## **NFHS Rules**

- 1. K, 4/10 @ K's 30 YL. K1 punts the ball beyond the NZ. R1 gives an invalid FC signal. A flag is thrown on R1 yet no whistle is blown to end the down as the signal was invalid. Ruling: A valid OR invalid FC signal ends the down whether the signal is given beyond, in or behind the NZ. Rule: 4-2-2-g.
- 2. K1's KO is muffed by R1 at RT's 3 YL, the ball rolls across R's GL. R1 picks up the ball in his EZ and is downed at R's 25YL. Ruling: The original force is K1's KO. Once the ball crosses R's GL it's a TB. Rule: 8-5-3-1 and 2-13-3.
- 3. A, 4/1 @ A's 40 YL. B1 enters the field and assumes his position as a punt returner. B1 then realizes A's not punting and immediately leaves the field. After the snap A1 is stopped short of the LTG. Ruling: Illegal substitution on B1. B1 became a player when he positioned himself in the formation. B1 must remain in the game for one down unless a penalty is accepted, a dead ball foul occurs, there is a charged TO, or the period ends. Result: After the penalty is accepted it's A, 1/10 @ A's 45 YL. Rule: 3-7-3.
- 4. On a Try A's captain informs the **U** they want the ball placed on the right side HM. The **R** sounds the RFP then A1 calls TO. After the TO A's captain requests the ball to be moved to the center of the field. Ruling: This request is denied, once the ball is placed & the ball marked RFP. It may not be moved by a 2<sup>nd</sup> request unless a dead ball foul occurs or a foul occurs during the down and the penalty is accepted. The R needs to ask the scoring team HC each time where they want the ball placed for the Try. Rule: 4-3-6, 4-3-7 and Case play: 4.3.6 Sit.
- 5. A, 3/7 @ B's 25 YL. At the snap A77 (tackle) goes 4 yards downfield. Realizing he should not be downfield he retreats behind the NZ. A2 then throws a forward pass to A3 at B's 15 YL. Ruling: Penalty on A77 for ineligible illegally downfield. The prohibition for ineligibles downfield for A starts at the snap. A77 retreating behind the NZ before the forward pass was thrown has no bearing on the ruling. Rule: 7-5-12 and Case Play 7.5.12 Sit. A.
- 6. During a successful 2 pt. Try B1 roughs the passer. Ruling: A will accept the score and have the 15 yd. penalty enforced on the ensuing KO. Rule: 8-3-5 and Case play 8.3.5 Sit. B
- 7. Prior to the opening KO KT is not on the field to start the game. The **R** flags the KT for a 5 yard delay of game penalty. **Ruling: Incorrect penalty. This is s 15 yd. UNS penalty on K's HC.** *Rule: 9-8-1-g-2*

## **OHSAA Mechanics**

- 8. On Try-Run A1 is downed just short of the GL. The LM & LJ both mark FWP. Ruling: The R is the only official to signals "no good" to the PB. Correct Mechanics by the LM & LJ. Gold Book: page. 24- #35.C.5.
- 9. It is a very rainy and muddy night. A2 goes OOB without contact. A2 comes back in and catches A1's forward pass. The LJ drops his BB where A2 went OOB and his flag where A2 re-entered. Incorrect. On a muddy field YELL the player's number loudly where they go OOB. Gold Book: Pg. 14- #19-A.

## **OHSAA Regulations**

10. The PC must be corrected a 4<sup>th</sup> time. The **R** informs the HT PB to turn the PC off and that the PC will be kept on the field by the **BJ**. **Ruling: Correct.** *Gold Book: Pg. 36 #15.A.*
