Quick Hits:

- 900 WINS! With their win against Hofstra, Old Dominion became just the third program in NCAA history to reach 900 wins in program history (Louisiana Tech and Tennessee)
- ODU has won eight straight and nine of the last ten games; over .500 for the first time this season, 11-9 -- the win over UNCW ran the all-time series to 41-0, the second best winning streak against an opponent for ODU
- According to rpiratings.com, the Lady Monarch schedule through 19 games was ranked the 18th toughest in the nation, #18 out of 345 total programs; ODU's RPI is now 63, third in the CAA
- Sophomore Tia Lewis is averaging 11.2 points per game and 7.8 rpg after averaging a double-double during her first season at UCF
- Despite just 92 points her freshman year as a reserve player, senior Jessica Canady now has 923 career points; she needs to average 9.6 ppg to to become 27th Lady Monarch with 1,000 by the end of the regular season
- VCU was in a three-way tie for first place until last game, when they suffered just their second loss in CAA play, at JMU
- D'Andra Moss ranks sixth in the CAA in scoring, averaging 17.4 ppg; Kita Waller is fourth in the CAA in Conference Only scoring, averaging 18.3 ppg in league games this season

Recap:

Senior Tiffany Green led the Lady Monarchs with her ninth double-double of the season with 21 points and 12 boards and sophomore Jasmine Parker added in 12 points, but ODU fell to VCU, 58-51, the last time they faced.

It was just the third time since joining the league in 1991-92 the Lady Monarchs have suffered three consecutive CAA losses. Old Dominion fell to VCU, James Madison, and Delaware in a row in 2002-03 and James Madison, Richmond, and East Carolina in its first season in the league in 1991-92.

Old Dominion, who committed a season-high 28 turnovers at Georgia State on Thursday, turned the ball over 25 times against the Rams. VCU was able to score 21 points off the Lady Monarchs' miscues.

The Lady Monarchs trailed 25-21 at the intermission with junior Jessica Canady (Williamsburg, Va.) having already hauled in 10 of her 12 rebounds of the afternoon.

The second half was neck and neck much of the way. VCU established a five point, 33-28 lead, five minutes into the half, but Old Dominion managed to erase it by continually chipping away at the Ram advantage. The Lady Monarchs regained the lead at the seven minute mark leading 43-40.

The Rams' Kita Waller sunk a three on the following play to tie the game for the fourth time at 43 all with 6:16 remaining and Hollingsworth sank four straight free throws to give VCU the lead for good.

VCU finished the game with four in double figures with Quanita Hollingsworth leading her squad with 21. Moss netted 12, Radoslava Bachvarova added in 11, and La'Tavia Rorie contributed 10 points in the win.

All-Time Series

Against VCU:

The series against VCU is the second-longest standing series in ODU history, in terms of games played. ODU has played 63 games against the Rams, dating back to the 1969-70 season. Only JMU has had more match-ups with Old Dominion. ODU has a 54-9 advantage in the all-time series, including wins in 31 of the last 33 games. Last season, though, the two teams split with ODU taking a one-point victory at home and falling by seven in Richmond

About the Rams:

VCU had been deadlocked with the Lady Monarchs and Drexel atop the CAA standings until last game, when James Madison handed the Rams their second loss in CAA action this season. VCU will be looking to get back into first place in Sunday's game as they take on the Lady Monarchs.

The Rams have won 10 of 12 after opening the season 5-5. They have been led by D'Andra Moss, ranking sixth in the CAA in scoring. She averages 17.4 points per game and is also second on the team in rebounding, hauling in 6.5 boards per game.

Three more VCU players are averaging double figures, including Kita Waller (14.1 ppg), La'Tavia Rorie (13.8 ppg), and Courtney Hurt (12.0 ppg). Rorie, the Rams top 3-point shooter, suffered a season-ending injury in mid-January. Hurt pulls in a team-high 7.7 rebounds per game while Waller has stepped nicely for Rorie, knocking down 40% of her 3-point attempts to lead the team.

The Rams are the league's second-leading offense, averaging 68.8 points per game. They also have proven one of the top teams in the league in terms of taking care of the ball. They lead the league in steals (11.0 spg) and turnover margin (+6.86).

Streaking to the Top

Old Dominion has won eight straight games and nine of the last ten games since the conference season has begun. ODU was locked in a three-way tie for first until the win against UNC Wilmington, when Drexel and VCU both lost to give the Lady Monarchs sole possession of first place.

51's Enough

Old Dominion defeated Hofstra this season by a final of 51-46. The 51 points scored tied the lowest scored in a win for Old Dominion since 1973-74. Twice prior, ODU has won with just 51 points scored, against UVA in 1980-81 and an overtime win against UNC Wilmington in 2002-03.

Whew! That Was Close

ODU is excelling in tight ball games this season, winning seven of the nine games decided by single digits, including five straight. Three came on the road (JMU, Towson and UNCW). ODU also defeated Georgia State and Hofstra at home by single digits. Old Dominion's closest game this season was a 1-point win at Delaware, powered to victory by Jasmine Parker taking a charge and knocking down a go-ahead 3-pointer late in the game.

Big Win in Harrisonburg

The Lady Monarchs earned their first win against JMU in Harrisonburg since 2005, snapping a four-game losing streak over that span. The win also snapped JMU's nine-game home winning streak and was just the ninth loss suffered on the home floor in the last 75 home games for the Dukes. Old Dominion won 67-58, holding off a second half surge from the Dukes after taking a 15-point halftime lead. Junior Jasmine Parker nearly had a triple-double, hauling in a career-high nine rebounds and dishing a career-high tying six assists to go with her ten points. Senior Jessica Canady led the way with 14 points.

Three-Point Defense

JMU, one of the nation's top long-ball teams, was able to knock down just a pair of 3-pointers on 23 attempts against the Lady Monarchs. For the season, ODU ranks third in the CAA in 3-pt FG percentage defense, allowing just 30% from beyond the arc. In conference only games, ODU leads the league, allowing an abysmal 21.7% from long range (28-for-129).

Hot Conference Shooting

ODU can be found among the league leaders in several statistical categories. In conference games this season, sophomore Tia Lewis is second in the league in field goal percentage, knocking down 56.9% of her shots. In fact, ODU holds two of the top three spots. Senior Jessica Canady is third in the league, with 53.8% of her shots falling.

As a team, ODU is leading the league in shooting percentage. ODU is shooting at a 44.4% clip while Northeastern is second at 42% as a team. The Lady Monarchs are also scorching from long-range, shooting 35.1% from beyond the arc in CAA games, second in the league. ODU also ranks second in free-throw shooting, knocking down 75.5% from the charity stripe.

12-for-12

Junior Jasmine Parker helped lead ODU past Drexel with a perfect 12-for-12 night at the free-throw line. It was a career-best, a new Constant Center record and the second best performance by a Lady Monarch in the history of the program. Only Nancy Lieberman had a better night from the line, going 15-for-15 in 1978.

1200 And Counting...

With the non-conference finale against Tennessee, the Lady Monarchs reached 1200 games played in the history of the program. ODU joins a select group of just eight programs to play 1200 games in their histories. They are Tennessee Tech, Tennessee, Stephen F. Austin, Long Beach State, Kansas State, James Madison, and Hofstra. ODU ranks second in winning percentage among these eight teams, going 901-309 over the past 41 years for a .745 success rate.

Senior Moments

ODU has just one senior this season, First Team Pre-season All-CAA forward Jessica Canady. Canady has been working her way back from offseason surgery and has now started ten straight games after being forced to sit through half of the non-conference schedule. She broke out in a big way against Northeastern, scoring 18 points and hauling in a team-high 12 rebounds while playing a career-high 36 minutes. She led ODU in rebounding again against Drexel, with 11. The Lady Monarch senior has breached the 900-point plateau and is now also over 600 career rebounds. Canady was a reserve player her freshman year, scoring only 92 points, making her 923 career all the more impressive, averaging 11.1 points per game since her sophomore season.

A Rare Occurrence

ODU lost to Tennessee by a final score of 102-62 in the non-conference finale this season, marking just the sixth time in program history the Lady Monarchs allowed a team to reach 100 points. Northeastern then posted its first ever 100-point game against ODU, marking just the seventh occurrence against the Lady Monarchs.

Stop! Thief!

Jasmine Parker is among the CAA leaders in steals this season, averaging 2.5 per game with 50 thefts. The ODU junior now has 146 career steals, averaging 1.7 per game in her career.

Still Toughest Schedule in the CAA

Old Dominion's schedule is the toughest in the CAA, and among the strongest in the country. After closing out the non-conference schedule, Old Dominion had the fifth toughest schedule in the nation. Heading into today's game, ODU's schedule was listed as the 18th strongest and the Lady Monarchs RPI is also listed as #63 after the first 17 games. Both numbers come from piratings.com's weekly report.

Magic Number 24

Three players have tallied new career highs early this season, all with 24 points scored. Jasmine Parker scored 24 against Maryland to set a new career-high, while Tia Lewis and Shadasia Green both scored 24 against Louisville to set their new mark.

17 Again...

Sophomore forward Tia Lewis tied her career-high with 17 rebounds against Ole Miss, taking over the top spot in the CAA with 9.2 rebounds per game at the time. Lewis had 17 in a game against North Florida during her freshman year while playing for Central Florida and the 17 hauled in against Mississippi tied that mark for the first time as a Lady Monarch. She also posted her first double-double in the game, scoring 15 points for Old Dominion.

Potent Parker

In the second game of the season, Jasmine Parker scored a career-high 24 points and is now third on the team, averaging 11.7 points per game this season. She came out of the locker room on a torrid pace, scoring 12 of Old Dominion's first 20 points and giving the Lady Monarchs the lead against the 20th ranked team in the nation. She finished with 24 points, four assists, four rebounds and three steals in her second consecutive solid game against a nationally ranked opponent.

Parker is knocking down scoring marks this season, breaching the 600- and 700-point plateaus as a junior. She is just 26 points shy of 800 in her third year for Old Dominion. She is one of two active Lady Monarchs to reach 700 points, as senior Jessica Canady has over 900.

Welcome to the Ted

Since the doors opened at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2002, the Lady Monarchs have enjoyed a 98-18 record. Last season, ODU suffered just its second CAA loss ever at the Ted, when JMU defeated the Lady Monarchs 72-67 on January 25, 2009. Of the 18 losses in the Constant Center, TEN have been to nationally ranked opponents.

The Lady Monarchs are just two wins shy of 100 in the Constant Center. Head Coach Wendy Larry is also approaching yet another milestone, just 22 wins shy of her 600th.

Individually, Jessica Canady is just 77 points shy of becoming the 27th Lady Monarch to reach the 1,000 point mark.

900 WINS!

With the 51-46 win over Hofstra on January 31, the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 901-309 (.745) in over 40 years of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.

Toughest Schedule in the Nation

Though it's early, the Lady Monarchs schedule has been ranked the toughest in the nation through six games by rpiratings.com. According to the same source, ODU had the 74th best RPI, even with just the 1-5 record. Through six games ODU faced four teams receiving votes in the national rankings and the six teams combined had gone 39-8.

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish third in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the head coaches. Defending champions Drexel were pegged as the top team heading into 2009-10 with James Madison also selected ahead of ODU.

Startin' Out Right

Jasmine Parker played extremely well against the second ranked Cardinal in the season opener, scoring a team-high 16 points and adding five rebounds, four assists, a career-high five steals and a perfect 5-for-5 night from the free-throw line. Despite a poor first half, Tia Lewis also came away with a stellar first game, finishing just one rebound shy of a double-double. Lewis finished with 15 points and nine rebounds in her first game as a Lady Monarch. Junior Shadasia Green continued her hot play of late with 11 points and seven rebounds. She averaged 16 ppg and 7 rpg in the two exhibitions.

Season Openers

The Lady Monarchs are 27-14 in season openers, falling to 2nd ranked Stanford at home in this season's opener. ODU has dropped six of their last eight season-opening games.

Home Openers

In home openers, Old Dominion is 29-12, including a 4-4 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Last season, ODU opened the regular season home schedule with an upset of 11th ranked UVA by a final score of 78-70. It was the second straight win over the nationally ranked opponent at the Ted, including the overtime thriller in the NCAA Tournament the year before, and the seventh win over a nationally ranked opponent at the Constant Center. ODU lost to #2 Stanford in this season's home opener.

Exhibition Recap - Shaw

In the final tune-up of the 2009-10 preseason, ODU took care of the Shaw Lady Bears by a final score of 82-48. Senior Jessica Canady returned to the floor for her 2009-10 debut and dazzled, scoring 13 of her 15 points in the first half. She also grabbed five rebounds in 21 minutes of play. Junior Shadasia Green again had a stellar outing, posting 16 points in her second straight exhibition and added five boards. Tia Lewis joined Green and Canady in double figures with 10, despite only scoring two points in limited action in the first half due to foul trouble. Lewis finished 4-for-6 from the field. Rookie point guard Carolann Cloutier distributed eight assists in the game while newcomers Jackie Cook and Kquanise Byrd each dished four. Cook added eight points in the game and Byrd had two thefts. Sophomore center Mairi Buchan got on the boards for a second straight game, rebounding a team-high six missed shots against Shaw.

Exhibition Recap - Chowan

In the first look at the Lady Monarchs, ODU won in front of nearly 3,000 fans with ease, 85-52. Junior Shadasia Green led the way, with 16 points and 9 rebounds, just shy of a double-double. Newcomers Tia Lewis and Kquanise Byrd also showed off what Lady Monarch fans can expect to see this season with 11 and 12 points respectively. Byrd added four steals off the bench and went a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line, while Lewis hauled in six boards. Leading the way on the glass after Green was sophomore center Mairi Buchan, grabbing eight boards. ODU had a commanding rebounding edge with 59 in the game compared to just 30 for Chowan.
