

ST EDMUND'S FINANCIAL UPDATE

I am very pleased to let you know that we have just paid the last instalment of the repayment of the loan we got from the diocese to help us with the replacement of the heating system in 2013. That will free up a bit more income to spend on other building projects. We have spent some £2,500 already this year on the building – a lot of things seem to have failed or broken at the same time! We have about the same

amount of expenditure in the plan for the second half of the financial year. In an ideal world we would do more, but we have to tailor our plans to the available resources.

Whilst we could always spend money on the building, the DCC's other key priority is to continue to contribute as much as we can reasonably afford to the Parish Support Fund (PSF). This is because – as I have been repeating ad nauseam for years – it pays for the clergy! Standing Committee, endorsed by DCC last week, decided to make an inflation-related increase in our PSF pledge for 2019 of 2.5% (rounded), so that we shall be contributing £21,780 next year. This is only possible because of the continuing generosity of the congregation – very many thanks to all! **Chris Treasurer St Edmunds.**

Regular Worship Survey

As you may be aware attendance figures for the Church of England are widely acknowledged to be falling throughout the country. There are, of course, exceptions to the rule but in general the trend is downwards.

Here at St Antony's and St Edmund's our attendance figures have also declined. New members have joined the electoral rolls but the decline remains evident. Whilst we are aware that the decline is partly due to people moving away, moving to other churches or natural decline due to ill health and death, another significant issue appears to be that those that do attend Church choose to do so less frequently than previously.

Therefore, the DCC's have jointly decided to ask members to complete a short Regular Worship Survey. This will take place during the services on **Sunday 29th July** and anyone who does not get the opportunity to complete one on that day will be able to do so over the next couple of weeks. The survey is anonymous though you may add your name if you wish (*).


Once the results are reviewed we hope to gain a clearer insight into the challenges our members are facing and we will seek to address them wherever possible.
