

Tip 7 Don't heat rooms you're not using



This week's tip is simple, just turn off the heating on rooms that you don't use. Certainly guest rooms etc, but you can extend it by not heating bedrooms during the day and living rooms during the night-time (and day time too if you are out all day). There is a common myth that is better to keep the heating on all day than to let it cool off and then heat it up again when you need it. This is almost NEVER true, the rate you lose heat is directly related to how much warmer the house is than outside, so as your house cools, it is losing less energy than if you try to keep it warm all the
