The Diocese of Southwark offers many excellent ministry courses for training and refreshment. These are shown in the mini booklets which you will find at the door, or ask the Rector.

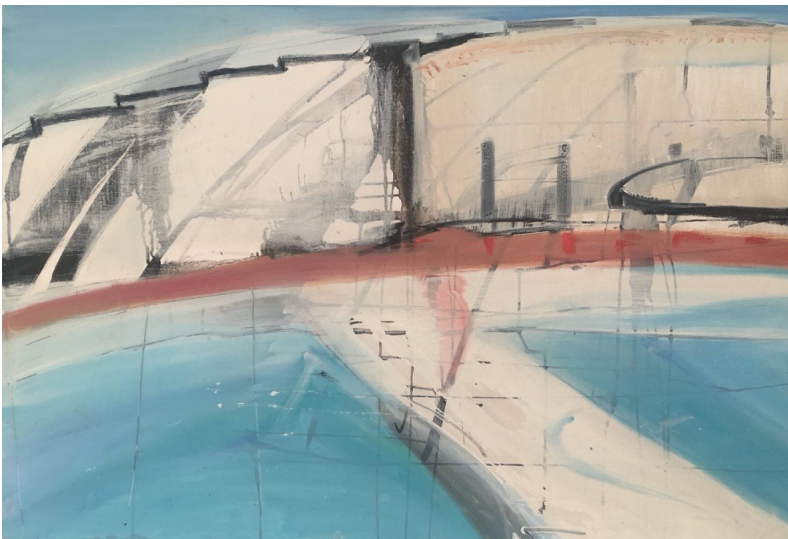
VOLUNTEER(S) needed to organise Christmas Day Lunch
