



In the event of rain, a 'rain call' will be made on Friday, November 6, at 5:30 PM and all patrons will be notified about parade cancellation information.

Judges table will be located on Monarch Way behind the Ted Constant Center. During the parade the judges will select the 12 best parade floats to line-up on Bluestone Avenue across from the Football Stadium. One of those 12 floats will be selected as the overall parade winner. The winner will be announced at half-time during the football game.

All parade floats will be judged on the following criteria:

- Originality of theme and float
- Incorporating the Homecoming Theme
- Quality of Construction/Special Effects
- Enthusiasm of people on and around the float
- Overall Impression of the float

Parade Line-Up/Start Time Information

Lining up for the parade will begin starting 8:30 AM on Elkhorn Avenue. Please note that all vehicles must enter Elkhorn Avenue from 43rd street since Elkhorn Avenue will become a oneway street for the parade. Parade will begin promptly at 10 AM.

Parade Route

Parade Starts at 10:00 AM on Elkhorn Avenue and everyone is encouraged to watch all along 49th Street and Monarch Way. The parade route is as follows:

- START parade on Elkhorn Avenue
- Turn right on to 49th Street
- Follow 49th Street across Hampton Boulevard to Killam Avenue
- Turn right on Killam Avenue and continue on to 47th Street
- Turn right on to 47th Street
- Turn left on Monarch Way
- Follow Monarch Way to 43rd Street
- Turn right on 43rd Street
- Follow 43rd Street across Hampton Boulevard to Elkhorn to disperse

General Information

REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must be full-time, undergraduate students, currently enrolled on the Old Dominion University main campus. Students must be of Junior or Senior standing during the fall of 2009. Candidates must also have a 3.0 cumulative Grade Point Average or above.

SELECTION OF HOMECOMING COURT

The Homecoming Court selection process is different than years past. This year the homecoming court will be selected based on an application and interview process.

Application – All applicants who meet or exceed the Homecoming Court requirements stated above are encouraged to apply. A Homecoming Court Selection Committee comprised of faculty, staff and students will score each application using a point system. Applicants will be scored on application question responses, leadership qualities, and campus/community involvement. Please note that the committee is charged with identifying the students who represent ODU as well-rounded individuals through their academics, extracurricular involvement and demonstrate spirit and pride for ODU. The committee will then narrow the applicant pool to the top 24 candidates with the highest average scores. The scores from the application process will account for 20% of the overall score. PLEASE NOTE, NOT ALL APPLICANTS WILL BE INTERVIEWED.

Interview – Based on the application scores, the top 24 candidates – consisting of 12 males and 12 females – will be called to schedule an interview with the Homecoming Court Selection Committee. Interviews will be held during October 26, 2009 through October 29, 2009. Based on the interviews, the applicant pool will be narrowed to the top 12 Candidates – 6 male and 6 female – that will makeup the Homecoming Court. The Homecoming Court candidates will be announced on the homecoming website (http://studentaffairs.odu.edu/homecoming) at noon on October 30, 2009. The scores from the interview process will account for 30% of the overall score.

SELECTION OF HOMECOMING KING/QUEEN/PRINCE/PRINCESS

Once the Homecoming Court is determined through the application and interview process, then the candidates must go through an on-line student vote process.

Student Vote – Following the application and interview processes, the homecoming court will then be voted on by the student body starting at 12:01 a.m. on Tuesday, November 3, 2009 through 8:00 a.m. on Friday, November 6, 2009. The scores from the on-line vote will account for 50% of the overall score.

Homecoming King/Queen/Prince/Princess – Once the on-line voting is complete, the scores from each portion of the selection process (application, interview, and student vote) will be used to determine the overall scores. The male candidate with the highest overall score will be crowned the Homecoming King and the female candidate with the highest overall score will be crowned the Homecoming Queen. The male candidate with the second highest score will be crowned the Homecoming Prince and the female candidate with the second highest score will be crowned the Homecoming Princess.

OBLIGATIONS

All semifinalists are required to attend a number of Homecoming functions including, but not limited to the following:

- Pride Day Celebration on Tuesday, November 3, 2009 between 12:30-1:30 p.m.
- Homecoming Pep-Rally and Basketball Game events on Friday, November 6, 2009
- Homecoming Parade at 10 a.m. on Saturday, November 7, 2009
- Homecoming Game for the announcement of winners (Game tickets will be provided)
- Homecoming Ball on Saturday, November 7, 2009 at 9 p.m.

Upon selection, the court will be notified of dress requirements for each event. With the exception of class commitments, each applicant must understand that these appearances are **MANDATORY**, and by accepting the court position, is also agreeing to fulfill them. Failure to uphold these obligations will result in removal from the court.

DEADLINES/COPIES

Applications are due by 12:00 p.m. on Friday, October 23, 2009 to the Office of Student Activities and Leadership located in room 2122 of the Webb University Center. Late applications will not be accepted. Applicants should submit **eight** stapled copies of the entire application. Applications not meeting this requirement will not be considered.
