when their anger flared against us;**

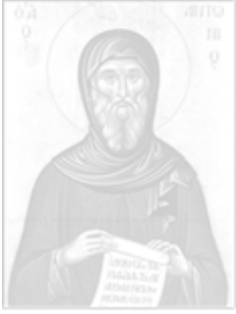
**⁴ the flood would have engulfed us,
