East Carolina (American Athletic Conference) and Old Dominion (Sun Bet Conference) are both unranked heading into Saturday's contest.

EAST CAROLINA

Feel free to call us East Carolina or ECU. However, we respectfully ask that the erroneous designation of Eastern Carolina or flawed abbreviations such as E-Carolina, East-Car, ECaro, EC never be used.

THE GAME

East Carolina hits the road for the first time this season traveling to Norfolk, Va. to take on Old Dominion. This is the second of four-straight non-conference games as the Pirates will host Appalachian State (Sept. 14) next week and travel back to Virginia to face Liberty (Sept. 21). ECU holds a 4-0 overall advantage in the series with ODU earning win in 2013, 2018, 2019 and 2022 (see page 2 for more information).

EAST CAROLINA RECORDS, STREAKS & TRENDS

- ▶ Forced at least one turnover in 40 of the last 44 games (and in 51 of the last 58) ...
- ▶ Since the start of 2023, ECU's defense has scored four touchdowns (2/ASU '23, 1/UTSA '23, 1/NSU '24) ...
- ▶ With its 42-3 win over Norfolk State, ECU won its first season opener since 2016 when it defeated Western Carolina 52-7 inside Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium ...
- ▶ The Pirates tallied 506 yards of total offense against the Spartans - a first since 534 at Temple in 2022 ...
- ▶ Jake Garcia, in his first start as a Pirate, passed for 308 yards marking the first ECU quarterback since Holton Ahlers (300 yards) in the 2022 TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl to throw for 300 or more yards in a game ...
- ▶ Thirteen different ECU defenders recorded at least a half TFL in the opener against Norfolk State - In all, ECU tallied 17.0 for minus 50 yards, the most in a game by a team since racking up 15.0 at ODU in 2018 ...
- ▶ Recovered five fumbles against Gardner-Webb in 2023 (most in Mike Houston era) - a first since setting that standard against TCU on Nov. 23, 2002 - a span of 253 games ...
- ▶ Registered first defensive shutout with a 44-0 win over Gardner-Webb in 2023 (last time was on Sept. 2, 2000; 38-0 over Duke) - a span of 285 games ...
- ▶ Stood among the NCAA leaders (Top 40) in 13 categories in 2023 - see page 7 ...
- ▶ Earned bowl eligibility in two of last three seasons under Mike Houston (2021-22) ...
- ▶ Won its first bowl game since 2013 with a 53-29 victory over Coastal Carolina (TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl) ...
- ▶ Set single-season record for average yards per play (6.6) surpassing 6.5 ypp ('14) in 2022 ...
- ▶ Led the NCAA in fewest fumbles lost (2) and turnovers lost (7) in 2022 ...

FAST FACTS

ECU's contest against the Monarchs will be the Pirates' 931st since the start of football in 1932 (465-454-11/506).

THE HEAD COACH

MIKE HOUSTON (Mars Hill '94) is in his 14th year as a collegiate head coach with a 105-59 (.640) mark, while he is 25-34 (.424) in his sixth season at East Carolina. When he officially became the Pirates' 22nd all-time head football coach on Dec. 4, 2018, Houston finished a three-year stint directing the James Madison program. Houston signed a contract extension with the Pirates securing his position through the 2026 season. Houston guided the Dukes to a 37-6 mark, which included three NCAA FCS postseason appearances (2016 national champions, 2017 national runner-up, 2018 second round) and a pair of Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles. He was named the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) FCS National Coach-of-the-Year in 2016 after JMU turned in a 14-1 campaign.

The appointment to the top Dukes' football position followed brief head coaching assignments at Lenoir-Rhyne (2011-13) and The Citadel (2014-15). He led the Bears to a 29-8 ledger and a pair of NCAA Division II playoff showings before guiding the Bulldogs to a 14-11 record, a Southern Conference co-championship and a venture into the FSC playoffs in 2015.

Houston, a Franklin, N.C. native, began his collegiate coaching career as defensive coordinator at Brevard College in 2006 before serving in a similar capacity at L-R from 2007 to 2010.

AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE WEEKLY HONORS

ECU quarterback Jake Garcia was named to The American's weekly Honor Roll after leading ECU to a 42-3 opening weekend win over Norfolk State ... The California native completed 23 of 36 passes where he threw for 308 yards with four touchdowns and three interceptions ... His 300-plus yard effort was the first for a Pirate QB since Holton Ahlers threw for 300 yards against Coastal Carolina in the 2022 TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl.

AT DOWDY-FICKLEN STADIUM

East Carolina's all-time record at Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium is **202-119 (.630)** ... The Pirates opened the facility on Sept. 21, 1963 with a 20-10 win over Wake Forest in front of 17,000 fans, celebrated the stadium's 50th anniversary in 2013 and recently hosted its 300th game vs. Tulane in 2020 ... ECU played seven home games in 2022 posting a 4-3 record ... Before a 4-2 clip in 2021, a 1-3 record two years ago and a collective 13-19 mark from 2015-2019, ECU was 5-1 in 2014, 2013 and 2012 (15-3) and won a combined 10 of 12 home matchups in 2009 (6-1) and 2008 (4-1) ... With its 34-13 win over UCF (Oct. 22, 2022), ECU posted 41 winning campaigns at DFS since 1963.

ON THE ROAD

Since becoming a conference member in 1997, East Carolina is 67-103 (.394) when playing away from Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium ... This season, the Pirates are 1-5 following a 10-0 loss at Navy ... Last year they posted a 4-2 road slate (wins at South Florida/Boca Raton, Fla., BYU, Temple and Coastal Carolina/Birmingham, Ala.; losses to Tulane and Cincinnati) ... From a non-conference standpoint, ECU snapped a seven-game skid when it topped Old Dominion 24-21 on Sept. 28, 2019 but has only played five road non-AAC tilts since (2-3).

NON-SATURDAY MAYHEM

East Carolina is 23-31 in non-Saturday games since 2000 ... Oddly, the Pirates have fared better on the road (16-15; 7-16 at home) ... In terms of days (including bowls), ECU is 5-1 on Sundays, 1-1 on Mondays, 3-1 on Tuesdays, 0-3 on Wednesdays, 8-13 on Thursdays and 6-12 on Fridays ... Most recently, ECU is 12-16 when deviating from the normal Saturday routine since 2010 ... The Pirates had one non-Saturday game in 2023 hosting SMU inside Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium on Oct. 12 (loss/31-10) ... In 2022, ECU played three non-Saturday contests posting a 2-1 ledger (win at BYU/27-24, win vs. Coastal Carolina/53-29; loss at Cincinnati/27-25) ... With their win in Provo, Utah the Pirates became bowl eligible for the second-straight year under Mike Houston.

During its 17-year membership in Conference USA (1997-2013), East Carolina tallied an overall 78-50 (.609) regular season league record - 35-29 (.547) on the road and 43-21 (.672) at home, which led to pair of conference championships in 2008 and 2009 ... The Pirates closed out their C-USA home slate by winning nine-straight, 21 of their last 23 and 29 of their last 35 ... During its last two years of membership (2012 & 2013), ECU turned in perfect league home records (4-0) on the way to a combined 18-8 mark (13-3 in conference play).

A SINGLE-GAME RECORD-BREAKER

With an attendance total of 51,711 against NC State on Sept. 3, 2022, ECU established a single-game home record - surpassing the 51,082 clip who watched the Pirates beat North Carolina on Sept. 20, 2014 ... In all, East Carolina has enjoyed sell out crowds for 13 contests since Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium was expanded in 2010:

LOOKING FOR MORE LOOT

After one game in the 2024 season, East Carolina sits a -4.00 in turnover margin (ECU 6, Opponents 2) ... The Pirates turned the ball over six times (3 fumbles, 3 INTs) against Norfolk State marking the most since they gave up seven against UAB in 2011 ... East Carolina finished the 2023 campaign with a -0.42 turnover margin (ECU 21, Opponents 16) ranking 101st nationally ... The Pirates tied a program-best record with eight forced fumbles against Gardner-Webb recovering five (most in the Mike Houston era) - a feat that they last accomplished on Nov. 23, 2002 against TCU (span of 253 games) ... The Pirates also scored three defensive touchdowns on the season (2 at Appalachian State, 1 at UTSA) ... A year ago, the Pirates finished with a +13 turnover margin forcing 10 fumbles, recovering nine and picked off 11 passes for 154 return yards ... Against UCF, ECU forced a season-high four turnovers (3 INTs, 1 fumble) and had five multi-turnover games on the year ... Despite its impressive 45-3 win, East Carolina's 16-game streak of forcing at least one turnover came to a halt against Temple on Nov. 6 (2021) ... The run, which began on Oct. 3, 2020 at Georgia State and produced 36 takeaways (22 interceptions, 14 fumble recoveries), was the program's longest since a 33-game streak (from 2007 to 2010) ... In all, ECU still has at least one takeaway in 40 of the last 44 (and 51 of 58) contests, as well as 21 of 26 games dating back to the start of the 2022 campaign.

CONRAD SETS SCHOOL MARK; TIES NCAA RECORD

East Carolina place kicker Andrew Conrad had career game in the Pirates 22-7 win at Florida Atlantic (Nov. 11) ... The sophomore connected on all-five field goal attempts (a new ECU single-game record) and converted on one PAT for a personal-best 16 points, which ranks as the third most points by a place kicker in program history ... Conrad tied an NCAA record for most field goals made in a game of 40 or more yards (46, 47, 43, 46, 40) and became the second player in AAC history to connect on five FGs of 40-plus yards in a contest ... His mark is also tied for the second-most FGs in a game by an AAC kicker and his performance was the seventh time at ECU that a kicker posted a 100.0 percent accuracy rate in a single game with at least four attempts ... For his performance at FAU, Conrad was named The American Special Teams Player of the Week and College Football Network Special Teams Player of the Week ... More on Conrad's record setting day:

1999 PIRATES TO BE RECOGNIZED AT UTSA GAME

East Carolina University Athletics officials have announced that the 1999 Pirate Football team will be recognized at the UTSA game on Saturday, Sept. 28 inside Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium.

The 1999 season was one of perseverance following the catastrophic damages left behind from Hurricane Floyd, which impacted Eastern North Carolina on Sept. 16. ECU started the season 2-0 after wins against West Virginia and Duke before traveling to South Carolina. Prior to the Pirates' 21-3 win in Columbia, S.C., Floyd made landfall and much of Eastern North Carolina received 15-20 inches of rain over the next 12 hours.

Unable to travel back home, the Pirates stayed in Columbia, preparing for what would have been their home game against the ninth-ranked University of Miami Hurricanes. With portions of the city still reeling from the flood, the game was moved to Raleigh, N.C., and Carter-Finley Stadium. Trailing 23-10 after the third quarter, ECU rallied from 20 points down to defeat the Hurricanes and improved to 4-0.

The 1999 team finished with a 9-3 overall record, played in the 1999 Mobile Alabama Bowl against TCU and was the recipient of the 1999 Disney's Wide World of Sports Spirit Award at the annual Home Depot College Football Awards.

GREENVILLE, N.C. - New faces in vital places laid the groundwork Saturday night as an inspired East Carolina football team took a big step to putting the 2023 season in the rear-view mirror by dominating FCS visitor Norfolk State 42-3 at Dowdy-Ficklen Stadium.

With transfer quarterback Jake Garcia directing new offensive coordinator John David Baker's up-tempo offense, the Pirates churned out 506 total yards, surpassing their yardage for any game during last year's season.

Despite six turnovers and seven penalties, the Pirates easily delivered head coach Mike Houston his first season-opening win in six seasons at the helm. Much of that thanks goes to a smothering defense that yielded just 114 total yards and forced 12 punts.

"Six turnovers, which means we gave them six extra possessions," Houston said. "It's staggering the score is what it was. I think that shows, number one, how good we can be on that side of the ball. But number two, I think that shows you if we can get that corrected, we've got a chance to be a pretty good ballclub."

That's what linebacker Zakye Barker is counting on, given the transfer additions and new mind-set.

"Wins are hard to come by," said Barker, who recorded a team-high eight tackles. "It's a great feeling. It's a great thing for this team, it's a great thing for the city of Greenville, all the Pirate fans to see us win and get that winning feeling back and understand that's what it is going to be like from now on."

The charismatic and confident Garcia plays an integral role in trying to make that happen as he takes over at quarterback. The 6-3, 203-pound junior, suiting up for his third different school in as many years, won a preseason battle with Michigan State transfer Kaitin Houser to earn his second career start. In just his 10th career game overall and first action in 21 months, he completed 23 of 36 passes for 308 yards with four touchdowns and three interceptions.

Houser came on for the final two series and connected on all three of his passes for 50 yards.

The two combined to distribute the ball to 10 different receivers.

"I feel like I played well," said Garcia, who spent two years at Miami and one season at Missouri. "There's a lot of things I wish I could take back. It was good to get my feet wet again and take some snaps and get hit a little bit when the live bullets are flying. A win is a win, and at the end of the day I know for a fact I'm going to build on it."

Garcia said he embraced the opportunity to come to ECU and help change the direction of the program.

"The past is the past," he said. "The people that were here (last year), you have to go into it and keep a chip on your shoulder and have something to prove every day. The guys that weren't here, we're just going in and with a winning mind-set. We're the group that's going to do it. We're a group of winners. We're going to win each and every week."

Garcia had plenty of company among newcomers making key contributions.

Florida State transfer Winston Wright Jr. delivered a pair of impressive kickoff returns - a 29-yarder to open the game and a 48-yard sprint that set up the Pirates' first touchdown of the year. He also had three catches for 24 yards.

Tight end Casey Kelly, a graduate transfer from Oregon, accounted for one score, taking a toss from Garcia in the left flat and rumbling 22 yards to the end zone. He finished with three receptions for 35 yards.

Maryland transfer Gavin Gibson, a junior cornerback, picked off a Jalen Daniels pass and returned it 30 yards for a second-quarter touchdown.

Speedster Anthony Smith made the most of his first collegiate start with a career-best and team-high five catches for 86 yards, highlighted by an 18-yard touchdown to make it 35-3 early in the third quarter.

"This is my first college start ever so I had a little first-start jitters the first drive, but once we got going, I felt so good out there," said Smith, who compiled just 13 receptions in four years at NC State. "It was super, super exciting to be out there."

Houston stressed the importance of the newcomers' impact, especially in the new world of NIL and transfer portals.

"I think it's important for them to come in here and justify why they came here," Houston said. "All of them came here for a reason. They came here for a fresh start, a second chance or for whatever reason. I think it's important for our donors to understand the importance of NIL. Obviously, it played a huge role in us retaining our top players and us being able to attract these guys to East Carolina."

Barker, one of the Pirates' returnees from last year's disappointing season, is glad to have more ammunition.

"Every addition that came to this roster was specifically placed for success, whether that be the offensive side or the defensive side," he said. "We all bought in. Everybody that you saw on that field has bought in and put the work in."

Barker led an ECU defense that limited the Spartans to just 43 yards on 45 rushing attempts and just one third-down conversion in 18 attempts.

After 34 yards on their opening drive, which ended in a 39-yard field goal, the Spartans managed just 80 yards the rest of the night and finished with only seven first downs.

All told, it adds up to a season-opening win and momentum heading on the road to Old Dominion next week.

"Everybody is going to wake up and the sun is going to be a lot brighter in the morning, but I am a little frustrated or disappointed, I guess, because I know what we could have done tonight," Houston said. "... But we're 1-0, and we know we've got to be much better next week if we're going to be 2-0. But you can't be 2-0 if you don't win this one."
