PILOLLI WINS C-USA HITTER OF THE WEEK

Charlotte's **Dominic Pilolli** put together a monster weekend hitting .600 in the fourth-straight series win for the 49ers leading to Conference USA Hitter of the Week honors announced on April 19th. The Niners outfielder opened the UTSA series with a RBI double in a five-run third that proved to be the difference in a 6-2 victory. In Saturday's double dip, Pilolli got the first comeback started with a solo home run in the fourth, RBI single and stolen base in the fifth and two-run triple to left-center capping off a three-hit night at 10-6 win in game one. In game two, another three-hit effort capped off a six-hit DH with a game-tying two-run homer in the bottom of the fifth adding a double, single and walk during the 11-10 win that tied the school record with the Niners 11th-straight victory. Pilolli finished the doubleheader 6-for-7 hitting for the daily cycle with six RBI and three runs scored. On Sunday, Pilolli put the Niners on the board with a RBI double in the first and blasted another two-run, opposite-field homer in the third to tie it up before UTSA win on to win in extras. For the week, Pilolli hit .600 going 9-of-15 at the plate with three homers, three doubles, a triple, 10 RBI and four runs scored in addition to slugging 1.513 and a .647 on base percentage.

BIG NIGHT FOR KNIGHT LEADS TO SWEEP OF SEASON SERIES WITH APP

The 49ers completed a season sweep of App. State after an 11-8 victory in Boone on April 20th. **Austin Knight** became the first 49er since Tony Montalbano in 2011 to drive in six runs doing so with a pair of home runs and a double. Knight's solo home run in the 4th got the Niners on the board, his go-ahead three-run HR in the 7th put the Niners up for good while in nation-leading 21st double of the year in the 8th drove in two more for insurance. **Todd Elwood** and **Jack Dragum** also joined Knight in the three-hit club all in Charlotte's 14-hit attack. The Niners swept both meetings with App. using 26 runs and 32 hits combined in both meetings.

FASTER THAN THE ROADRUNNERS, TYING SCHOOL-RECORD

Charlotte picked up their fourth-straight Conference USA series win on April 18th, making some history in the process, scoring three wins in four attempts against UTSA. The 49ers used a five-run third en route to a 6-2 win on Friday, used a seven-run sixth in a 10-6 and five unanswered in an 11-10 DH sweep on Saturday before the historic win streak came to an end in extra innings on Sunday. With both Saturday victories, the Niners tied the school-record with their 11th-straight win. Charlotte hit .346 in the weekend series led by Hitter of the Week **Dominic Pilolli's** .600 average followed by **Todd Elwood** at .500 (7-for-14) and **Jack Dragum** at .429 (6-for-14).

MOVING UP TO #19, RANKED IN FOUR OF FIVE

The 49ers continued their climb in the nation's polls after winning their fourth-straight weekend series in Conference USA, this time taking three-of-four from UTSA. Charlotte moved up two spots to #19 in the DIBaseball poll, #21 in the USA Today Coaches Poll, #24 in the NCBWA baseball writers poll and #29 in the Collegiate Baseball top-30. For the first time since 2011, the 49ers found themselves ranked inside the nation's top-25 checking in at #21 in the DIBaseball poll released on April 12th. After receiving votes in various polls during the first half of the season, the Niners second-straight

Conference USA series sweep propelled them into this week's top-25. The 49ers last received votes in 2017 and haven't been in the ranks since coming in at #28 in 2011. The Niners have sights set on the program's all-time best ranking of #18 that came back in 2007.

KNIGHT NAMED TO GOLDEN SPIKES WATCH LIST

For his stellar play through the first half of the 2021 season, Charlotte's **Austin Knight** has been named to USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List. Of the initial 45 players to be named to the list, Knight is the only representative from Conference USA and the first to come from Charlotte. Knight currently leads the team hitting .373 on the year, fourth-best in Conference USA, while leading the country with his 18 doubles. Knight ranks second in C-USA in hits (44), slugging (.695) and total bases (82), third in hits per game (1.47) and fifth in RBI (34). Knight has picked up six, three-hit games this season and has recorded a pair of three-double games which ties a school record. Through eight weekend series in 2021, Knight has hit .350 or better in five of them.

NINERS UP TO #18 IN LATEST NCAA RPI HEADING TO APP STATE

The 49ers have jumped up to #18 in the latest NCAA RPI ranking as of Monday. The strength of schedule sits at #51 with key wins over Tennessee, Rhode Island (twice) and Western Carolina, all ranked in the top-50 RPI, helping the 49ers.

4-0 FIU WEEKEND, 8-0 vs. STATE OF FLORIDA

Charlotte continued their Conference USA roll after sweeping a four-game series at FIU April 9-11. The 49ers opened up with an 11-8 victory on Friday, swept the Saturday DH 5-4 and 3-1, before closing out the weekend 9-5 on Sunday afternoon. **Will Butcher** led the way hitting .412 on the weekend as Charlotte hit .323 as a team while holding FIU to a slim .193 average. **Carson Johnson** followed with a .400 average on the weekend with **Jack Dragum** sitting at .385. The four-game sweep of FIU comes on the heels of a four-game sweep at home against Florida Atlantic giving the Niners a perfect 8-0 record against both C-USA schools from the state of Florida.

NATIONAL LEADERS

Entering the weekend with #20 Old Dominion, the 49ers currently lead the country with 86 doubles on the year with Austin Knight's 21 also leading the country. Charlotte also sits 3rd nationwide with 375 hits and 10th with a .307 batting average. All categories lead Conference USA.

SWEEPING FOUR FROM FAU; 7-1 START IN C-USA; BACK TO RECEIVING VOTES

The Niners put together a perfect 4-0 league weekend sweeping Florida Atlantic at Hayes Stadium April 2-4. Charlotte opened with a 9-5 victory on Friday with a five-run fourth, another win on the mound by **Bryce McGowan** and three-inning save by **Jackson Boss**. A pair of dramatic victories followed on Saturday as **Carson Johnson** completed a 5-for-5 game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the eighth for a 9-8 game one win. In game two, **Craig Keuchel** delivered the walk-off single for a 5-4 victory in game two as the Niners rallied with a run in the sixth to tie on a **Todd Elwood** RBI single and Keuchel's game-winner in the seventh. In Sunday's 11-10 win, the Niners scored multiple runs in four innings and saw Johnson's two-run single in the seventh provide the difference as Charlotte had to hold off FAU in the ninth with the go-ahead runs on after the Owls scored four in the frame. The 49ers hit .355 in the four-game series-sweep, have started a C-USA best 7-1 in league play and are back to receiving votes in the latest NCBWA poll released earlier in the week.

JOHNSON COLLECTS HITS IN SEVEN-STRAIGHT AB's; A NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Carson Johnson flirted with a rare school-record during the Florida Atlantic weekend April 2-4 collecting seven hits in seven-straight at-bats. A single in Johnson's final AB of the 9-5 win on Friday started the streak, a 5-for-5 day with a double, HR and walk-off single in the bottom of the eighth pushed the streak to six before the final hit in Sunday's finale adding a couple of walks. Johnson's streak is third-best all-time and just one behind Associate Head Coach **Bo Robinson** who had eight. For his entire weekend production, Johnson was named one of the nation's player of the week by Collegiate Baseball.

OFFENSE BACK ON TRACK

The 49ers have gotten the offense back on track with a 9-1 record over their last 10 games, a 7-1 start to C-USA play and all off a four-game sweep of FAU April 2-4. The Niners are hitting .331 over the last 10 with seven guys hitting over .300 playing in at-least half of the 10 and scoring 89 runs for an average of nearly nine per game (see page 9). The hot start in C-USA play sees a team average of .333 with six guys hitting at-least .300 and an 11 runs/game average (see page 6). In the recent four-game sweep of over the Owls, a .355 average over the weekend, 11 hits per game average and seven players again hitting at-least .300.

OPENING C-USA WITH 3-of-4 AT WKU

Charlotte began 2021 Conference USA play by taking three-of-four at WKU March 26-28. The Niners scored a 7-4 victory in the opener behind six strong innings from starter **Bryce McGowan**. McGowan fanned a career-high 10 in the win while **Christian Lothes** went the final 2.1 innings to record the save. In game one of Saturday's doubleheader, it was five shutout innings from **Austin Marozas** to get the day going with the final two frames from **Casey Bargo** in a 6-0 victory. Marozas allowed just four hits with four strikeouts while Bargo struck out two. **Aaron McKeithan** got the scoring going with a two-run double in the third while **Jake Cunningham** capped off the day with his first career home run, a two-run shot, in the visitors sixth. In game two, a Nate Furman RBI triple down the right field line in the top of the eighth was the difference in a 5-4 victory as the Niners moved to 2-0 in extra innings. In the series finale, it was a wild 17-16 victory for WKU in 10 innings. The Niners saw a 7-0 deficit turn into a 15-7 lead, that lead disappear and requiring a run in the top of the ninth to help force extra innings.

MAKING HISTORY IN 15-5 ROMP OF APP. STATE IN KANNAPOLIS

For the second time in six years, the 49ers got to play the first official game at a new minor league facility doing so on March 23rd at Atrium Health Ballpark, home of the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. During the first-ever game in the \$52 million facility, the Niners scored 15 runs on 18 hits to rout their in-state opponent App. State by 10. **Gino Groover** collected a career-high four hits and three runs scored as one of seven players with multi-hit nights. **Hale Sims** got the win on the mound tossing four innings of one-hit ball adding six strikeouts for new career highs in all three categories.

SERIES WIN OVER RHODE ISLAND

Charlotte scored a series win over visiting Rhode Island March 20-21 in a newly-scheduled series due to COVID cancellations with both teams' opponents. The 49ers used a 2-1, 10-inning walk-off walk in game one of a doubleheader at Truist Field in Uptown Charlotte on Saturday before doubling up the Rams 6-3 in Sunday's rubber game at Hayes Stadium. **Austin Knight** led the way hitting .455 in the series with four doubles, three in Saturday's game two alone, marking the first time a Niner had accomplished that feat since Jackson Mims did so against #17 Wake Forest back in April of 2017. **David McCabe** hit a solid .400 on the weekend while **Gino Groover** collected a career-high three hits on Sunday in a .364 series against the Rams.

BOMBS FROM BOTH SIDES

Charlotte's **David McCabe** became the first 49er since 2017 to homer from both sides of the plate doing so on Friday, March 12th at #9/#14 East Carolina. McCabe belted a two-run shot in the fourth from the right side before sending a mammoth 430-foot blast to right from the left side in the sixth. McCabe was the first since T.J. Nichting did the same back in February of 2017 at home vs. Rider. McCabe is currently second in the country with eight HR's on the year.

SHUTTING OUT #14 TENNESSEE

Charlotte picked up their biggest win of the season on March 9th by shutting out #14 Tennessee 9-0 inside Hayes Stadium. The Niners saw **Will Butcher** homer twice and start a historic string of going back-to-back-to-back with **David McCabe** and **Gino Groover** in a four-run seventh. **Austin Marozas** got the win with a superb six innings of shutout ball allowing just the five total Tennessee hits and struck out three. It was the Niners first win over a nationally-ranked opponent since topping #4 Arkansas 6-3 back in March of 2018.

CLINCHING 1,200TH WIN IN NATIONAL FASHION

Entering the 2021 season, the 49ers sat just eight wins away from hitting 1,200 as a program which began in 1979. The 49ers eighth win of the year to hit 1,200 came on March 9th in a dominant 9-0 shutout over #14 Tennessee. Gary Bartley was the first coach in Niners history from 1979-1981 followed by Gary Robinson (1982-1991), Jeff Edmonds (1992), Loren Hibbs (1993-2019) and now led by Robert Woodard. Over 450 players have worn the 49ers uniform, including those on the 2021 roster.

McCABE'S HITTER OF THE WEEK HONORS

David McCabe was named C-USA's Hitter of the Week on March 1st after leading the Niners to a second-series sweep, this one over William & Mary. McCabe opened up Saturday's doubleheader blasting a pair of two-run homers before adding a double to complete a 3-for-4 game one driving in four and scoring three. In game two, McCabe scored in the four-run first after reaching on an error before delivering a single in the second. Charlotte swept the Saturday DH 7-1 and 4-0. In Sunday's 20-4 rout, McCabe ended the weekend the exact same way he started with a two-run bomb to left-center capping off a 2-for-5 day with three more runs scored. McCabe ended the series hitting a team-best .462 with three homers, seven runs scored and six driven in. The Canadian added a walk and stolen base while also going error-free at first base in 27 chances.

SECOND-STRAIGHT SWEEP

The Niners picked up their second-straight series sweep to begin 2021 after doing so against William and Mary February 26-28. Charlotte won the opener 7-1 behind seven strong innings from **Andrew**

Lindsey who moved to 2-0 allowing one run on two hits with seven strikeouts. **David McCabe** hit a pair of two-run homers a part of a three-hit game one. Game two saw **Austin Knight** hit a three-run shot... In the series, Charlotte hit .352 as a team with 38 hits, 10 of those leaving the yard, with 31 runs scored.

OPENING WEEKEND DOMINATION

Charlotte picked up a season-opening sweep of Morehead State with dominant hitting and pitching February 19-21. The 49ers won the opener 12-4 behind six innings from **Andrew Lindsey** who took a perfect game into the fifth, only allowed one hit with six strikeouts, in his debut. Charlotte used a five-run second frame to get the offense rolling led by a three-hit afternoon by **Austin Knight**. **Rafi Vazquez** and **Craig Keuchel** each homered in the win. In Saturday's slugfest 18-3, Knight powered a seven-run frame with a grand slam as the offense scored in seven of their eight innings at the plate. **Christian Lothes** got the Saturday win going five with eight strikeouts while three relievers combined to hold the Eagles hitless over the final four frames. To complete the sweep Sunday, a Knight three-run homer, a Keuchel insurance blast in the eighth and more quality pitching saw **Bryce McGowan** earn his first win of the year after seven strikeouts with **Sam Grace** notching his first collegiate save with a perfect ninth to secure a 4-2 victory.

RAKING AT THE PLATE, NEARLY UNHITTABLE ON THE MOUND

Charlotte hit .343 as a team opening weekend with 37 runs on 34 hits in the three games cranking out eight bombs and 29 RBI. **Craig Keuchel** led the way hitting .583 (7-for-12) with three homers, five RBI and six runs scored while **Austin Knight** trailed right behind hitting .538 (7-for-13) with a couple of homers, including his grand slam, adding three doubles, eight RBI and five runs scored. **Rafi Vazquez (.429)**, **Aaron McKeithan (.400)**, **Dominic Pilolli (.385)** and **Carson Johnson (.375)** gave the Niners a total of six starters who hit at-least .375 on the weekend. On the mound, 14 pitches held Morehead State to a .144 average on the weekend posting a 2.33 ERA in 27 innings of work. A total of 45 strikeouts were racked up by the staff while giving up just seven earned runs on 13 hits.

TOP TWO DRAFT PROSPECTS IN C-USA; SEVEN FROM 49ERS

A total of seven 49ers were ranked inside the top-30 by D1baseball.com as top prospects in the upcoming 2021 MLB Draft. **Bryce McGowan** and **Christian Lothes** found themselves at the top of the list ranking first and second in the league. **Andrew Lindsey (12th)**, **Austin Marozas (13th)**, **David McCabe (20th)**, **Casey Bargo (22nd)** and **Dillon Phillips (27th)** all made the list.

JUCO RECRUITING CLASS RANKED #7

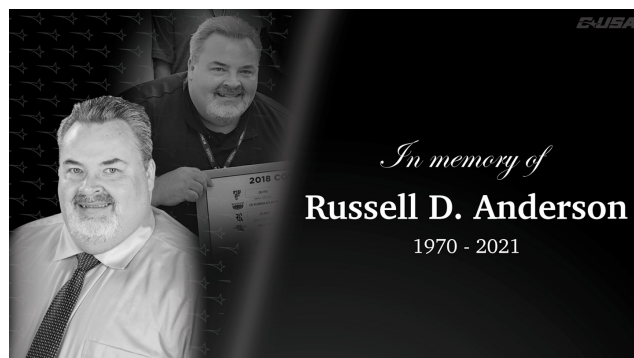
In early December, Charlotte found themselves ranked #7 in the country for their JUCO recruiting class spearheaded by assistant coach **Toby Bicknell**. A total of 14 JUCO transfers make up the class as Charlotte was the only C-USA school represented and finished ahead of Miami, Kentucky and South Carolina.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

Charlotte began the 2021 season with 44 players on the roster that includes 26 newcomers. Pitchers make up 24 of the 44 on the roster with the class breakdown as follows: Seniors (6), Juniors (6), Sophomores (18) and Freshmen (14). In all, 30 players are MLB Draft eligible.

WOODARD ERA CONTINUES; QUEEN CITY CONNECTIONS

A new era of Charlotte baseball began in 2020 as Head Coach **Robert Woodard** took over at the reigns of the 49ers. In his first season, Woodard led the Niners to a 9-8 record which included a seven-game win streak at home in late February and ended the shortened-season with a thrilling 9-8 win at #9 NC State on March 10th. Woodard comes back home to Charlotte, a Myers Park HS product, after spending three seasons as pitching coach at his alma mater North Carolina. Woodard, a nationally-recognized pitcher at UNC from 2004-2007, finished his collegiate career 34-5 including a perfect 22-0 record at home. Woodard has rounded out his 2021 coaching staff with Charlotte natives **Bo Robinson**, **Toby Bicknell** and **Tyler Simmons** along with adding Austin Meine (Pitching Coordinator) and Eric McKibban (Baseball Performance) in the offseason.
