Quick Hits:

- Old Dominion and UNC Wilmington are tied for second-place in the CAA standings. Today is the only matchup between the squads during the regular season.
- The Lady Monarchs are a perfect 41-0 all-time against UNCW, the third longest active win streak over an opponent in D-1 women's basketball.
- Today's game matches two of the Top 5 scoring offenses in the CAA. UNCW ranks third in the league in points per game (69.8), while ODU sits fifth (64.4).
- UNCW leads all CAA teams with a +8.0 scoring margin in its 23 games this season.
- Junior Tia Lewis became just the 29th all-time Lady Monarch to reach the 1,000-point scoring plateau in Thursday's win over Northeastern.
- ODU is 15-0 this season when scoring 61 points or more and the Lady Monarchs have yet to drop a game when leading at the 10-minute mark in the 2nd half.

- The Seahawks routed William & Mary, 72-48, on Thursday to remain tied with ODU for second in the CAA standings.
- Senior forward Brittany Blackwell ranks sixth in the CAA in scoring (16.0 ppg) and fifth in rebounding (8.4 rpg).
- The Seahawks shoot 46.1 percent from the floor as a team, the best mark in the CAA.
- UNCW (16.3 apg) and ODU (14.0 apg) are the top two teams in the league in assists per game.
- The Seahawks boast three of the top nine rebounders in the CAA and four of the top eight players in the league in shooting percentage from the field.

About Old Dominion

- Old Dominion has won three straight at the Ted Constant Center and is 10-2 at home this season.
- Senior Jasmine Parker leads ODU with 12.3 points and 3.3 steals per game. The guard has scored in double-figures in 19 of 23 games and she has led the team in scoring in seven contests. Her 3.3 steals per game ranks 4th nationally. The Norfolk native has swiped six or more steals in a game on four occasions this season.
- Junior Tia Lewis paces the squad in rebounding (7.9 rpg) and is second in scoring (11.9 ppg). The forward has a team-high seven double-doubles.
- At the completion of her junior season, Alena Voronina averaged 1.3 points & 1.0 rebounds for her career. This season, the forward is third on the team in both scoring (11.6 ppg) and rebounding (5.8 rpg).
- The Lady Monarchs played the 16th most difficult non-conference schedule in the country according to CollegeRPI.com.

Game Day Notes

Northeastern Recap

Old Dominion connected on a women's basketball Ted Constant Center record 11 three-point field goals, including four from sophomore Jackie Cook, in a 69-44 win over Northeastern Thursday evening. Cook hit for a career-high 16 points on 6-of-14 shooting to surpass her previous best scoring mark of 14, set just two weeks ago at William & Mary. Junior Tia Lewis was just one point shy of her eighth double-double of the season, but did score enough to become just the 29th all-time Lady Monarch to reach the 1,000-point scoring plateau. Lewis netted nine points and pulled down a game-high 14 rebounds in the win. Old Dominion dominated the glass, grabbing a season-high 56 rebounds, including 31 on the offensive end. The Lady Monarchs ended the game with a 27-rebound edge over the Huskies.

First In The Nation

Old Dominion ranks No. 1 nationally in defending the three-point line. The Lady Monarchs have shut down their opponents on the perimeter, holding them to a 23.3 percent shooting clip. Teams are 72-of-309 from beyond the arc against ODU this year.

Mid-Major Poll

Old Dominion fell to No. 11 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, which was released February 8. Green Bay sits atop the rankings, while James Madison (No. 8) and UNC Wilmington (No. 20) also represent the CAA.

600-Win Club

Old Dominion's Wendy Larry reached yet another coaching milestone this season, netting her 600th career victory on January 23 against Towson. She has compiled a 604-230 record in 27 seasons as a head coach, including 555 career wins at ODU. Larry reached the 600-win plateau in just 829 games which makes her the 10th fastest coach to accomplish the feat.

CAA Honors

Three different Lady Monarchs have garnered the CAA Player of the Week award this season. Senior Jasmine Parker was named the CAA Co-Player of the week Nov. 29 after scoring a combined 47 points and swiping nine steals in games at NC State and home vs. Louisville. Junior Tia Lewis earned the same honor January 10 after recording back-to-back double-doubles against George Mason and James Madison and Kquanise Byrd was honored after scoring a career-high 22 points in ODU's win at Delaware on January 16.

Parker Reaches 1,000

Senior guard Jasmine Parker became just the 28th all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points. With her game-high 16 points against No. 9/8 Tennessee, the guard from Norfolk reached the major plateau.

ACC Win

Old Dominion topped Atlantic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008. The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs play one of the toughest schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule features games against five teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane and JMU) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida, Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel). At the end of its non-conference slate, ODU's schedule ranked No. 16 according to CollegeRPI.com.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

RECORD CROWDS AT THE TED:

Old Dominion set the all-time women's basketball attendance record at the Ted Constant Center earlier this season when the Lady Monarchs hosted Tennessee. The game between the two historic programs was a **BLUE OUT** and a remarkable 7,774 fans packed the Ted. ODU boasts a dominant 111-23 overall record in the Constant Center, including seven victories over nationally ranked opponents.

NCAA Host Site

Old Dominion has been selected as one of 16 host sites for first- and second-round games in the 2012 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Games will be played at the Ted Constant Convocation Center on either March 17 and 19 or March 18 and 20, with exact dates and ticket availability for those contests to be released at a later date.

Lady Monarchs Ink Five To National Letters of Intent

Old Dominion head women's basketball coach Wendy Larry announced the signing of five players to National Letters of Intent. Myeisha Hall, Tiffany Minor, Queen Tiye Jackson, Ashley Betz-White and Kaneisha Atwater will continue their academic and athletic careers with the Lady Monarchs beginning in 2011-12.

Hall is ranked the 53rd-best guard in the Class of 2011 by ESPN. She's 5-8 and can play the point or shooting guard spots. Hall averaged 22 points, nine rebounds and four assists last season for Palm Beach (Fla.) Lakes High School. The combo guard, who scored 40 points in a game as a junior, was named the South Florida Sun-Sentinel Big School Player of the Year in Palm Beach County.

Larry on Hall: "Myeisha is an athletic scorer with tremendous transitional skills."

Minor is ranked No. 72 among wing players in her class by ESPN.com. The 5-11 wing player averaged 16.7 points last year at The Maret School in Washington, D.C. She's an excellent set shooter who can rebound and pass well for a wing player. She's expected to either play shooting guard or small forward at ODU.

Larry on Minor: "She's extremely versatile with good court awareness. She also adds a great deal of length on the defensive side of the ball."

Jackson led Trenton (N.J.) Catholic Academy to a state title last year. She's an excellent rebounder at 5-11 and she's expected to contribute at one of the two forward spots at ODU. Jackson has a strong build and can score both inside and out. Her range extends to the three-point line.

Larry on Jackson: "She has the size of a post player with a perimeter players skills."

Betz-White is a 5-5 point guard out of Trinity High School in Camp Hill, Pa. She averaged 11.4 points and 4.2 steals last year en route to being named to the Class AAA All-State Third Team as a junior. A true point guard, Betz-White excels in transition and on the secondary break, but is also comfortable in a set offense. The guard is a solid outside shooter and features a good pull-up jumper.

Larry on Betz-White: "She's a true point guard with personality and flare. Ashley makes everyone around her better."

Atwater is a 5-7 combo guard from Fort Pierce Westwood High School in Florida. She led her high school team in scoring as a junior, averaging 28.2 points. Atwater tallied five triple-doubles last season. She's a three-sport high school athlete who is quick off the dribble and strong on the defensive side of the ball.

Larry on Atwater: "She's an athlete that's extremely quick and fast. Additionally, she's an exceptional defender that can help us a great deal."

900 WINS!

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 925-321 (.742) and is in its 42nd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.
