### NFHS Rules

1. During a Try, A decides to go for a 2-point conversion. The Try is successful. During the Try B32 is flagged for DPI. A's HC is told he/she must decline the penalty to keep the 2-points or accept and replay the untimed down. **Ruling: Incorrect. A does have the option of accepting the foul and retrying the untimed down half the distance to the goal. However, A undoubtedly will keep the 2-points and accept the penalty, and have it enforced from the SS. Rule: 8-3-5 and case play 8.3.2 Sit. C**
2. A, 1/10 @ B's 40 YL. A12 scrambles and ultimately hands the ball forward to A32 @ B's 40 YL. A32 was a running back in the backfield at the snap. **Ruling: Legal. The ball can legally be handed forward if A32 was in or behind the NZ. Rule: 7-3-2 and case play 7.3.2 Sit.**
3. A, 3/5 @ B's 35 YL. Team A has two # 4's participating during the same down in a varsity game. The **Crew** does not throw a flag. **Ruling: Incorrect. This is Illegal Numbering which carries a 5 YD penalty. Rule 7-2-5c**
4. Team K comes out for a try-kick. The holder does not have a tee. The **R** tells the holder he/she must use a tee. K is forced to go for a 2-point conversion as they do not have a tee. **Ruling: Incorrect. Nothing in the Rules state a tee is required. The only requirements for a tee are the maximum height and material a tee must be made of when a tee is used. Rule: 1-3-4.**
5. A, 3/G @ B's 4 YL. :02 seconds remain in the 4Q with A trailing by 3. Runner A30 falls on top of a B player @ B's 2 YL but doesn't touch the ground. The **LJ** blows his whistle as A30 jumps up and runs into B's EZ. The **Crew** gets together and determines this was an IW by the **LJ**. The **R** signals the game is over by raising the ball. **Ruling: NO. Since the IW occurred during a down in which the period expired the period shall be extended by an untimed down. Rule: 3-3-3c**
6. A calls a TO. Immediately after the TO is over they call a second TO. The **R** tells them they cannot call 2 timeouts in a row. **Ruling: Incorrect. Successive TO's may be called in the same dead all period. Rule: 3-5-4**
7. FK from K's 40 YL. While K10's kick is still airborne, R21 runs and blocks K10 @ K's 44 YL. **Ruling: Foul for illegal blocking (15 YDS) by R21. The kicker cannot be blocked until he/she has advanced 5 yards from K's FK line. Rule 9-3-4a**

### OHSAA Mechanics

8. 4<sup>th</sup> & very close to a 1<sup>st</sup> down. The **HL** yells for the ball. The **U** tosses the **HL** the ball to place down at his/her feet. **Ruling: Incorrect. The U shall never toss the ball to the official who yells for it. The U shall take the ball and hand it to the official. Reference: Gold Book page 13, #11-D**
9. During a quick pass to the HT side of the field, A80 is hit and driven backward. The **LJ** tries to get the spot but is confused to where A80 was when he/she was hit and drove backward. He/she guesses. **Incorrect. The LJ should use cross-field mechanics and look across field for help from the HL. The HL needs to move in to the hash mark & mark FWP for the LJ. Reference: Gold Book page 13, #13-B**

### OHSAA Regulations

10. GC operator is continuously not stopping the GC. The **Crew** must keep resetting the GC. **Ruling: After the 3<sup>rd</sup> time the GC must be corrected it can be turned off and the LJ keeps the GC. Gold Book: Pg. 36 #9-A.**
