgh back on Jan. 10, 1978. Lieberman's record stood for over 26 years.

MORE FROM THE LINE:

Shareese Grant wasn't the only Lady Monarchs to have an impressive performance at the free throw line against Rutgers. Junior Lawona Davis took her first free throws of the year against the Scarlet Knights and managed to hit all 10 of her attempts. Head coach Wendy Larry joked about both Shareese Grant's and Lawona Davis' free throw abilities after the game. She noted that even though Grant broke a nearly 26 year old record held by Lady Monarch legend Nancy Lieberman, its Davis who earns the team's sticker for going perfect from the line. Grant actually missed a free throw going 17-of-18. The coaches award stickers following each game based on various performances. Davis has still not missed a shot from the line and is currently shooting a perfect 14-of-14.

CAA PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

11/29 - Shareese Grant:

Shareese Grant averaged 20 points per game against ACC opponents Georgia Tech and Virginia Tech and scored her 1,000th career point in an Old Dominion uniform last week. Grant scored a team-high 18 points on 7-of-16 shooting against Georgia Tech. The senior from Virginia Beach, Va. led all scorers with a 22 point outing on 10-of-19 shooting in the Lady Monarchs' win over Virginia Tech. Additionally, she dished out a game-high six assists against the Hokies.

12/6 - Shareese Grant:

Grant led Old Dominion to two victories, a 30 + point victory over East Tennessee State and a 69-61 win over #16/19 Rutgers. Grant led all scorers in the 86-52 win over the Lady Bucs as Old Dominion posted back-to-back 30-point wins for the first time since the 2001-02 season. Grant once again led all scorers with 21 points against a ranked Scarlet Knight squad to give Old Dominion its third victory over a ranked opponent at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Of her 21 points, Grant scored 17 of them from the free throw line setting a new school record for free throws made in a game. She resets the record held by Nancy Lieberman that was set back on January 10, 1978 against Pittsburgh.

ALL THAT JAZZ:

Jazzmin Walters, a 5-2 guard from Lake Taylor High School in Norfolk, Virginia, has signed a national letter of intent to play women's basketball at Old Dominion beginning next fall. Walters averaged 19.9 points, seven assists, and six steals as a junior, leading her school to a 20-4 record and an appearance in the East Region quarterfinals. Entering her senior season, she has accumulated 1,286 career points and scored in double figures in each of her 24 appearances last season. Additionally, she also earned Eastern District Defensive Player of the Year, a First Team All-Eastern District, Street & Smith Honorable Mention All-America, and AP Second Team All-State honors. Walters was ranked 87th in the Blue Star Report of the country's Top 100 senior high school women's basketball athletes. She also attended the Nike All-America Camp and was a Co-MVP at the End of the Trail Tournament, an all-star event in Oregon. Walters becomes the fifth student-athlete to sign with Old Dominion from the Hampton Roads area in the last three seasons.

FAMILIAR FACE RETURNS:

Adrienne Goodson, a WNBA All-Star, Kodak District All-American, and a member of the 1985 NCAA National Championship women's basketball team, has joined the Lady Monarch coaching staff. Goodson will serve as a replacement for assistant coach Juliet McGee Schweiter who is on maternity leave. Schweiter and her husband, Herb, welcomed their first child, Gavin Richard, on October 15th. During her career at Old Dominion, Goodson was a two-time second team All-Sun Belt performer and was also on the Sun-Belt All-Tournament squad in 1987. As a junior in 1987, she was named the Sun Belt Conference Tournament Most Valuable Player and as a senior in 1988, she was named the Sun Belt Player of the Year. During her freshman season. Goodson was a member of the 1985 NCAA National Championship squad. She averaged 9.5 points per game as she scored 323 points, which is the seventh most points scored in Lady Monarch history for a freshman. In the NCAA title game, Goodson scored nine points and hauled in six rebounds to help the Lady Monarchs defeat Georgia, 70-65 in Austin, Texas as Old Dominion rolled to a 31-3 record. With Goodson on the floor, the Lady Monarchs won the Sun Belt Conference title in 1985 and in 1987 and helped lead Old Dominion to three NCAA tournaments. Goodson closed out her career with 1,574 career points and 863 career rebounds. She ranks 11th all-time in scoring. Following her graduation in 1988 with a degree in secondary education, Goodson captained the 1993 USA National Basketball team and was a two-time All-Star in the American

Basketball League for the Richmond/ Philadelphia Rage. She has spent the last six years in the WNBA. Selected by the Starzz in the third round (27th overall) in the 1999 WNBA Draft, she spent four years in Utah before playing the last two seasons with the San Antonio Silver Stars. In 2002, she was selected to the WNBA All-Star Team.

WE'LL BE BACK:

The Lady Monarchs visited the city of Atlanta, Georgia in their 2004-05 season opener and the city will be one the Lady Monarchs will become familiar with in the near future. Georgia State, located in Atlanta with approximately 28,000 students along with Northeastern in Boston, Massachusetts, will join the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) as the conference expands to 12 members for the first time in its 20-year history in the 2005-06 season. The new members will give the CAA a presence in five of the nation's nine largest media markets (#1 New York, #4 Philadelphia, #6 Boston, #8 Washington, D.C. and #9 Atlanta). Headquartered in Richmond, Virginia., the CAA showcases the talents of student-athletes, coaches and administrators who stand out not only on the playing field, but also in the classroom. CAA schools have produced 16 national team champions in five different sports, 33 individual national champions, 11 national coaches of the year, 11 national players of the year, 12 Honda Award winners, 16 NCAA post-graduate scholars, five Rhodes Scholars and four Nobel Prize winning faculty.

In league play, Old Dominion holds a 233-11 overall record, which includes eights seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 126-1 record at home and a 107-10 road record. The lone CAA loss on Old Dominion's homecourt was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992. Four schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Drexel (6-0), George Mason (34-0), UNC-Wilmington (30-0), and Towson (6-0).

Points of Pride

The pride of Old Dominion University and its athletic programs reflects the...

Recognition of the excellence of our program...

- Over the last 20 years, 87% of Old Dominion's student-athletes that have exhausted their eligibility have graduated, a percentage far above the national average.
- Old Dominion University athletic teams have captured 28 team national championships and four individual titles, including a men's basketball crown in Division II in 1975, three titles women's basketball, nine in field hockey, 15 in sailing, and individual championships in wrestling and women's tennis.
- Old Dominion has been the site of five NCAA women's national championships including the 1982 and 1983 basketball "Final Four" and the 1985, 1986 & 2000 field hockey tournaments.
- Old Dominion was selected as one of 45 institutions nationally for the NCAA Pilot Certification Program, a pioneer program that looked at the athletic department's overall operations, including philosophy, academic requirements, competition, etc.
- Old Dominion was among one of the first institutions to implement a successful drug testing and education program, now entering its thirteenth year.
- The SACS Committee commended the University and the Athletic Department on its program oh high integrity, honesty, fiscal soundness and effective management, noting that excellent people, facilities and services are in place
- Old Dominion University was the first institution in Virginia to offer grants-in-aid for women athletes, beginning in 1974.
- Old Dominion's nine national titles in field hockey are unprecedented in NCAA record books for most titles in that sport by the same school.
- Old Dominion has had 100 first team All-Americans and 82 Academic All-Americans since 1976.
- Old Dominion has been the host site of three ICSA Sailing national championships, including 1985 Team Race, Dinghy, Women 1993 Team Race and 2001 men's and women's singlehanded.

Reaching the pinnacle of achievement and honor within sport...

- Seven former Old Dominion coaches or athletes have been inducted into national sports halls of fame. Former Old Dominion basketball standout and three-time Olympian Anne Donovan was inducted into the GTE/CoSIDA Academic All-American Hall of Fame in May of 1994, and was inducted into the Hall of Fame on May 15, 1995. Nancy Lieberman-Cline was inducted into the Basketball Naismith Hall of Fame in 1996 and both Nancy and Anne were in the first class of inductees in the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame in 1998. In 2002, former women's basketball coach Marianne Stanley was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame. Retired wrestling coach Gray Simons is an inductee of the U.S. Wrestling Hall of Fame, Beth Anders is enshrined in the U.S. Field Hockey Association Hall of Fame, and the late Bud Metheny is remembered in the Collegiate Baseball Coaches Hall of Fame. Sue Stahl, named Lacrosse Magazine's Coach of the Century, was inducted into Virginia Lacrosse Hall of Fame and the United States Lacrosse Hall of Fame.
- Ten Monarch coaches and athletes have been enshrined in the Virginia Sports Hall of Fame in Portsmouth, Va.- Bud Metheny, Paul Webb, Gray Simons, Dave Twardzik, Nancy Lieberman, Tom Scott, Anne Donovan, Yogi Hightower-Boothe, Joseph "Scrap" Chandler and Lou Plummer.
- Three former Old Dominion University women's basketball players have been recognized as national players of the year; Nancy Lieberman 1979 and 1980 Wade Trophy winner and Honda-Broderick Cup winner in 1980 (nation's top female athlete); Anne Donovan 1983 Naismith Award winner; and Ticha Penicherio 1998 Wade Trophy winner.
- Seven women athletes have earned the Honda award as the nation's top athlete in their sport. Nancy Lieberman won the award in 1979 and 1980 in women's basketball, Anne Donovan in 1983, while Yogi Hightower, Kelli James, Chrisy Morgan, Mimi Smith, Marina Digiacomo and Tiffany Snow were named the Honda Award winners for field hockey in 1983, 1984, 1993, 1998, 2000 and 2002.
