Green Team Tip of the Week

Each week, your Green Team plans to bring you a Tip of the Week to help you be even better stewards of God's lovely creation (and probably save you money too!).



Tip 1

When you need a pound of apples, don't buy 2 and throw one away on the way home! "Don't be silly, of course we don't do that", I hear you say (at least I HOPE I hear you say that!).

BUT THAT'S EXACTLY WHAT YOU DO WHEN YOU PUT TWICE AS MUCH WATER IN THE KETTLE THAN YOU NEED.

It takes twice as long to boil, uses twice as much energy, and costs you twice as much. When you come for your next cuppa, it'll have gone cold (and you might even top it up AGAIN).

Empty your kettle, (and clean the cruddy scale off while you're at it) put a cupful of water into your kettle (or 2 if you ALWAYS make 2), (add more if the element isn't at least $\frac{3}{4}$ covered) and note, or better still mark, where it comes up to.

If you have say 4 cups of tea a day, you could save 36kWhr every year (100Wh per cup) and that's if you only overfill by 1 cup, most people actually overfill a lot more!

Finally, remember, even the combined might of All Saints and St Anthony's can't save the planet alone, so **SPREAD THE WORD!**
