Quick Hits:

- ODU's eight-game winning streak came to a halt last game when VCU became just the fourth league opponent to win in Norfolk since ODU joined the CAA in 1992; ODU is now 150-4 (.974) in CAA regular season home games
- The Lady Monarch schedule through 21 games still ranked among the top 25; ranked as high as #1 this season, it is now slated as the 24th toughest in the nation
- Sophomore Tia Lewis is averaging 11.0 points per game and 8.0 rpg after averaging a double-double during her first season
- Despite just 92 points her freshman year as a reserve player, senior Jessica Canady now has 925 career points; she needs just 75 more to become the 27th Lady Monarch with 1,000 career points
- Junior Jasmine Parker has been on fire since the CAA season started, leading the team in CAA-only scoring with 13.8 ppg; she has 786 career points in her third year, ranking fourth among active CAA juniors
- Delaware is in 5th place in the CAA standings, just 2 games back of the Lady Monarchs and VCU for first place; the Blue Hens have lost a pair of overtime games to Drexel and a pair of one-point games to ODU and VCU
- Rookie sensation Elena Delle Donne leads the Fightin' Blue Hens this year, as the 6-5 guard-forward ranks second in the nation in scoring (25.6 ppg) and in free-throw percentage (.917) -- she is also leading the CAA in rebounding at 9.1 per game

Recap:

Behind a well-timed heater from beyond the arc, the Lady Monarchs came from behind in the final minutes to halt a University of Delaware six-game winning streak, dropping the Fightin' Blue Hens on their home floor, 60-59. Old Dominion improved to 19-0 all-time in CAA openers with the victory.

At the intermission, ODU held a slight 31-29 advantage behind their best shooting performance of the year, going 50% from the field on 11-of-22 shooting. Delaware had 10 made field goals in the half, but was shooting just 35.7% from the field.

A pair of Delle Donne free-throws with 2:08 remaining set up the dramatic finale. After the freshman Player of the Year candidate stole the ball from ODU, she received the ball at the elbow facing the basket. She drove to the left side where Parker stepped in and drew a huge charge, the first and only foul of the game for Delle Donne. The turnover gave ODU the ball with 1:31 down just two points.

The Lady Monarchs rotated the basketball to the right corner, where it was Parker again, knocking down what would prove to be the eventual game-winning score.

Out of timeouts, Delaware looked to Delle Donne, who had the gamewinner against UMASS with five seconds to go in Delaware's last game. She was double-teamed at the elbow, but still found a wide open Carra on the back door cut. As Carra put up the shot, Byrd rushed back to apply pressure and the Delaware rookie missed the shot, and Tia Lewis, the team's leader on the glass hauled in the game-winning rebound.

Old Dominion shot a season-high 48.9% from the field (23-47) including a season high-tying 42.9% from 3-point range (6-14), getting three from Parker, two from Byrd and one from freshman Jackie Cook.

All-Time Series

Against Delaware:

Earlier this season, ODU took a one-point victory in Newark to extend the Old Dominion advantage in the all-time series to 13-3. The Lady Monarchs have won five straight and ten of the last twelve against the Blue Hens. Delaware, though, was the last team to win in Norfolk before VCU's victory last time out. ODU has never lost two straight CAA games at home.

About the Blue Hens:

The nation's second leading scorer, Elena Delle Donne, leads Delaware this season, averaging 25.6 points per game in her rookie season for the Fightin' Blue Hens. Not only is she leading the league in scoring, but she is also atop the league in rebounding, with 9.1 per game.

As a team, Delaware is fifth in the CAA, posting four losses by just seven points combined. Delaware lost to ODU by one to open league play and sandwiched a pair of one-possession overtime losses to Drexel with another one-point loss at VCU. They have won four of the last five, outscoring opponents by over 12 per game.

Delle Donne is leading the squad in nearly every statistical category with a team-high 32 steals and 34 blocks to go with her scoring and rebounding. She's also second on the team in assists, with 2.4 per game. The rookie player of the year candidate is shooting .504 from the field, .433 from beyond the arc and .915 from the free-throw line, which ranks second in the nation.

Tesia Harris is the only other player averaging double figures with 13.1 points per game while also hauling in 5.0 rebounds per game. Freshman Lauren Carra has started nine games and is third on the team with 6.7 ppg. The three combined have knocked down 96 three-pointers, 90% of the made 3's for the team.

Streaking to the Top

Old Dominion won eight of the last nine games and is tied for first place with VCU. ODU was locked in a three-way tie for first until the win against UNC Wilmington, when Drexel and VCU both lost to give the Lady Monarchs sole possession of first place. VCU answered with a win over ODU last time out to tie the Lady Monarchs at the top of the standings again.

51's Enough

Old Dominion defeated Hofstra this season by a final of 51-46. The 51 points scored tied the lowest scored in a win for Old Dominion since 1973-74. Twice prior, ODU has won with just 51 points scored, against UVA in 1980-81 and an overtime win against UNC Wilmington in 2002-03.

Whew! That Was Close

ODU is excelling in tight ball games this season, winning seven of the nine games decided by single digits, including five straight. Three came on the road (JMU, Towson and UNCW). ODU also defeated Georgia State and Hofstra at home by single digits. Old Dominion's closest game this season was a 1-point win at Delaware, powered to victory by Jasmine Parker taking a charge and knocking down a go-ahead 3-pointer late in the game.

Big Win in Harrisonburg

The Lady Monarchs earned their first win against JMU in Harrisonburg since 2005, snapping a four-game losing streak over that span. The win also snapped JMU's nine-game home winning streak and was just the ninth loss suffered on the home floor in the last 75 home games for the Dukes. Old Dominion won 67-58, holding off a second half surge from the Dukes after taking a 15-point halftime lead. Junior Jasmine Parker nearly had a triple-double, hauling in a career-high nine rebounds and dishing a career-high tying six assists to go with her ten points. Senior Jessica Canady led the way with 14 points.

Three-Point Defense

JMU, one of the nation's top long-ball teams, was able to knock down just a pair of 3-pointers on 23 attempts against the Lady Monarchs. For the season, ODU ranks fourth in the CAA in 3-pt FG percentage defense, allowing just 30% from beyond the arc. In conference only games, ODU leads the league, allowing an abysmal 22.7% from long range (32-for-141).

Hot Conference Shooting

ODU can be found among the league leaders in several statistical categories. In conference games this season, sophomore Tia Lewis is second in the league in field goal percentage, knocking down 54.7% of her shots. In fact, ODU holds two of the top four spots. Senior Jessica Canady is fourth in the league, with 52.4% of her shots falling.

As a team, ODU is leading the league in shooting percentage. ODU is shooting at a 43.4% clip while Northeastern is second at 42% as a team. The Lady Monarchs are also scorching from long-range, shooting 33.9% from beyond the arc in CAA games, third in the league. ODU also ranks second in free-throw shooting, knocking down 77% from the charity stripe.

12-for-12

Junior Jasmine Parker helped lead ODU past Drexel with a perfect 12-for-12 night at the free-throw line. It was a career-best, a new Constant Center record and the second best performance by a Lady Monarch in the history of the program. Only Nancy Lieberman had a better night from the line, going 15-for-15 in 1978.

1200 And Counting...

With the non-conference finale against Tennessee, the Lady Monarchs reached 1200 games played in the history of the program. ODU joins a select group of just eight programs to play 1200 games in their histories. They are Tennessee Tech, Tennessee, Stephen F. Austin, Long Beach State, Kansas State, James Madison, and Hofstra. ODU ranks second in winning percentage among these eight teams, going 901-309 over the past 41 years for a .745 success rate.

Senior Moments

ODU has just one senior this season, First Team Pre-season All-CAA forward Jessica Canady. Canady has been working her way back from offseason surgery and has now started 12 straight games after being forced to sit through half of the non-conference schedule. She broke out in a big way against Northeastern, scoring 18 points and hauling in a team-high 12 rebounds while playing a career-high 36 minutes. She led ODU in rebounding again against Drexel, with 11. The Lady Monarch senior has breached the 900-point plateau and is now also over 600 career rebounds. Canady was a reserve player her freshman year, scoring only 92 points, making her 925 career all the more impressive, averaging 11.0 points per game since her sophomore season.

A Rare Occurrence

ODU lost to Tennessee by a final score of 102-62 in the non-conference finale this season, marking just the sixth time in program history the Lady Monarchs allowed a team to reach 100 points. Northeastern then posted its first ever 100-point game against ODU, marking just the seventh occurrence against the Lady Monarchs.

Stop! Thief!

Jasmine Parker is among the CAA leaders in steals this season, averaging 2.4 per game with 51 thefts. The ODU junior now has 147 career steals, averaging 1.7 per game in her career.

Still Toughest Schedule in the CAA

Old Dominion's schedule is the toughest in the CAA, and among the strongest in the country. After closing out the non-conference schedule, Old Dominion had the fifth toughest schedule in the nation. Heading into today's game, ODU's schedule was listed as the 24th strongest and the Lady Monarchs RPI is also listed as #66 after the first 21 games. Both numbers come from rpiratings.com's weekly report.

Magic Number 24

Three players have tallied new career highs early this season, all with 24 points scored. Jasmine Parker scored 24 against Maryland to set a new career-high, while Tia Lewis and Shadasia Green both scored 24 against Louisville to set their new mark.

17 Again...

Sophomore forward Tia Lewis tied her career-high with 17 rebounds against Ole Miss, taking over the top spot in the CAA with 9.2 rebounds per game at the time. Lewis had 17 in a game against North Florida during her freshman year while playing for Central Florida and the 17 hauled in against Mississippi tied that mark for the first time as a Lady Monarch. She also posted her first double-double in the game, scoring 15 points for Old Dominion. Last time out, she marked a new CAA-high with 13 rebounds.

Potent Parker

In the second game of the season, Jasmine Parker scored a career-high 24 points and is now third on the team, averaging 11.7 points per game this season. She came out of the locker room on a torrid pace, scoring 12 of Old Dominion's first 20 points and giving the Lady Monarchs the lead against the 20th ranked team in the nation. She finished with 24 points, four assists, four rebounds and three steals in her second consecutive solid game against a nationally ranked opponent.

Parker is knocking down scoring marks this season, breaching the 600- and 700-point plateaus as a junior. She is just 26 points shy of 800 in her third year for Old Dominion. She is one of two active Lady Monarchs to reach 700 points, as senior Jessica Canady has over 900.

Welcome to the Ted

Since the doors opened at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2002, the Lady Monarchs have enjoyed a 98-19 record. ODU suffered just its third CAA loss ever at the Ted earlier this season, when VCU defeated the Lady Monarchs 75-56 on February 7, 2010. Of the 19 losses in the Constant Center, TEN have been to nationally ranked opponents.

The Lady Monarchs are just two wins shy of 100 in the Constant Center. Head Coach Wendy Larry is also approaching yet another milestone, just 22 wins shy of her 600th.

Individually, Jessica Canady is just 75 points shy of becoming the 27th Lady Monarch to reach the 1,000 point mark.

900 WINS!

With the 51-46 win over Hofstra on January 31, the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 901-310 (.744) in over 40 years of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.

Toughest Schedule in the Nation

Though it's early, the Lady Monarchs schedule has been ranked the toughest in the nation through six games by rpiratings.com. According to the same source, ODU had the 74th best RPI, even with just the 1-5 record. Through six games ODU faced four teams receiving votes in the national rankings and the six teams combined had gone 39-8.

Jasmine Parker played extremely well against the second ranked Cardinal in the season opener, scoring a team-high 16 points and adding five rebounds, four assists, a career-high five steals and a perfect 5-for-5 night from the free-throw line. Despite a poor first half, Tia Lewis also came away with a stellar first game, finishing just one rebound shy of a double-double. Lewis finished with 15 points and nine rebounds in her first game as a Lady Monarch. Junior Shadasia Green continued her hot play of late with 11 points and seven rebounds. She averaged 16 ppg and 7 rpg in the two exhibitions.

Season Openers

The Lady Monarchs are 27-14 in season openers, falling to 2nd ranked Stanford at home in this season's opener. ODU has dropped six of their last eight season-opening games.

Home Openers

In home openers, Old Dominion is 29-12, including a 4-4 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Last season, ODU opened the regular season home schedule with an upset of 11th ranked UVA by a final score of 78-70. It was the second straight win over the nationally ranked opponent at the Ted, including the overtime thriller in the NCAA Tournament the year before, and the seventh win over a nationally ranked opponent at the Constant Center. ODU lost to #2 Stanford in this season's home opener.

Exhibition Recap - Shaw

In the final tune-up of the 2009-10 preseason, ODU took care of the Shaw Lady Bears by a final score of 82-48. Senior Jessica Canady returned to the floor for her 2009-10 debut and dazzled, scoring 13 of her 15 points in the first half. She also grabbed five rebounds in 21 minutes of play. Junior Shadasia Green again had a stellar outing, posting 16 points in her second straight exhibition and added five boards. Tia Lewis joined Green and Canady in double figures with 10, despite only scoring two points in limited action in the first half due to foul trouble. Lewis finished 4-for-6 from the field. Rookie point guard Carolann Cloutier distributed eight assists in the game while newcomers Jackie Cook and Kquanise Byrd each dished four. Cook added eight points in the game and Byrd had two thefts. Sophomore center Mairi Buchan got on the boards for a second straight game, rebounding a team-high six missed shots against Shaw.

Exhibition Recap - Chowan

In the first look at the Lady Monarchs, ODU won in front of nearly 3,000 fans with ease, 85-52. Junior Shadasia Green led the way, with 16 points and 9 rebounds, just shy of a double-double. Newcomers Tia Lewis and Kquanise Byrd also showed off what Lady Monarch fans can expect to see this season with 11 and 12 points respectively. Byrd added four steals off the bench and went a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line, while Lewis hauled in six boards. Leading the way on the glass after Green was sophomore center Mairi Buchan, grabbing eight boards. ODU had a commanding rebounding edge with 59 in the game compared to just 30 for Chowan.
