KEY COLONIAL CLASH

The Monarchs face a key weekend as they host George Mason Friday night at 7:00 and Towson Sunday afternoon at 1:00. Mason is just one win ahead of the Lady Monarchs and Towson is tied in the conference standings. ODU would make a significant push for the postseason with a couple of wins.

ODU has struggled against GMU historically, but have won three straight against the Patriots to close the all-time series to 4-9-1. Towson and Old Dominion have split their all-time series at 3 games apiece. ODU has won the last two meetings, including a 2-1 victory in Baltimore a year ago.

ODU is ranked 12th in the SOCCER BUZZ Mid-Atlantic Regional Rankings.

NATIONALLY RANKED

Janna Pearson ranks 59th in the nation in assists per game at 0.45. Shavon Knight is listed among the nation's top 100 scorers. Knight ranks 96th in goals per game (0.5). Lauren Tupman is also ranked among the top 100 keepers in save percentage and saves per game. She ranks 100th in the nation with an 0.806 percentage and 75th in the nation with 5.27 saves/game.

GEORGE MASON HAS JUMPED TO A 3-3 START IN CAA ACTION, BEATING NORTHEASTERN, GA STATE & DELAWARE. THE MASON DEFENSE IS VERY GOOD, ALLOWING JUST 14 GOALS IN 13 GAMES THIS SEASON. KASEY DAVENPORT, THE Patriots keeper has 5 shutouts, a 1.08 GAA and has PLAYED EVERY MINUTE BETWEEN THE PIPES THIS SEASON. THE GMU ATTACK ISN'T STRONG, THOUGH, WITH JUST 19 GOALS. ALISON REINHARDT LEADS THE TEAM WITH FIVE ASSISTS.

SCOUTING REPORT:

TOWSON BOASTS AN EXCEPTIONAL DEFENSE AS WELL, AS THE TIGERS HAVE ALLOWED JUST 9 GOALS IN 13 GAMES. TOWSON HAS ALLOWED MORE THAN ONE GOAL IN A GAME ONLY ONCE THIS SEASON. LEADING THE TEAM ON THE OFFENSIVE SIDE OF THE BALL IS JUNIOR FORWARD KAITLYN ZAMROZ. SHE HAS 8 GOALS ON THE SEASON, JUST ONE SHY OF THE LEAGUE LEAD.

THE COACHES

GMU: Diane Drake is in her fourth season at George Mason and has compiled a 78-77-11 record. Before Mason, she coached the Georgetown program for five seasons. She is assisted by Michael Needham, Nick Carlin-Voigt and Anibel Jimenez.

Towson: Greg Paynter is in his 1st season as the head coach of the Tigers, but is very familiar with the CAA. He was an assistant at JMU for eight seasons before taking the helm at Towson this season. In his first year, he's led the Tigers to an 8-4-1 record overall and a 2-3-1 CAA mark. He is assisted by Erin Konheim, Dave Nesbitt and Lauren Windsor.

OLD DOMINION: Head Coach Joe Pereira, two-time CAA Coach of the Year, leads the Lady Monarchs for his 13th season. His 258 career victories currently ranks him 25th on the NCAA All-Time wins list with 131 of them coming at Old Dominion. He coached the Lady Monarchs to the programs first ever NCAA Tournament last season in the finest season of ODU Women's Soccer history. He is assisted by Kim Francis & Stephanie Miller.

LAST TIME OUT

The Monarchs had a roller coaster of a weekend against the top two teams in the league. ODU came away with one win and a loss in the third weekend of CAA play. The Lady Monarchs were knotted in a 1-1 tie in the final seconds of double overtime against VCU when senior Lisa McKenzie knocked home the game-winner with one second on the clock. ODU then took a 2-1 lead against unbeaten JMU with less than 20 minutes to go in the game. The Dukes, though, would score three late goals to win 2-4 over the Lady Monarchs. ODU is now 6-4-2 overall and have a 2-3-1 CAA mark.

POTENT ATTACK

Last season, the Lady Monarchs were extremely difficult to shutout. In 23 games, ODU was held empty just once, a new record for the program. It wasn't until the final game of the season when the Lady Monarchs faced the tenth seeded Wake Forest team on the road that they suffered their only shutout of the season.

The loss ended Old Dominion's 22 match streak of games with at least one goal scored. The Lady Monarchs continue to be an extremely potent offense and have scored at least one goal in all but three of the last 35 games. They are currently averaging 1.72 goals per contest, having scored 22 goals in just 13 games this season.

CLIMBIN' THE CHARTS

Junior Shavon Knight is already among the programs historically best scorers and continues to climb. With her six goals this season, she is now in the top five all-time with 24.

Her 56 career points has trampolined her into sole possession of fifth all-time behind Jen Henley (109), Beeman (86), Melanie McGovern (74) and Jennifer Gillespie (63). She is also tied for 9th all-time in assists with nine.

Fellow junior Janna Pearson also is among the top ten in points (38), goals (13) and assists (12). Also among the leaders is senior Lisa McKenzie with 41 points, 15 goals, and 11 assists.

A WHOLE HEAP OF HELPING

This season, ODU has been extremely unselfish with the ball on the attack, dishing out 19 assists on 22 goals. Eleven different Lady Monarchs have at least one assist and Janna Pearson leads the team with five. Newcomer Ashley Kukura added two this weekend and is second on the team with four.

DOMINANT DEFENSE

The Monarchs have only allowed more than one goal in a game once this season. This obviously can be attributed to stellar goalkeeping (Lauren Tupman and Colby Owen have combined for a 0.95 GAA) but more importantly, the back four for the Monarchs have been near impregnable.

Dani Hammer, Saratu Dodo, Marilee Mastaler, Beth Messier and ODU's first off the bench Brittney Kortz have been very solid. The defense in the second half has been especially impressive, allowing just 68 shots and seven goals in the second frame this season. That's good enough for just over five shots a game in the second half. For the game, ODU is allowing just over 13 shots per game.

Last season, ODU broke a team record with a goals against average of 1.06. The Lady Monarchs back line is working to ensure they best that mark again in 2007.



OFFENSE A BREWIN'

Junior Lizzy Brewster has become another offensive weapon for ODU having moved up front during the NC State game earlier this season. She has been an anchor on the defensive line her entire career, but has already enjoyed significant success up front. She has scored five goals in her first nine games up front and she's already eclipsed her two-year total for points in her career.
