- Today will be the final home game for four Old Dominion senior starters: Jasmine Parker, Shadasia Green, Alena Voronina & Kquanise Byrd. They will be honored pre-game.
- The Lady Monarchs have won five straight at home and are 12-2 at the "Ted" this season, including wins over Georgia Tech, Louisville and James Madison.
- ODU has won nine straight over Delaware, but the last four games have been decided by a total of seven points.
- With Old Dominion's next win it will be the programs 29th 20-win season, but first since 2007-08.

About Delaware

- The Blue Hens are coming off a big CAA home win over VCU Thursday. Sophomore All-American Elena Delle Donne tallied 31 points on 9-of-17 shooting. She also went a perfect 11-of-11 from the free throw line in the UD victory.
- Delaware is just 7-5 in road games this season, including a 4-4 mark in CAA games away from the Bob Carpenter Center.
- Sophomore All-American Elena Delle Donne returned from her 11 game absense on January 30 at Hofstra. Since that point, UD has gone 5-3. Delle Donne is averaging 24.8 points and 8.1 rebounds in 15 games this season.
- Blue Hen forward Danielle Parker, who is averaging 8.2 points and 8.2 rebounds this season, recorded her sixth double-double of the season with a career-high 18 points and a game-high 11 rebounds in Delaware's home loss to ODU on January 16.

ODU Senior Class

- Junior Tia Lewis paces the squad in scoring (12.1 ppg) and rebounding (7.9 rpg). The forward ranks in the Top 7 in the CAA in rebounding, field goal percentage (51.6%), double-doubles (7) and blocks (28).
- Norfolk native Jasmine Parker leads the CAA and is ranked sixth nationally with 3.3 steals per game. The guard is second on the team in scoring at 12.0 points per game. She has scored in double-figures in 21 of 27 games and has swiped six or more steals in a game on four occasions this season. Parker leads the team and ranks in the Top 10 in the CAA in assists (4.3 per game), free throw percentage (76.0) and three-pointers made (51).
- At the completion of her junior season, Alena Voronina averaged 1.3 points & 1.0 rebounds for her career. This season, the forward is third on the team in both scoring (11.6 ppg) and rebounding (5.7 rpg).
- Kquanise Byrd is averaging a career-high 8.2 points per game and her 29 three-pointers rank third on the team.

William & Mary Recap

Junior Tia Lewis posted a game-high 17 points and hauled in nine rebounds to lead Old Dominion to a hard-fought 70-65 victory over intrastate rival William & Mary Thursday evening at the Ted Constant Center. William & Mary trailed by just one with a minute to play, but sophomore Jo Guilford hit a jumper, swiped a steal and blocked a shot, all in the final minute to push Old Dominion (19-8, 13-3 CAA) to its fifth consecutive home win. Guilford, who was just two points shy of her career-high, posted 10 of her 11 points in the second half.

Fourth In The Nation

Old Dominion ranks No. 4 nationally in defending the three-point line. The Lady Monarchs have shut down their opponents on the perimeter, holding them to a 24.9 percent shooting clip. Teams are 92-of-370 from beyond the arc against ODU this year.

600-Win Club

Old Dominion's Wendy Larry reached yet another coaching milestone this season, netting her 600th career victory on January 23 against Towson. She has compiled a 606-231 record in 27 seasons as a head coach, including 557 career wins at ODU. Larry reached the 600-win plateau in just 829 games which makes her the 10th fastest coach to accomplish the feat.

CAA Honors

Three different Lady Monarchs have garnered the CAA Player of the Week award this season. Senior Jasmine Parker was named the CAA Co-Player of the week Nov. 29 after scoring a combined 47 points and swiping nine steals in games at NC State and home vs. Louisville. Junior Tia Lewis earned the same honor January 10 after recording back-to-back double-doubles against George Mason and James Madison and Kquanise Byrd was honored after scoring a career-high 22 points in ODU's win at Delaware on January 16.

Parker & Lewis Reach 1,000

Senior guard Jasmine Parker became just the 28th all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points with her game-high 16 points against Tennessee on December 5. Just over two month later junior Tia Lewis reached the 1,000-point plateau by scoring nine against Northeastern.

Mid-Major Poll

Old Dominion fell to No. 14 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, which was released February 22. Green Bay sits atop the rankings, while James Madison (No. 7) and UNC Wilmington (No. 18) also represent the CAA.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs play one of the toughest schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule features games against five teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane and JMU) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida, Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel). At the end of its non-conference slate, ODU's schedule ranked No. 16 according to CollegeRPI.com.

Dixon's Jersey Retired

Former Lady Monarch basketball All-American and Olympian Medina Dixon had her jersey retired on Sunday, Jan. 30, prior to Old Dominion's game against Georgia State at the Ted Constant Center. During her three years as a Lady Monarch, Dixon helped lead Old Dominion to an 84-14 record and two trips to the NCAA Final Four. In 1983 the Lady Monarchs rolled to a 29-6 record and hosted the Final Four in Norfolk. ODU lost the semi-final game to Louisiana Tech. As a senior in 1985, Dixon guided Old Dominion to a 31-3 record and the NCAA National Championship. The Lady Monarchs topped Georgia for the title and Dixon was named to the NCAA All-Tournament team. Dixon, a Boston, Mass. native, was a standout forward for ODU from 1982-85. She completed her career with 1,968 points, 979 rebounds, 417 assists and 277 steals. She ranks seventh all-time at Old Dominion in scoring and rebounding, fourth in steals and fifth in assists.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

RECORD CROWDS AT THE TED:

Old Dominion set the all-time women's basketball attendance record at the Ted Constant Center earlier this season when the Lady Monarchs hosted Tennessee. The game between the two historic programs was a **BLUE OUT** and a remarkable 7,774 fans packed the Ted. ODU boasts a dominant 113-23 overall record in the Constant Center, including seven victories over nationally ranked opponents.

Lady Monarchs Ink Five To National Letters of Intent

Old Dominion head women's basketball coach Wendy Larry announced the signing of five players to National Letters of Intent. Myeisha Hall, Tiffany Minor, Queen Tiye Jackson, Ashley Betz-White and Kaneisha Atwater will continue their academic and athletic careers with the Lady Monarchs beginning in 2011-12.

Hall is ranked the 53rd-best guard in the Class of 2011 by ESPN. She's 5-8 and can play the point or shooting guard spots. Hall averaged 22 points, nine rebounds and four assists last season for Palm Beach (Fla.) Lakes High School. The combo guard, who scored 40 points in a game as a junior, was named the South Florida Sun-Sentinel Big School Player of the Year in Palm Beach County.

Larry on Hall: "Myeisha is an athletic scorer with tremendous transitional skills."

Minor is ranked No. 72 among wing players in her class by ESPN.com. The 5-11 wing player averaged 16.7 points last year at The Maret School in Washington, D.C. She's an excellent set shooter who can rebound and pass well for a wing player. She's expected to either play shooting guard or small forward at ODU.

Larry on Minor: "She's extremely versatile with good court awareness. She also adds a great deal of length on the defensive side of the ball."

Jackson led Trenton (N.J.) Catholic Academy to a state title last year. She's an excellent rebounder at 5-11 and she's expected to contribute at one of the two forward spots at ODU. Jackson has a strong build and can score both inside and out. Her range extends to the three-point line.

Larry on Jackson: "She has the size of a post player with a perimeter players skills."

Betz-White is a 5-5 point guard out of Trinity High School in Camp Hill, Pa. She averaged 11.4 points and 4.2 steals last year en route to being named to the Class AAA All-State Third Team as a junior. A true point guard, Betz-White excels in transition and on the secondary break, but is also comfortable in a set offense. The guard is a solid outside shooter and features a good pull-up jumper.

Larry on Betz-White: "She's a true point guard with personality and flare. Ashley makes everyone around her better."

Atwater is a 5-7 combo guard from Fort Pierce Westwood High School in Florida. She led her high school team in scoring as a junior, averaging 28.2 points. Atwater tallied five triple-doubles last season. She's a three-sport high school athlete who is quick off the dribble and strong on the defensive side of the ball.

Larry on Atwater: "She's an athlete that's extremely quick and fast. Additionally, she's an exceptional defender that can help us a great deal."

900 WINS!

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 928-322 (.742) and is in its 42nd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.
