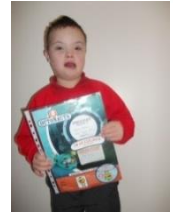
Lola Lovett – Cedar Class

Harry achieved Octonauts certificate for his swimming success and great kicking



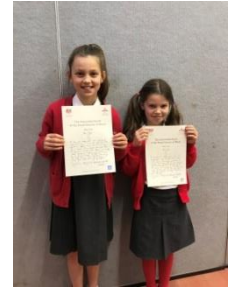
Ethan - Cedar Class
