- Tuesday is the 76th meeting in the modern era between ODU and JMU with the Lady Monarchs holding the 52-23 edge. JMU has won three in a row and 8 of 10 in series.
- Old Dominion has held three opponents this season to under 40 points in a game for the first time since the 2001-02 Elite Eight team which held four teams under 40.
- ODU has forced 20 turnovers or more in 16 of their games this season and is 12-4 in those games. The Lady Monarchs lead the league in turnovers forced with 499.
- The ODU bench is outscoring opponent's bench in CAA games, 301-104.
- The Lady Monarchs have forced 499 turnovers in 23 games this year (21.7 per game)

At home, Coach Barefoot meets with the team after each game before going on ESPN 94.1 FM for a radio interview. She will then be available for interviews at the postgame press conference along with selected players following the visiting team's postgame press conference. On the road, Coach Barefoot immediately gets on radio interviews with ESPN 94.1 FM and is then ready for any interview requests that should be passed on to Ben Waring.

ON THE RADIO

Old Dominion women's basketball games are aired on ESPN Radio 94.1 FM, a 40,000 watt station with a signal strength that stretches to the Northern Neck and Eastern Shore, west to Richmond and south to northeastern North Carolina. In addition, selected games will be simulcast on WGAI AM 560 in Elizabeth City, increasing the coverage area to the Outer Banks of North Carolina. Fifteen-time sportscaster of the Year Tony Mercurio will call all the action. Former assistant coach Susan Montgomery will join Mercurio and add color commentary at all home games at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

OLD DOMINION HEAD COACH KAREN BAREFOOT



In her 17-year coaching career, Karen Barefoot has been a part of 14 winning seasons and an overall coaching record of 298-187. She is a proven winner that has made history in resurrecting programs, winning championships and producing success in the classroom and in the community. She became one of the youngest head coaches at the age of 22 and her passion for the game of basketball is contagious.

In just 14 years as a head coach, Karen Barefoot has compiled 11 winning seasons and has won two National Coach of the Year awards.

Just as she expects out of her players, Barefoot is an extremely active member of the community, being involved in the Lady Monarchs Hoops for the Cure, Susan G. Komen Race for the Cure, Coaches vs. Cancer, visiting countless schools and starting the first ever ODU "Education Day" game, just to name a few.

She is also seen in the community as one of the top speakers in the Hampton Roads area, speaking for organizations, An Achievable Dream, school graduations and heavily involved in the Lady Monarchs annual golf tournament, which raised more than \$45,000 this year.

In her first season at Old Dominion, Barefoot raised the bar in the community, as the Lady Monarchs did more than 10 activities this season. On the court, Barefoot guided Ashley Betz-White to CAA Rookie of the Year honors and helped Betz-White and Myeisha Hall earn All-Rookie honors. Senior Tia Lewis was named to the All-CAA squad, All State and earned a tryout with the WNBA's Washington Mystics while Mairi Buchan was named First-Team All-Academic and CoSIDA First-Team All-Academic.

Barefoot has already made her presence known on the recruiting trail at Old Dominion, as she signed the Virginian-Pilot Player of the Year, Galaisha Goodhope, and the Peninsula District and Daily Press Player of the Year, LaQuanda Younger. Also in the fray for the 2012-13 season will be Miami, (Fla.) transfer Stephanie Gardner, who in 2010-11, helped the Hurricanes to their first Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) regular-season championship as well as junior college All-American Shae Kelley and earned a Ms. Colorado Basketball honor coming out of high school. The Lady Monarchs have brought in a top-45 nationally ranked recruiting class and the No. 1 class in the CAA for the 2012-13 season.

Barefoot, who hails from Newport News, Va. (Menchville High School), has a career head coaching record of 221-164, resulting in 11 winning seasons. Aside from Elon, Barefoot has also held the head coaching position at Division II Lenoir Rhyne University and at the Apprentice School.

Barefoot helped Elon reach new heights in 2010-11, as the Phoenix finished the season with a 20-13 record - the program's best season at the Division I level and only the fifth team in program history to reach the 20-win plateau. The Phoenix 11 home victories marked the most home wins in a single season in the Division I era, while the team's postseason appearance in the Women's Basketball Invitational was the first since joining Division I. Elon recorded its 20th win of the season in the WBI. Barefoot also led Elon to 12 victories in SoCon play, doubling their 2009-10 total and tying the 2003-04 squad for the most SoCon wins in a season.

Prior to coming to Elon, Barefoot was an assistant coach at Old Dominion, where the team compiled a 77-23 record, won three CAA Championships, and was a perennial top-25 program. In 2007-08, ODU advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament, defeating 12th-seeded Liberty University and fourth-seeded Virginia, which to this day is one of the most memorable games in the history of the Ted Constant Convocation Center. The Lady Monarchs completed 2007-08 with a 31-5 record. Along with its 17th consecutive Colonial Athletic Association crown, ODU earned a ranking as high as 11th in the nation.

Barefoot originally came to Old Dominion after serving as the head coach at Division II Lenoir-Rhyne from 2001-2005. While at the NCAA Division II school, Barefoot captured the first South Atlantic Conference regular season title in school history in 2003-04 en route to claiming league Coach of the Year honors. Under her leadership, the team also grabbed the first SAC tournament championship in school history in 2002-03. That year, the team finished the season ranked eighth in the region following its first-ever trip to the NCAA Division II National Tournament. In her first year at Lenoir-Rhyne, she led the program to its best record in 15 years, going 19-9 Barefoot coached Lenoir-Rhyne's first NCAA First Team All-American, South Atlantic Player of the Year and SAC Tournament Most Valuable Player. Additionally, under her guidance the Bears had four student-athletes earn All-SAC honors and 13 student-athletes named to the SAC Commissioner's honor roll.

Prior to her stint at Lenoir-Rhyne, Barefoot spent six winning seasons at the Apprentice School after helping to initiate and develop the first-ever female athletic program in the 75-year history of the school. She started the program at the age of 22, becoming the youngest head coach in the country. A two-time NSCAA National Coach of the Year (1999 & 2001), she compiled a 102-41 mark and captured the 2001 NSCAA National Championship. Barefoot was also given the Peninsula Sports Club Special Achievement Award for winning a national championship. Under Barefoot, the Builders had seven NSCAA All-Americans and four Academic All-Americans. All-Americans Keisha Joseph and Taffey Thomas both played professionally in Finland.

As a former student-athlete at Christopher Newport, Barefoot still holds the recognition of being the first player in NCAA history, male or female, to score over 2,000 points and accumulate 1,000 assists during her career. Barefoot was the only player to achieve this height until Gonzaga's Courtney Vandersloot (who now plays for WNBA's Chicago Sky) accomplished the feat on March 21, 2011. For four consecutive seasons, Barefoot led the nation in assists and is CNU's all-time leader in assists and steals, while ranking second in scoring. She is the only player in any division to lead a statistical category all four years. She was a four-time team MVP and team captain and was also the Peninsula Sports Club's Female Athlete of the Year four-straight years. Barefoot was also invited to the free-agent camp with the Utah Stars in their inaugural season.

A three-time Kodak/WBCA All-American, she has been inducted into the USA South Hall of Fame, the CNU Athletic Hall of Fame and had her college jersey (No. 10) retired. Barefoot was just recently honored during CNU's 50th anniversary celebration as one of the school's Top 50 Most Distinguished Alumni.

ABOUT JAMES MADISON

The Dukes come in at 15-8 overall and 9-2 in CAA action and in second place in the league. James Madison is coming off a tight 71-64 loss to #20/23 Delaware in Harrisonburg on Sunday.

Senior guard Tarik Hislop is one the league's best players averaging 16.3 points per game to go along with 82 assists while junior guard Kirby Burkholder adds 15.7 points per contest with 44 steals and a 64 three-pointers.

Head Coach Kenny Brooks is in his 11th season at the helm of the JMU program. The Dukes return four starters from the 2011-12 WNIT runner-up squad. Last season, JMU went 29-8 overall and 14-4 in conference play. As a team, Madison blocked 172 shots from opponents last season and tallied 1,674 rebounds, both new school records. Senior guard/forward Nikki Newman who accounted for 52 of those denials and averaged a team-leading 7.8 rebounds per game, returns to the lineup as the reigning CAA Defensive Player of the Year. The two main scorers for the Dukes in 2011-12 also return to the court. Senior guard Tarik Hislop and junior guard Kirby Birkholder each averaged double-digit point production during their All-CAA season, dropping 14.8 ppg and 11.5 ppg, respectively last season. JMU was picked to finish second in the CAA this season.

A TOUGH STRETCH AHEAD

Sunday's game at Drexel started a stretch of four games in eight days for ODU who finishes the regular season taking on six opponents with winning CAA records in their final seven games.

TURNING UP THE DEFENSIVE PRESSURE

After forcing 22 turnovers by George Mason on Feb. 5, Old Dominion has now forced 20 turnovers or more in 16 of their 23 games this season. The Lady Monarchs lead the league overall (499) and in CAA games (216) is turnovers forced.

PACKING THE TED

Old Dominion ranks 44th nationally and second in the CAA this season with an average of 2,514 fans per game at home at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

SMOTHERING DEFENSE

ODU has held three opponents this season to less than 40 points in Virginia Tech (35), North Carolina Central (33) and most recently George Mason (39) making it the first time since the 2001-02 season that has happened. That season, ODU went 28-6 overall and advanced to the Elite Eight while holding four teams under 40 points.

SECOND HALF SURGES

The Lady Monarchs have overcome a pair of double-digit halftime deficits in league play so far. Overall, they are outscoring the opposition this season in the second half, 803-682. ODU averages 35 points after halftime compared to 29.6 for the opponents. In CAA games, ODU is outscoring the opposition, 380-337 with 34.5 second half points for the Lady Monarchs compared to 30.6 for the opponent.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT

Old Dominion kept their unblemished record alive on Jan. 31 when coming off a loss as they defeated Drexel, 53-50, to improve to 6-0 in games this season following a defeat. They will be that record to the test against JMU on Tuesday night.

FREE THROW LINE

ODU has been hot from the free throw line since CAA play has started. In four of their league games, the Lady Monarchs have shot over 80% from the chairty stripe including a season high 84.6% from the line at UNCW on Jan. 17. In nine of their 11 CAA games this season, ODU is 71% or better from the free throw line. Overall in CAA action this season, ODU is shooting 76.1% (144-189).

BENCH HELP

The Lady Monarchs continue to utilize their bench having outscored the opposition 590-285 in bench points this season. 40 percent of ODU's season point total has come from their bench compared to just 22 percent from the opposition. In CAA play, the ODU bench is outscoring the opposing bench, 301-104.

ODU has had more bench points in 18 of their 23 games this season.

BETTER AT NIGHT

With the win over George Mason on Feb. 5, ODU improved to 8-1 in night games this season with their lone loss coming to #10/11 California back on Nov. 30. In contrast, ODU is 8-6 in day games this season.

IMPACT BY KELLEY

Sophomore forward Shae Kelley has already made a big impact on her teammates as she was selected as one of the team captains for 2012-13 despite not having played a single minute yet for Old Dominion. The Colorado native has scored in double-digits in 14 of the 23 games this season and leads the team in rebounding, blocks and steals while registering six double-doubles. She has recorded double-digit rebounds in six of ODU's last nine contests and has a double-double in three of the last six games.

COOK PASSING MILESTONES

Senior Jackie Cook continues to rack up the milestones this season. She passed the 900-point mark in her career on Jan. 27 at William and Mary. Also in that game, she connected on her 100th career three-point basket. On Jan. 24 against Georgia State, Cook passed the 400 career rebound mark. She currently sits at 950 points in her Old Dominion career and 529 career points in CAA play.

ODU saw their three-game win streak end on Feb. 10 at the Daskalakis Athletic Center as they fell to Drexel, 64-50, in Philadelphia.

Stephanie Gardner scored a career-high 18 points to lead Old Dominion, who lost for the first time since Jan. 27. Gardner was 7-for-11 from the field and 3-of-4 from behind the arc to go along with two rebounds, an assist and a steal.

Drexel, who led from start to finish, turned it over just seven times which was the fewest by any Lady Monarch opponent this season. The Dragons were led by CAA scoring leader Hollie Mershon who had 19 points and seven rebounds, six assists, two steals and was 8-for-16 from the field.

ODU shot 38.5 percent for the game (20-for-52) while Drexel shot 45.5 percent (25-for-55). The Dragons had a 36-28 rebounding advantage as well as a 32-18 advantage in the paint while the ODU bench outscored DU, 31-5.

BUCHAN EARNS ACADEMIC AWARD

Redshirt senior Mairi Buchan was named to the Capital One Academic All-District First Team on Jan. 31 for the second straight year. The teams are selected by College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Buchan holds a 3.93 grade point average majoring in biology (pre-med).

CAA ROOKIE AWARDS

With LaQuanda Younger picking up her second CAA Rookie of the Week honors this season on Jan. 21, that marks the eighth time since the beginning of the 2011-12 season that an ODU player has recieved this award. Last season, Ashley Betz-White, the CAA Rookie of the Year, was honored four times while freshman Galaisha Goodhope earned the honor on Jan. 7 this season.

ATOP THE CAA IN NON-CONFERENCE ACTION

Old Dominion finished tied for the best non-conference record in the league at 9-3 along with Delaware.

Both the nine non-conference wins and the 9-3 start are bests for ODU since the 2007-

WORLD VISION CLASSIC

ODU finished in the third place at the World Vision Classic in Las Vegas on Dec. 19-21. The Lady Monarchs defeated UNLV in the opener and Alabama A&M in the finale while dropping the middle game to runner-up No. 22 Texas A&M. No. 5 Notre Dame won the tournament.

Senior Jackie Cook was named to the World Vision Classic All-Tournament team after average scoring 58 points in three games for an average of 19.3 per contest. She scored in double figures in all three games and eclipsed the 800 mark for career points in the finale.

LaQuanda Younger was named the CAA Rookie of the Week for the second time this season it was announced by the league office on Jan. 21

Younger recorded career-highs in points in back-to-back games last week as she drilled eight three-pointers in two road contests at UNC Wilmington (1/17) and Hofstra (1/20).

In Thursday's win over the Seahawks, three freshman guard was ODU's leading scorer as she connected on four three-pointers in the first half to lead the team with 12 points. On Sunday, she drained four field goals from behind the arc and scored 14 total points. ODU GRINDS OUT 53-59 WIN AT MASON

ODU won their third straight game on Feb. 5 with a 53-39 win at the Patriot Center over George Mason in Fairfax.

The Lady Monarchs forced 22 Patriot turnovers, making it the 16th time this season that an ODU opponent has turned it over 20 or more times and scored 16 points off those miscues while taking a 24-10 advantage in points in the paint.

Old Dominion used a balance scoring attack from Jackie Cook who scored 12 points and collected four rebounds and three assists along with Mairi Buchan and Tiffany Minor. Buchan scored nine points in the first half and tallied four rebounds, two assists, two blocks and two steals in the game while Minor scored nine of her 11 points after halftime to go with five rebounds, three assists and two steals.

The Lady Monarchs pressure defense flustered the Patriots at times as they turned it over on six consecutive possessions midway through the first half and didn't score a point for over five minutes as ODU took a 29-21 lead into halftime.

CAA GAME-BY-GAME HIGHLIGHTS (1ST HALF)

KELLEY RALLIES OLD DOMINION PAST UNCW, 62-55

ODU used a strong second half on Feb. 3 at the Ted Constant Convocation Center to rally past UNC Wilmington, 62-55.

Down 34-26 at half, the Lady Monarchs were able to overcome a sluggish start behind the strong play of Shae Kelley who scored a game-high 19 points and collected a career-high 17 rebounds to go with three steals, three blocks and two assists. She had 11 points and 11 rebounds in the second half as she recorded her sixth double-double of the season and third in the past four games.

The Lady Monarchs took their first lead since early in the first half with 8:31 to play on a free throw from Kelley. ODU and UNCW would then battle back and forth as the score alternated five times after half with two ties in that span before Old Dominion took the lead for good with 5:32 to play on a jumper by Kelley.

Jackie Cook picked up her 15th double-digit scoring performance of the season and 38th her career as she scored 13 points to go with seven rebounds, two steals, a block and an assist.

COOK AND MINOR POWER ODU OVER DREXEL, 53-50

ODU persevered late to top Drexel at the Ted Constant Convocation Center on Jan. 31, 53-50. After Old Dominion was able to open up a 13-point margin early in the second half, Drexel was able to claw back behind the CAA's leading scorer in senior Hollie Mershon, who scored 15 of her game-high 22 points in the second half.

The Dragons took their first lead of the game since midway through the first half with 3:32 to play after a Mershon free throw but Jackie Cook responded when she nailed a three-pointer a minute later to give ODU back the lead they would not relinquish. Neither team then made a shot until Shae Kelley's bucket with 23 seconds left put ODU up four at 51-47. The Dragons were able to hit a three-pointer to close within one with eight seconds left but Cook connected on a pair of free throws after she was fouled and Drexel never got off a shot before the clock expired to give the Lady Monarchs the win.

Kelley missed her third straight double-double by just a point as she added nine points, 10 rebounds, two steals, a block and an assist while Minor set her career-high with 12 points, two rebounds and two steals. Cook led ODU with 14 points and seven rebounds and Ashley Betz-White set a new career-high with nine assists which is the most by an ODU player in a game this season.

TRIBE TRIPS UP LADY MONARCHS, 73-69

ODU fell to William and Mary on Jan. 27 at Kaplan Arena, 73-69. In a highly contested back-and-forth affair, William and Mary shot a sizzling 56.6 percent from the field, including 66.7 percent in the second half.

Shae Kelley recorded her fifth double-double of the season and second in as many games as she led ODU with 18 points, 10 rebounds, six steals and three assists. Tiffany Minor matched her career-high with 10 points for the second straight game while LaQuanda Younger set new career-highs with four assists and six rebounds to go with nine points. Jackie Cook scored in double figures for the 13th time in 18 games this season with 12 points as she eclipsed 900 points in her ODU career in addition to connecting on her 100th career three-point basket.

The game featured seven lead changes and seven ties but the Tribe was able to persevere late behind the strong performance of senior Janine Aldridge who scored a game-high 26 points and was 11-for-15 from the field including 6-for-6 in the second half. She connected on four three-pointers and had three rebounds and four steals.

LADY MONARCHS CLAMP DOWN DEFENSIVELY ON GSU

ODU clamped down defensively against Georgia State on Jan. 24 in a 68-45 victory at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. The Panthers shot just 24.1 percent from the field, the lowest by any ODU opponent this season as they went 13-for-54 from the field. GSU went a stretch of 13:54 spanning midway in the first half and into the second half without registering a field goal.

Shae Kelley recorded her fourth double-double of the season with 12 points and 12 rebounds to go along with three assists and a steal. It was the 12th time in 18 games that Kelley has scored in double figures along with Jackie Cook who poured in a game-high 15 points, three steals, two rebound and an assist. Cook also passed 400 career rebounds on Thursday night.

Michelle Brandao racked up a career-best eight assists off the bench along with two rebounds, two points, a block and a steal. The eight assists are the most in a game by any ODU player this season. Tiffany Minor matched her career-high with 10 points while adding five rebounds and three steals. The Lady Monarchs held a 35-20 advantage in the paint and the ODU bench outscored GSU, 30-9.

OLD DOMINION UPENDED AT HOFSTRA, 83-72

ODU gave up a season-high 83 points and fell to Hofstra on Jan. 20 at the Mack Sports Complex, 83-72. The Lady Monarchs forced 23 turnovers, the 12th time in 17 games this season an opponent has turned it over on 20 or more occasions, but Hofstra shot 49.1 percent (28-57) from the field led by All-American center Shante Evans who recorded her 58th career double-double with 30 points and 10 rebounds.

Shae Kelley scored in double digits for the 11th time in 17 games and powered the ODU offense with 16 points, seven rebounds, two blocks, two steals and an assist. LaQuanda Younger hit four three-pointers for the second consecutive game and set another new career-high with 14 points.

ODU shot 42.4 percent from the field (25-59) as Becca Allison added 11 points, two rebounds and two assists but the Lady Monarchs were just 4-for-22 (18.2 percent) from behind the arc with all four treys coming from Younger.

ODU CRUISES PAST UNCW, 74-50

Old Dominion scored a season-high 42 first half points and improved to 5-0 this season on the road with a 74-50 win at UNC Wilmington on Jan. 17.

The ODU bench outscored UNC Wilmington, 38-9, and was led by LaQuanda Younger who scored a career and game-high 12 points as she connected on four first half three-pointers that sparked the Lady Monarchs on a 24-12 run to end the half and take a 42-28 lead into break.

UNCW closed to within nine points five minutes into the second half but could get no closer as ODU used a balanced scoring attack throughout the evening to overwhelm the Seahawks. ODU shot 45.9 percent (16-33) for the game and 84.6 percent (11-13) at the free throw line while converting seven three-pointers in the game and had a 16-3 advantage in second chance points.

The Lady Monarchs outrebounded the Seahawks, 44-32, behind 10 rebounds from Shae Kelley who recorded her fourth double-digit rebounding game this season while adding five points and an assist. Jackie Cook scored in double figures for the 11th time in 16 games this season as she added 11 points, six rebounds, three assists and three steals while Mairi Buchan was the third Lady Monarch to score in double digits with 10 points and two rebounds.

BLUE HENS TOP LADY MONARCHS, 63-46

ODU fell to Delaware on Jan. 13 in a battle of the team with the best records in the CAA at the Ted Constant Convocation Center, 63-46.

The Blue Hens were able to take advantage on the boards with a 59-35 rebounding margin, including 22 offensive rebounds. Shae Kelley recorded her third career double-double with 15 points and 13 rebounds to go along with three steals and an assist but the Lady Monarchs were held to a season-low 27 percent from the floor (17-63).

Delaware won their 21st consecutive CAA regular season contest dating back to 2011. Unanimous preseason All-American and reigning CAA Player of the Year Elena Delle Donne scored a game-high 28 points to go along with 13 rebounds, five blocks, two steals and an assist.

Ashley Betz-White added 13 points, two assists and a steal for ODU while Michelle Brandao recorded her first career points as a Lady Monarchs with five points in the first half. The Lady Monarchs forced 18 Blue Hen turnovers while committing just 10. The ODU bench outscored Delaware, 14-4, while the Blue Hens held the advantage in points in the paint, 31-22.

LADY MONARCHS OUTLAST TIGERS, 65-55

ODU defeated Towson on Jan. 10 in their home CAA opener with a 65-55 victory.

After a slow start by both teams offensively in the first half, ODU was able to find their stride in the second half by shooting 44.9 percent (22-49) from the field while converting on 17 of their 21 free throws (81 percent) in the game to match their season win total from a year ago.

Shae Kelley, who battled foul trouble all evening, scored in double figures for the ninth time in 14 games this season and led Old Dominion with 14 points, six assists, four assists, four steals and a block while freshman Galaisha Goodhope warmed up in the second half for the second consecutive game with 11 of her 12 points after halftime in addition to four rebounds, four assists and a steal.

Both squads started cold from the field as ODU was able to take a 27-22 lead into halftime spurred on by junior Stephanie Gardner who scored a career-high 11 points, all in the first half, while draining three field goals from behind the arc. Sophomore Tiffany Minor earned her first career start in 46 games played at ODU and added six points, four rebounds, two steals and a new career-high three assists.

ODU RALLIES FROM 20-POINT DEFICIT TO STUN GSU

The Lady Monarchs used a furious 42-16 rally to end the game and overcome a 20-point second half deficit to stun Georgia State on Jan. 6 in Atlanta in their CAA opener, 72-66.

The win is the 950th in program history and improves ODU to 21-1 all-time in CAA openers while the Lady Monarchs moved to 14-1 all-time against the Panthers.

Galaisha Goodhope scored a career-high 21 points to lead all scorers with 19 of those points coming in the second half. Ashley Betz-White added 14 points and three assists to power ODU.

Tiffany Minor matched her career with 10 points while Shakeva Richards, playing in her hometown, added seven points and six assists. The ODU bench outscored GSU, 40-17.

NON-CONFERENCE GAME-BY-GAME HIGHLIGHTS

LADY MONARCHS EDGED OUT BY PITTSBURGH

ODU was edged in a tightly contested back-and-forth affair against Pittsburgh, 55-54, on Jan. 2 in Norfolk.

After trailing by as many as nine points in the first half and facing a 23-18 halftime deficit, ODU was able to go on a 23-8 run in the first 11 minutes of the second half, a run that included 14-0 at one point.

Pittsburgh was able to sustain the run that saw Old Dominion (9-3) up 10 points with less than nine minutes to play as the Panthers closed the game on a 24-13 run of their own and held on for the one-point victory despite a late rally by ODU which came up just short.

The Lady Monarchs forced 20 Panther turnovers which makes it the ninth team in 12 games this season an opponents has turned it over 20 or more times. Shae Kelley powered the ODU offense as she scored 17 points and grabbed eight rebounds along with a career-high seven steals and added three assists and two blocks in 35 minutes of action. It is the eighth time in 12 games this season that Kelley has scored in double figures.

KELLEY LAUNCHES ODU PAST SCSU

ODU rode Shae Kelley's second career double-double along with an 11-0 run to start the second half to defeat South Carolina State on Dec. 29 in their final game of 2012.

After holding just a five point halftime lead, Kelley took over in the second half as she scored 20 points while putting up career highs of 14 rebounds and four blocks to power the Lady Monarchs.

After holding a 34-29 advantage at half, ODU went on a quick run to open the lead up to as many as 25 points midway into the second half as the Lady Monarchs shot 48.5 percent from the field after halftime.

ODU raked in a season-high 48 rebounds and scored 49 points in the paint against South Carolina State while earning a 21-3 advantage in fast break points. The Lady Monarchs got points from 10 of the 11 players that saw action on Saturday.

COOK, LADY MONARCHS ROLL OVER ALABAMA A&M

ODU rebounded to take third place on Dec. 21 in the World Vision Classic with a 75-46 defeat of Alabama A&M. Jackie Cook scored a career-high 25 points and surpassed the 800-point mark in her ODU career to power the Lady Monarchs, who scored 43 points off 34 Alabama A&M turnovers.

The Lady Monarchs committed a season-low nine turnovers in the ballgame. Eight of ODU's 10 opponents this season have now turned the ball over 20 times or more as the Lady Bulldogs turned it over 34 times.

A total of 12 ODU players saw action and 10 of them scored as the Lady Monarchs distributed the ball well offensively with 22 assists. Sophomore Ashley Betz-White put in 10 points, five assists and four steals while sophomore Shae Kelley added nine points and six rebounds to go along with four steals and two assists.

AGGIES OVERPOWER ODU INSIDE

ODU fell to their second ranked foe of the season on Dec. 20 in the World Vision Classic as No. 22 Texas A&M came out victorious, 78-55.

The Lady Monarchs had double-digit scoring performances from Jackie Cook (10 points) and Shae Kelley (11 points) and were able to cut the Aggie deficit down to five points with 8:22 to play in the game, but Texas A&M (8-3) proved to be too much for ODU on the inside.

Junior center Kelsey Bone scored a career-high 33

points as she went 15-for-18 from the floor and added 14 rebounds, two assists and a block to power the Aggies. Texas A&M was able to go on a 24-6 run after ODU pulled within five midway through the second half to collect their eight consecutive victory.

Cook scored in double figures for the eighth time in nine games this season in her 100th career game played at Old Dominion while Kelley scored in double digits for the sixth time in nine games.

12 3-POINTERS BY ODU OVERWHELMS UNLV

ODU tied the school record by connecting on 12 three-point baskets and put up a season-best 85 points on Dec. 19 en route to defeating host UNLV, 85-67, in the opening day of the World Vision Classic at the Cox Pavilion.

Old Dominion shot a season-best 53.1% (34-64) from the field and forced more than 20 turnovers for the seventh time in eight games this season.

Spreading the wealth offensively, 10 different players scored in the first half as 12 players saw action in all for Old Dominion. Jackie Cook scored 17 of her 23 points in the second half while sophomore Shae Kelley reached double digits for the fifth time in eight games this season.

Rebecca Allison scored a career-high 14 points and nailed a career-best three field goals from behind the arc in 14 minutes off the bench while Stephanie Gardner scored six points in 10 minutes off the bench in her first career game in a Lady Monarch uniform.

ODU RUNS PAST NCCU ON EDUCATION DAY

After a tie game midway through the first half, ODU went on a 28-6 run stretching into the second half to pull away from North Carolina Central on Dec. 7 in front of a season-best 5,287 fans at the Ted Constant Convocation Center for a 59-33 victory.

Several key reserves sparked the Lady Monarchs' run then as Becca Allison scored a season-high 10 points in 19 minutes off the bench while LaQuanda Younger registered a career-high eight points in 19 minutes of play.

ODU's bench outscored North Carolina Central by a margin of 26-0 as the Lady Monarchs scored 26 points off 27 Lady Eagle turnovers in the game. Old Dominion also took advantage in transition as they held an 18-2 advantage in fast break points.

BUCHAN'S CAREER DAY VS. BIG GREEN

Mairi Buchan scored a career-high 23 points to lead ODU over Dartmouth on Dec. 2, 73-59.

The Lady Monarchs overcame a sluggish start as they went 0-for-10 from the field to start the game while Dartmouth started 9-for-12 and shot 59.1 percent in the first half. The Lady Monarchs forced 15 turnovers before half to climb back into things and closed on a 23-9 run going into break and never trailed again.

In the second half, ODU turned up the pressure defensively as they held the Big Green to 27.3 percent from the field. Senior Jackie Cook ignited the offense scoring 10 of her 19 points in the second half including a pair of three-pointers as the Lady Monarchs shot 46.4 percent from the field after halftime.

No. 10 CAL TOO MUCH FOR ODU

ODU dropped their first game of the season despite putting a scare into No. 10/11 California on Nov. 30. The Lady Monarchs pulled to within four points midway through the second half but Cal closed the game on a 12-0 run and out rebounded the Lady Monarchs, 66-33, to pull out the win.

Shae Kelley scored a career and game high 21 points to power ODU. Despite the defeat, it was the best result for the Lady Monarchs against a top 10 team since a 78-63 loss in 2008 to top-ranked Connecticut in the NCAA Sweet 16.

In front of 3,003 fans, ODU was able to hold the Bears to 21 points below their season average and force Cal into 25 turnovers.

SECOND HALF SURGE AT UMES

ODU closed the first half on a 13-1 run on Nov. 20 and never looked back as they defeated Maryland Eastern Shore at the Hytche Center, 62-46.

Shae Kelley recorded her first career double-double in an ODU uniform as she scored 12 points and grabbed 10 rebounds while senior Jackie Cook scored 18 points in the second half and a game-high 22 total points.

ODU outrebounded UMES, 46-34, and had a 30-10 advantage in points in the paint. The Lady Monarchs pressure defense allowed Old Dominion to take a 16-2 advantage in fast break points as well. ODU distributed the ball well as nine different players recorded an assist for a total of 16.

ODU BATTERS VCU

Jackie Cook registered her second career double-double and was one of three Lady Monarchs to register double figures as Old Dominion snapped its four-game losing streak to VCU on Nov. 17 with a 74-51 win in Norfolk.

Cook scored 12 points and scooped up a game-high 10 rebounds while sophomore Ashley Betz-White scored a season-high 17 points to go along with four steals and three rebounds. Sophomore Myeisha Hall was the game's leading scorer at halftime with 10 points and five rebounds and finished with 11 points and eight rebounds in the contest.

Old Dominion's pressure defense continues to give opponents trouble as the Rams were forced into 25 turnovers with ODU scoring 22 points off those turnovers. VCU shot just 15.4% from three-point range as they were 2-for-13 in the game and shot just 31.3% from the field overall. ODU had a 16-0 advantage in fast break points.

COOK LEADS ODU PAST USCU

Jackie Cook had 18 points by halftime and ODU jumped out to a 16-3 lead and never looked back on Nov. 13 in a 77-46 win over USC Upstate in their home-opener.

Cook racked up a career-high 24 points and five steals as ODU scored 34 points of 34 Spartan turnovers. Shae Kelley added 10 points and seven rebounds while Galaisha Goodhope scored 12 points and had two steals off the bench.

HOKIES SMOTHERED DEFENSIVELY

Jackie Cook (17 pts, 9 asst) and Shae Kelley (14 pts, 9 asst) each missed a double-double by just a single assist as the Lady Monarchs locked down defensively in their season-opening 55-35 win at Virginia Tech on Nov. 9.

It was the lowest output for the Hokies against ODU since their initial meeting back in 1972 when VT scored 29 points, a span of 30 games. The last time ODU held an opponent to 35 total points and 13 points at the half was on Dec. 8, 2010 vs. George Washington.

Virginia Tech shot just 19.6% in the first half from the field and finished the game 0-for-12 from behind the arc. ODU improved to 29-15 all-time in season openers with the win.
