Live Streaming of services at St Edmund's

On Sunday 2nd December we live streamed the 10am service for the first time. This has attracted considerable interest and at time of writing (3 Dec) this has been viewed by over 150 people world-wide.

Following the success of the unplanned live streaming of the community Remembrance service, the DCC decided at the November meeting that this is a good way to expand our outreach and evangelism to those who may not otherwise attend church. This reach is world-wide but I have been told by the Diocese of Southwark's Communications Department that we are the first church they are aware of in the diocese to attempt this and they would like to encourage more to do it.

We will be live streaming our 10am service at St Edmund's regularly from Sunday 16 December and most of the Christmas services too. You will be able to find links via the parish website.
