THE BAPTISM

Jesus said, 'Let the children come to me. Do not stop them'.

We thank God for Alfred who has come to be baptised today. Christ loves him and welcomes him into his Church. So I ask you all:

Will you support Alfred as he begins his journey of faith? **We will.**

Will you help him to live and grow within God's family? **We will.**

God knows each of us by name and we are his. Parents and godparents, you speak for Alfred today. Will you pray for him, and help him to follow Christ? **We will.**

We all wander far from God and lose our way: Christ comes to find us and welcomes us home. In baptism we respond to his call.

Therefore I ask:
Do you turn away from sin?
I do.

Do you reject evil? **I do.**

Do you turn to Christ as Saviour? **I do.**

Signing With The Cross

The minister makes the sign of the cross on Alfred's forehead saying:

Christ claims you for his own. Receive the sign of his cross. Do not be ashamed of Christ. You are his for ever.

against all the powers of evil, and remain faithful to Christ to the end of your life.

May almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness, and lead you in the light and obedience of Christ. **Amen.**

The minister prays over the water

Praise God who made heaven and earth, who keeps his promise for ever.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. It is right to give thanks and praise.

We praise you, loving Father, for the gift of your Son Jesus. He was baptised in the River Jordan, where your Spirit came upon him and revealed him as the Son you love. He sent his followers to baptise all who turn to him. Now, Father, we ask you to bless this water, that this little one who is baptised in it may be cleansed in the water of life, and, filled with your Spirit, may know that he is loved as your child, safe in Christ for ever.

Amen.

The people affirm their Christian faith

Let us affirm, together with this little one who is being baptised, our common faith in Jesus Christ.

Do you believe and trust in God the Father, source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist?

Do you believe and trust in God the Son, who took our human nature, died for us and rose again?

Fill them with the light of your presence and establish them in the joy of your kingdom, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

God of grace and life, in your love you have given us a place among your people; keep us faithful to our baptism, and prepare us for that glorious day when the whole creation will be made perfect in your Son our Saviour Jesus Christ. **Amen.** Welcome to Alfred, the minister says:

There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism. By one Spirit we are all baptised into one body.

We welcome you into the fellowship of faith; we are children of the same heavenly Father; we welcome you.

GOSPEL READING: Mark 8:27-end

- ²⁷ Jesus and his disciples went on to the villages around Caesarea Philippi. On the way he asked them, 'Who do people say I am?'
- ²⁸ They replied, 'Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, one of the prophets.'
- ²⁹ 'But what about you?' he asked. 'Who do you say I am?' Peter answered, 'You are the Messiah.'
- ³⁰ Jesus warned them not to tell anyone about him.
- ³¹ He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again. ³² He spoke plainly about this, and Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him.
- ³³ But when Jesus turned and looked at his disciples, he rebuked Peter. 'Get behind me, Satan!' he said. 'You do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns.'
- ³⁴ Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said: 'Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. ³⁵ For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me and for the gospel will save it. ³⁶ What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? ³⁷ Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul? ³⁸ If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels.'
