(**Weather, Events**) It was the hottest July in the past 126 years since statistics began in 1898. Some areas experienced disastrous heavy rains before the rainy season ended.

(**Business at TRIAL stores**) High temperatures stimulated demand for summer products. Robust demand for daily necessities expanded the number of customers which resulted in the solid SSS growth rate.

<u>Food:</u> Grocery - confectionery and salt candy grew. Daily - ice cream contributed to sales. Fresh - fresh food and ready meals such as seasoned meat and eel showed strong performance.

Non-Food: Marine products such as swim rings and barbecue supplies struggled to perform as the people refrained from going out due to the extremely hot weather. On the other hand, seasonal home appliances such as fans rose the sales.
