What are you allowed to do with the product?	<p><u>You are free to:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Use the product for your internal technical evaluation.</li> <li>✓ Create value added product (e.g. mosaic) and derivative work (e.g. map, report) for your internal technical evaluation.</li> </ul> <p><u>You may not :</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Distribute, sell and otherwise make available the product nor value added product to third parties.</li> </ul>
