We have three Superstars to celebrate this week:

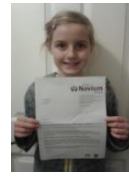
Anya Baker - Walnut Class

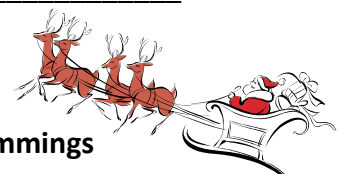
